

Descendants of Ågota Nilsdatter Fylkesnes

Generation No. 1

1. ÅGOTA NILSDATTER² FYLKESNES (*NILS¹ FILIPPUSSEN*)¹ was born 1836 in Fylkesnes in Bremnæs, Norway², and died 1913. She married (1) HANS HANSSON ALVSVÅG^{3,4,5}, son of HANS ALVSVÅG and GYRI ÅDNANES. He was born 1826 in Alvsvåg [farm], NORWAY [Finnås parish, near Bremnæs, on Bømlo], and died 1875⁶. She married (2) GUNNAR NILSSON LITLANESET 1878. He was born 1849 in Hallaråker⁷, and died 1929⁷.

Notes for ÅGOTA NILSDATTER FYLKESNES:

Alma Eritsland wrote: "My mother's mother [Aagot] had brown eyes and wavy auburn hair. Her father's eyes [Hans] were very blue. All the children had hazel eyes.

"When my mother was still a young girl, her father died. My mother said she overheard her father and mother talking before he died. Evidently they had been much in love and had vowed never to marry any other, but since there were so many children, he advised her to marry again, which she did later."

-- On document giving Oscar Eritsland's ancestors, Aagot (his siblings' grandmother) is referred to as having the last name "Nielsen." However, this is probably an error: being a daughter, Nilsdotter or Nilsdatter is probably correct. (Their father's mother is listed as Larsdatter, not Larsen.)

email from Betty (Lowe) Wulff, Jan 2002: " After Hans died, Agota married Gunnar Nilsson Litlaneset, who, it seems, had lived on Eritsland farm. (Aunt Hilda told me that she recalled our grandma Eritsland relating to her the overhearing of her mother, Agota discussing with other adult relatives or friends that she would have to remarry now that husband Hans had died, in order to help run the farm and finish raising the children.)

They had one daughter, Hanna, who died unmarried. After Agota died, Gunnar married Barbru Olive Olesdatter. They had no children.

Notes for HANS HANSSON ALVSVÅG:

"In 1865 he had 1 horse, 7 cows, 4 sheep and 1 pig. He grew 3000 kg oats and 2000 kg potatoes in one year. At that time this was good." (Source: Josef Nesse, his great-grandson in Oslo, letter to Lis Angus Jan 4, 2002)

[email from Betty (Eritsland) Wulff, January 2002:] They wrote this about him in the Bygdebok District Book: "This man did well for himself in his 49 years" or some such, listing all he left in worldly goods, (excluding children) so many horses, cows, pigs, and tilled land of oats, barley, potatoes, etc. ending with "HAN STOD SEG BRA." - which means literally that "he stood so well."

Note from great-granddaughter Brit Langkaas, April 2002: "The township of Bømlo consists of one large island named Bømlo, and a great number of small islands, among them Hiskjo. In 1975 Hiskjo was connected to the south part of Bømlo by a bridge, and in 2001 Bømlo was connected to the mainland by bridges and a submarine tunnel. This tunnel, about 8 km long, is placed in Bømlafjorden. It starts on the mainland in Valevag (north of Haugesund) and ends on a very small island named Føyno in the middle of Bømlafjorden. At its deepest it is 260 m below sealevel. It is the longest submarine tunnel in Europe. On Føyno there are two large bridges (each about 1 km long) going to Bomlo and to the island of Stord.[Anna Marie.FTW]

Marriage Notes for ÅGOTA FYLKESNES and HANS ALVSVÅG:

Alma Eritsland (Ågota's granddaughter) wrote: "My mother's mother [Ågota] had brown eyes and wavy auburn hair. Her father's eyes [Hans] were very blue. All the children had hazel eyes. When my mother was still a young girl, her father died. My mother said she overheard her father and mother talking before he died. Evidently they had been much in love and had vowed never to marry any other, but since there were so many children, he advised her to marry again, which she did later."

Notes for GUNNAR NILSSON LITLANESET:

second husband of Ågota Hansen born Nilsdotter. Gunnar and Ågota lived first in Alvsvåg. In 1894 Gunnar bought Litlaneset and they moved there. When Ågota died, Gunnar married Barbru Oline Olsdatter, the widow of Ingemar O. Svortland. Barbru died in 1920. Barbru and Gunnar had no children.

(Bomlo Bygdebok, quoted in email by Brit Langkaas, April 2002. Brit adds "It seems to me that Gunnar must have been a very good man, as he twice married a widow, and the first time a widow with 6 children! And Gunnar himself was 13 years younger than Ågota!")

Marriage Notes for ÅGOTA FYLKESNES and GUNNAR LITLANESET:

from Bømlo Bygdebok: "Gunnar believably leased the farm Alvsvåg when he married Ågota, and he was a holder until he (in 1894) moved to Litlaneset, under Ersland. The place Litlaneset was drawn into the farm Ersland." - translation by Brit Langkaas.

She says "In Bomlo you have many names with the ending "våg" (eg Alvsvåg) and "nes" (e.g. Fylkesnes). "Våg" means bay, and "nes" means headland. The name Litlaneset means "the little headland."

As for why Gunnar leased Alvsvåg (when presumably Ågota owned it after her husband died) -- this may have been an arrangement to ensure that inheritance of Alvsvåg did not leave Ågota's children: it defined the relationship of Gunnar -- and any eventual children of Gunnar and Ågota -- to Alvsvåg as that of tenant, not owner. That is presumably why Gunnar later bought Litlaneset.

2. BOL JOHANNE HANSDTR³ ALVSVÅG (ÅGOTA NILSDATTER² FYLKESNES, NILS¹ FILIPPUSSEN) was born 1861 in

Alvsvåg , NORWAY [Finnaas parish, near Bremnæs, on Bømlø], and died 12 Mar 1946 in Marietta, Minnesota¹⁰. She married ANDREW O. DAHLE¹¹ 12 Nov 1892 in Winneshiek County, Iowa, USA. He was born 07 Jul 1858 in Norway¹², and died Oct 1946 in Marietta, Minnesota¹².

Notes for BOL JOHANNE HANS DTR ALVSVÅG:

"She emigrated to the US around 1887. She married Andrew O. Dahle (a widower with children) in Winneshiek County, Iowa, November 12, 1892. The family moved to Marietta, Minnesota around 1902. Andrew O Dahle had 8 children: Ue, Jetmund, Margaret, Andrew, Gerhard, Helmer, Bernard, and Casper. The older children were born to Andrew O. Dahle's first wife, and the younger children were born to our great-aunt Johanna Hanson Dahle - these younger children were our mothers' first cousins. Johanna Hanson Dahle died in 1941 and is buried in the Marietta cemetery. Andrew O. Dahle's son, Jetmund (called "Jappe") married Anna Marie's oldest daughter, Lydia Eritsland, around 1910. Jappe and Lydia had 10 children (5 are still living - 2001). I [Iris] was at their Marietta farm in the summer of 1957." [email from Iris von Tettenborn Nast, Sept 5 2001.

She says "Much of the above information is jotted on the back of a photo of our great-aunt's grave taken by Kimary [Nast] in the early 1980s, when she visited some of our Dahle relatives still living in the Marietta area."

The first thing he did was show me a picture of your Mom, Alma, at about 19 yrs. of age-she was beautiful, telling me that he and she had corresponded for years. He was Haldri's third of four children. Haldri's eldest, Martin Solberg, was the father of Hanna and Ingeborg [married to Jonas & Knut Knutsen]."

Brit Langkaas (email July 2003) "When Ole Larsson Ersland moved to Oldereid, the family (or at least some of them!) took the surname Oldereid."

ANNA MARIE HANSDTR³ ALVSVÅG (ÅGOTA NILSDATTER² FYLKESNES, NILS¹ FILIPPUSSEN)^{25,26} was born 30 Apr 1867 in Alvsvåg, NORWAY [Finnås parish, near Bremnæs, on Bømlo], and died 03 Dec 1963 in Alhambra, AB, Canada²⁷. She married LARS ANDREAS PEDERSON ERITSLAND 25 May 1889 in St. Paul, Minnesota (Ramsey County), son of PEDER OLSEN and LARINE LARSDATTER. He was born 07 Nov 1864 in Eritsland [farm], NORWAY [Finnås parish, near Bremnæs, on Bømlo]²⁸, and died 02 Jun 1930 in Leslieville, AB, Canada.

Notes for ANNA MARIE HANSDTR ALVSVÅG:

Her great-grandniece Brit Lankaas (granddaughter of Anna Marie's youngest sister Lydia Kristine, in email message from Norway February 2002) says " We used to call her [Anna Marie] only by one name, Marie, and that was the name she also used herself in her letters to my grandmother." Anna Marie's daughter Alma (Eritsland/von Tettenborn) confirmed this: "Apparently my mother was always called Marie."

Alma wrote: "She came to the USA in 1888 [a year before Lars] but they were engaged in Norway. They took up residence in Ridgeway, Iowa, where they lived about 13 years."

Betty (Lowe) Wulff forwarded a note written by Hilda (Eritsland) Stratton:

"Lars Pederson and Marie Hanson met as teenagers when they went for religious instruction at their church. Lars was then apprenticed to learn the painting trade -- had a year to finish. My Aunt Johanna -- my mother's sister -- had gone to America in 1887 or 1888 -- auntie was disappointed in love. Their mother said it would be better if the two of them (my mother and my aunt) went over together. Whether they left at the same time I don't know. Anyway I can only know that papa and mamma were married in 1889 - they lived in St. Paul Minnesota for a while then moved to Iowa, to a place a couple of miles north of Ridgeway - Iowa -- Mamma had worked there with Auntie the year before."

Earlier in the same note Hilda says "Papa's father was Peder from Eritsland place in Norway. Norwegian custom was to call the children by father's name which made papa Pederson -- but in Iowa there were so many Pedersons -

Petersons & so on their mail got mixed up. When Uncle Peder and Papa bought land in Minnesota they decided on Eritsland the name of the farm they came from in Norway. Our cousins in Madison Wisconsin knocked the IT out of Eritsland and called it Ersland."

Alma Eritsland wrote: "My mother's mother [Agota] had brown eyes and wavy auburn hair. Her father's eyes [Hans] were very blue. All the children had hazel eyes. When my mother was still a young girl, her father died. My mother said she overheard her father and mother talking before he died. Evidently they had been much in love and had vowed never to marry any other, but since there were so many children, he advised her to marry again, which she did later.

Alma also wrote: "My mother said she had scarlet fever when 10 years old and 'died.' At least everyone thought her dead, though she was aware of what went on. She said they even measured her for her coffin (all home-made then.) I don't know how they discovered she was not dead. Anyway she grew up to raise a large family and live to be almost 97 years old.

"My mother came to America in the spring of 1888 on the ship 'Eldorado' from Bergen to Hull, England one or 2 days, arriving on a Saturday, then by train to Liverpool. She admired the fields of England, such a contrast to rocky Norway. After a week in Liverpool, left on a Saturday morning on the ship 'Etruria' came to New York on a Sunday night one week later. Came by train to Ridgeway, Iowa, May 6 where her sister Johanne was already working at Aakre. Johanne had come over at least a year before. I heard a rumor she had left Norway because of a disappointed love affair, but am not sure. Anyway, Johanne probably helped with her fare. Aakre was not a town but a family, fairly enterprising and well to do. / After a few weeks my mother went to St. Paul Minnesota and worked (housework) for about a year." [see continuation on Lars Andreas' entry]

Alma continues "... he [Lars Andreas] and my mother were married in St. Paul, May 28, 1889. That fall they went back to Ridgeway (Winneshiek County) - lived there till 1901 or so. [Note: in 2002, according to <http://www.usacitiesonline.com/>, Ridgeway had a population of about 295 (127families); so who knows what size it was in 1901!]

"Children born in Ridgeway: Lydia (died), Lydia, Hilda, Oscar, Emma, Paul. Then they moved to Nassau, Minnesota, where they had 4 more children: Ida, Agnes, Alma & Esther. [Nassau is about 4-5 mi north of Marietta, MN)

Note: apparently they moved first to Marietta -- where they lived with Anna Marie's sister Johanne and husband Andrew Dahle before buying Peg Lake farm in Nassau in 1902. (email from Iris Nast, May 2002 -- based on note written on photo of the house they lived in in Marietta, by Kimary Nast when she visited that house and the Nassau house in August 1982 with Mel and Myrtle Dahle.)

more from Alma: "In Nov 1909 they moved to Eugene Oregon, then in July 1916 to Alberta Canada. In Eugene they had a 100 acre farm, and 2 houses in the city, but one was small. This they traded, sight unseen, for 2 quarter sections in Alberta.

"My mother enjoyed telling that after they were married, my father had 3 cents left in his pocket. He had wages coming at the end of the week, but it made a good story anyway."

email from Betty (Lowe) Wulff, January 2002: "the house they lived in in Nassau still stands, well kept by owners who welcomed us in to see the 'L.P. Eritsland' carved on a basement ceiling beam. He has shown others who came to ask, and has kept the beam that way. Nice man....

"Anna Marie had been a house maid, cook, laundress, seamstress, babysitter, etc. etc., as all good Scandinavian immigrant ladies generally were, but she stopped to "look after her man and have a family herself." They bought a farm at Nassau, Lac Qui Parle county, Minnesota, and moved there, had the four more children, and attended church in Marietta, MN.

In 1909, when Esther was a 4 month old baby and Alma just 2 1/2 years old, and Ida only 6 years, they sold the Nassau farm, had an auction, and moved to the city of Eugene, Oregon, living near the University there. A minister friend from Minnesota recommended that they purchase a farm 9 miles out of Eugene, as he had a farm there also. He wanted Lars to lend him \$1,000.00 but instead Lars offered to purchase the ministers farm, and they made a deal. They travelled into Eugene by train, but only lived on the farm for two years until they rented it and purchased two houses in Eugene. They lived at 855 Agate St., but these numbers have now changed to 1355 - Agate Ave., but the house is long gone from that address now. In 1916 they "traded" ?? the two houses and farm

for two quarter sections of farmland at Leslieville--North of Alhambra, AB. When I asked, "Why?" I was told that John Eggen, (who turned out to be my mother's brother-in-law, because he was married to Clara Lowe, my papa's only sister) and his father-in-law, Per or Peder H. Lowe (my paternal grandpa) convinced Lars and Anna Marie to come up to Blackfalds and work for John Eggen and make some \$\$\$\$ for three months. Lars liked it around central Alberta, made the deal to buy the Leslieville place, and went down to bring his family up by train. Anna Marie and the four younger children came, coming across the "line" at Kingsgate (BC), where they first met with the wee pest called, mosquitoes, and 'bulldog' flies, also called "horseflies." They had never had them down south.... Anna Marie died December 3, 1963--96 years of age, and with Lars is buried in the Leslieville Cemetery, 1 mile E and 1/2 mile S of Leslieville, Alberta. I have a clear picture of their headstones--quietly resting under the branches there." (all in Jan 2002 email from Betty (Lowe) Wulff, granddaughter of Anna Marie]

Document on microfilm in the National Archives in Ottawa says that Mrs. L.P. Eritslund entered Canada at Kingsgate B.C. by train on July 12, 1916, accompanied by Paul, Ida, Agnes, Alma and Esther, travelling from Eugene Oregon to Blackfalds Alberta. The declared value of their cash and effects was \$150. The document has some errors: it spells "Alma" as "Elma," and though Paul's age is correctly given as 15, the girls' ages are confused. Ida was 13 at the time (given as 11), Agnes was 11 (given as 9), Alma was 9 (given as 7) and Esther was not quite 7 (given as 8). However, the date and port of entry at least is presumably correct, and matches Betty Wulff's report.

Her granddaughter Carol Wait (Oscar's daughter) says Anna Marie drove to Chicago in 1954 with Oscar, Mildred and Carol. "Yes Grandma was with us in 1954. She didn't go to the Madison reunion [Erslunds] with us. We had gone to Chicago to visit Esther and family and went to Madison from there. Grandma thought she would be too tired and it was extremely hot in Chicago. She wanted to stay at the farm with Aunt Lydia."

There is a photo from 1956 -- the year Anna Marie was 89 (published in Red Deer paper, Carol Wait has a copy) of a 5 generation photo taken in Minneapolis. The photo has Anna Marie, Lydia, Agnes (Aggie), Joan, and Diane Dooley as a baby. (Diane was born July 1956). It says Anna Marie moved to Alhambra five years before, ie 1951.

Note written by Lars' daughter Hilda Eritslund Stratton - copy sent by Betty Wulff 1998: "Papa's father was Peder from Eritslund place in Norway. Norwegian custom was to call the children by father's name which made papa Pederson - but in Iowa there were so many Pedersons/Petersons & so on that their mail got mixed up. When Uncle Peder and Papa bought land in Minnesota they decided on Eritslund the name of the farm they came from in Norway. Our cousins in Madison Wisconsin knocked the "IT" out of Eritslund and called it "Erslund". [Note: these are simply alternate spellings for the farm name, and both spellings are in use in the family back in Norway today. Konrad Eritslund wrote in 1969, "In the churchbook for Finnås parish in 1858 the farm name Eritslund is written as Eritslund, Eritzland and Erritzland." A chapter on "Erslund" in a book tracing ownership of Bømlo farms also gives other spellings dating back to 1519: Ericksland, Eresland, Ericklanndt, Erichslanndtt, Erichslannd, Eridsland, Erisland, Errisland, Eridtzland, Eridsland, Eriitsland, Erridtzland, Erridsland. Since 1890 it has been Erslund.]

Alma (Eritslund) von Tettenborn wrote: "My father Lars Peterson, came from Norway the next year [1889], my mother probably helped him as her sister had helped her. They were probably engaged before either left Norway. They went to the same church in Norway and were in the same confirmation class, but did not attend the same school. If they had, my father indicated, there would probably not have been any romance. In Norway the 'Gaars' or farms had been subdivided until they could no longer be. The land always went to the oldest son, in this case Ole. My father apprenticed for 4 years in Bergen, learning the craft of painting and interior decorating, which craft he followed in America between bouts of trying to farm, at which he wasn't too successful. For his 4 years apprenticing, besides his necessary food and clothing, he received the grand sum of \$32.00.

"He probably followed a similar route to my mother's [see Anna Marie's entry: by ship from Bergen to Hull, by rail to Liverpool, and from there by ship to New York -- a typical itinerary for thousands of Norwegian emigrants] but I have no record of ships' names. On arriving in New York he knew no one, and understood no English. Undaunted he set out to knock on every door and ask, "Can you speak Norwegian" -- in Norwegian, of course. As luck would have it, he met with success on his first attempt. Arriving in St. Paul, he probably worked for a while, then he and my mother were married in St. Paul May 28, 1889. That fall they went back to Ridgeway - lived there till 1901 or so.

" I remember seeing a reference about Peder and Lars working for farmers in the Marshalltown, Iowa area right after they came to the USA. Later, Peder was living in Decorah, Iowa for awhile. " email from Ron George, husband of Peder's granddaughter Gail (ie Violet's son-in-law) May 2002)

Lars became a US citizen on Oct 1, 1895, "abjuring all allegiance and fidelity to every foreign prince, potentate, State and Sovereignty whatsoever, and particularly to the King of Norway and Sweden." [his granddaughter Carol Eritslund Wait has the original document]

More from Alma's narrative: "Children born in Ridgeway: Lydia (died), Lydia, Hilda, Oscar, Emma, Paul. Then they moved to Nassau, Minnesota, where they had 4 more children: Ida, Agnes, Alma & Esther.

"In Nov 1909 they moved to Eugene Oregon, then in July 1916 to Alberta Canada. In Eugene they had a 100 acre farm, and 2 houses in the city, but one was small. This they traded, sight unseen, for 2 quarter sections in Alberta.

"My mother enjoyed telling that after they were married, my father had 3 cents left in his pocket. He had wages coming at the end of the week, but it made a good story anyway."

email from Betty (Lowe) Wulff, Jan 2002 [info she got from Hilda (Eritslund) Stratton]: "In Ridgeway, Iowa Lars did housepainting and interior decoration--wall papering, special paint finishes--using feathers and rags and spattering by flipping paint brushes, -- which are all the rage right now, again!" Betty also gave more information about how/why they moved to Eugene and then to Alberta -- see Anna Marie's entry below.

"When Mom was visiting us in 1983, she mentioned that she would very much like to go to Fort Columbia where Dad was stationed when they were married Nov, 24, 1917. Whenever she would say she would like to go back there on their various trips, he would say "why would we want to go back to that godforsaken place?" So Mom and I went. This was the first time she had been there since leaving for Eugene, Oregon in March 1918. Dad had already gone to the Presidio of San Francisco and embarked to Europe in January 1917. Mom and Dad were married in the Astoria Hotel in Oregon and took the ferry 'Chisholm' to Megler, WA. Richard and I had taken the very same ferry in 1953 when we went to the motorcycle Gypsy Tour at Long Beach, WA. Then too, we as a family and our dog 'CoCo' were on the (Chisholm Ferry)on it's last run before being commissioned to Viet Nam.

Mom showed me where they first lived on the Fort in a two story duplex. Then we went up the street to the house where the commanding General had lived, which was now a museum. Mom was especially pleased to be able to tour the house and be in it for the first time. Our next stop was the command post where Dad had his office as battalion Sgt. Major. Mom was Post Mistress in the same building across the corner from Dad's office. When Mom and I went back up to Fort Columbia in 1986 these buildings were closed. We also went up the coast to the town of Long Beach and stayed over night in an old hotel. This was also the first time Mom had gone across the bridge at Astoria. The hotel where they were married had burned to the ground or bay in the 20's.

Hilda Marie (Eritsland) Stratton - 1894-1988 - 94yrs Born in Ridgeway, Iowa, April 22, 1894, second daughter of Lars and Anne Marie (Peterson)Eritsland (name change after Oscar started school?) The family moved to Nassau, Minnesota?(date)moved to Eugene, Ore?(date)lived on a farm near Fernridge in Spencer Creek area then a house on Agate St. Grandpa was a house painter - Interior floor tiler - & wall paperer (did a floor for a church in Eugene, Fairview Hts.)

Family emigrated to Leslieville, Alberta in 1911. Mom & Aunt Emma stayed in Eugene, to finish High school. Mom graduated in 1913- attended Normal School in Portland, Ore.

summer of 1913, taught Trapp family in Spencer Creek home. Attended Normal School in Portland in 1914 (said the sail ships were in harbor in 1913-by 1914 mostly steamships, very few sail ships) continued teaching Trapp family, 1914-1916 (Trapp family moved to Mackenzie River area.)(Emma graduated & went to Alberta to join Family) Trapps were on the School Board of Deadmans Ferry School - asked Mom to apply for the job there. [note -- these dates can't be right. The family emigrated to Alberta in 1916, and to Oregon in 1911-- L.A.]

She and Emma took the ferry across the river to see the school and apply for the job. She met Dad there, he brought the ferry across from other side. The Strattons ran the ferry and Grandpa Stratton was on the School Board, (They also boarded the teachers, but Dad's Mom had passed away that summer). So when Mom was hired she boarded with Mrs. Patterson across the road from the school, her little house is still there on riverside. (White school on hillside, now gone, was there in 1950) Mom taught school there Fall 1916 to June of 1917.

Uncle Paul had written Mom about a school position at Bingley 2mi. north of their farm, so Mom came to Alberta to take the job. She lived at home and walked, or rode horse. She was caught in a very bad blizzard, Grandma came to her rescue, that was enough for her. She had been corresponding with Dad - he was so disappointed that she had left for Canada without consulting him. He had been in the Oregon National

Guard for years. Training at Ft. Stephens in Oregon. Then World War I was declared he was stationed at Ft. Columbia, Washington. Wrote Mom to come back to the States (Nov. 1917) and marry him before he was shipped out to fight overseas in Sp. of 1918. That Blizzard was enough for Mom - she quit her school job, took the train to Vancouver, then on to Astoria, Oregon. They were married Nov. 24th 1917. took the ferry to Ft. Columbia in Washington. Dad was a Sargent Major, his office was in the front right corner of Bldg. & Mom's Post Mistress job was in the opposite corner of Bldg. He left in Jan. & it was 3 months. before they got a replacement for her at Post Office She went directly to Eugene, Or. to live with Grandpa Stratton to await the Arrival 1st born Julia Marie, Sept 17th, 1918 at Aunt Blanch's (Dad's Older Sister)home on Coburg Rd. (Still There) War was over Nov 11th, 1918, but Dad was not out of service till 1919 at Ft. Lewis, Wash. He remained in the Oregon National Guard as a 1st Lieutenant till 1922. Marcia Lillian was B. at Aunt Blanche's in March 16th, 1922 - Victor Lionel, March 8th 1924, at home (Dad Built home on hillside across road from Stratton Farm (no longer there, but was there in summer of 1950)

Grandpa passed away in 1925. David Edwin, B. Nov 28, 1928. Dad bought 160 acres land in Willakenzie area across the river. They sold the home on the hill and lived in a granary across from the Willakenzie School. Then sold that place & lived on Uncle Pat's & Aunt Gladys house next to the Hop Dryer Bldg. when David was 2 yrs old. The Older brother Victor and Sister's Lillian & Julia attended Willagalespy School till June 1931. Grandpa Lars, in Leslieville passed away in 1983.(date)There happened to be an unclaimed homestead 1/2 section next to Grandma's & Uncle Paul's farm. Dad had heard from other Oregonians who had settled in Alberta, about the great amount of grain you could get per acre from first breaking & so was persuaded to come to Alberta and claim the homestead.

Also would make a good combination of one section. So they packed up the Family in July 1931, emigrated to Leslieville. Mom driving a 1928 Dodge Sedan w/trailer, Dad with a 1928 or 29 Maxwell Flatbed truck loaded with furniture & complete sawmill equipment.

Grandma was then in Minnesota, with Aunt Lydia, helping her with Gerald, B (date?). I was B. Nov. 8th 1931 Grandma was home then, Cousin Esther (Uncle Oscars oldest) was living w/her. Dad was hunting Moose with a neighbour, Uncle Paul had taken everyone else to a Chautauqua 1 Program in Leslieville. When they came home Esther & Julia implored Mom to name me Lucille after the Star of the show. (Esther told me this story when we had the family Reunion in 1983) So Mom said "Alora" (for Alberta & Oregon), Lucille. When Dad registered my birth the next day, he didn't know how to spell Alora, so he put in Alma instead, after Mom's sister.

The homestead property was mostly swamp. Dad had a job hauling gravel (put a box on truck.)for the new highway (correction line) from Red Deer to Rocky Mountain. House. He found out that the Railroad 1/4 section at Condor was for sale (sloping land), bought that & moved everyone over in the Spring of 1932.Needed to clear brush & build a house & barn.

Julie went back to Oregon to finish high school. lived with Aunt Blanche. The Twins, Daniel Parke & Douglas Demora, were born on the farm March 4th 1934. Aunt Blanche, Uncle Ed. & Demora brought Julia home & she called them her two Doll Babies.

Uncle Oscar & his family lived with us on the farm with Bernard, Dorothy, & Marie before Lawrence was born. B. & D. went to first grade in Condor School. Lillian & Victor attended Condor school. Aunt Blanche, Uncle Ed. & Edwin visited us in summer of 1937. When war broke out in 1939 Victor joined the Army in Feb. 1941. Julie & Lill went to U.S. so Lill could go to High school. They met Victor in Innisfail bus from Uncle Oscar's before he was shipped out for England after basic training.

Julie came home in Sept. 1941, Lillian stayed in States, graduating from Eugene High School in 1944. Japanese invaded Pearl Harbor Dec. 7th 1941. Dad had gone to work at Penhold Airport summer of 1941. We moved to Penhold on my Birthday Nov. 8th 1942.

Kit & Vic. were married April 22nd, 1944, he went to Continent after D-DAY June 1944. War II was over in Europe, May 1945 - Japanese War over August 1945.

We moved to Red Deer August 1944 to West Park. Julie had moved to Red Deer Spring of '44, worked at Dairy Pool as Secretary to Pres. Johnstone. Lill worked at Training School, then the Dairy Pool, David worked at Coca Cola Bottle wks. I Started 7th GRD., Twins 4th GRD. we moved to our house on Waskasoo Ave (45th) in 1945.

Mom taught school at Beaver Flats, spring, of 1944 & North of Red Deer fall of 44 til Xmas. Julie & Norman

Von Hollen were married in Red Deer Spring of 1946, David & Lawrence went to Minnesota Sp. 1947. Victor & Kit & Angie came over from England , Sept. 1947. Dave came home then & went to Oregon Sp. of 1948. Kit & Vic went back to England Sp. of 1948, after Dave left, Vic worked for Canadian Pacific Railway, & Red Deer Plumbing Shop during a very cold and blizzardy winter. Mom went to teach at Blackfalds school in Sp. of '48 and back to Beaver Flats. Christine was b. Feb. 1948. Lill went back to U.S. Spring 1948 then worked for Red Deer Composite High school 1949-1951. then to Minnesota for Lab. training. Worked at Sacred Heart, Eugene Or. 1953 Then Roseburg Mercy Hosp 1957. Married Norris Langsef, Monica B. 1959. They moved to Portland, Summer of 1966. Lill Passed away Dec. 27th 1966.

What sticks in my mind the most about Grandma Stratton is that she is the only person who really made me feel like it was okay to be smart and she encouraged me. I know that may sound funny and I dont want to be negative about anyone else, but when I think of Grandma I think of her as being that one person who made me feel good about my "intelligence". Thats probably her school teacher background. I also remember her telling me about flowers and birds. When we would take walks - regardless of where it was - on mom & dad's property in Auburn or around her neighborhood in Red Deer she would tell me the names of the different plants/flowers we saw or point out the different kinds of birds. I also remember her being a bit of a "packrat" her house in Red Deer was full of STUFF - mostly STUFF that really needed to be thrown away. I remember her Norwegian outfit - I borrowed it once to wear for international day at high school. (I will see if I can find both pictures - one with Grandma wearing it and one with me wearing it). [Narrative by his daughter, Carol (Eritsland) Wait]:

1914-1915 - Oregon National Guard - Honorable Discharge

1916 - National Guard, State of Minnesota - Honorable Discharge

1917 - United States Army - Honorable Discharge

He was trained as an electrical engineer in the U.S. army. While in the Army he was stationed in Texas along the Mexican border. At that time he got malaria which affected him all of his life. He never went overseas as he got the flu of 1917 and by the time he was over that the war was over.

He married Bertha Christensen about 1918 in Chicago. They had a daughter Esther, who was raised by her Grandmother Anna Marie Eritsland after Bertha died in a fire in Chicago in 1922. Dad's hands were burnt trying to get Bertha out of the fire.

He worked as a taxi driver in Chicago before he came to Canada. He was with the taxi drivers when they started the union, and if they had not changed their meeting place, well that would have been bad, as it was the garage where the St. Valentines massacre took place.

Dad always said he was never without a job during the depression of the 1930s, he just never got paid. He travelled throughout Alberta showing motion pictures. He owned Eritsland and Holmes Auto Repairs and Service in Rocky Mountain House. Once in a while he would get a chicken or something for gasoline etc at the garage in Rocky.

He also belonged to a semi - professional baseball team. I think he was the pitcher. He had many awards for Marksmanship, usually came in 1st in competitions. I don't know who has these award badges.

From 1942 - 1945, he taught Airplane Mechanics to Canadian and British Air Force personnel who were going to England to maintain the Air Force fleet during WW 2.

When we moved to Lethbridge in 1945, Dad worked at a garage that went out of business. The owner couldn't pay Dad his salary so gave him some furniture instead. I don't know how he managed to feed us all at that time. He then taught auto mechanics at the Lethbridge Collegiate institute (1945 - 1961). There was no course in mechanics at that time and he convinced the school board to develop one. In the summers he went to University to get his teachers certificate. The LCI was located on the North side of Lethbridge at that time. In 1949 the new Lethbridge Collegiate Institute was built at 7th Ave and 15th Street, on the south side of Lethbridge. Dad organized the shops, mechanics, electrical and woodworking.

From 1961 - 1962 he taught Auto Mechanics in Westlock Alberta; he retired due to illness

Dad was an avid hunter. We ate a lot of ducks, pheasants and partridge but he never did bring home a deer or moose or an elk. I used to tease him that he would rather let them go than shoot them. He also liked to fish, especially for trout. We spent a lot of time around Pincher Creek and in the Kananaskis fishing.

He belonged to the Fish and Game Association in Lethbridge and wrote several articles for their magazine. He was also instrumental in setting up the shooting range in Lethbridge so that people who wanted to target practice could do so in a safe place. When he was in the U.S. Army he was considered to be a sharpshooter.

[in a Jan 2002 email message, Carol Wait commented on his death in 1971, age 75]: "Mom and he came out for a Christmas visit and were staying in North Vancouver with Rosalind. They both came down with a terrible flu.

Dad phoned me Christmas Eve day and was very upset: [his sister] Esther had died [on December 19], and he said he wouldn't be around long either. One of Rosalind's twins took Dad to the hospital and he died there. They did an autopsy as he was from Lethbridge [ie not a resident], and discovered he had diabetes. They were amazed he had lived as long as he did. "

email from his nephew Don Lowe, Jan 2002: " Lorna, Larry and I attended Oscar's funeral in Lethbridge. The cemetery was cold, windy, no snow, on the NW side of Lethbridge."

Her daughter Carol Wait writes (email June 2002): "My grandfather [Mildred's mother] was born into a very wealthy family in Ontario. He would ride around the town in his own buggy with his own team of horses, wearing white gloves and a top hat. They had a huge house there, I have never seen it. When he married my grandmother he was disowned. Grandma's family moved west and talked (some say pushed) my grandparents into going and Grandpa was disowned. He was given \$200.00 (a lot of money in those days) and was told to get lost (it seems his mother visited them out west though). Since my grandfather was so spoiled he didn't know how to work or run a business or anything so they were very poor. Mom started cleaning house and taking care of her baby brother when she was around 4. My aunts and uncles all say that she raised them. When she was 12 she was sent out to do housework to support the family. She never saw my grandfather except on payday and never was able to keep any money for herself. She did say she was fortunate as the people she worked for were very kind. The lady (I don't remember her name) taught mom how to cook, sew, crochet, knit and keep house better. Later on (not sure of the year) my grandparents owned a hotel and cafe in Swalwell where my Mom was the chief cook (only cook) bottle washer etc. They lost the hotel as grandpa kept feeding people for free and had no sense of business. So they were very poor all the time. Then she married dad and the depression hit. She wasn't "worldly" hadn't been anywhere until she met dad but she sure knew a lot and was as sharp as a tack."

Once again her family moved, only this time it was to a new country, Canada, where they settled at Leslieville Alberta. Emma taught for one year at a small school named Bingly, northwest of Leslieville.

Emma met and married Pastor Andrew Hjortaas on November 27, 1918. They adopted a baby girl Frida shortly after being married. Pastor Hjortaas was serving at Sylvan Lake when in 1922 they decided to move to Macrorie, Saskatchewan where he served a 3 point parish for 2 years. Emma was very involved with her husband's work, playing either the piano or organ for as many as 3 services a Sunday, plus whatever other jobs that she thought only she could handle best.

Pastor Hjortaas married and baptized many in this Eritsland family.

In the early days they used horses to get around and later they had a "Reo" car. One time Andrew was late coming home and Emma was her usual worrisome self. She said to Frida, "Wonder why Dad is late?" Frida said, "It's OK, Mamma, Daddy is bringing a new car home." Emma just thought what an imagination you have, Frida - but lo and behold a couple of hours later, Andrew drove in with a new car.

During the early 1940s Emma and Andrew raised two children for 3 years, Arnold and d Sonja Schulkes, until their Dad could resume taking care of them. They remained in touch with Emma until her death. Arnold lives in London, England, and Sonja lives in Oakville, Ontario.

Due to Andrew's poor health they moved to Calgary in 1947. He passed away in 1951.

In 1954 Emma married Gerhard Benjamensen and moved to Camrose. He died in 1967.

Emma had many interests and hobbies. She sewed all her own and Frida's clothes plus Andrew's shirts. She knitted, crocheted, and did embroidery. She also loved her flowers. Emma played both the organ and piano, sketched and painted and was very active in Ladies Aid organizations. She often had to be resourceful and a good manager especially when her husband's salary wasn't paid on time and during war time rationing. She did often comment that everyone was in the same boat, most people didn't have much.

Another pastime Emma loved was writing letters to friends and family.

After moving to Camrose she and Frida made many good and lost lasting friends. In fact at her 80th birthday party there were at least 50 people gathered. It was actually held at the hospital as she was a patient at the time. Emma lived in her own home until 1979; then she moved into Heritage Manor where she lived until shortly before dying in December 1986.

Frida resided at Bethany Nursing Home in Camrose for 21 years and died in 1996.

He kept singing, 'My stomach hurts, my stomach hurts,' all the way to school in time to Dolly's trotting hoofs. We got there early, so played a round of softball, but he lay down in the early sunshine on the grass near the ball diamond and went to sleep. When roll was called someone said, 'Gornie is here, but he is asleep on the grass out by the ball diamond, because he has a stomach ache.' Teacher said, 'Well, go wake him and tell him he can go home on his bike.' Someone did, and he did, and he lolled around home, eventually going upstairs to bed with his stomach ache. When Papa came home, Mom said, 'We better take him to the hospital in Lacombe.' Later she told us that part way there he suddenly said, 'Ohhhh ! It just quit hurting! Let's go home!' But they continued until he was eventually examined by the doctor and put to bed. The doctor had misgivings, and 'Gornie' soon began to feel awfully cold. Mom said she put extra blankets around his feet and rubbed his legs, but he just faded away and died. We were all devastated and it was pure awful around our place for weeks!"

Betty Lowe Wulff (who was 7 when her sister Edith died at age 16) writes, "Edith had just begun grade 10 in Lacombe and was 'working for her board and room' for a family there. I heard later that she became unusually tired, very tired one weekend while she was home, so off they went to the doctor. She was diagnosed with rheumatic fever, kept in hospital for months of rest --- seemed like years -- while she just got worse and worse, until her heart was greatly enlarged, feet and legs swollen, etc. etc. She died of rheumatic fever. Ironically, a few months later penicillin was developed--a quick cure for such ailments. I recall Mama running outside shouting, crying, 'They have invented a new medicine that would have saved Edie! !! Tooo late, tooo late!' ... Edie was like a mom to me, fussed over me and primped me up, cut my nails, washed my hair, and tried to get me to quit sucking my fingers. She taught me to ask, 'Whadyanojoe??' whereupon she would answer, 'Idononothin!' and we would laugh. It was a popular saying around that time, I think--a hit song. Anyway, we could not enter the hospital to visit her at bedside during those days, so we had to visit through the screened, second floor window. Edie would call to me, "What do you know Joe?" and I would answer, "I don't know nothin." and we would laugh at that. While hospitalized, Edie wrote a poem about a robin she witnessed on the hospital lawn. Mom sent it off somewhere and it was printed, I think in a farm newspaper. "

Here is Edith's poem, "From my Bed" [provided by brother Don Lowe]:

Out on the green of the hospital lawn
A quiet fat robin bounces along.
From my bed by the window I watch as he hops --
But now, with a jerk, he suddenly stops.
Tail braced, listening, head cocked to one side,
Bright eyes, fixed intently, having suddenly spied
Some moving thing. In an instant he dives
And brings up a worm which he swallows alive.
This is repeated oft times in my sight:
I sigh for the worms who [are] in such a plight.
I shudder to think of Rob's murderous zeal --

But Redbreast's now chirping, he's finished his meal.

The nursing home was her choice, she didn't want to disturb anyone's way of life or be a burden to her family. Mavis was a very private person, and I didn't tell anyone because of that. I knew that if she wanted anyone else to know she or Warren would tell them.

She gradually became locked in her body, her mind still clear. What a horrible way to go. At the last she only had eye movement, could only turn her eyes left or right for yes or no. They used an alphabet chart for communication. I last saw her in July, she could hardly even use the alphabet chart and we both found it so frustrating to try to communicate. I read to her for awhile and she enjoyed that.

Mavis had 4 girlfriends who were her "hiking group". They came regularly to visit her and feed her ice cream which she loved. After she had been in the nursing home for about 6 months they took her to Banff for a weekend, and then last year in early Dec took her to Kimberley. By that time she needed total care, and it says a lot for them,that they were willing to do this. One friend and built a ramp to her back door, so that they could bring her out for a few hours to visit. She didn't go back home at all after a few weeks in the home as she found that very hard, but she went out on bus trips, while she was still able to enjoy that, and loved to go to her friends house.
