James Stevenson lived in Pointville NJ and immigrated to Lapeer Co, Michigan. His wife Catherine died in Michigan and the children were living with friends and relatives in the 1860 Lapeer Co MI Census. James came to Morgan County Mo and had an orchard. He died while visiting his son, Joseph in Arkansas.

June 20, 2003 in researching the IGI at familysearch.org, I came across information that gave the month and day of birth for James and his family. My records show James born Oct 11, 1802, this record shows him born Nov 10, 1802. I believe that this information was submitted by my cousin, Bruce Keeler before his death as both his parents are listed and both sets of grandparents. Bruce's mother, Leona had done much research on the family and had supposedly obtained a copy of James Stevenson's Bible. Neither Richard nor Rachel were listed as children of James & Catherine.

Information from Aunt Paula Stevenson Herbold that was told to her by her father, Billy Stevenson as related to Polly Campbell Hunter

My great grandfather, James Stevenson came out to Missouri in a wagon pulled by oxen. He originally owned a place out of Versailles, had a peach orchard. And he was the only person who cast a vote for Lincoln. A posse waited at the crossroads under the old hangin' tree. He rode his horse, by chance, out the other road-he was a very determined man. My father said James went back to New Jersey after he lost his eyesight. Seems he regained his eyesight after he was 80 years old. Then he and my great uncle Joe Stevenson went to Lonoke, Arkansas and homesteaded a couple of sections of land. Had it under cultivation before he died. That great uncle of mine came to see us when I was quite small, He was a widower then, had some sons. For a few years we wrote those boys. Uncle Bill Stevenson went to Australia but kept in touch with the family, spent his entire life there.

Now, your great grandpa, James Cross Stevenson, ran away from home when he was 12 years old, got to New York City (from New Jersey)9I got this from my father). He lay down on the ground at Battery Park (where all the ships land) sound asleep. A sailor came along and kicked him. A big black man, knocked the sailor out picked up my grandpa and took him on board the ship he was on, put him to bed, fed him and made a cabin boy out of him. My grandpa told father the big black man shook his head and said, "Pore little feller, he be better off if he were dead." My grandpa heard hm and thought, "I've got it made, food, good bed, etc." So there he stayed with the black man and become a sailer, sailed all the Great Lakes here. he never married for many years-into his late 40's, came out to MO. went through the civil war and then married Harriet Murphy. Aunt Paula also said that she was told both the old Lawrence and Stevenson homes still stand in Burlington, NJ, buses take tour to them, they passed out of the owners hand after the Boer war - taxes could not be paid - government took over.

There was an old wedding certificate and silver of Stevenson family. The eldest in my grandfather Stevenson's family old aunt Mary Swain, fell heir & her son sold to a lawyer in Philadelphia. It was signed by Wm. Penn. This after he death - I was told also all of their old silver service etc was givento the museum.

Also handed down that Capt. James Lawrence (of "Don't give up the ship") was one of our Lawrence family. One of the Stevenson ancestors had married Elizabeth Lawrence in 1672 in NY. The Lawrence family had been high up in England and knew the people in government. Seems as tho these Stevenson's in New Jersey had become quite prosperous and married well. The ones who came to MO. didn't fare so well.

Lillian said that James Cross was a basket maker and also made chair bottoms. he also hwas a sailor some of his life. Lillian's brother Aaron said that he thinks he inherited his love of the sea from his grandfather James Cross. Aaron worked on ships most of his life and was torpedoed twice in WW II and was picked out of the waters both times, once in a life raft, the other with just a life jacket.

West of the house was an orchard. One night when Mary Elizabeth was a child they heard a rumbling sound. The next morning the apple trees had sunk down to tree top level. One time Clayton entered the cave that was on the south side of Hwy TT and followed it under the road up in a field close to their house. In some places you could walk up right and in other places you had to crawl on your hands and knees. He found a dinosaur tooth that disappeared when the house was rented after his death. Their daughter, Bessie Gant obtained the land with the house on it after Emily Alice died in 1928 and Mary Elizabeth Renfro obtained the land on the south side of the road, known as 80 acres. This land had been a grant to Charles Miller from Teddy Roosevelt. Clayton acquired this land around 1880.

My mother (Emly Alice Benham) passed away March 28, 1928 at my home in Sedalia, MO and James Stevenson never lived in Arkansas. He died in Morgan Co, MO. [not sure last statement is correct]

September 8, 1972

My aunt Mary (Stevenson Swaim) had a number of children and I use to hear from a married daughter before I was married. I new my aunt and uncle were Methodist, she wrote that she had a book of the Stevenson History so there must be someone in the area that would no where the other children are. I sure would like to of had that book. The Stevenson man married a Jennig on girl was where the Estate was in England. So my father (Clayton) always said and his grandfather (Joseph born 1772 who married Rachel Peterman), my father's grandfather was quite well to do and he deeded all his land and money to a younger son. And my father's father had no more to do with him.

July 10, 1973

My father (Clayton Stevenson) was born in NJ and reared in Michigan. US Grant was a cousin to his mother (Catherine Cross Stevenson) and Robert Louis Stevenson was supposed to be related from away back.

This letter was deciphered by Anna Burns Renfro written to her by Mary Stevenson Renfro. I can not find a date on the letter. "There was Royal blood connected in Stevenson Family. Her father (Clayton) said his grandfather & a great uncle hired 2 laywers to go to England to collect the Estate & they came back & didn't do any good. Her father (Clayton) always thought the lawyers were bought off. She never saw either of her grandparents as they were dead when she was born. Her brother Ruben and sister Anna saw her grandmother on her mother's side (Emily Jane Porter). Her father (Clayton) was a cousin of U S Grant that is their mothers were first cousins. (Still can't be proved). Her father's mother (Catherine Cross) was the mother of 13 children & she died young (1853 in Dryden Michigan). She left a tiny baby girl (Rachel). Clayton had 3 sisters that she received letters from. She was named for her Aunt Mary Swim in NJ. An older brother[Bill] went to Australia when he was 20 years old & few years before her father passed away they got letters from him. She said that red hair ran in her family from her grandfather (I B Benham)on her mother's side. He was Irish & her mother's parents came from NY State. I B passed away when her mother (Emily Alice Benham) was 6 years old. Her grandmother (Emily Jane Porter) remarried & had 2 girls by a (William) Fair. "
