

Descendants of Martin and Margaret (Turner) Carlow

Generation No. 1

1. John Martin² Carlow (John Jacob¹) was born 11 October 1757 in Pownalborough, Maine^{1,2}, and died Bef. 1830. He married **Margaret Turner** 06 November 1781 in Pownalborough, Maine^{3,4}, daughter of Richard Turner and Ellen Cowell. She was born Abt. 1752 in Yorkshire, England⁵, and died Bef. 1850.

Notes for John Martin Carlow:

John Martin Carlow (hereafter referred to as Martin Carlow) was a Loyalist along with the rest of his family. Lorenzo Sabine records in Biographical Sketches of the American Revolution, "[John and Martin Carlow] set out to travel by land in 1778 and, after enlisting with the 'Rebels' to avoid detection, and various other adventures, they arrived in Nova Scotia. The year following, Martin was in Lunenburg, in that Colony, and John at the British post at the mouth of the Penobscot, [Castine]. In 1782 Martin had 'gone to live at home in peace.'" According to Robert Brooks [The Maine Genealogist, May 2004, p. 55], Martin was a carpenter in the Engineering Department sent from Halifax, Nova Scotia to build Fort George at Majabigwaduce (Castine), Maine. He began work April 1780. After the war ended, Martin was granted land in Charlotte County, New Brunswick in the summer of 1784 as a reward for his loyalty to the Crown as part of the Penobscot Association Land Grants. He was granted a house lot (Parr's Division #L3) in the town of St. Andrews and a tract of land of 100 acres to develop on Bohannes Stream off the St. Croix River in what was then the Parish of St. Stephen (lot #202). In 1781 he and his bride were listed as living in Balltown, Maine (now known as Whitefield) as well as recorded in the 1790 and 1800 census records as living there. On 10 November 1801, while living in Balltown, he sold both his town lot and the Bohannes Stream lot to James Turner. He bought land and moved back to St. Andrews shortly after that because on 8 November 1809 he is recorded as living there when he sold 100 acre lot #52 (originally granted to James Maloney) to Stephen Lawrence. On 27 December 1809 he sold 100 arce lot #50 (originally granted to Benjamin Pomeroy) to his son Jacob Carlow. On 7 November 1812 he sold 100 acre lot #51 (originally granted to James Stewart) to his son Richard Carlow. Lots 50, 51 and 52 fronted the St. Croix river about midway between the mouth of Oak Bay and the town of St. Andrews. In 1820 Martin is living in Lubec, Maine (In the 1820 census an unknown male under 10 years of age is living in Martin's household, probably not his child). I am not sure what the original source is for the names of Martin's children, but I have not seen the list I am using contradicted anywhere. However, I did drop the name Eliza Isobella Carlow because it seems out of place and does not fit with other evidence.

Notes for Margaret Turner:

Margaret is head of the household and living in Robbinston, Maine in 1830 and Calais, Maine in 1840.

Children of John Carlow and Margaret Turner are:

- 2 i. Elizabeth³ Carlow, born 1783 in Maine^{6,7}; died September 1883 in Calais, Maine⁸.

Notes for Elizabeth Carlow:

Elizabeth was probably the female aged between 25 and 45 living with her father and mother in Lubec, Maine in 1820. She is probably the female living with her widowed mother in Robbinston, Maine in 1830. She was living as a border in the home of Duncan McPhail in Calais, Maine in 1870. In 1880 she is living with Arthur Carlow in Calais. She lived to be 100 years old!

3. Elinor³ Carlow (John Martin², John Jacob¹) was born Bef. 1790, and died Unknown. She married **John Young** 14 November 1805 in Charlotte County, New Brunswick, Canada⁹. He died Unknown.

Children of Elinor Carlow and John Young are:

4. Richard³ Carlow (John Martin², John Jacob¹) was born Abt. 1790 in Maine^{13,14}, and died 09 September 1865 in Calais, Maine^{15,16}. He married **Hulda Dorman** Abt. 1822¹⁷, daughter of Jabez Dorman and Mary Godfrey. She was born 02 October 1787 in Maine^{18,19,20,21}, and died Unknown.

Notes for Richard Carlow:

Richard was living in St. Andrews, New Brunswick, Canada 7 November 1812 when he purchased 100 acres of land (originally Penobscot Association Land Grant lot #51 of James Stewart) from his father. Richard was probably the other adult male reported living in James Carlow's household in Machias, Maine in 1820. He was living in Lubec, Maine in 1822 when he filed his marriage intentions with Hulda Dorman in Harrington, Maine. In 1830 he was living in Robbinston, Maine. He was living in Calais, Maine in 1840 and 1850.

Children of Richard Carlow and Hulda Dorman are:

- + 9 i. Arthur⁴ Carlow, born September 1824 in Maine; died 24 April 1883 in Calais, Maine.
- 10 ii. Hulda D. Carlow, born Abt. 1828 in Maine^{22,23}; died Unknown. She married Robert Pettegrove; born Abt. 1817 in New Brunswick, Canada²⁴; died Unknown.

Notes for Hulda D. Carlow:

Hulda was single and living at home with her parents in Calais, Maine in 1850. On 18 September 1856 she filed marriages intentions with Robert Petegrove in Calais, Maine. Robert's first wife died earlier that year. She does not appear in the 1860 census with her husband Robert, who is living alone with 4 children. None of the children's ages coincide with the time of her marriage, so she and robert probably left no descendants.

Notes for Mary G. Carlow:

Mary was single and living at home with her parents in Calais, Maine in 1850.

5. Jacob Henry³ Carlow (John Martin², John Jacob¹) was born Abt. 1792 in New England³¹, and died Bef. 1851³². He married **Elizabeth Lucy Turner**, daughter of James Turner and Rachel Sylvester. She was born Abt. 1791 in New Brunswick, Canada^{33,34,35}, and died 31 January 1875 in St. Andrews, New Brunswick, Canada^{36,37}.

Notes for Jacob Henry Carlow:

Jacob Carlow was living in St. Andrews, New Brunswick, Canada 27 December 1809 when he purchased 100 acres of land (originally Penobscot Association Land Grant #50 of Benjmain Pomeroy) from his father. He was in St. Andrews in 27 October 1835 when he sold 25 acres of his land to his brother James.

Notes for Elizabeth Lucy Turner:

Elizabeth is living with her son Henry in 1851 and 1871 in St. Andrews, New Brunswick, Canada and reported that she is a widow. In 1871 Elizabeth reported that she was of English descent and a Baptist by faith.

6. James³ Carlow (John Martin², John Jacob¹) was born Abt. 1795 in Balltown, Maine^{40,41,42,43}, and died 27 January 1861 in Brewer, Maine^{44,45}. He married **(1) Mehetable Ayers** 06 March 1816 in Woodstock, New Brunswick, Canada⁴⁶. She died Unknown. He married **(2) Clarissa Fickett** Abt. 1819^{47,48}, daughter of Zebulon Fickett and Sarah Fickett. She was born Abt. 1798 in Harrington, Maine^{49,50,51,52,53}, and died 15 January 1880 in Brewer, Maine^{54,55}.

Notes for James Carlow:

In 1820 James is living in Machias, Maine. In 1830 James is living in Robbinston, Maine. On 29 March 1835 James and Clarissa were baptized and joined the St. Stephen Baptist Church in Bayside, New Brunswick and were listed as residents of Calais, Maine. In 1840 and 1850 James was living in Calais, Maine (a male aged between 60 and 70 is living in James' household in 1840). James was working as a farmer in 1850. In 1860 James and Clarissa were living in Brewer, Maine and they were listed in the census as paupers. James was working as a day laborer in 1860.

Notes for Clarissa Fickett:

In the 1870 census, Clarissa is living with Asa Field in Bangor, Maine.

James' last appearance in the Maine census is probably 1830 as a boy between 10 and 15 living with his family in Robbinston.

9. Arthur⁴ Carlow (Richard³, John Martin², John Jacob¹) was born September 1824 in Maine^{68,69,70,71,72,73}, and died 24 April 1883 in Calais, Maine⁷⁴. He married **Mary Kennedy** 01 June 1852 in Calais, Maine⁷⁵, daughter of Alexander Kennedy and Harriet Stinson. She was born April 1832 in St. Andrews, New Brunswick, Canada^{76,77,78,79,80}, and died 02 February 1914 in Calais, Maine⁸¹.

Notes for Arthur Carlow:

Arthur was single and living with his parents in Calais, Maine in 1850. He was living in Calais in 1860, 1870 and 1880 and working as a master mariner.

Children of Arthur Carlow and Mary Kennedy are:

17. Margaret Ann⁴ Carlow (Jacob Henry³, John Martin², John Jacob¹) was born Abt. 1812 in New Brunswick, Canada^{85,86}, and died 24 September 1885 in St. Stephen, New Brunswick, Canada⁸⁷. She married **Elisha Prescott Hanson** 25 July 1833⁸⁸, son of John Hanson and Abigail Libby. He was born Abt. 1804 in New Brunswick, Canada^{89,90,91}, and died Bef. 1881⁹².

Notes for Margaret Ann Carlow:

Margaret is living in St. Patrick Parish, New Brunswick, Canada and her husband is working as a farmer in 1851 and 1861. In 1881 she is widowed and living in St. Stephen, New Brunswick. Margaret and Elisha were Baptists.

Abt. 1820 in Maine¹⁰⁷, and died Unknown. He married **(2) Margaret ?** Bef. 1860¹⁰⁸. She was born Abt. 1830 in Canada^{109,110,111,112}, and died Abt. 1912.

Notes for Mark Alfred Carlow:

Mark was living in Trenton, Wisconsin in 1850; in Mauston, Wisconsin in 1960; in Butler Precinct, Platte County, Nebraska in 1870; and in Arcadia, Nebraska in 1880 and working as a farmer.

Notes for Margaret ?:

In 1900 Margaret is widowed and living in Linn Township, Cedar County, Missouri. She reported in the census that she had immigrated lived in the USA 53 years and had 13 children, 8 of whom were still living.

In 1900 he is single and living with his step-mother (mother?) in Linn Township, Missouri. At that time he reported that he was born September 1845 in Canada and had lived in the USA for 53 years. In 1910 he is living with his sister Harriet in Linn Township and working as a farm laborer. In 1920 he is living with his nephew John Wigent in Linn Township and working as a farmer.

In 1920 he is living with Alfred Carlow in Linn Township and working as a farm laborer.

19. Isaac⁴ Carlow (Jacob Henry³, John Martin², John Jacob¹) was born Abt. 1815 in New Brunswick, Canada^{140,141}, and died 25 April 1879 in Bayside, New Brunswick, Canada¹⁴². He married **Mary Jane Smith**. She was born Abt. 1821 in New Brunswick, Canada^{143,144}, and died 04 July 1885 in Victoria, British Columbia, Canada^{145,146}.

Notes for Isaac Carlow:

Isaac was living in St. Andrews, New Brunswick, Canada and working as a farmer in 1851.

He was born 28 March 1815 in Tyrone County, Ireland^{163,164,165,166,167}, and died 29 August 1887 in Robbinston, Maine¹⁶⁸.

Notes for Ann Goss Carlow:

Ann (aka Nancy) was living in Robbinston, Maine in 1850, 1860, 1870 and 1880 and her husband was working as a farmer. She was living with her son Ernest Trimble in Robbinston, Maine in 1900.

According to Victor's obituary, he worked for the Gulf Corporation in Bangor, Maine for 30 years, retiring in 1951. In 1920 he is living in Orrington, Maine with his uncle, Ross Rich, and working in a lumber mill. In 1930 he is living in Bucksport, Maine and working as a gas truck driver. He left no descendants.
