1. Charles Quincy² Clay (Mr.¹) was born 11 February 1854 in Russell Co. VA, and died 10 January 1908 in Ft. Towson, Choctaw Co., OK. He married **Eliza Ann Pitcock** 04 August 1885 in Montague Co., TX, daughter of William Pitcock and Conzada Hestand. She was born 30 April 1866 in Williamson Co., IL, and died 06 March 1910 in Ft. Towson, Choctaw Co., OK.

Notes for Charles Quincy Clay:

A NEW TEXAN!!

In late 1879 or early 1880, Charles Quincy left his home in VA and followed his brothers Thomas Harmon and Henry Jackson to TX. The two brothers had immigrated to TX about 1874. Thomas Harmon settled in Montague Co., TX and Henry Jackson went back and forth from TX to the Chicksaw Nation, Indian Territory. When Charles Quincy arrived he stayed with Thomas Harmon in Montague Co. It was there that he met his wife Eliza Ann Pitcock, and they were married on 04 August 1885 in Montague Co., TX. C.Q. and Eliza Ann later removed to an area called "Boggy Bend" near Chicota, just north of Powderly in Lamar Co., TX. He was a resourceful and industrious man who tilled the soil for his livelihood. In 1908 the family was living in a log cabin just outside Ft. Towson near an old Indian fort. C.Q. had caught measles from his small children and tried to go back to work too soon. He contracted pneumonia which caused his death. His sudden death left the family almost destitute. After his death, Eliza Ann and her little family went to stay with her brother Greenberry Pitcock in Powderly, TX. The family only stayed for a short while and then returned to Ft. Towson where Eliza Ann died in 1910. She was buried next to her husband Charles in the Doaksville-Ft. Towson cemetery which is located 1 mile north of Ft. Towson, OK. Their son Albert died two months after his mother and another son, Henry died in 1915. Charles, Eliza Ann, and sons, Albert and Henry are buried by the west wall, near the road, where a beautiful headstone marks their final resting place.

Author Note: The years of death for Albert and Henry on the headstone are wrong. It names Henry as dying in 1910 and Albert in 1915. According to their sister Geraldine who had stayed in Ft. Towson after her mother's death, her brother Henry died in 1915. The headstone also has Elizabeth Pitcock instead of Eliza Ann Pitcock. The headstone was purchased in 1992 by the son of Emily Frances "Fannie" (Clay) Irwin, John W. Irwin who was living in Placerville, CA at the time.

One goes something like this: C.Q. was a resourceful and industrious man. While living at Ft. Towson, he became unemployed. So, he got himself a wash tub and put up a sign next to three big trees. The sign said "Laundry". His laundry business turned out to be quite a success.

Another, that goes like this: During that same period of time, C.Q. got upset because his small children were playing around the well at their home in Ft. Towson. He did not feel that it was safe for his children to be doing that. Being the resourceful person he was, he put a sheet over himself and pretended to be a ghost. The idea worked because he scared the kids away from playing around the well.

Notes for Leo C. Irwin:

Leo didn't want to go to war and when he was drafted he ran away to MO to get counsel from his "Uncle Dick (Scotty Clay). He stayed with us about a month, continually counseling with my dad. He went back to TX and was immediately shipped out for his initial training. Besides being trained as a groundpounder he became a cook. I suppose he thought that he would be a non-combatant and not be right on the front line. He was sent to Europe and a couple of weeks after arriving he became a casualty of the war he didn't want anything to do with. He was not on the front lines when he died. I remember him as a young man, rather slim and handsome and very fussy about his appearance. Its a shame he was taken from us at such an early age.

Author's Note: William Jasper "Bill" Clay was a preacher and a barber for many years in the town of Lamar, MO. He and Lois were god-fearing folk and he preached the gospel as no other. Aunt Lois could sing the gospel like no other. You could always hear her strong voice above all others. They made a pair, my Aunt and Uncle. Because I smoked, Uncle Bill would always tell me I was doing the work of the Devil and would surely burn in Hell. I can never forget my uncle because of his bald head and him a barber. That's not the only thing as there are so many more fond memories of him and my aunt. In 1958, when returning from a vacation in Arkansas I stopped at my Uncle's home and found that Aunt Lois had died several days earlier. I had not even been aware that she was ill. Uncle Bill was doing well, but you could tell he had lost his help-mate. That was in 1958 and several years later he took a second wife, Pearl (Peterson) Koch who was a long-time friend and neighbor to them. I only met her one time when I took my mother on a visit to Lamar. When she died in 1988, Uncle Bill went to live with his daughter Ida Clarine and her husband Glen Brown in Russell, Kansas where he spent his last days. He died in 1993 at the age of 95 years. Uncle Bill is buried along side his wife Lois, my aunt, in Lake Cemetery, Lamar, Barton Co., MO.

MRS. BILL CLAY DEAD

Mrs. Delana Lois Clay, sixty, wife of Bill Clay, well known Lamar barber, died at the Memorial Hospital at 2:45 a.m., Saturday. The sixty year old woman suffered first from diabetes. About three years ago she developed a serious heart disorder. She had been in a critical condition from the complication of diseases for the past several months. Friday she developed pneumonia. She was taken to the hospital Friday evening at 9:40 p.m. surviving only a few hours. She was born in Dade County on April 21, 1898, the daughter of Mike Workman and Lois Fowler Workman. When she was two years of age her family moved to Barton County where she was destined to spend the remainder of her life. She was married to William Clay at Lamar on September 28, 1919. She leaves him with one daughter, Mrs. Jack Stark of Butler and one grandchild. One brother, Ira

Workman of Gill, Colorado, and two sisters, Mrs. Goldie Lester and Mrs. Ida Eckert, both of Lamar also survive. The body was taken to the Chiles Funeral Home to be prepared for burial. The last rites were set for 2:00 p.m., Tuesday at the Chiles Chapel. Interment follows in Lake Cemetery.
