

Descendants of John Barr

Generation No. 1

1. **John¹ Barr** was born 01 May 1751 in County Mayo, Ireland, and died 22 Aug 1833 in Bald Eagle, Centre County, Pennsylvania. He married **Mary Elcock**. She was born 23 Jul 1764 in The Isle of Jersey, and died 17 Jan 1847 in Elk County, Pennsylvania.

Notes for John Barr:

John Barr enlisted in the Continental Army on February 1777 in the State of Delaware into a Regiment newly authorized by the Continental Congress (27 Dec 1776) and newly commissioned (11 Jan 1777) by General George Washington as Col. Hartley's "additional" Continental Regiment. Pvt. John Barr served in Company "D" commanded by Capt. George Bush. Source: Regiment Roster - Pennsylvania Published Archives - 2nd series - vol. X page 782.

Hartley's Regiment was in the 1st Pennsylvania Brigade, Gen. Anthony Wayne's Division. Hartley commanded the brigade in the battles of Brandywine , (11 Sept 1777) Paoli , (21 Sept 1777) and Germantown (4 Oct 1777) .

On 14 July 1778 , the regiment was sent to the fort at Sunbury, Pa on the Susquehanna River to counteract attacks by Indians and Tories on the frontier.

About 21 September 1778 John Barr, still serving as a Private under Capt. George Bush, and commanded by Col. Hartley , participated in an expedition sent by Congress, against marauding Indians along the Susquehanna West Branch territory. Many battles and skirmishes with waring Indians occurred on West Branch before it became nessesary to chase Indians northward up the Susquehanna East Branch. Col. Hartley and his men traversed about 300 miles in extremely difficult conditions in just over two weeks. This West Branch campaign of 1778 ranks as one of the most remarkable achievements ever accomplished in any war. Source: History of Lycoming County, Chapter V, pgs. 97-105

Col. Hartley requested to be relieved of his duties after the West Branch Campaign, which was granted November 1778. Lt. Col. Adam Hubley Jr, an officer of the New 11th PA Regiment under Col. Hartley, was placed in command of the Regiment.

By order of Congress on 13 January 1779 the "additional Regiments" and other companies were reorganized and incorporated with Hartley's Regiment, the whole, to form a complete Battalion and added to the Pennsylvania Line as the "New 11th Regiment " of that state. The July 1779 roster of "Field and Officers of the New 11th PA Regiment " listed ; Lt. Col. Adam Hubley Jr., Commander, Capt. George Bush, Captain of the Third Company (Company C), and Pvt, John Barr. Source: PA Published Archives 5th series vol. III pgs. 629-649.

The New 11th Regiment under the command of Col. Hubley was engaged in the Indian Campaign called the "Sullivan Expedition" from July through October 1779. This Campaign was designed to neutralize the British-lead Tory and Indian raids on frontier settlements of the West Branch Valley, Wyoming Valley and all along the New York / Pennsylvania state border. The New 11th, Company C, Capt. George Bush and Private John Barr were engaged in many skirmishes against overwhelming numbers of Indians. General Sullivan, running short of supplies, appealed to the troops to agree to half-ration of vegetables and extra pay in exchange for no meat rations in order to continue the expedition. The soldiers agreed. The army continued its march into the state of New York destroying villages and crops.

On 1 January 1781 the New 11th PA Regiment stationed near Morristown became involved in a protest and mutiny over the lack of food and supplies. Some had not received pay, others complained about inequities of benefits offered for new enlistments. New enlistments, were now being offered bounty payments of eighty one dollars in silver and the promise of 200 acres of land after the war. Soldiers enlisted for three years were being told they had to remain longer. The problem was resolved when Gen. George Washington gave his solemn promise that the soldiers would receive their back pay plus interest and soldiers would be discharged on completion of their term. Two and one-half weeks after the mutiny, John Barr received his discharge as a private at Trenton New Jersey 18 January 1781. He served 3 yrs. 11 mo. and participated in the Battles of Springfield, Brandywine, Germantown, Morristown and Paoli.

"Time Line" for John Barr and Mary Elcock"

1784 - Marriage to Mary Elcock ; Information in Mary Barr's 8 Aug 1846 declaration for pension - Her maiden name was Mary Elcock and (she) was married to said John Barr in the County of New Castle in the State of Delaware, according to the best of her recollection, on the 18th day of March 1784. She has no record of her marriage. She was married by Rev. William McCannon. Signed by Mary Barr, (her mark) On 25 August 1846, Mary provided additional information "according to the best of my recollection, the place of my marriage was called Red Clay Creek Hundredth, at that time there were no townships, but it was about 1 mile from Newport, 3 miles from Wilmington, and 4 or 5miles from New Castle."

Researcher's note: There is existing today, a Church named Red Clay Creek Presbyterian Church located 500 McKennans Church Road, Wilmington, Delaware founded in 1722. The first meeting house erected 1761 was located in what is now part of the cemetery adjoining the present church known as "The Little Church on the Hill". The original members of this congregation were Scotch-Irish immigrants who worked on nearby farms, some of their decedents are still members of the church. The first minister was Rev. William McKennan for whom the church road was named who served as pastor from 1755 - 1809. The marriage date, church location and minister's name (spelling variation accepted) matching Mary's description, it is probable that this is the location of John and Mary Barr's marriage.

1793 - Tax list - Pine Creek Twp. Northumberland Co. John Barr is listed as " additional resident " pg. 480 "History of Centre and Clinton Counties Pennsylvania", by John Blair Linn

1793 - On 24 April 1793, John Barr made application to the Land Office of Pennsylvania for a warrant and survey on a tract of land -- to purchase "vacant land" from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania -- an approximate 400 acres of land located on the West Branch of Wallace Run (which empties into Bald Eagle Creek) in upper Bald Eagle Twp. Mifflin Co. PA (now between Boggs and Union Twp's in Centre Co.)-- adjoining a tract of land applied for by Ann Deal.

1793 - Warranty certificate No. 220 was issued, as applied for, in Mifflin Co. -- for the amount of 50 shillings per 100 acres -- dated 27 April 1793 -- and signed by the Governor of Pennsylvania, Thomas Mifflin.

1808 -The tract survey was returned 20 Dec.1808 on warrant No. 220 (Mifflin Co.) for 412 acres and 84 perches -- land situate (after county line change) to Spring twp., Centre County, PA. The survey sketch, boundaries and location is copied into Pennsylvania land office-- Book "G" pg. 408.

Sold Land - Upon receiving the approved warrant of the above tract of land, John Barr then preceded to sell it to other parties. The deed read as follows: Know ye all men by this presence that application hath been made by me, John Barr of Pine Creek Twp. Northumberland Co. on the 24th day of April 1793 to the Land Office of Pennsylvania for the purchase of a tract of land containing 400 acres situate in the county of Mifflin --seeking

whereof a warrant and a survey of the same for my use. Now know ye that I, the said John Barr, for the consideration of 5 shillings apiece to me in hand paid by Robert Fleming and Thomas Grant, the receipt of which is acknowledged as well as other good causes and valuable considerations have bargained and sold to the said Robert Fleming and Thomas Grant. Filed in Spring Twp, Centre Co. and recorded Deed Book F pg.10, Dec. 1, 1817. Surveyors drawing and property can be located in State Land Records, Pennsylvania State Archives, Harrisburg, PA under Mifflin County, book G, pg. 407-408.

1798 - US Direct Tax of 1798 - John Barr listed on property number #51, living in a log cabin, 300 acres, located in Lycoming County described as follows: "on the east side of of Pine Creek known by the name of James Alexander improvement which includes a small island in said Creek of about 40 acres situate about 5 miles from the emptying into the west branch of Susquehanna: bounds on the lower side by a mountain and extending up said creek to the narrows" This property is listed as owned by Colonel Thomas Proctor, the noted Revolutionary War Artillery Officer. 1800 - List of taxable inhabitants of Pine Creek Township, Lycoming Co. PA - 7 March 1800 lists John Barr, occupation farmer

1808 - Land Purchase on Cooks Run - Lycoming County deed book Vol.10 pgs. 249-250. John Conaway deeds to John Barr of Dunstable Twp. for the consideration of 50 pounds, all the tract of land in Warrant No. 1933 (dated 20 August 1793), which was laid out about 1 mile above the north of Kettle Creek on the north side of the West Branch of the Susquehanna River in Dunstable Twp. (late Pine Creek Twp) Lycoming Co. PA

"A man by the name Conaway made the first improvement on the flat below Cook's Run which is known as the Millegan Place, and subsequently John Barr came into possession of the property, and planted an orchard and made most of the improvements. This was in a early day and contemporaneous with the settlements at Kettle Creek and Cook's Run. Mr. Barr had three* sons, William, Robert, and James.* (John's son -John Jr, b 1791- was somehow missed)This property was eventually purchased by Hugh Millegan." 1810 - US Census PA - John Barr listed in Lycoming Co property No. 837 Dunstable Twp.

1818 - Declaration for Pension Application - The Eighth Judicial District of the state of PA, Lycoming Co, Court of Common Pleas, Term no.10 - On the 18th day of June 1818 personally appears John Barr, age 67 years, resident of said County, doth on his oath make the following declaration ;... the said John Barr enlisted in Feb. 1777 in the state of Delaware in the company commanded by Capt. George Bush and joined the 11th Regiment commanded by Col. Hubley of the Pennsylvania Line, that he continued to serve in the said Corps in the service of US until 18th day of January year 1781. He was then discharged of service at Trenton in the state of New Jersey. He was in the battles of Springfield, Brandywine, Germantown, Morristown and at the Piole (Paoli) Source: Revolutionary War Pension file No. 3496

War Department Pension Certificate # 4805 -

I certify that in conformity of the law of the United States of the 18th March 1818 John Barr late private in the Army of Revolution is inscribed on the pension list, roll of the PA agency at the rate of \$8 per month to commence on the 18th day of June 1818. Pension Certificate 4805 given at the war office of the United States this 8th day of December 1818, signed; John C Calhoun, Secretary of War, Washington City.

1820 - US Census PA - John Barr listed in Lycoming Co property No. 081 Chapman Twp.

1820 - Declaration for Pension Application - Lycoming Co., Term No. 12 - On the 4th day of December AD 1820 personally appears in open court of Common Pleas held in Williamsport for the county of Lycoming, John Barr age 71 resident of Lycoming Co....doth make the following declarations....I do solely swear that I was a resident citizen of the United States on the 18th March 1818 and that I have not since that time by gift, sale or any manner have disposed of my property or any part thereof with intent thereby so to diminish it as to

bring myself within the provisions to an Act of Congress....signed by John Barr, (his mark).

Schedule of Property: I have besides necessary clothing and bedding, 1 cow, 7 sheep, 1 walnut table, 1 set cup/saucer value \$25.25 : 5 tin cups, 11 spoons, 2 tin buckets, 1 pot and kettle, value \$5.50: 1 churn, 1 tub, 6 plates, 6 knives and forks, value \$2.30: 1 tea cannister, 1 spinning wheel, 1 teapot, value \$2.37: 1 coffee mill, 2 bottomless chairs, value \$2.00: about 50 acres of land which lies in a remote place of the county on the Sinnemahoning Creek, without any communication to it for any kind of carriage, value \$50.00:

I am by occupation a weaver, but my age and many infirmities, am not able to pursue that occupation. I have 3 children residing with me, James age 19 years , Jane age 16 years, Esther (Hester) age 11 years and my wife Mary age 62 years and infirm like myself. Signed John Barr (his mark)

State of Pennsylvania Lycoming Co., : I, Thomas Hays, prothonotary of the Court of Common Pleas in and for said county hereby certify that the foregoing oath and the schedule, thereto annexed, are truly copied from the record of the said court and I do further certify that it is the opinion of the said court that the total amount and value of property on the schedule is \$87.42....Williamsport, 4 December 1820, signed Tho Hays, Prothonotary

War Department Pension Office dated 12 April 1821 Certificate No. 4805

Sir, you are hereby informed that the schedule of your property has been examined, and the Secretary of War has directed your name to be continued on the pension role. You will be paid, at the ensuing semi-annual payment in September next, the sum that may then be due from the time of suspending your pension....signed Travis L. Edwards, Washington City DC.

1826 - John Barr Sr. sells Cooks Run property to his son, John Barr Jr. - Lycoming County Deed book Vol.18 pg.8. John Barr Sr. deeds to John Barr Jr. property in Warrant No. 1933 for consideration of 50 pounds paid by John Barr, Jr. of Spring Twp. in the County of Centre State of PA. Signed, John Barr (his mark) Mary Barr (her mark) recorded August 14, 1826.

1846 - Widow's pension claim

State of Pennsylvania County of Elk, Be it known that before the subscriber, a Judge in and for said county of Elk personally came Mary Barr who having been by me duly sworn according to law on her oath making the following declaration in order to obtain benefits of the Act of Congress July 7, 1838. That she is the widow of John Barr who was a soldier in the Revolution and at the date of his death a pensioner of the United States, that her maiden name was Elcock and that she was married to the said John Barr at the town of _____ in the county of New Castle in the state of Delaware according to the best of her recollection on the 18 day of March 1784. That the said John Barr died at Bald Eagle Centre County PA, on the 22nd day of August 1833, that she has no record of the marriage of the said John Barr but has a record of the births of her children which is herewith sent to the pension office, that said record is in the handwriting of Elihu Chadwick and was made at the request of the said John Barr in the said year 1819 - that she was married by Rev. William McCannon - that she has not intermarried since the death of the said John Barr but remained his widow. signed by Mary Barr (her mark) 8th day August 1846. Declaration addition - 25 August 1846, Dear Sir, Herewith I send a declaration of Mary Barr with record of births of children and the pension certificate of her husband. Mrs. Barr is unable to state the town in which she was married but says the place according to the best of her recollection was called Red Clay Creek Hundreth that at that time there were no townships that it was about 1 mile from Newport 3 from Wilmington and 4-5 from New Castle. signed A L Lynde

2. Robert² Barr (John¹) was born 20 Jan 1785, and died 19 Nov 1824 in Gibson Twp, Clearfield Co., PA. He married **Catherine Smith**, daughter of Benjamin Smith and Mary Wilson. She was born Abt. 1790 in White Deer Valley, PA.

Notes for Robert Barr:

Robert Barr: Will --- In the name of God, I Robert Barr of Gibson Twp., Clearfield Co., in the state of PA, being and frail in bodily abilities, yet sound of mind and memory and thinking by the course of nature that my dissolution is not far distant, I do hereby make, constitute and ordain, make this my last will and testament, in manner and form following the wit: first, it is my will and do allow my body to be buried in a Christian like manner at the discretion of Executor and as touching those worldly goods and effects wherewith it has please the Lord God of the Universe to Bless me within this life, I do will and dispose of the same as to followeth to wit: First my lawful debts be justly paid by my executor and also I do have all and singular both real and personal property with my papers in his hands to do as his attorney in the law shall direct except my household furniture and 1 cow which shall be at the discretion of my beloved wife with the sheep which shall be for the use of my family. I do likewise constitute, appoint, and ordain my worthy brother William Barr, whole and sole executor of this my last will and testament, and I do hereby make null and void all other will and testaments made be me. In witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 26th day of August in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and twenty four. Signed and sealed and proclaimed by the said Robert Barr in the presence of us: John Berfield, Jr. and Daniel Miller. Signed and sealed by Robert Barr.

He had a farm of 50 acres which was accessible only by horseback believed to be located on Barr Run, Gibson Twp., Clearfield Co. (now Cameron Co) Barr Run was later called Plug Hollow, now called Stone Quarry Hollow.

In the book "History of Centre and Clinton Counties" by John Blair Linn, 1883 on page 648 in Noyes Twp. Chapter: " I was up on the Sinnemahoning one time in the company of Robert Barr. One Jerry Gaines who lived there had misused a sister of Barr's: he met Gaines: an altercation took place and resulted in Barr shooting Gaines in the leg. By advice of Barr's friends, he gave himself up and was taken to jail, and when the day of the trial came, Barr had hosts of friends; he was cleared without any trouble and came home rejoicing."

1814 - Robert appears on a tax list for the Sinnemahoning District, year 1814. He was at that time a taxable inhabitant of the Sinnemahoning District, Lawrence Twp, Clearfield Co, PA.

1821 - Robert appears on list of taxable inhabitants in Gibson Twp., Clearfield County 20 November 1821.

1824 - Centre County Courthouse deed book G pg. 633 dated 1 November 1824. Grantor: James D. Harris and wife Mary Ann -- Grantee: John Barr Jr. - Indenture (in part) from James D. Harris to John Barr of Spring Twp. Centre Co., PA. In consideration for the sum of \$125.00 to James D. Harris of Spring Twp. in Centre Co. has granted and sold to John Barr (Jr) a tract of land containing 11 acres 64 perches [being a part of a larger tract of land granted to James D. Harris by patent dated 5 October 1824 - enrolled in patent book H vol. 23 pg. 36] --- Deed recorded: 1 November 1824 Centre County Courthouse.

1826 - John Barr Jr. buys Cooks Run Property from his father John Barr Sr. - Lycoming Co. Deedbook Vol 18 Pg 68, John Barr Sr deeds Property in Warrant No. 1933 for consideration of 50 Pounds paid by John Barr Jr of Spring Twp Centre Co Pa. - Recorded 14 Aug 1826.

1827 - John Barr Jr. Deeds Cooks Run property to Hugh Millegan-- deed book Vol. 17 pg.358 Lycoming County Courthouse. Hugh Millegan purchases all of the property on Warrant No. 1933 from John Barr Jr. for the consideration of \$400 on 2 June 1827, signed John Barr Jr. (his mark) and Ellen Barr (her mark) recorded 3 September 1827.

1832 - Centre County Courthouse deed book 1 pg. 226 dated 31 March 1832. Grantor: John Barr Jr. and wife Ellen - Grantee: William Marshall - from John Barr of Spring Twp. Centre County and Ellen his wife, in consideration for the sum of \$600.00 has granted and sold the described parcel of land lying and being in Spring Twp., containing 9 acres, 118 perches - adjacent to land [being part of a larger tract of land granted to James D. Harris by patent dated 5 October 1824 enrolled in patent book H vol. 23 pg. 36] being part of the same

land conveyed to John Barr Jr. 1 November 1824 Spring Co. deed book G page 633 -- entered and recorded 17 May 1832.

7. William² Barr (John¹) was born 26 Jan 1798 in Lycoming Co. Pa, and died 28 Apr 1886 in Cameron County, PA. He married **Sarah Ann Miller**, daughter of John Miller. She was born 09 Mar 1800, and died 06 Mar 1875 in Cameron County PA.

Notes for William Barr:

William and Sally Barr owned a tract of land on both sides of the stream, Bennet's Branch, located 1.4 miles below the mouth of Hicks Run Stream.

1821 - William Barr appears on list of taxable inhabitants in Gibson Twp., Clearfield County, 20 November 1821

1830 - US Census PA William Barr is listed in Gibson Twp. in property No. 240, Clearfield Co, PA

1844 - Tax List - William Barr is listed as a farmer in Gibson twp.

1844 - Elected School Director in Gibson Twp. Elk Co. PA

1850 - Property Deed Gibson Twp. Elk Co., PA 31 Oct. 1850 from William Barr and wife Sarah to Anson G. Phelps of the city of New York. This indenture made 31 Oct. 1850 between William Barr of the Twp. of Gibson in the County of Elk, PA and Sally his wife of the first part Anson G. Phelps of the city of New York of the second part -- in consideration of the sum of \$150.00. Clearfield Co. 66 acres and 70 perches being the same place on which the family now resides. Now the consideration of said covenant is this. The said Saul Barr and Jacob Barr being their heirs and obliged to pay all the bills due and owing by the said James Barr at the time of signing this agreement, bonds, bills, notes or judgements or otherwise, agrees to keep in sufficient meat, food and clothing for said James Barr and Margaret Barr, their parents, during their natural lives and suffer them to reside on the said place and in the house on the said place and do for them. The said Saul Barr and Jacob Barr are to find sufficient bread and meat for the rest of the minor part of the family, for and during the space of 5 years of this date and who are to reside on the said place with their parents during said term of 5 years as above

mentioned and it is at the same time expressly understood and agreed upon that the minor brothers and sisters of the said Saul and Jacob are to give their labor and industry to farm and cultivate the said place, as formally, during the said terms of 5 years provided they all remain on said place with their parents during the said term of 5 years as aforesaid it is also expressly agreed and understood and to which the parties bind themselves that when John Barr shall arrive at the age of 21 years of age, if he the said John Barr should desire or wish it he may by paying to his brothers the said Saul and Jacob Barr his proportion of the said sum of \$500.00 with interest be permitted to come in as partners with them in this the said place under the same contract and covenant as they the said Saul Barr and Jacob Barr their heirs and assigns are by this presence to support their parents James Barr and Margaret. That this covenant and contract is to be recorded with and the same time the deed of conveyance is from the said James Barr and Margaret Barr to the said Saul and Jacob Barr and to be considered a lien on said place conveyed as aforesaid. In witness whereof we have hereunder give our hands and seals this 29th day of April in the year of our Lord 1845. Sealed and delivered in the presence of us William M. Mason and Ellis Barr --(son of William Barr) signed, Jacob I Barr.

Note: Saul and Jacob Barr were the oldest and the only adult children of James and Margaret Barr at the time of this Covenant, John would be next to reach the age of 21. There were 4 children, under 5 years of age.

Summary

Jacob Barr was born 1 June 1823 in what was then part of Lycoming County, Pennsylvania. He later moved to Dents Run, Gibson Twp, Elk Co. Pa. and was raised and farmed in the Miller Run area of Gibson Twp. in what is now Cameron County. In 1860, Cameron County was created from parts of Clinton, McKean, Elk, and Potter Counties. His parents James Barr b. 24 March 1802, d. 14 Feb. 1860 and Margaret Miller Barr b. 3 April 1802, d. 15 Jan 1865 are both buried in the Miller Run cemetery in Gibson Twp. Cameron Co. PA.

Jacob was married 19 Aug 1848 in Lockport (across the river from Lock Haven) Clinton Co, PA to Harriet A. Johnston (newspaper reported Marriage of Jacob I Barr, of Elk Co., to Miss Harriet Johnson, of Colebrook Twp, Clinton Co.) by Justice of the Peace Charles Creys. They lived on Miller Run until after the Civil War. Jacob and Harriet had purchased 19 acres of land in Gibson Township on Bennett's Branch of Sinnemahoning Creek - part of warrant No. 3475 adjoining the property of William P. Barr. Deed for the purchase of land bearing the date of 2 December 1858 and recorded in the recorder's office of Elk County PA, 13 June 1861 deed book H page 451.

1860 - U S Census Gibson Township Elk Co. Pa. Jacob, Harriet, and Five children on page No 52.

1861 - Jacob enlisted 30 Oct 1861 as a Corporal in Company G of the 84th Regiment of the PA Volunteer Infantry. In his Army Service Record he is listed as 5'8 1/2", dark complexion, black hair and brown eyes. On the 12th of May 1862 Jacob was in the Union Hotel " Rebel" Hospital in Winchester, Virginia suffering from injuries sustained in battle. Stonewall Jackson captured Winchester on 26 May taking soldiers prisoner that were in the Union hotel, including Jacob. Jacob has a Prisoner of War Certificate dated 26 May 1862. On 31 Oct. 1862, Jacob was granted a medical leave and sent home to recuperate.

1863 - Census - The Pennsylvania Septennial census was taken in Gibson Twp., Cameron Co. PA between August 17 & 24 of 1863. This was the first and last Septennial Census taken in Cameron Co. PA which was formed in 1860. Jacob Barr, age 39, farmer and Harriett Barr age 31 are listed in Gibson Twp. Jacob was home from the 84th PA regiment on convalescent leave from injuries sustained in Stonewall Jackson's capture of Winchester, VA. Their son William G. Barr was born September 26, 1863.

In Sept. 1863, he returned to Company G of the 84th. He fought in the Battle of the

Wilderness, and was wounded in the knee on 9 May 1864 while fighting the Battle of Spotsylvania Courthouse, VA. He was sent to the hospital in Washington D.C., thence to Baltimore Md, and later transferred to a hospital in Little York, PA until his discharge 5 Dec 1864. Jacob returned to his home on Bennetts Branch before going west to find land. His wife Harriet sold the property in Gibson Twp. on 3 October 1865. There is a photograph that I have in his Civil War uniform that he signed "Jacob Barr to Mr. & Mrs. Mather" and on the back stated "I'm in Grand Island, Neb."

1866 - Jacob and Harriet acquired a government grant of 166 acres in what is now Yellow Medicine County Minnesota on the recently vacated Souix Indian Reservation. The move was sometime in the year 1866 - they were among the earliest to settle in Wood lake Township. Frank was the first child born in Minnesota 17 July 1867. Their children attended one of the first schools in Yellow Medicine Co, School District #7, a mile from his home.

1870 - U S Census - Town of Yellow Medicine Redwood Co. Minnesota Jacob, Harriet and their eight children are listed in the same household.

1874 - Jacob filed for a Civil War Pension as an invalid dated 6 April 1874 , Application # 191,857, Certificate # 514,155. He and family lived on the banks of Wood Lake, Mn and farmed over 200 acres until they sold the property in 1887 and moved to Taney County Missouri.

1880 - U S Census - town of Wood Lake Yellow Medicine Co. Mn, Jacob, Harriet and their children William, Frank, Rosa Bell, Lillie Mae, and Allen are listed in the same household. Ransom, Rosetta and their child Henry Ransom are in the next household. Edmond Castle, wife Eliza Ann and their two children are listed in the next household.

18 Aug 1888, book 1, page 228, deed record, Taney Co Missouri - Jacob purchased from George and Martha Seaton 160 acres of sec. 14 Twp. 24 range 22, and 2 1/2 acres of sec. 13 "a tract situate in the forks of Bear Creek and West Branch" for the sum of \$960.

28 May 1889, Jacob received title from the US Land Patent office, land purchased in Taney Co Missouri, through the Springfield Land office - 200 acres - in sec. 13 and 14 Twp. 24 range 22.

20 Oct 1891, book 6, page 242, deed record, Taney Co Missouri - Jacob and Harriet purchased from Ransom and Rosetta Barr (whose address was Boom Co., Arkansas) for \$400, the 80+ acres in Taney Co which they had acquired in 1888.

Jacob and his family lived in Taney County from 1887 until his death. He died there on 5 November 1891 and is buried in the National Military cemetery in Springfield Missouri. Military marker #1804 Marks his grave.

Obituary in Carthage Missouri evening news...Oct. 10 1911. Harriet A. Barr, 85 years of age and widow of an old soldier, died at 1 o'clock this morning at the home of her daughter, Mrs. James Shada, at 720 W. Sycamore St. Death was due to stomach trouble. For 2 years, Mrs. Barr had suffered, but she had been bedfast since last August. She has been in Carthage 12 years, during which time she has always made her home with Mrs. Shada. Her husband has been dead 20 years. Eight children survive her, they are -- Ransom and Frank Barr, of Mankato MN; William Barr in Idaho; Harry Barr in Montana; Mrs. Eliza Cassil (Castle) of Quincy, IL; Mrs. Lillie Sinott of St. Louis; Mrs. Bell Adams of Reeds Spring, Missouri; and Mrs. Shada. Mrs. Barr was born in Luzerne County, PA and spent the early part of her life there. Then she moved to MN, and in 1888 with her husband, moved to Taney County in this state. It was from Taney County that she came to Carthage to make her home with Mrs. Shada. Mrs. Barr is a member of the Advent Church. Funeral services will be held at 10 o'clock tomorrow morning from the Dunkard Church on Forrest St. Elder George Bernhart will be in charge. Burial will be in Oakhills cemetery.

Death Certificate states that she was living on Sycamore St. in Carthage, Jasper Twp. Missouri at the age of 85 and one month and 21 days. She was a housekeeper. Born in Luzerne County, PA. Father John Johnston, born in MA and mother Rebecca Brooks born in

. Family Struggle over Jacob's Missouri Farm - goes to Missouri Supreme Court

When Jacob died, 5 Nov 1891, he left 440 acres of land to his widow Harriet. Ransom and Rosetta had recently moved back to Blue Earth Co., MN where Frank and his family were living. Rosa Bell Depew, Harry and possibly William were living on the Barr farm at the time of his death. Lilly May Viers married Crane W. Viers (1891) and was living in Hannibal Missouri just across the Mississippi River from Quincy Illinois where Eliza Ann Castle and family were living. 25 April 1895 the Sheriff of Taney Co, notified Harriet that property taxes were unpaid for the years 1889, 1890 & 1892 and demanded payment, book 1, page 80, Circuit Court Taney Co Missouri. The document listed all of Jacob's living heirs -- Harriet A. Barr, William G. Barr, A.J. Reece, Elza W. Hoxie, Eliza A. Castle, Ransom Barr, Harry M. Barr, Maggie E. Cooper, Frank J. Barr, Belle Depew, Lillie M. Viers, C. C. Alkinson & J.B.

Hoxie. On

1 Nov 1895, the Sheriff of Taney Co Missouri sold and titled the land to Lillie May Viers all of Jacob's property for \$118 in back taxes, book 2, page 201, Taney Co, Circuit Court Record. Following was a family struggle and legal battle over the land that lasted for 7 years and finally was resolved in favor of Lilly May, to whom it was originally titled, in the Sheriff's sale. At the Supreme Court of Missouri, Crane Viers testified, as follows, "In 1891 I was married to the defendant, Lilly M. Viers, at Hannibal Missouri which was my home at that time. I was in the employ of the Hannibal & St. Joseph Railroad Co as a locomotive engineer up until the fall of 1895. The latter part of Oct I traveled to Forsythe Missouri, and on the first day of Nov 1895, I purchased at a Sheriff sale the lands mentioned in the suit for which I paid \$118. In the summer of 1899 I left my wife in charge of my business in the City of Quincy, State of Illinois, where we resided together at that time, and I came to Taney Co Missouri and moved and settled on this land. Before leaving Quincy, I had arranged with my wife to remain there and sell our business property which was worth something like \$600. In the fall of 1899 she instituted a divorce preceding in Adam Co Illinois, and wrote me that she never intended to live with me anymore. My wife, Lilly M. Viers who is the defendant in this case, refuses to live with me upon this land and she also refuses to longer live with me as my wife."

Lilly Viers testified as follows, " I am the defendant in this case and now reside in Quincy Illinois. I was married in Hannibal Missouri, nine years ago. I have begun a divorce suit against him in Adams Co, Illinois. The suit is now pending in Adams Co Circuit Court. In the fall of 1895 my husband came to Taney Co to purchase at Sheriff's tax sale the land involved in this suit, which was my father's old farm. My father had previously died leaving my mother and eight brothers and sisters as his heirs. My husband was engaged in the saloon business at Quincy Illinois, which he left for me to sell, which I did. I then went into the saloon business with a gentleman in Quincy. I was in the saloon business for about 3 months then I sold out and have been sewing some since. My object in buying the land was to get my mother off the land and get her to make her home with me. My mother, brother and sister were living on the land at the time it was sold for taxes. They would not give possession after the tax sale and my husband was a obliged to bring an ejectment suit against them (ejectment suit page 438, book 3, Circuit Court record, Taney Co Missouri) before they would get off. My mother has never made her home with me since I have been married. "

RESEARCHER'S PERSONAL COMMENTARY

In the Northwest corner of Quachita Parish, Louisiana - on the borders of Lincoln and Jackson Parish in the sandy pine-covered hills of Louisiana is a small community known as Indian Village. The Village area was settled early in 1800 by a small tribe of Choctaw Indians from Mississippi - fifty families with their Chief "Tusquahoma". They were granted permission by the Spanish government to settle in Quachita Parish. Around 1820 Chief Tusquahoma decided it was time to move further west and began to sell the land - first to local land owners and later to settlers from Mississippi and Alabama. Among these buyers between 1845 - 1849 was Wade Bryan and his wife Sarah, who by family tradition, was a full blooded Cherokee or Choctaw Indian.

It was M. Ruth Grigg's interest and curiosity about the early settlers of Indian Village, the migration of the Griggs and Bryan families from North or South Carolina through southern Alabama and on to north Louisiana, that developed into a full time quest for more information.

Ruth spent hundreds of hours in libraries and courthouses with a box full of sharp pencils and note pads, copying every remotely connected document she could find. Eventually her oldest daughter, June, began to accompany her and became a proficient researcher. Thereafter, family functions became forums for Griggs family history updates.

I, Ray Barr, began to wonder about the BARR side of the family and who my

grandparents mother and father were. I questioned family members and made notes of oral accounts, but no one knew the parentage of my grandfather, William G. Barr.

In 1998, with the help of my sisters, Dorothy Barr Perkins and June Barr McKinney, we began in earnest to trace the few leads we had which were, my grandfather's birth date, and his birth state of Pennsylvania. This report is our progress-to-date thanks to the able assistance of my sisters, June and Dorothy, and my mother's inspiration.
