

# *Descendants of James Le Broke*

## *Generation No. 1*

1. JAMES<sup>2</sup> LE BROKE (*LE BROKE*<sup>1</sup>) was born Abt. 1762 in Paris, France, and died 13 Apr 1812 in Paris, Oxford Co., Maine. He married SARAH GARDNER 12 Aug 1784 in New Gloucester, Shepardsfield, Maine, daughter of NATHANIEL GARDNER and SARAH RANDALL. She was born 22 Jan 1753 in Pembroke, Plymouth Co., Mass., and died 1852 in Greenwood, Maine.

### Notes for JAMES LE BROKE:

James Le Broke a skilled tailor and variously referred to as Le Brook, Le Brock, La Broque, Brock, Brook, and Brooks, came to America from France as a young man with General Lafayette on the French fleet that assisted the colonists in their struggle for independence. James was born in Paris, France, but there is contradictory data on his Parisian birth date. In 1781 James enlisted and served for one year in the Sixth-Massachusetts Regiment during the American Revolutionary War, later settling in Pembroke, Mass. His record appears on pg. 622, Vol. 9, "Massachusetts Soldiers and Sailors of the Revolution". In 1784 he moved to Hebron, Maine and from there to Paris, Maine; and was among the pioneer settlers of "Old Shepardsfield" in the district of Maine. That same year he married Sarah Garnett (Gardner) in Shepardsfield, Maine, (marriage certificate is under the name of James Brock), they had three sons and a daughter. His wife stated in 1838 that James wrote his name as Brock and Broke indifferently and during the later part of his life he was called Le Broke, and so wrote his name. He spent the last years of his life in Paris, Maine, falling to his death from a house-top roof in 1812. Many of the history books of Paris, Maine and his obituary, record his death as 1812. His obituary in the "Eastern Argus Newspaper" in Portland, Maine states he was 50 years old at his death in Paris on 13 April 1812 and left a wife and four children. When Sarah applied for his pension in the state of Maine, County of Oxford, on October 16, 1838, she stated his death as 1813.

Notes for SARAH LE BROKE:

Miss Sarah Le Broke, a single woman, had for many years been a valued school teacher in Oxford County, but when her brother Jacob decided to make a home in far-away Foxcroft, she came with him. Jacob's family increased rapidly and Miss Sarah was a much needed and esteemed member. She was the children's first teacher. In the summer of 1825, Miss Sarah taught the second school to be held in District #5, or Foxcroft Center, as it was soon to be known. The school was in a barn near the house of Charles Harmon.

**2.** JAMES<sup>3</sup> LE BROKE, JR. (*JAMES<sup>2</sup>, LE BROKE<sup>1</sup>*) was born 1784 in Paris, Oxford Co., Maine, and died 1867 in Greenwood, Maine. He married NANCY ANNA BECKLER 27 Oct 1814 in Paris, Maine, daughter of DANIEL BECKLER and ELIZABETH MILLER. She was born 28 May 1793 in Woodstock, Maine, and died 03 Jul 1860 in Waterford, Maine.

Notes for JAMES LE BROKE, JR.:

On a short cross-road near the village there was a small shabby house occupied before 1852 by an old man named James LeBroke, and his wife. He was much bent and lame with rheumatism and used tobacco and rum altogether too freely, so that it nearly cost him his life on more than one occasion. He did odd jobs and eked out a scanty living by digging out ancient pine logs, the decaying tops of former large timber trees that had been discarded. These he sawed up into blocks to be made into shingles, with a cross-cut saw, one end of which was usually worked by some boy, who would help him out of pity in part, and partly for the "resting spells". I have often spent an hour or two at this work for him myself and can testify that it was not light work for the boys. His wife was most unfortunate in having an enormous tumor or "wen" on one side of her face, which distorted one eye and her mouth and lips horribly. Still she kept apparently cheerful and did hard work washing and "cleaning house" for the village families. It used to be said that he came from a good Massachusetts family. If so, he had degenerated remarkably.

**3. JACOB<sup>3</sup> LE BROKE** (*JAMES<sup>2</sup>, LE BROKE<sup>1</sup>*) was born 03 Jun 1789 in Heborn, Oxford Co., Maine, and died 15 Mar 1867 in Foxcroft, Maine. He married MARTHA FOSTER 1821, daughter of ABNER FOSTER and POLLY HILTON. She was born 01 May 1801 in Aurora, Maine, and died 16 Oct 1868 in Foxcroft, Maine.

Notes for JACOB LE BROKE:

Jacob and his brother Nicholas were Privates in the War of 1812. Jacob served in the 45th Regiment of the United States Infantry under Captain Bailey Bodwell, Lt. Wm. Twombly and Ensign Wm. Reed. This company was raised principally in Norway, though a few men enlisted from Paris, Waterford and Greenwood. It was recruited in the months of September and October, 1812, mustered in November, and served until January, 1813. After a mishap in the war, Jacob & Nicholas were taken prisoner to be shot. When the guards became intoxicated they were able to climb out of the roofless jail and escape unharmed. Jacob Le Broke moved to Foxcroft, Maine in 1824, a few years after his marriage to Martha Foster. He settled on lot #5 in the 7th range, a short distance over the hill in "Dundee" from his uncle William Steadman. With so large a family on the hills of "Dundee", starvation's wolf troubled the Le Broke family, and the struggle made by them was intense. They however, had a comfortable framed house, and the children attended school taught by his sister Miss Sarah Le Broke, a single woman. Buried at Steadman's Landing, Foxcroft, Maine, with his wife Martha, the headstone reads "Long years they traveled together in the path of rectitude, always toiling for the children."

Augustus G. Le Broke was educated in the common schools in Foxcroft and the Foxcroft Academy, graduating with honors. The two terms of schooling a year, provided by the town, did not satisfy young Augustus. In those early days a reciprocal custom prevailed in the frontier towns, of allowing scholars who wished for increased "schooling", to pay tuition for a certain number of weeks in an adjoining district, even though that district was in another township. As a youth, Augustus took advantage of that custom, working hard to earn the tuition, either in working the cedar swamps cutting trees and shaving shingles in the winters, raising sufficient wheat, picking berries, or employment on and off the farm, and so got three terms a year at a school in Sebec. He worked hard and frequently walked to school barefooted rehearsing, as he walked, his school declamation, or his part in Lyceum debate at the Academy. He taught at the common and high schools for several years with marked success, and read law in the office of Esq. James S. Holmes in Foxcroft. He had experience as Assistant Postmaster at Dover Village and East Corinth. In 1849, during the gold rush, he worked in the California mines for one and a half years. After returning to Foxcroft, he continued his law studies and in 1854 he first married Abbie Jane Gage. In that same year he purchased his first home, the old Le Broke home, had it taken down, hauled to the village and rebuilt. That house was later owned by George Colcord near the old campground. He was admitted to the bar in the courts of Dover Maine on Feb 26, 1857; and practiced law in the offices of the Hon. C.P. Chandler, and the Hon. A. W. Paine in Bangor. After the death of his wife Abby Jane Gage in 1862 he married Sarah Jane Hayes. They moved to the house occupied by his nephew, Charles Pollard, where he built his first office just west of the house. From 1859 to 1872 he was a member of the Maine Legislature and one of the most distinguished debaters. For 15 years he was a member of the S. S. Committee (supervisor of schools) in Foxcroft, and 24 years as Town Agent. From 1860 to 1870 he served as County Attorney for Piscataquis. From

1878-1884 Augustus formed a partnership with Willis Ellis Parsons "Le broke & Parsons". In 1882-1885 he was elected a member of the Maine Senate, serving as Chairman of the Judiciary Committee. He was an able lawyer and natural born orator, having a wonderful command of language and remarkable pleasing address, being regarded as one of the most efficient speakers in the Republican party, of which he helped create. He sympathized deeply with every living creature that was oppressed and hated slavery. He was the most able, eloquent, and influential lawyer in the State, and a prominent citizen of Foxcroft for many years. An honored member of the I.O.O.F., he loved it's principles with all the intensity of his nature. He died in Foxcroft in 1889 at the age of 66 yrs, 5 months and 10 days, nearly all the lodges of the county were in attendance at the time of his burial.
