On April 1, 1780, at age 15, he volunteered as a private in the United States army under Capt Samuel Rosamond. They marched to Beach Island near Augusta, Georgia. . He became ill and eventually went home and rejoined Capt Rosamond in May 1780. He recounted in his pension application that Charleston had fallen and the area was dangerous for the friends of liberty as there was rape and plundering and inciting and influencing the Indians on the borders of South Carolina ...savage acts of cruelty and outrage toward the Whigs and they the Tories frequently themselves taking the lead in the plunder and depredation. This state of things existing at the time in full energy against the the comparatively few friends of liberty in Carolina give to these friends almost constant and active employment in appeasing in every manner theythis double enemy until a third enemy, the British under Col. Crugen affected a lodgment of their forces in the District 96 at a place called 96 or sometimes Cambridge which force together with their allies the Tories and the Indians kept the surrounding settlement or country in a subjected state until the arrival of Gen Greene with his forces before Cambridge to which he laid siege and to which place the Whigs of the country flocked to aid the besiegers in driving or expelling the British. John Hodges was marched in Capt Rosamond's company with all the Whig militia of the country who were all under the command of Col.Pickens to succor and aid Gen Green in his advances against Col. Crougen at Cambridge or 96 and continous there in active employment against the beseiged British under Gen Greene until he raised the seige in June 1781and marched his force as well as the forces under Pcikens towards the Cor(r)gan (???) River in this state at which post and to theof South Carolina to check the tories in that section of country according John Hodges in Capt Rosamonds company was marched back to the District 96 and the soon after discharged. John Hodges at the seige of Cambridge lost a horse saddle and bridle appraised at \$100 which fell into the hands of the British for which he never received one cent in any way towards the payment for his loss directly or indirectly.and that from the best of his recollection he computes this tour of service and duty to be at least nine months.

5th son of James Hodges and Elizabeth Jones Weatherall. Story is that Ab was the "wild one".

Ab and Frances were married by 1857. They farmed near Dumas, MS, and owned their land which was worth \$400. They already had Betsy, Mollie, and Abbie had just been born when Ab enlisted in the 34th Regiment Mississippi Infantry in Holly Springs, MS in April, 1862. His record said he deserted and was captured on September 11, 1863, near Chattanooga, TN. In Stevenson, AL, he took the Oath of Allegiance on September 17, 1863, and was paroled on September 27, 1863. He apparently went home to as we know now very hard and difficult conditions. In the 1870 census, they seem to be farming somewhere else near Ripley and appear to not own the land they are farming. There are six children now, Dora, Ottie, and James have been born. During the 1870's they had Leonora, Nancy, Eliza, and Sallie. By 1880, daughter Betsy had married Thomas Jefferson White and they had all moved to Prairie Township, AR. The census says Ab and Tom are both farm laborers. Hodges family lore in MS is that several of the children died in AR (and we have no further record of Dora,

James, or Sallie, and I am confused about "Ottie" since my grandmother's notes say she had an aunt named Ottie Hodges Brown). There are no records of Ab and Frances' deaths. Hodges family lore in MS is that Ab was murdered in a cotton field, and that at that point the rest of the children moved to OK. Mollie married Jefferson Davis SANFORD 1882. When the children moved to OK, Eliza lived with sister Mollie Sanford's family and Nancy lived with sister Betsy WHITE'S family.

Thomas Jefferson White and Frances Elizabeth Hodges White (Grandpa and Grandma White):

My Grandpa White raised apples. Winesap apples mainly. Dad built a cellar for him to put the apples in for storage. Grandpa would go down there in the wintertime and cull them out. He put straw down in the bottom of the wagon to protect the apples and took them around the to sell by the peck all the way to as many bushels that you wanted.

They were living about a mile and a half west of Grandview School. He weighed about 170-175 pounds and was about 5 feet 11 inches. She weighed less than a hundred pounds. I think he died in 1924 and was buried at Crittenden Cemetery. There were living the Grandview area at the time mama and dad married. They lived in Arkansas before and had lived in Mississippi before that. The house where I was born was half a mile south of where they lived.

Grandpa White and grandma got up at 4:30 the year round. In the wintertime he would go out and harness his horses if he was going to be working them. They didn't have a well. They had a cistern. It was dug I don't know how deep, probably 25 feet. They caught rainwater. That was their drinking water. In the early twenties they had a well drilled. It took the guy two maybe three years to drill it. It went down 350 feet before finally they got water. When they got it up and drank it, it wasn't any good. IT had an oil scum on it

I like to go by Grandpa and Grandma White's house on the way home from school so I could get an apple from their root cellar.

Grandma White chewed tobacco. She would keep chews up on the top part of the porch by the roof.

When I would sun bath during the summer and Grandma would get on to me! She told me that she and her sisters, Eula and Fannie, would make a paste out of flour and water and cover their skin with it when they had to pick cotton so they would not get dark and leathery. She always said "Well, I'll swan". She loved to eat toast with butter and sugar at night. And did that woman love Jesus! She never once in her life drank alcohol or tobacco, never touched a playing card, and never danced. But she did love to sing. Once when I was in college I went to Wichita and could not get her on the phone. Finally tracked her down. She had been at the hospital sewing lap blankets for the old people. She was 80 at the time.
