

# *Descendants of John William Smith*

## *Generation No. 1*

1. JOHN WILLIAM<sup>1</sup> SMITH was born August 02, 1832 in St. Helena Parish, LA<sup>1</sup>, and died November 05, 1905 in Ponchatoula, Tangipahoa Parish, LA<sup>2</sup>. He married LENORA E. LEE September 02, 1853 in Liberty, Amite Co., MS<sup>3</sup>. She was born Abt. 1838 in Louisiana, and died 1908 in Louisiana.

Notes for JOHN WILLIAM SMITH:

Enlisted in Co. H., 27th La. Reg., Captain John T. Spencer, Commanding. Was slightly wounded in a leg during Siege of Vicksburg. Smith replied that he was at Liberty, Mississippi on detail at the surrender. In response to another pension application question, Smith reported that he was at the surrender of Vicksburg, was paroled and released to his regiment. He said that he did not take the oath of allegiance to the US Government.

When asked how many children, and what sex they were, Smith replied that he and his wife had one boy and four girls!

There is a John W. Smith enumerated in the 1850 St. Helena Parish, LA census with the James L. Belue family. The family is found in the Eastern District, p181, dwelling/family 69, and includes: James L. Belue, age 37, farmer, born LA; Mary Belue, age 10, born LA; Edward Wales, age 80, farmer, born SC; Elizabeth Wales, age 60, born NC, and John W. Smith, age 17, born LA. John is the right age to have been born in 1833.

2. ANGUS MCNEIL<sup>2</sup> SMITH (*JOHN WILLIAM*<sup>1</sup>) was born February 1857 in East Baton Rouge Parish, LA, and died May 10, 1935 in Pride, EBR Parish, LA<sup>7</sup>. He married (1) MARY AMELIA MCCLENDON November 23, 1876 in East Feliciana Parish, LA<sup>8</sup>. She was born July 1859 in Clinton, East Feliciana Parish, LA, and died August 09, 1915 in Stoney Point, EBR Parish, LA. He married (2) MARY ANN HOGARE February 05, 1917 in Amite Co., MS. She died Unknown.

Notes for ANGUS MCNEIL SMITH:

When giving census data, Angus reported that he was born in Louisiana. His death certificate reports that he was buried at Bluff Creek on May 12, 1935. I have been unable to locate his grave site. Local funeral homes, Rabenhorst, in particular attempted to help but were unsuccessful. None of the older homes in Baton Rouge have a record of his service in their files. Church records from that period are not available. His death certificate records his profession as farmer.

His youngest daughter, Lillian Smith Roe, related that Angus was a blacksmith and had a shop near the Zachary Crossroads when she was a small child. The Zachary Crossroads are generally considered to be the intersection of Plank Road (La. Hwy 67) and Zachary-Deerford Road (La. Hwy 64) in East Baton Rouge Parish.

According to Lillian, Angus had a twin brother that died at birth. He also had several sisters. One sister, Mary Melissa Smith married Levi Ratliff Chaney April 18, 1858. Melissa and Levi had five (5) children: dau: Jessie Lenora m: Napoleon Bonaparte Calmes, 13 Aug. 1916; dau: Vallie m: Miller; dau. Mae m: Rogillio; dau: Johnnie m: Vine and dau: Lucy, m: Vine. Jessie and Napoleon had at least one daughter, Virginia Calmes m: Lawrence Phillips. Currently reside at 39540 Calmes Road, St. Helena Parish, LA. Tp: 665-6562. Mail is received at Denham Springs, LA 70726. Napoleon Bonaparte Calmes was the son of Napoleon B. Calmes, Sr. He married Julia Virginia Matthews.

East Feliciana Parish (Clinton) Vendee Book B-2, p455-456, dated Nov. 10, 1885, lists a sale to A. M. Smith by Franklin D. Brame of lands "bordered on North by Bluff Creek, East by lands of Mrs. McClendon, South by lands of Vendor and West by lands of A. H. Cline and containing fifty-eight acres...." Vendor Book E-2, p183-184, dated Dec. 21, 1892, lists a sale by Angus M. Smith to Orville H. Cline. This sale was the land bought from Brame in 1885. Book K-2, p236, dated Apr. 4, 1906, records a sale by A. M. Smith to Estelle A. Singletary of lots in Wilson, La.

The 1880 census for East Feliciana Parish shows Angus and Mary with two children, Adda, a daughter aged 2; and Mary, a daughter aged 2 months, having been born in April, 1880. It is possible that the enumerator reversed the children's names and ages and that Mary was aged 2 and "Adda" was Abiah, born in 1880. Mary is probably a child that did not survive to adulthood. The 1900 Census records the family in Zachary Town, East Baton Rouge. That is Supervisor District 6, Enumeration District 38, Sheet 3, page 858. They family consists of Angus, age 43; Mary A., wife, age 40; Abiah P., single son, age 20; Tullie C., single son, age 17; Emmett B., single son, age 15; Estelle E., single daughter, age 13; Jennie L., single daughter, age 8; and Florence A., single daughter, age 3.

Family members appear in the 1910 census as follows: Angus M., age 53; Mary A., wife, age 51; Florence, daughter, age 13; Lillian, daughter, age 10 and Emmet B., son, age 25. They are in EBR Parish, Fifth Ward, Sheet 15, Enumeration District 32, dwelling family 250.

In 1920, the family is still in Ward 5, Richardson Road, East Baton Rouge. The family consists of Angus, a widower aged 62; Florence, single and age 24; Jinnie Hannah, a widowed daughter, age 26 and two grandsons, presumed to be Jinnie's children: Joe Smith, age 10 and Clifton Smith, age 5.

According to Lillian, his youngest daughter, Angus was a Blacksmith by trade.

Notes for MARY AMELIA MCCLENDON:

In the 1900 census, Mary reported that she was the mother of nine children, six were living. The date of the census was in June, 2 months before the birth of Lillian in August, 1900. Unless Mary was counting the unborn Lillian as her ninth child, there must have been another child born and deceased between the 1880 and 1900 census. In the 1910 census, Mary reported that she was the mother of 10 children, and seven were still living, further indication that there was a child born and deceased between 1880 and 1900.

Lillian told me that she had three brothers that were born and had died before she was born in 1900, Willie, Mack, and Walker. Based on census records, and Mary's census reports, it's likely that at least one of these brothers was real, and the other two were perhaps part of her imagination, based on what she thought she had heard as a child. In any event, I have found no record to confirm that either of the three actually existed.

Webster Parish records show that at one time Frank owned the Tri-State Novelty Company, a juke box vendor, in Minden.

A search of court house records in Cass County did not reveal any business license (Index to Assumed Names, 1971 forward) marriage record or other information about Frank with the exception of probate documents prepared upon his death.

Frank's death certificate was recorded in Jefferson, Marion County, because he was taken from his residence in Cass County to the nearest hospital which was in Jefferson. Jefferson and Avinger are only a few miles apart. Frank's death certificate recorded his social security number as 575-03-1416. G. E. Haggard and Son Funeral Home, Inc. in Marion County, handled the arrangements.

In a 1995 exchange of letters with Fred McKenzie, author of the book Avinger Texas USA (M&M Press, Rt. 1, Box 404, Avinger, Texas 75630), I was told that Frank was a barber and that he had a shop near the beauty shop of Shannon Burns Terry. I was unable to locate a business license for either person at the courthouse in Avinger.
