He lists her throughout as Elizabeth Cann, although I have her Birth Certificate which only lists her as Bessie Cann, as her full name.

Elizabeth Cann, the ninth child of William Cann and Gertrude Louise Stanlake, was born on 4 Aug 1855 (actual birth date 3 Aug 1856, on Birth Document). at Westleigh, Devon, and died on 10 January 1944 at Millwood Street, Swansea, S.Wales.

Bessie married James Taylor (William James Taylor), son of William Eastman Taylor and Ann Hearn on 5 Feb 1873 at Swansea Register Office. He was born 30 Dec 1852 in Bideford Devon, and died 31 Dec 1932 in Swansea, S.Wales.

Bessie was known in her community - an active as a midwife and though untrained she was in great demand at laying - in and indeed, layings - out. She organized temperance teas at chapel where she used her special teapot with a picture of John Wesley on one side and the Doxology on the other, and provided cakes cooked by herself.

An avid reader who never had glasses, nor needed them to the day she died, she read the paper every evening to her husband who could neither read or write. She did all his accounts and secretarial work. And she brought up 14 children.

The Taylors

Jim (Wllm James Taylor) and Bessie crossed the Bristol Channel to Swansea quite frequently on day excursions. They found it a growing area so they decided to move there in the 1870's, to get married and to set up a building business. By 1881 they had four children and were living at 60 Llangyfelach Road, Bryn Terrace, Brynhyfryd.

In 1887 other Taylors followed: James brother William Eastman Taylor and his wife Maria, their children Annie and William. James sister Kate crossed the water later. William Eastman joined the business. Jim (William James Taylor) was renowned for the quality of his work and was now living in Hopkin Street Brynhyfryd. He built houses close by for all these Taylors.

The family spent holidays in the Bideford area on relations farms, ne of which was a large From at Chumleigh owned by one of Bessie's Brothers.

As Wesleyan methodists, and staunch teetotallers, they attended the English speaking chapel just up the road at Landore. This had a very social as well as religious focus for the immigrants from Devon - The Taylors, Cann's, and Jewell's. Will Cann, who was Sunday School Superintendant there, is well remembered by one Taylor descendant, a Denise Frew (Nee Philips) G Grandchild of William Taylor. Will knew her parents, aunt and uncle.. Other descendants are still living around Swansea and are known to Lena Cann.

The early Taylors were yeoman farmers around the Bideford area and the family tree goes back to the 1650's. Bessie gets a mention in Growing up in Wales 1895 -1939 by Jeffrey Grenfell Hill.

William James Taylor & Bessie Cann ran a small shop on the corner of Freeman st and Eaton Road, Brynhyfryd Swansea, Known as "Ma Taylor's", It sold some groceries, and once a week hot faggots and peas, this helped to supplement the family income, as did her role as a much respected local midwife: "you were safe in Ma Taylor's hands" was commonly known to be true. The workshop and stables were immediately behind Number 24, both 24 and 25 were built by Wllm James Taylor, He was known for his good nature, and was supposedly owed considerable amounts of money by unscrupulous people who paid partially for their homes. William James Taylor's business went bankrupt in 1914 around the time of the war. He was owed money which he was too proud to take anyone to court, he in turn suffered and his business collapsed. He was in ruin. Eventually James had a nervous breakdown and he was taken into an Asylum. Later his houses were sold off to pay debt, and his daughter Alice Taylor (Grenfell) bought Number 24 and 25 Freeman Street properties with a shop which they rented out to pay off loans, and there was a stable, and an allotment which Ernest Grenfell (son in law) harvested to help repayments of debts. These were not good years for the old couple as they tried to make ends meet. The house which Wllm James had built for himself further along the street, had to be sold off, and they never moved in. When Wllm James died, Bessie went to live with cousin Marguerite, the grand daughter she had brought up when her own daughter died in childbirth in Oregon (she never forgave her Ackland son in law for emigrating).

The Stables and workshops belonging to Wllm James Taylor and Bessie Cann were facing Eaton Rd opposite to the Chapel, (now a Barbers 2003)

The name Grenfell was from the name Grenvilles the same family as Sir Richard Grenville of the Revenge, the English Admiral who had fought the Spanish Fleet off the Azores in the time of Queen Elizabeth I. Lord Tennyson had written a famous poem about him. The Grenvilles were Lords of the Manor of Bideford, High Sheriffs of Cornwall for generations; and one of the biggest landowners there.

Lord Grenfell of Kilvey one of the Aristocratic Grenfell's acknowledged this Grenfell line (Swansea) as a relation. Lord Grenfell's family and this line can from St Just, they all had a "thing" about being of Norman descent. (Alys Grenfell words from J Grenfell Hill - "Growing up in Wales")
