

# *Descendants of Robert Levi INGLE*

## *Generation No. 1*

1. ROBERT LEVI<sup>2</sup> INGLE (*ISAAC HENRY*<sup>1</sup>) was born 1820 in Madison, Buncombe, NC, and died Dec 1889 in Prairie Township, Marion, AK. He married MALINDA ROBERTS Abt. 1848 in Madison, Buncombe, NC, daughter of ROBERT ROBERTS and MARY DEWEESE. She was born 1820 in Madison, Buncombe, NC, and died in Prairie Township, Marion, AK.

### Notes for ROBERT LEVI INGLE:

(Robert) Levi Ingle, b. March 1820 served in the Co. 60th NC Infantry, Light Artillery. He was captured after the Battle of Nashville, on Dec. 17, 1864, and marched to Louisville, KY, the held at Camp Chase, OH until he swore an oath of allegiance to the Union in March of 1865.

After the war, he moved his family to Marion County, AR.

Malinda Roberts (Mary (Polly) Deweese, Rev. Garrett, Henry) was born in Buncombe Co, NC around 1818.

She married Levi Ingle. Levi was born in 1819 or 1820. Enlisted Civil War age 42 in April 1862 Levi was the son of Isaac Henry Ingle and Mary (Ingle).

Levi Ingle was named as the husband of daughter Malinda in the settlement of the estate of Robert Gaines Roberts about 1840 in Buncombe Co, NC. In 1850 in the Census of 1850, Levi was listed as a head of household in Buncombe Co, NC. In 1860 in the Census of 1860, Levi was listed as a head of household in Madison Co, NC. 12 April 1862 at age 42, a resident of Madison County, he enlisted in Buncombe County in Company A of the 60th NC Infantry Regiment.

In 1880 Levi was listed in the 1880 Census as a head of household in Marion Co, AR. 12 June 1885 Levi purchased 162.58 acres in Twp 17N Ranges 17W, Sec. 6 and 18W, Sec. 1 & 12 in Marion Co, AR.

Malinda was named as a married daughter in the settlement of the estate of Robert Gaines Roberts about 1840 in Buncombe Co, NC.

Moved from Arkansas to Indian Territory in 1903. Moved to Broken Arrow in 1919.

"Dad (J.A. Ingle) sat on the first jury ever held after Okla became a statehood- 1907 wasn't it? Anyway, we came to Okla 1903 in the winter and Dad was one of the first law men after statehood. The old Indians Cherokees would come to our house at all times during the night (drunk) wanting Dad to take them home. He'd bring them in the house and tell them to lay down in front of the fireplace and go to sleep. We'd be right there in the same room scared to death-ha-old Isock Greece and old Gee Dick-remember them Mary. Our first county Supt was Will Gromley and my teacher to (later) Dad bought our organ from Old Appletree Smith (such names)."

Notes for CORTUS INGLE:

Obit: Cortus Ingle, the youngest son of J.A. Ingle and wife, died at this home in the north part of Tahlequah, last Saturday with typhoid fever. Cortus was 17 years, 6 months and 10 days old, and he first saw the light of day in the state of Arkansas, but he spent the better part of his life in or near Tahlequah. He was a fine young man and to know him meant to love him, for he was not of the rowdy class. Rev A. W. Culver preached the funeral at the residence Sunday afternoon at 3:30, and his message fraught with loving kindness went straight home to the hearts of all who heard them. Undertaker J.B. Grindle had charge of the body and it was laid to rest in the Blue Spring cemetery Monday at high noon. The bereaved parents of this young man, his brothers and sisters all have our heartfelt sympathy and at any time we can speak word of consolation we are glad to do it. Friends, think, his passing may be of benefit to us all some day. Our thoughts on so grave a subject follow: .....our summons come.....loved ones gone be---spirit be our guide....the right.

She always said "Well, I'll swan". She loved to eat toast with butter and sugar at night.

And did that woman love Jesus! She never once in her life drank alcohol or tobacco, never touched a playing card, and never danced. But she did love to sing. Once when I was in college I went to Wichita and could not get her on the phone. Finally tracked her down. She had been at the hospital sewing lap blankets for the old people. She was 80 at the time.
