

# *Descendants of William Cecil*

## *Generation No. 1*

1. WILLIAM<sup>1</sup> CECIL was born 1665 in Prince George Co., Md., and died 1749 in Frederick Co., Md. He married <UNNAMED>. She died Bet. 1697 - 1698.

### Notes for WILLIAM CECIL:

The first accounts of the Cecil Family in Prince George County, Maryland show the last name spelled Sesell. That may be because Cecil was pronounced that way. In a deposition made to the November Court of Prince George's County, Maryland, in 1732, William Sesell deposed that he was 67 years of age which would make his birth date around 1665. He further deposed that he had spent most of his time in this Province. William Sesell at a session of the County Court held in Prince George's County, Province of Maryland, on March 19, 1697/8, bound his three children to Mareen Duvall, as follows: "To the Commissioners of Prince George's County, these are humbly to Satisfie you that I, William Sesell, by the request of my wife as She lay upon her death bed I have disposed of my children to Marreen Douall (sic) and his heirs till they are of age. John Sesell, age 7 years the 24th of December last past, Phip Sesell, aged 5 years the 28th day of this instant, Susan Sesell aged 2 years of January last. These are humbly to Request of your Lordship to bind these children this Court to the aforesaid Douall and his heirs to the age of 21 and the girle att 16 as witness my hand and Seale the day and years above Written." Signed, Sealed and delivered in ye presents of us, Alex Beall and Solomon X. Simpson.

Maureen Duvall, who became the guardian of the children of William Sesell, was the son of Mareen Duvall, Sr., a French Huguenot, who settled on South River in Anne Arundel County. As Mareen Duvall, the Emigrant, had two sons name Mareen , designated as the Elder and the Younger, it is not known who became the guardian of the Sesell children, but most likely Mareen the Younger.

He married ELIZABETH SOLLARS 1718 in Queen Anne Parish, Prince George Co., Md., daughter of JOHN SOLLARS. She was born in Calvert Co., Md., and died Unknown.

### Notes for JOHN CECIL:

According to the register of Queen Anne's Parish, Prince George's County, Maryland, John Cecil was born in the year of our Lord 1691 and married Elizabeth Sollars in the year of our Lord 1718. His last will and testament was dated 14 July 1758 and admitted to Probate in Prince George's County, Maryland on 28 January 1759. He devised his wife Elizabeth during her widowhood the dwelling-plantation, but after her marriage or death, it was to revert to his son Zephaniah Cecil and his heirs forever. All Negroes were bequeathed to his wife Elizabeth and at her death, they were to be equally divided among all his children. The administration bond of his widow and executrix valued at 600 pounds was dated February 5, 1759, with Sabret Cecil and Samuel Cecil as sureties. The inventory of his personal estate was appraised on February 5, 1759, by Thomas Gordon and William Shaw, Jr.

Thomas Cecil and James Cecil signed the papers as next of kin. They were filed at court on 4th of May the same year of our Lord by Elizabeth Cisel the executrix. Thomas Cecil and Sabret Cecil, who approved the inventory, were the brothers of Samuel the Administrator, and sons of John the Bondsman.

Notes for SAMUEL W. CECIL, SR.:

Samuel W. Cecil , revolutionary war ancestor, a native of England, emigrated to America and settled first in the province of Maryland. Tradition makes him a direct descendant of Sir William Cecil, the first Lord Burleigh who was the 15th in line of descent from Sir Robert an Sioelt, a noted Welshman. While in Maryland around 1750, Samuel W. Cecil married Rebecca White. About 1760 Samuel and Rebecca with their children moved to Pulaski County in Virginia. He purchased over 1000 acres of land lying on the head waters of Neck Creek. At his death about 1785 his personal estate, including slaves, etc., summed over \$3000 in value. His widow (Rebecca) kept a place of public entertainment at a point near what is now known as Dublin, Pulaski Co., Va. She died in 1815 at the age of 96 years. They both were buried on their farm at a point 50 ft. N of a large walnut tree, which was half way between the old Cecil mansion and a house built in 1861 by David McGavock, and about 20 ft. W of the SW corner of the McGavock yard fence. Their graves are unmarked. They had 10 children.

Notes for JOHN JACKIE CECIL:

John Cecil succeeded to the estate of his parents, to which he was entitled under the British law of primogeniture. There is a tradition that he generously divided this estate equally with his brothers and sisters. There are several deeds for lands in the archives of Christiansburg where he was affectionately called "Uncle Jackie". In August 1786 he purchased 142 acres of land lying on Neck Creek for 100 pounds from Alexander Page. In 1891 that property belonged to Rufus Morgan. He sold, as heir at law of Samuel Cecil, Sr., 43 acres of land lying on Neck Creek to Samuel Cecil, Jr., his youngest brother; to brother Thomas Cecil, June 21, 1800, 217 acres of land lying on Neck Creek. John Cecil and Keziah were buried on his farm on Neck Creek, Pulaski Co., Va. at a spot well known today. Their tombstone reads:

Another deed from Rebecca Cecil to Thomas Cecil for 217 acres lying on Neck Creek dated April 7, 1795. April 1, 1800 Thomas and John sold 520 acres to Richard Gutherie. In 1812 he sold two tracts of land, embracing 642 acres, to John Hoge, the land lying on Neck Creek, and moved to near Troy, Miami Co., Ohio, where he died in 1823. In 1763 he married Nancy Grayson born in Culpepper Co, Va about 1780, the daughter of John and Barbara Grayson.

In the archives at Christiansburg there is a deed from John Craig to Zachariah Cecil for 380 acres of land including the "halfway spring", for the consideration of 100 pounds dated Oct 24, 1787. D.R. Cecil now living at Prospect Dale, Giles Co., Va. thinks this spring must have been half way between Ingles Ferry and the Town of Newborn. There is another deed from Zachariah Cecil and Nancy his wife to David Waggoner for two tracts of land embracing about 600 acres dated Sept 1812. That year he moved to Shelby Co., Ohio and settled in Washington Township where he died. His farm adjoined that of his nephew Judge William W. Cecil.

Cecil, Sr., December 21, 1786, lying on Neck Creek. This deed bears date of May 7, 1799. Samuel Cecil, Jr. deeded this same tract of land to Thomas Cloyd April 3, 1834 for 2500 pounds and then moved to Missouri, where he shortly thereafter died.

Samuel Stewart Cecil was reared in Scotland County, Mo, attending public schools and Fayette College, he later engaged in farming. He emigrated to Tennessee and there married Lillie Richardson in 1831, who was born and reared in that state. Accompanied by his young wife he sought a home in the then undeveloped region of Missouri. He acquired various large farms, including his home place near Memphis, Scotland County. When news came of the discovery of gold in 1849 he crossed the plains with oxen and engaged in mining and freighting for three years in California. At the expiration of that time he returned to Missouri, leaving his brother, Burlin, who had decided to remain in the west. Lilly his wife died in 1856 leaving him a widower. During the ensuing years favorable reports concerning California continued to reach his Missouri home, and on April 10, 1863 he again came west with his children. This time crossing the plains he joined up with horse teams of 105 wagons. This journey held only one event which the emigrants never forgot. At Deep Creek, Utah, they came upon a party of US soldiers engaged in conflict with a large band of Indians. The pioneers quickly took a hand in the battle, routing the Indians and safely guarding their own company until reinforcements arrived. They reached their goal and arrived in California in July 1863 and separated to locate in various sections of the country. July 23 of that year the Cecil party went to the Robert Armstrong ranch in Solano County, and thereupon the father and son took charge of the farm until their removal to Oregon with their stock. They remained in the Upper Willamette Valley about 18 months, after which they returned to Yolo County by horse teams. For one year after their return they located on the Ike Chiles ranch of 500 acres near Davis. A year later Samuel and his family settled in Yolo County, near Davisville where he improved a tract of 160 acres. On that farm his death occurred in 1894 at the age of 89 years. His sons managed that property until 1870.

Notes for JAMES GRANVILLE CECIL:

James Granville Cecil was born in the isolated settlement at Sand Hill, Knox County, Mo in 1836. Sand Hill was famous as the birthplace of the noted humorist, Mark Twain. John came out west in 1862 and settled on Putah Creek in Solano County near the Yolo County line. He took up land and engaged in raising grain. At that time Nevada offered the best market for produce and the greater part of the grain was freighted over the mountains to mining camps and villages in Nevada. Going to Oregon in 1864, Mr. Cecil married Eliza Lindsay, a native of Kentucky, their wedding being solemnized in the city of Portland. The bride had arrived in Oregon only a short time before her marriage, having to cross the plains with her parents. After a brief sojourn in Oregon the Lindsay family came to California and settled on a ranch near Madison, Yolo County, where Mr. Lindsay died in 1870 and his wife 5 years later.

Coming to Yolo County as a permanent resident in 1867, James and his wife secured a quarter section north of the Village of Davis and for 14 years he gave his undivided attention to the improvement of the property.. Next he purchased 320 acres in the same locality and eventually purchased a ranch of 123 acres, where he remained until his death in 1892. Mrs. Cecil, his widow, went on to manage the property and greatly increased its productiveness. From the harvest of 1910 she secured 35 sacks of barley per acre. Other crops were also correspondingly valuable.

For a long period he held prominent identification with the blue lodge of Masonry and in his life he always endeavored to exemplify the philanthropic teachings of the order.

Logan Jones Cecil who was born in Memphis, Mo., received a public school education. He married Mary Ellen Bedell the 17th day of November in 1884 in the Territory of Washington in Clarke County. As a single man in 1861, with others, he started across the plains with ox teams, but upon reaching South Pass, several of their oxen died. The balance they traded for ponies, on which they rode back to Missouri. This unfortunate experience did not put an end to Logan's dream to get to California. The following year he made a second attempt in which he was destined to meet with more favorable fortune. The party reached Sacramento in 64 days from Council Bluffs. While on the plains Dr. Glenn and Samuel Wilson overtook his party and traveled in the same train from that time forward.

Arriving in California without money or friends, Logan made haste to secure employment and hired out to work for Hutchins & Malone. In the fall of the same year (1862) he rented a farm from Jack Adams and remained there for two years, after which he leased other grain farms until 1868. Meanwhile, as early as 1864, he began to handle stock in the Willamette Valley of Oregon. In the fall of 1871 he went there for the purpose of buying stock. In the spring of the next year, with his brother Carroll, he embarked in the cattle business in what was then Wasco (now Crook) County, their ranch being on Willow Creek. For their cattle brand they used a circle on the right hip and "71" on the left; while for a horse brand a "71" was placed on the left shoulder. In 1877 the

headquarters was moved to what was then Grant (now Harney) County, Oregon, where they had their ranch at Old Camp Curry on Silver Creek. Here they remained, the brother Carroll being resident manager of the ranch which comprises about 3000 acres on Silver Creek and vicinity, all which is under fence. Prior to 1887 they usually made sales in the Sacramento Valley, making one trip a year with cattle. Since 1882 a specialty has been made of horses and mules, which has proved profitable to an encouraging degree,. At this writing a double "CC" is used on the left side of the cattle for a brand, while horses are branded as before, with the addition of a "71" on the left jaw. After a few years of this, Logan returned to Grimes, California, while his brother Carroll took full control of the Oregon ranch. The land possessions of Logan Cecil in Colusa County include 3 ranches, on one of which, 2 miles north of Grimes, he made his home since 1887. The home farm consists of 353 acres, devoted to general farming and stock raising. Three and one-half miles southwest of Grimes he owned a ranch of 400 acres and adjacent to Sycamore, five miles north of Grimes, he owned a tract of 533 acres, all of which is adapted to grain and stock raising. Though politically a Democrat, he took no part in politics, for his extensive and varied personal interest left him no leisure for other matters.

In 1893, that the children might enjoy suitable educational advantages, Logan and his family moved to College City. Ten years later he moved them to Chico, that they might have the opportunities offered by the Chico Normal School.

Burlin Cecil, a retired farmer of Yolo County, has done much toward the improvement of this county and in retrospection, views a life well spent and holding few regrets. He was born in Scotland Co, Mo in 1845. Coming to California with his father he settled in Davis, California and took up clerking in a mercantile store in Davis for two years. Later he farmed the well known Lillard ranch. In 1882 he bought 160 acres which he later sold. He then purchased 250 acres northwest of Davis, upon which he resided until 1910, when he sold it and retired from active farm life to a comfortable home in Davis. In speaking of his agricultural success Burlin remarked that he had secured as high as 21sacks of wheat to the acre, each sack weighing 150 pounds. Barley crops ran 25 sacks to the acre, also an exceptional record. In connection with his general farming pursuits, he raised cattle, hogs and mules with profit. After retirement from farming he devoted his attention to the real estate business, making a specialty of buying and selling farm lands. Mr. Cecil was much interested in education and was an advocate of and liberal contributor toward the upbuilding of churches and schools. In 1868, before Prineville, Oregon was officially a town, Carroll and Logan Cecil, sons of Samuel Stewart Cecil and Lilly B. Richardson, were listed as residents in the area. The two brothers, better known as Carl and Logue, didn't own any Oregon land, their holding were near Grimes, California, and they were grazing their California cattle on Oregon grass by making long drives from the Sacramento Valley to Prineville.

After the Indian uprising of 1868, the land of eastern Oregon became relatively safe, and the Cecil brothers tiring of making the long drives to California, started looking for good grazing land in Oregon. In 1871, as the two brothers were trailing their horses and mules south towards California, they came upon the lush verdant grasslands growing around Indian Springs which gushed cold and clear from a hillside. They immediately knew that this place should be their Oregon holdings. According to one of their descendants, Carrol and Logan probably "squatted" on this land while they filed for 640 acres. Part of their holdings was acquired by the purchase of land from the WVCMMW Company.

The brothers built a log cabin in 1871 and used it as their headquarters. Later they married twin daughters of A. D. Bedell, a homesteader who lived near the Cecil ranch. Unfortunately, their cabin burned in 1890 and another house, now part of the kitchen of their second residence, was constructed by the two families. A third residence was later built against the hill where the spring was located.

In the early days, draft animals were much in demand in the largely agricultural Sacramento valley, so the brothers gave up raising cattle and concentrated on horses and mules to satisfy this growing market to the south. The Cecil branding iron was a "CC" back to back on the ribs. They took the horse iron which was a "71" (for the year the ranch was established) and added a bar to it, "71" bar. They branded the horses on the jaw in the early days and then later, on the shoulder.

They raised mules for the California market for years. After the mules were halter broke, they would put a bell on one and that one would lead the rest of them down the road. The chuck wagon pulled by four mules, would follow along. It took about a month to trail their stock from Oregon to their winter feeding ground.

After a few years of this, Logan took over the California property, Carrol and his wife, Ollie took full control of the Oregon ranch.

Carroll and Ollie had two daughters and two sons, only one of the sons had interest in ranching. During World War I Carroll still retained good stallions and mares which he bred for the remount service and for polo ponies.

After Carroll died in 1938, leaving no will, the Cecil "71" Bar Ranch was bought by "Pat" Cecil, who had married Jessie Bibee in 1915.

Mary Louise Cecil never married, but came close a couple of times as we were told. She was born in Willows, California in 1925 and lived at 257 S. Murdock St. in Willows. She was known by all her school friends as "Sis". She grew up with children of family friends (all boys) and they treated her like a sister, thus she got the nickname. One time the boys dared her to climb the water tower at the ranch. She did, and with every yell of "higher", she kept on going, determined to show she could compete with them. As they were growing up the boys took "Sis" everywhere with them, so she always managed to have a date! These kids remained lifelong friends and today, sadly, only one remains.

Mary Lou attended grade school and high school in Willows. After graduating in 1943 she entered Stanford University. She graduated in 1948 with a BA in Education, intending to work with delinquent children., but instead went to work for Pan American Airways in San Francisco. She transferred with the airlines to Honolulu, Hawaii in the early 50's and became Reservation Supervisor. She left her job with Pan Am in the early 60's to take care of her mother Henrietta Hoever Cecil, who became quite ill with emphysema, til Henrietta's death in 1971. Her father Calvert Cecil, Sr. died Christmas Eve that same year. Shortly after, she returned to Honolulu to make it her permanent home. Besides working with Pan American Airways in Hawaii, she also worked at a dress shop at one of the local hotels. Later she got a job at the Education Department at the University of Hawaii until she retired. After retirement she sold real estate, owned an employment hiring agency and volunteered for many charitable societies. Her favorite was the "Adult Friends for Youth" where she was very active in their cause in helping troubled teenagers. They honored her with a memorial plaque in her memory.

On August 8, 2003 while visiting her doctor for a routine blood test in Honolulu, Mary Lou suffered a stroke at approximately 200PM. She was put on life support and claimed terminal (brain dead) at the Straub Clinic & Hospital. At approximately 822PM the same day she suffered a massive stroke which took her life. She did not die alone and was surrounded by many of her friends, where they said prayers for her and gave her the "last rights". She left behind two of her most precious possessions, her two little dogs Kiki and Kalo. A very close freind was most gracious and consented in taking them.

Mary Lou requested cremation for her remains. A second request made that 1/2 of her ashes be buried in Hawaii, and the other 1/2 to be interned with her mother in Willows, Ca. A beautiful ceremony was given for her by the Honolulu Emblem Club with an outrigger provided by the Honolulu Outrigger Canoe Club; 1/2 of her ashes were scattered at sea by her nephew Donald Cecil. The remainder 1/2 was interned with her mother in Willows on August 26, 2003, she requested no memorial service for California.
