The progenitor of the Prugh family in Maryland is Conrad Bruch/Brucher/Brook, he and his wife Lucia Maria Finkbeiner are buried in St. Luke's (Winters) Lutheran Church in New Windsor, Carroll County.

While Conrad and Lucia's names have been at the mercy of English speakers Lucia's name on her tombstone is spelled Prugh.

Regarding your Schells I quote from "Prugh Genealogy 1705-1973" by Robert N. Feicht page vi:"Let us consider Elizabeth, shown in TABLE I to have been born "about" 1778, and who married Larry Schell and migrated to Montgomery County, Ohio, having among her children a

son, Joseph. Inquiries among genealogy-minded Schells in Montgomery County have been fruitless. But in Montgomery County's Beaverton Cemetery, in close proximity to a number of Prugh graves, stand the gravestones of Lawrence Schell, his wife Elizabeth, and a Joseph Shill. While Lawrence Schell's stone is almost totally illegible, Elizabeth's marker recites that she died March 24, 1850, aged 77 years, 1 month, 22 days, which is to say she was born February 2, 1773. That can be construed as about 1778.

There are Prughs buried all over Carroll County, I would suggest reading the cemetery books in the Westminster Library.

As far as I know my mother-in-law, Martha Hollus Prugh, was the last Maryland born Prugh when she passed away in 1983.

Notes for LAWRENCE SCHILL:

First recorded and confirmed record I have of Lawrence Shill is his tax record from Montgomery County, Ohio, in 1816. Also some property that was exchanged in 1816. His birth date is an estimate from the date listed on his grave stone, in Beavertown Cemetery in Kettering Ohio. Located just outside of Dayton. The Immigration record that was found has not been confirmed if it is indeed our Lawrence. Census reports in 1800 show that there were immigrants living in the household. That would mean he was not born in America. It list three. But no names are given. His will states Elizabeth had a son Joseph who he would provide for. My guess is that Elizabeth, Joseph and Laurence were in immigrants. Unless they had a servant living in the home.

I Joseph Shill of the County of Montgomery in the State of Ohio being of sound and despairing mind memory and understanding do make publish and declare this to be my last will and testament hereby revoking and making will and said all former wills and testaments in the nature of wills by me hereafter rev____. And first it is my will that my funeral expenses and all my just debts be fully paid. Second, I give devise and bequeath to my two nieces Mahala J. Moates and Lydia J. Moates each fifty dollars. Third, I give and devise to my friend John W. Moates six hundred dollars, \$600/ Fourth, I give and devise to Rebecca Merton my sister one hundred dollars, \$100/ Fifth , I give and devise to my sister Katherine Rike one hundred dollars, \$100/ Sixth, I give and devise to my sister Mary Ewry one hundred dollars, \$100/ Seventh, I give and devise to my sister Elizabeth Moates, three hundred dollars \$300 / Eighth, I give an devise to my two nephews Joseph Moates and John L. Moates each fifty dollars. Ninth, I give and devise to my brother Jacob Shill one hundred dollars \$100/ Tenth, I give and devise to my brother Henry Shill (\$50) fifty dollars Eleventh, I give and devise to my brother Laurence Shill (\$50) fifty dollars Twelfth, I give and devise to Kennedy Merton, Twenty five dollars (\$25) And lastly I give and bequeath all the balances of my estate including my given bed and building and clock to my friend John W. Moates . Be compensations for defining and paying off all my lawful debts and funeral expenses and boarding and I hereby constitute and appoint my friend Allen Bradford to be the executor of this my last will and testament. In publishing where of I have hereunto _____? ____? authorized this ___day of December 1837.

He met and married Eliza Owens in 1831 in Dayton, Ohio. They moved to Shelby County Ohio which is located north of Dayton. All 10 of their children were born in Shelby County. They stayed there until 1860 or 61.

He packed up his family and moved to Lafayette Indiana, Wea Township, near his sister Mary's family She moved there around 1829. They all walked or rode in a covered wagon. Was also known as John H. Shill. He moved a few times into the homes of his son Joseph and also into the home of his daughter Elizabeth. He was at the home of his son Joseph, about 6 miles south of Lafayette, when he died.

C. W. SHILL, M.D., a prominent physician of Lafayette, and the present city health officer, was born in Shelby Count y, Ohio, July 25, 1851, a son of HENRY and ELIZA (OWINGS) SHILL. HENRY SHILL was a native of Pennsylvania, and was there reared, removing thence to Shelby County, Ohio, where he married ELIZA OWINGS, a native of Dayton, Ohio. In 1860 the family moved to Indiana and settled in Tippecanoe County , in Wea Township, where the father died in February, 1886 , at the age of eighty-three years. The mother now lives in Benton County, Indiana.

C. W. SHILL came to Tippecanoe County when nine years of age, and here received his elementary

education. He later attended Brookston Academy three years, and after leaving school began the study of medicine with DR. COBLIN, of Henry County, Kentucky. In 1874 he entered Louisville Medical College, from which he graduated in 1876. He graduated from Louisville Medical Hospital College in 1877, and subsequently remained in the hospital eight months. He then located at Battle Ground, where he practiced until 1880. He then moved to Lafayette, where he has since been one of the most successful practitioners. He had charge of the county infirmary four years, one year while living in Battle Ground and three years after moving to Lafayette. In 1881 he was appointed county coroner, holding the position until the following election. He was a member of the board of health before that board was abolished, and has been the city health officer since June, 1886, serving now on his second term. DR. SHILL is a Republican. He is a member of the Masonic order, and has taken the Knights Templar degree, and is a member of Lafayette Commandery No. 3.

JACOB EWRY, one of LaFayette's enterprising merchants, was born in Montgomery County, Ohio, a son of JOHN and MARY L. (SHILL) EWRY, his father being a native of Baltimore County, Maryland, and his mother of Montgomery County, Ohio. JOHN'S EWRY'S parents were natives of Maryland, and when he was a boy they removed to Dayton, Ohio, and there he was reared to manhood, and learned the carpenter's trade. In the spring of 1828 JOHN EWRY, leaving his family temporarily in Dayton, came to LaFayette, Indiana, going by canal to Toledo and making the rest of the journey on foot. He then went to Crawfordsville from LaFayette, on foot to attend the land sale, but having observed that LaFayette was the head of steamboat navigation, he returned to this city. Building was then pretty active and JOHN EWRY obtained plenty of work, working that year on the store room of JOSEPH HANNA and on one for JOHN McCORMICK, and built a dwelling for himself. In September, 1829, he returned to Ohio on horseback, and soon after came back to LaFayette with his family, and household effects in a covered wagon. He followed building exclusively until about 1840, when he engaged in the manufacture of plows in company with GEORGE ERWIN, with whom he was associated about eight years, after which he carried on the business alone until the spring of 1857. January 1, 1857, he engaged in the dry goods business in connection with his son JACOB EWRY, the subject of this sketch, under the firm name of J. EWRY & Co., being a member of this company until his death, which occurred April 25, 1886. He was a prominent pioneer, and took an active interest in the welfare of his county until his death. In politics he was a Democrat. He was a member of the First Presbyterian church of LaFayette for many years, but latterly was identified with the Second Presbyterian church. His wife

survived him but twenty -four days, her death taking place May 19, 1886. JACOB EWRY was reared principally in LaFayette, and after completing his education at J. G. WILSON's seminary, he began clerking in the general mercantile store of DAVID ROSS, and later was with HANNAH & POTTER. In the spring of 1853 he went to California, having gone that far with a brother who was moving to Portland, Oregon. He remained in California about two years, when he returned to LaFayette, and engaged with the mercantile firm of BROWN & WEAVER. He succeeded this firm in the business early in the spring of 1857, and in the fall of the same year his father became associated with him. Andrew Jackson Shill was born in Sidney, Shelby County, Ohio. He lived there until around the mid 1860's when the family moved to Lafayette, Indiana. He worked as a mail

carrier in Indiana carrying mail between Lafayette and various parts of Indiana.

On the 1st of April, 1862, along with his brothers John and Thomas, enlisted in the Union Army. They all were in the 26th Indiana Infantry, G Co. Their residence was listed as Concord, Indiana. During a battle at Sterling Plantation in Louisiana, Andrew and his brother Thomas were captured by the confederates. Below is a brief summary of the battle. They walked to Tyler Texas along with many more prisoners. Some only in shorts with no shirts or shoes. He was fed only a tablespoon of corn and sometimes a piece of dried beef. Andrew and Thomas remained prisoners for 10 months. They were part of a prison exchange. They all mustered out, April 4, 1865.

After the war, he moved to Iowa along with his brothers John and General. General Shill served in the Union Army but enlisted in Ohio. Thomas moved back to Shelby County, Ohio. He lived with General and his wife Margaret, until he married Elnora in 1873. He worked as a Harness maker. Harley was born 1874 in Lucas County. Arthur was born 5 years later in 1879.

Andrew spent the the next 15 years in Council Bluffs, Iowa. When Elnora died in 1908, he moved in with his son Harley and family. In August he married Georgia Kramer. She gave birth to a boy named George and then died in 1910. It is unknown what became of George. He married a third time in 1913 to Edna Pace. Had one more son named Lee in October of 1914. Andrew died the following year.

Stirling's Plantation

Description: Following the Union defeat at Sabine Pass earlier in the month, Maj. Gen. Nathaniel P. Banks intended to occupy important locations in Texas. He decided to send troops up the Bayou Teche, disembark them on the plains and march overland to Texas. Maj. Gen. Ulysses S. Grant sent him a division, commanded by Maj. Gen. Napoleon J.T. Dana to garrison Morganza and prevent Rebel troops from operating on the Atchafalaya River. A 1,000-man detachment, under the command of Lt. Col. J.B. Leake, was at Stirling's Plantation to guard the road to the Atchafalaya River and deter any enemy troops from passing by. Brig. Gen. Alfred Mouton, commander of the Sub-District of Southwestern Louisiana, decided that he had a favorable opportunity to defeat the Union forces around Fordoche Bridge. On September 19, he instructed Brig. Gen. Tom Green to prepare for such an attack. Mouton provided Green with reinforcements and gave the order to attack on the 25th. Green's force

began crossing the Atchafalaya River on the 28th, and all were over after midnight of the 29th. At dawn on the 29th, Green's men marched out. Confederate cavalry began skirmishing with Union pickets at Fordoche Bridge before noon and continued for about a half hour. Green's other troops then hit the Union force, drove them and captured many, although most of the Federal cavalry found an escape route. Although Dana sent reinforcements, mud and rain slowed their progress and allowed Green to get away. Green had defeated this Union force handily, but it did not deter Banks from his intended movement.

Result(s): Confederate victory

Camp Ford

On this site during the Civil War was located Camp Ford, the largest prisoner of war compound for Union troops west of the Mississippi River, named in honor of Col. John S. 'Rip' Ford who originally established a training camp here in 1862. It was converted in the summer of 1863 to a prison camp.

It first consisted of four to five acres enclosed by a stockade sixteen feet high. In the spring of 1864 following the Confederate victories at Mansfield, Louisiana and Mark's Mills, Arkansas the enclosure was doubled to accommodate the large influx of prisoners. Approximately 4700 Federals were confined here during this period. This overcrowded condition was somewhat relieved through a series of prisoner of war exchanges between the North and the South.

Union soldiers representing nearly one hundred different regiments plus sailors from gunboats and transports were confined here. In addition there were imprisoned Union sympathizers, spies, and even Confederate deserters.

The prisoners constructed their own shelters ranging from log huts and burrows called "shebangs" to brush arbors and tents made of blankets.

A spring located about 100 yards southwest of this marker furnished an ample supply of good water. Their meager rations, essentially the same as that of their guards, usually consisted of beef and corn meal and were sometimes supplemented by vegetables purchased from nearby farms.

Although escape attempts were frequent, very few were successful due to the long distance to Union lines and the difficulty in eluding the tracking hounds used by the Confederate guards. Even though conditions were primitive it compared favorably with the other Civil War prison camps. Camp Ford continued to serve as a prison until the surrender of the Trans-Mississippi Department in May, 1865. It was later destroyed by Federal occupation troops.

One day at a combat field hospital

At CASH unit, U.S. troops, Iraqis all bleed same color

In an exclusive report, Dateline takes you behind the scenes at the Task Force 86th CASH. NBC's John Hockenberry reports.

NBC NEWS

March 30 Battlefield casualties are treated at what's called a CASH a combat support hospital. They're larger than those famous MASH units, but they operate in much the same way. In a Dateline exclusive, correspondent John Hockenberry reports on what happens behind the scenes at the Task Force 86th CASH.

CALL IT a CASH or the more familiar MASH unit, this combat field hospital is close to the front lines, deep inside Iraq. There is a rhythmic fury of ambulance choppers bringing wounded and they're not all American soldiers.

The thing I'll never forget is seeing the eyes on this little three-year-old girl, she was carried in a blanket, says NBC producer Tim Uehlinger.

But whatever you think you know about these real war time images is wrong. It's one of the things Uehlinger learned as he watched a hospital get built by scrappy combat medics out of desert dust.

I couldn't believe it when I saw the place, says Uehlinger. It was such a wreck, it was beyond belief, it was an abandoned old building.

It's in a location that the military doesn't want disclosed. The wounded know where it is and when they get there, they'll find Colonel and also doctor Harry Warren.

Our forward surgical hospital mission is to move forward rapidly and set up a complete hospital to take care of any kind of wounded patients immediately, even in a remote area like this, says Warren.

Amidst the desert haze the CASH sign is one of hope, orange because there was no red paint.

At first these are doctors without patients, battling the wind to erect their tents. But it was only a few minutes before the first wounded soldier arrived. It was a sergeant, shot in his Humvee in an ambush. He bled the whole two miles to the hospital.

Medics found the wound in his upper arm. But they did not find all of the bullet, so he was prepped for surgery.

This is really pretty straightforward, it's just a matter of cleaning up the wound edges and washing things out," said the doctor on his case.

It was a simple bullet wound from a complex military situation, where U.S. soldiers can be ambushed anywhere and everywhere.

It's from a hit and run attack," says Warren. That's usually from one or two people with an AK-47 type weapon.

Iraqi wounded soon begin arriving there, too, children and POWs.

You judge an army by how they treat their prisoners, says Lutheran minister Rev. Cruise.

But it is the judgements of these doctors that mean life or death for the combat wounded. While a 70 mile-per-hour wind howls and tears at their fragile clinic, the calm voices of triage are calling out the cases.

Then there is a pause in the weather and the casualties, but not the cleanup.

During the time of the worst weather, says Warren, the morale of the people here was actually higher than normal.

The war seems to be beyond the horizon. Doctors prepped for surgery and medics cared for patients. But the worst mistake you can make there is to imagine there's any kind of routine.

Be ready for whatever might come your way, says Dr. Robert Burnette.

On this day, it started early and just kept coming, constant stream of choppers and trucks bearing patients.

And for Tim Uehlinger, out of the chaos, destiny arrived wrapped in a blanket.

I saw it reveal the face of a child, a little three-year-old girl, says Uehlinger. Well, the second I saw her eyes I knew it was really bad.

At nearly the same moment, a Marine arrived, beyond help. Other marines are brought in. The word is they started out as victims of an accident and then were ambushed while in the ambulance on their way to the hospital.

But by the twisted logic of this war, the Marine's Iraqi attackers are not far behind. From enemy to POWs to patients, Marines say 12 hours earlier these Iraqis were shooting at them.

This is war," says one medic. They come to the same place to be patched up. It's kind of like a time out."

It's an old saying about war: Rule number one is people die. Rule number two is that doctors can't change rule number one.

It was actually good that a six-year-old girl was screaming. She was strong and doctors said she'd be okay.

But the three-year-old girl in the blanket had never made a sound. Uehlinger learned that she died of a head wound.

A medic came up and told me she had seen the little girl draw her last breath, says Uehlinger. And she was devastated, as was everyone.

I'm tired of this, says another medic. It's the right thing to do and all that, but there's too much human

n you and it hurts too much sometimes.

More than 100 wounded or dying, and at one point more than 60 in a single hour, arrived in this place. Many of the medic officers believe it's perhaps the busiest, bloodiest day for a U.S. army field hospital since the Vietnam War.

I told these guys before we got here, we gotta be ready for anything, says Warren.

They are words to quite literally live by. On this day and the many days to come, there are too many words, too many emotions for the doctors and an NBC producer. Tomorrow is the only objective.

Whether we're civilians or soldiers or Iraqi POWs or Iraqi civilians or children, says Uehlinger, "we're all human beings. And as one doctor said, 'We all bleed, and we all bleed red.'
