Professor of Music

In 1881 the family lived at 54 St Anne's Street, Salisbury. 3 years previously they had lived at Ryde, Isle of Wight where 4 of the children were born.
They came to live in Basingstoke before 1901.

Notes for William Price Aylward:
Mayor of Salisbury twice

Owner of Music Shops (largest music business in the West of England). At the age of 69 he was still in his shop.

Professor of music (Flute & Organ)

My 2nd great grandfather.

Most of his children children were accomplished musicians.

William: Kings Scholarship, Royal Academy of Music when 15 years old.
Member of The Orchestra of The Royal Italian Opera.
One of the greatest English Cellists of his time.
Taught music at Eton Prep School.

Jannetta: Kings Scholarship, RAM, Pianoforte when 15.

Leila: Professor of Music

Theodore: Organist & composer of music & hymns.
Studied organ music at Salisbury Cathedral. Pupil of Samuel Wesley & articed to him.
Organist at St Martins & St Edmunds, Salisbury, Llandraf & Chichester cathedrals.

Augustus: Professor of Music.

My great grand uncle
Gresham Professor of Music.

Organist & composer of music & hymns.

Studied organ music at Salisbury Cathedral. Pupil of Samuel Wesley & articled to him
Organist at St Martins & St Edmunds, Salisbury, Llandraf & Chichester cathedrals & St Michaels
Cornhill, London.

The collection was purchased by Cardiff City Council in 1926 from Theodore Edward Aylward
(1844-1933), conductor of the Cardiff Musical Society and former organist of Llandaff Cathedral,
and was deposited with UW Cardiff in the 1990s. The collection, containing more than 2,000 items,
consists mainly of 18th and early 19th century printed music scores for piano and organ, together
with songs, dances, and concert programmes (1836-42). The collection gives an interesting insight
into performance related material for that period.

Organist at Chichester Cathedral 1876 - 1887. He is in a list of Chichester Cathedral organists at the
side of the Cathedral organ.

In 1881 he was in lodgings at Tower Street, Subdeanery, Chichester.

9. Sarah Penn, born 24 Dec 1752 in St Martin in The Fields, London, England. She was the daughter of William Penn and Elizabeth Hammond.

Notes for Henry Aylward:

Henry married Jane Hardham on 11 NOV 1769. She died soon after. He went on to marry Sarah Penn 2 years later.

My 4th great grandfather.

By marrying Sarah Penn, the family history of the Penn side of the family can be traced far back in history.

All dates checked & confirmed at Chichester Records office.

Notes for Sarah Penn:

2nd wife of Henry Aylward She was the third of 5 children.

My 4th great grandmother

She was christened at St Martin in the Fields, Westminster (where her parent had a London home) and married my 4th great grandfather, Henry Aylward, at St Peter the Great at Chichester.

She was 19 when she married Henry who was 44.

They had 2 sons, Thomas and George.

Sarah's brother in law, Theodore Aylward, was the organist at Windsor Castle.
