A native and former Dyersburg resident who had lived in Memphis for the past nine years, was killed instantly in an automobile accident early Sunday morning near Corinth, Mississippi. The driver of the car was also fatally injured and a passenger is in serious condition at a Memphis hospital.

Dead are Mrs. Alta Marie Garvey, 40, of 755 Newell, Memphis, daughter of Mrs. Ida Morris, 131 Broadway, Dyersburg, and Russell Maniere, 34, former Memphian of Gainesville, Florida.
