I don't have any definite evidence that Elizabeth Simmons was the first wife of Francis Scrivener. I'm basing this on circumstantial evidence, particularly the name of George Scrivener. This is the first instance of George in this line and I'm assuming that he was named for his maternal grandfather. George Simmons was a neighbor of Francis Scrivener and his daughter Elizabeth was of the right age to be married to Francis. Elizabeth Simmons was not married when her father wrote his will in 1764. Francis and his first wife married abt 1770 and had their first child, Mary abt 1770. Francis and his first wife named a daughter Elizabeth. Also their daughter Ann named a daughter Elizabeth S. Dowell.

(II) Richard Pindle, son of Rev. Henry and Mary Belt (Sprigg) Camden, was born in Collin's settlement, near Weston, Harrison county, Virginia, November 19, 1810, died at Parkersburg, January 9, 1876. (The county designations, here and in the former paragraphs, are given according to the county divisions in force at the dates; Weston is in Lewis county, according to the present division.) Educational opportunities were very meagre in the new and sparsely settled country where his youth was passed, but by force of character he made of himself a gentleman acceptable in all circles. In early life he entered into mercantile business, at Weston, with Weeden Huffman, and by close attention to business he laid the foundation of a large fortune. Later, on account of his health, he abandoned mercantile activities and was engaged in cattle raising and banking. In all branches of business with which he was connected he earned a fine reputation for skill and judgment, also for rigid exactness and strict honesty in all transactions. At the time of his death he was president of the National Exchange Bank, at Weston, and was carrying on one of the largest grazing farms in his state, although he was living for the greater part of the time at Parkersburg. His death was due to the effects of a kick from one of his horses. Mr. Camden was a man firm in his convictions, sincere in his attachments, affable in society, affectionate and devoted in his domestic relations; he had the regard of upright men, the respect of all who knew him, and the warm affection of his relatives and friends. He was not inclined to public affairs, and only once held a state office. In the legislature of 1866 he consented to serve in the hope of soothing the asperities due to the civil war and of bringing about a more kindly feeling between the opposing parties. On account of the pressure of private business and his disinclination for public life, he refused a re-election.

Mr. Camden married, at Weston, June 2, 1870, Flora, born at Clarksburg, Harrison county, Virginia, February 15, 1841, died at Parkersburg, April 7, 1912, daughter of Granville G. and Charlotte (Despard) Davisson. Her grandfather was George I. Davisson, born April 29, 1786, died November 4, 1836; he married, September 9, 1809, Jemima Pindall, born October 3, 1790, a sister of the celebrated lawyer of Clarksburg, Colonel James Pindall. Granville G. Davisson was born June 25, 1810, died April 6, 1856; his wife was born May 2, 1817, died February 28, 1851; they married in 1837. -Yesterday Mrs. Charles P. Culver received the sad intelligence by telegraph that her husband, who went to Texas for his health a short time ago, was rapidly failing, and that there was little ground for hope. She hastened to make ready to go thither, but before the train started she received another telegram stating that he was dead. Mr. Culver has been for many years a resident of this county, and had a large circle of relatives and friends to whom this blow will be very heavy. He has been in very poor health for several years, and went to Texas in the hope that the climatic change might have a beneficial effect. Mr. Culver's mother started with the remains, for this city, this morning. The ~ for the funeral will be announced hereafter.

OBITUARY.

CHARLES P. CULVER.

This afternoon train from the South brought to this city the remains of the late Charles P. Culver, the notice of whose death in Texas has already been made. A number of friends gathered at the depot and from thence proceeded to the late residence where the funeral services were held. Rev Mr Sawin conducted the services after the usual form. A quartet consisting of Mrs Ruger, Mrs Sanderson, Mr D D Bennett and Mr John Wingate sang appropriate music. Messrs W H Tallman, E D Tallman, D Strunk, Mark Ripley, E T Foote and Dr L J Barrows served as bearers.

Mr. Culver was born in Chih <not sure of spelling>, near Rochester, New York, in June, 1828, and was therefore in his fifty-first year. He has resided in this county for thirty-three years, and has during this long residence gained a large circle of acquaintances and many friends, who not only heartily sympathize with the wife and three children upon whom the blow falls the heaviest, but who also feel that the loss is one in which they too share. His death was not wholly unlooked for, though coming sooner than was expected. For nearly two years his health had been poor, and he has during that period travelled much of the time, in the hope that some climatic change might be invigorating. He beneficially spent several months in St. Paul, and one winter he tried the climate of northern Georgia. About the middle of last month he went to Texas, accompanied by his mother, who had been with him on all these journeys but the change was in vain, and soon the sad news flashed over the wires that he was not more.

Mr. Culver was a man of kindly spirit, and void of all ostentation. To all he was courteous and genial, ever inspired respect and esteem, but it was only his friends who really saw the wealth of character which he possessed, and who truly appreciated his good qualities of mind and heart. He was acquainted with many. He was known by few. He was a man of sterling integrity, a man who had a mind of his own, who was never ashamed to express his opinion, and however it might differ from the opinion of others, they never doubted that he was honest in his views. In all his dealings he was prompt and reliable. In fact there was much true manhood in him.
