As a British novelist who often combined the spy thriller and the private eye crime mystery, Victor Canning drew comparisons to predecessors such as Eric Ambler, contemporaries such as Ian Fleming, and successors such as Len Deighton and John le Carre. Canning published his first novel in 1935; over fifty more novels followed before he died in 1986. In many of these works, Canning sets a moral conflict as the central theme. His characters live in a confusion of good and evil, their "bright aspirations," as Harry Sumrall wrote in the *Washington Post*, "beset by the sinister demands of reality." Yet, even with the serious struggle between good and evil, Canning also managed "a generous dollop of humor, usually droll, urbane, and finely sketched, a trait not often found in spy and espionage stories," noted Frank Denton in the *St. James Guide to Crime and Mystery Writers*.

One of Canning's creations is Rex Carver, a British spy turned private eye, who appears in a series of books, including *The Whip Hand*, *Doubled in Diamonds*, *The Python Project*, and *The Melting Man*. Carver is a private eye who does not just work the streets and back alleys of London in search of mysteries to solve. He, like most of Canning's characters, is a traveler. And the novels in which Carver plays a part, like most of Canning's novels, demonstrate the author's "eye for local color and detail," as Denton put it. In *The Whip Hand*, Carver pursues a beautiful German woman from England across Europe to Yugoslavia, through locales that *Book Week* contributor D. B. Hughes found were sketched "with elegant detail." "The women, and the regular security people, are out of Ian Fleming," M. K. Grant, a *Library Journal* reviewer commented at the time, "but there is a slashing climax at the altar of a hideous past that isn't quite creditable." Even so, in Hughes's opinion, "This may be the most superior of all the superior Victor Canning adventures. . . . His hero is wily, the two girls entrancing, and the German villains deep-dyed."

In *The Python Project*, published in 1967, Carver is again on the move, this time from England across the Channel to France, then across the Mediterranean to Libya, then back to Spain. The mystery begins as a simple case--recovering a stolen bracelet--but along the way it becomes far more complex. Still, as A. L. Rosenzweig pointed out in *Book World*, "Canning arranges his bookings like a seasoned travel agent and manages brawls and boudoir scenes with the dry wit we have come to expect from this master of elegant espionage." Commending Carver's creator, A. J. Hubin wrote in the *New York Times Book Review*, "Canning is an old pro whose pen has lost none of its cunning, as convincingly demonstrated in [this] effective blend of a medium-boiled British private investigator caper and the spy story." The main reservations critics had about the novel reflected more on the times in which it was published than the novel itself. These reservations were voiced in a *Best Sellers* review: "A fine suspense thriller that unfortunately is too sensual to be recommended widely." Yet for Hubin, *The Python Project* represented "spy fiction at its bewildering best."

The Melting Man, which appeared one year after *The Python Project*, also involves Carver in a seemingly simple case. This time he needs to recover a missing Mercedes somewhere in France. But the car contains a secret coveted by many parties. "Canning again provides one of those serpentine story-lines that have become a Carver hallmark," noted Hubin. But Hubin faulted Canning for using one character purely for her capacity to titillate the readers and a reviewer for the *Times Literary Supplement* criticized him for beginning in a formulaic fashion. Yet this same reviewer concluded that *The Melting Man* was "a first-class professional thriller fringed with international sophistication."

In a review of one of Canning's later works, the 1980 novel *Fall from Grace*, Sumrall commented, "Canning is a resourceful writer, adept at illustrating man's paradoxical nature." The main character of *Fall from Grace*, for example, is John Corbin, a selfish blackmailer whom the author endows with sympathetic qualities. As Charles M. Coffey pointed out in *Best Sellers*, *Fall from Grace*, as its title implies, conveys the "ironic lesson . . . that those who are capable of creating great beauty can sometimes be the 'perpetrators' of ugly deeds as well."

Some reviewers have been critical of the timing and plot development of *Fall from Grace* and other Canning novels. T. J. Binyon of the *Times Literary Supplement*, for instance, described *Fall from Grace* as a "slow moving novel, low on incident." The book's ending, Sumrall believed, arrives rather clumsily, "as if Canning suddenly lost interest and decided to dispense with the proceedings." In the *New York Times Book Review*, Robert Brandreth, despite a general high regard for *The Satan Sampler*--published in 1979--called it a "shade mechanical." Christine Raux, reviewing the book for *Best Sellers*, felt the "action is not fast paced . . . [and] coincidence plays a much too major role in the plot."

Many reviewers, even those critical of the mechanics of Canning's works, were impressed with his characterization. Peta Fordham in *Books and Bookmen* praised *The Satan Sampler*, emphasizing its "unusually real-life hero." Binyon lauded the author's "subtle creation of character" in *Fall from Grace*, and Sumrall found the book's figures "droll, urbane and finely sketched." As Brandreth summed up, Canning

"never introduces a character in black and white. In his books there are real people."
