

Descendants of Thomas Dailey

Generation No. 1

1. THOMAS¹ DAILEY was born Abt. 1806 in Ireland, and died Bef. 1850 in New York. He married BRIDGET DUFFEY Abt. 1826 in Ireland. She was born 1808 in Ireland, and died April 12, 1884 in St. Louis, MO.

Notes for THOMAS DAILEY:

Some of the hereditary Gaelic surnames took form at periods as early as the ninth and tenth centuries. These names are the earliest substantiated European records of family names. The majority however, like the surnames met in France and Italy, appear to have been adopted in the eleventh or twelfth centuries as in the case of the family name O'Dalaigh.

The earliest recording of the name was Cuchonnacht O'Dalaigh, who lived in Teffia, in what is now the County of Westmeath. Being noted for his learning, he was called "Cuchonnacht na Sgoile," meaning "Cuchonnacht of the School." He died in the year 1139.

The "O" prefixed to the name "Dalach" or "Dalaigh" signifies grandson or male descendant of Dalach in contrast to the prefix Mac or Mc which would mean son of the ancestor specified. The modern Anglicized versions of the ancient Gaelic family name Ua Dalaigh or O'Dalaigh, pronounced "O'Dhaulee," came about as a result of tyrannical laws, designed by the English rulers, which outlawed Gaelic names and customs as a means of penalizing the Irish people into a state of subjugation. Beginning with the reign of the English King Edward IV (1465), the law demanded that every Irishman living within the territory known as the "Pale" take an English name and comply with other English customs or forfeit his possessions. Most families resisted and it wasn't until the close of the Seventeenth Century, after constant persecution and ridicule that the Gaelic form nearly disappeared. In many cases the Anglicized forms were actually closely related to the basic Gaelic surnames minus the "Macs" or the "O's" as in the case of the name Daly.

The final doom of the Gaelic surnames came as a result of the widespread establishment of the English language among the Irish. This circumstance caused the English form of names to be taken for granted and considered as natural. In recent times, the Gaelic original has been re-adopted by some of the families. This trend back to the Gaelic will naturally spread as the ancient language gradually resumes its old dominant position in Ireland.

The common definition of the O'Dalaigh surname today is, "deriving from Dalach meaning 'one who is present at assemblies'; the root word is Dail, now the official title of the parliament of the Republic of Ireland". A connection is also possible to the long tradition of scholarship and poetic achievement associated with those who bear it, since the ollamh of Gaelic Ireland had a place of honor at the tribal dail as a man of learning and a poet. Other evidence points to an even older more significant meaning, based on the claim by the pagan Irish that they were offspring of their gods. This evidence is found on several Ogham stones which contain the oldest known form of Irish writing.

An example from the Gowran Stone;

DALLO MAQA MUCORI MAQI ERACIAS MAQI LI

and one from the Dunbell Stone of Kilkenny

BRANITTOS MAQI DECARI DDALLOS

These inscriptions appear to invoke either pagan gods or mythological figures with names similar to the ancestral "Dalach". A third ogham, Monattagert II further specifies the Dalach (Dalagni) as sons of the eponymous ancestor (Dali). In many cases the mythological ancestor was

female.

From this evidence and other data associated with times of antiquity in Ireland, it would appear that there are reasonable grounds for assuming the family name "O'Dalaigh" has a godly or mythological significance. Indeed, it provides a more logical probable meaning of the name O'Dalaigh than the more popular versions built almost entirely on definitions given in modern dictionaries for supposed parts of the family name.

So begins the story of this Irish Dailey family...

We do not know much about Thomas Dailey except he did exist. He and Bridget married in Ireland and had Bernard, the oldest son, there. The three of them immigrated from Ireland to New York sometime after Bernard's birth in 1828 and before Thomas' birth in 1832 since all census records show Thomas born in New York in 1832. We have possibly found BRidget in the 1850 census and it seems Thomas was not there putting his death berfore 1850. By 1850, Bernard and Thomas are living alone in a boarding house in St. Louis and by 1860 Bridget is in St. Louis also with the two younger boys. There also is evidence of a daughter. This is due to the 1880 census for Peter Dailey which shows an Ellen Breslan living with him as a niece born in Connecticut.

Notes for BRIDGET DUFFEY:

Thomas does not show in any St. Louis census so we can surmise he died before this group came to St. Louis, most likely in New York City since this is where two of the sons are shown as born in the census records. Bridget is shown as living with Thomas J. Dailey in the 1880 census records at the age of 72. She died several years later. Earlier, in the 1860 census Bridget shows up living in Bernard's house with John and Peter. Bridget also shows up in the St. Louis City directory in 1854 as a widow living on Mullanphy.

Bernard was born in Ireland in 1828 and Thomas was born in New York in 1832 so Bridget and Thomas would have arrived from Ireland into New York between 1829 and 1832 (accounting for babies and pregnancies). Also, Bridget would have arrived in St. Louis between 1851 and 1859 (Thomas was first to be married in St. Louis).

Note: There is a B. Duffey arrived from Ireland (Belfast) to New York on the "Josephine" on April 30, 1928.

Notes for JOHN A. DAILEY:

John never married. John shows up in the 1860 and 1870 census' but I could not find him in the 1880 census for Missouri. He was buried in the family plot in Calvary cemetery in St. Louis in 1890. John is shown in the 1870 census as a tobacco dealer and living with his mother, Bridget. In the 1854 city directory he is shown as living on Main and is a ship carpenter. In the 1866 city directory he is listed as a salesman. His address at the time of his death in St. Louis was 2819 Thomas Ave. His death certificate lists him as single when he died.

I did find a John Daley, same age, in the 1880 census, married to a Margarett from Ireland with 4 children ages 11 to 2 (1869-1878). He is listed as a Rag Peddler. It could be a match. Childrens' names from oldest to youngest were Mary, Katie, Thomas, and Lizzie. They were living in the 12th Ward, Precinct 120, St. Louis.

2. BERNARD FRANCIS² DAILEY, SR. (*THOMAS*¹) was born 1828 in Ireland, and died March 11, 1882 in St. Louis, MO. He married HARRIETTE LOUISE BOSTWICK 1859 in St. Louis, Missouri, daughter of ORSAMUS BOSTWICK and SARAH BARDWELL. She was born March 04, 1841 in Illinois, and died April 05, 1901 in St. Louis, MO.

Notes for BERNARD FRANCIS DAILEY, SR.:

Bernard and Thomas were the first Daileys to arrive in St. Louis. They arrived sometime before the 1850 census as they show up in that census living together in a boarding house. Bernard shows up in the 1860 city directory as a barkeeper living at 246 Biddle and living with Patrick J. Dailey. Later, between 1850 and 1860, Bridget shows up with the two younger sons. Bernard married in St. Louis and raised his family there. He is shown living at 908 N. 17th on the 1880 St. Louis City census. Bernard made a living first as a blacksmith as listed in the 1850 census and 1854 city directory, then a whitesmith, and then as a deputy sheriff of St. Louis. In the 1880 census he is listed as "Frances B. Dailey". By 1859, Bernard and his wife are living at 23 Gay Ave. in St. Louis. In the 1866 directory, he is living on 25th between Carr and Biddle and is both a blacksmith and a collector of "Dram Shop Licenses" at the city court house.

Notes for HARRIETTE LOUISE BOSTWICK:

1900 census shows Harriet as the head of household living with Edward (32), Francis (aka "Frank", 27) and Walter (26). The only odd thing about this is that Edward is married at this time and shows up in the same census with his family. I am positive these are the same people but why he shows up twice is a bit of a mystery. In the 1901 city directory, Harriett is listed as a "dressmaker" and living with Frank and Walter.

Notes for WALTER R. DAILEY:

In the 1901 city directory, Walter is living with his mother and brother at 1407 Spruce and is listed as a clerk at the W. Reid Oil Company. Walter is in the 1905 St. Louis city directory and listed as a porter living at 4670 Greer Ave. with his brother-in-law and sister, Rose. Walter shows up in the 1920 census as living with his brother-in-law, J. Edward Reid. Since he was 47 at this time, it can be assumed he never married. Walter is shown as being a clerk for the Rosenthal Paper Co. and living at 3042 Market avenue in 1932.

3. THOMAS J.² DAILEY (*THOMAS*¹) was born 1832 in New York, and died November 09, 1887 in St. Louis, MO. He married ANN M. KEATING October 24, 1859 in St. Louis, Missouri. She was born 1837 in Ireland, and died January 13, 1883 in St. Louis, MO.

Notes for THOMAS J. DAILEY:

Thomas shows up in the St. Louis City census in 1850 living in a boarding house with his brother Bernard. I found him in the 1860 census although the rest of the family. He is living with his wife Ann and a Mary Keating (ward7, pg. 150), two servants and a boarder. Thomas' occupation is city recorder. The rest of the Dailey family is

shown as living together in St. Louis. I did find him in the city directory living on 16th St. with Peter. Thomas again appears in the 1880 census with a 20 year old daughter so he must have been married in 1860 although I cannot find out where. Shown living on 3114 Brantner Place in St. Louis in 1880 census. Thomas does show up in the 1854 city directory living with Bernard at 86 Franklin Ave. and he is a "carriage trimmer". There is a Thomas J. Dailey in the 1859 directory who is a justice of the peace and who shows up as a lawyer in the 1866 directory. Since Thomas is listed as a Lawyer in the 1880 census, this is the same person.

Notes for PETER P. DAILEY:

Peter arrived sometime between 1850 and 1860 with his mother and older brother, John. Peter shows up in the 1860 city directory as a blacksmith living at 37N 16th St. with his brother, Thomas, who is listed as a city recorder. Peter shows up in the St. Louis city directory in 1866 as a student in the Bryant, Stratton & Carpenter's College.

Peter married in St. Louis and raised his family there. He is shown as living at 2450 N. Market in the 1880 census and employed as a Deputy Circuit Clerk for the City of St. Louis. In the 1894 city directory, Peter is shown living at 3616 Chestnut, which is now part of the St. Louis University soccer field, and his occupation is as a Deputy Sheriff at the court house. His sons, Edward and Thomas (who is shown as Joseph T.) are living with him. Edward is a clerk at J.A.Duffy. Joseph (Thomas) is listed as an electrician. He is later shown living at 3506 Chestnut in 1900 St. Louis census and the 1900 city directory with his sons, William F. and Edward. In the 1905 St. Louis City directory he is shown as a salesman for the Lambert-Deacon-Hill Printing Company and living at 3620 W. Pine. Peter shows up as a witness on the will of Maurice Ducy on 2/20/1873 (St. Louis Will Book K).

St. Louis Post Dispatch Obituary Sept. 8, 1913:

"Entered into rest on Saturday, Sept. 6, 1913, at 11 p.m., Peter P. Dailey.

Funeral from the residence of his daughter, Mrs. C.L. Lyle, 6219 Berlin avenue, on Tuesday, Sept. 9, at 8 a.m., front St. Francis Xavier's Church, thence to Calvary Cemetery, Interment private, Motor."

Notes for EDWARD P. DAILEY:

This person is interesting. He shows up in a 1910 census as the 34 year old son of Peter P. Dailey and Bridget and still living with them. This would have him born around 1876. However, in the 1880 census for Peter P. Dailey he does not show up and he would have been 4. He does not show up in the 1920 census. Charles shows up in the 1905 St. Louis City directory as living with his father, Peter, and he is a Deputy Marshall for the city. They were living at 3620 W. Pine. In 1906, Charles was the Asst. Secretary to the St. Louis Democratic Club. He does show up in the 1930 St. Louis City directory living with his sister, Mary, and her husband, Charles at 6159 McPherson Ave. In the 1930 directory he is listed as a Recorder of Deeds. We do have him buried in the family plot and it shows him as born in 1874. It is also believed that this Edward Dailey never married. In Edward's obit. no one is mentioned.

Notes for ? BRESNAN:

Since "Breslan" is the surname of Ellen, her father would have had that surname.

Notes for EDWARD JOSEPH DAILEY:

When Kitty died, Edward basically abandoned his children so they had to be parceled out to relatives to be raised. It is believed he never really became a part of their lives again. In the 1893 city directory Edward is listed as a driver and living at 1504 Belmont. His mother is living with them.

When Kitty died, the raising of her children fell to her sister, Mary and her sisters husband, John Traynor.

Wilbert Dailey, 30, of 4849A Easton, surrendered at the Deer Street police station when he learned he was sought in the case, was turned over to St. Louis County authorities and released under \$1000 bond. Dailey was sought following the arrest of Mrs. Bonnie Clare Andrews, 24, of 2750A Bartold, Maplewood, Friday night. The complaint on the bigamy charge was filed by her husband, Chrls Andrews, 34, of 7034 Emma, Jennings. Mrs Andrews' second marriage was disclosed in an investigation by Andrews' attorney, Donald McKee, during divorce proceedings. Mrs. Andrews had filed suit for divorce, and Andrews filed a cross bill. McKee said he learned during a routine check that Mrs. Andrews and Dailey were married Nov. 16, 1945, in Kansas City. She had spent time the last months of 1945 in Kansas City with him while Andrews was overseas with the Army, according to Andrews' affidavit. Mrs Andrews was released under \$1000 bond. She and Dailey are to appear May 10 before Magistrate Frank W. Tirrell. Dailey told police he married Miss Loraine Trout at St. Charles 10 years ago, but she obtained a divorce in 1942 while he was in the service. He married Miss Buelah Ferguson at Augusta, Ga. a few months later, he said. They were divorced last Tuesday. A picture of Mrs. Andrews and Dailey, sent to his parents, bore the inscription on the back, "To Mom and Dad, with lots of love, Bonnie and Bill."

The charges were later dropped due to limitations and jurisdictions.
