In the 1880 Tyler Co. census, Delila is found in Samuel & Hester (Weekley) Wright's household. Delila is listed as aunt. In the 1900 Tyler Co. census, Delilah Weekley is living with her son, Harvey Booher. She stated that she was a widow, the mother of 5 children, 3 living.

Research: According to information received from Nancy E. Gates with Susan Wedig contributing, Delilah had a son named Henry Harvey Booher born in 1858. Is Harvey Booher, b. 1880 actually Delilah's grandson or did she have two sons named Harvey, namely Harvey G. and Henry Harvey? Daughter Sarah A. Booher, b. 1854 is reported to be the daughter of John D. Weekley, who later married her sister, Susannah. Was John D. Weekley also the father of Delilah's other children? If not, who was? Who was the father of Harvey G. Booher, who was born when she was 43 and only four years before she married James A. Weekley? Did she have all five children out-of-wedlock? If Henry Harvey, Harvey G., Frank and Sarah A. are all her children, then who is the missing child mentioned in the 1900 census and who are their fathers? How many times was Delilah married? With how many different men did she have children?

Delilah's middle name was probably Eva and she may have gone by the nickname Ilah. Delilah's son, Harvey named his daughter Ilah Eva, presumably after his mother, Delilah Eva Booher.
