He married **Ann Mills**^{7,8} March 21, 1821 in Morristown, Morris, N.J.⁸, daughter of Edward Mills and Phebe Byram. She was born 1793 in Morristown, N. J.^{9,10}, and died January 09, 1857 in Terre Haute, Vigo Co. Indiana^{11,12}.

Last will and testament of James Cook from the records of Vigo County, Terre Haute, Indiana provides "I James Cook of Terre Haute Indiana do make and publish this my last Will & Testament, to-wit: First. I do give and devise t my wife, Sophia W. Cook, the sum of One Thousand dollars per annum to be paid to her quarterly from my Estate during the term of her natural life, Also the dwelling house and the furniture and property therein of all kinds and description and upon the premises where I now reside together with the lot, being part of out Lot number forty four (44) in Terre Haute Indiana to have and to hold the sum during her natural life without charge these bequest are to be in lieu of dower or any other legal interest of any kind in my estate. The annuity to my wife is hereby made a charge on all he real estate left by me. Second. I do give devise and bequeath to my eldest daughter, Mary H. Freeman the house and lot above described in which I now reside in fee simple, subject on to the life estate therein above devised o my wife with all the appurtenances to have and to hold the same to hereself her heirs and assigns forever. Third, I do give and devise furher to my said daughter Mary H. Freeman one-half (1/2) of all the remainder of my property and estate of every kind after the payment of debths and discharge of the foregoing specific legacies. And to my youngest daughter Anna Louise Clippenger, one-fourth (1/4) of said remainder and to my only sone, Louis M. Cook one-fourth (1/4) of said remainder. Fourth. I hereby nominate and appoint my friend Charles Gruff and my son, Louis M. Cook and my son-in-law Annzi W. Freeman to be the executors of this my last Will and Testament, Hereby revoking all other and former Wills by me made. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my and and seal at the city of Terre Haute aforesaid this twenty-fifth dayof April, A. D. 1872. Signed James Cook

The foregoing Last Will & Testament was subscribed and sealed by James Cook, in presence of the undersigned, who in his presence and in the presence of each other have at his request subscribed our names as witnesses to the execution and publication thereof by him as his Last Will this twenty fifth day of April, 1872. Records of Trustees and Sesson First Presbyterian Church, Morristown N. J. Morristown Public Library (11M6 15 Hist) page 48 shows Marriage to Ann Mills dau. of Edward. Children shown as Lewis Mills b. 30 Oct 1824; Bap. 13 Feb. 1825 (date shown in record is 30th; John Cook report is 31st)

Other notes found in research by John Cook in Morristown Library files 12-6-02 indicate second marriage was to Sophia Woodhull, dau. Lewis Condit, MD. of Morristown. This is apparent reason will leaves life interst to Sophia in Will.

Born Oct. 6, 1842 (never married); Jacob A. born April 27, 1844; Rebecca C. born Oct. 5, 1846 (Colleen Yates Line) Charles A. born March 8, 1848 and Stephen F. born Feb. 15, 1850 died Oct. 16, 1853. Mr. Moser lived n Ohio til the spring of 1837 when he moved to Pike Co. ILL and in May 1841 he came to Hold Co. MO where Mrs. Moser now lives. He following farming as an occupation, and at the time of his death in 1872, he owned a farm of 500 acres which has since been occupied by his widow... Mrs. Moser was born in Morris County, NJ, 1807. Heer father Abraham Cook (born 1775) was a native of the same state, though his ancestors came of English origin. He learned the trade of shoemaking, in Elizabethtown, (Essex) NJ, and when 21 years old married Miss Mary Lyon, a native of N.J. He then went to the Island of St.Domingo, one of the West Indies, where he lived for a short time, and then returned to NJ and embarked in the mercantile business in Morris Co. He farmed in Greene County until the last year of his life when he went to New Carlisle. He had a family of six children, Ms. Mary Moser being the 3rd child. She was educated in NJ and received an excellent educatino, being ably proficient to teach school, but having no such desire turned a deaf ear to all entreaties.

The Last Will and Testament of Louis M. Cook dated August 22, 1882 appears in the probate records of Vigo County, Indiana and is proved by William Mack May 3, 1886. The will devises all property to his wife "Phoebe" providing that if Phoebe should die before "Mabel my daughter, marries, then Mabel takes whatever property remains undisposed of"

Lewis M. Cook son receives 1/4th of the estate of James Cook and is a co-executor of the eatate as the will appears in the records of the Vigo Circuit Court sitting in probate. The copy reviewed is at page 512 but the volume or case number is not identified. The probate index of 1879 Settled estates show letters were granted to Louis M. Cook and Anzi W. Freeman in the estate of James Cook August 12, 1872.

Notes for Phoebe A. Dowling:

Obituary for Phoebe says that three children were born; Thomas Dowling Cook, the elder son, Will a younger

son died in Phoenix, Arizona where he practiced medicine and Mabel, the only daughter who died in Chicago. All died prior to Phoebe. Obituary says she was in recent correspondence with her grandson W. H. Cook of Albany, Texas.

Obituary in Terre Haute Tribune, Page 2 of October 29, 1907 show " Mrs. Cook is survived by three grandchildren, W. H. Cook of Albany, Texas; a Mrs. TieWalt of Vincennes and another granddaughter, living in Kansas, all children of her elder son, Thomas.

The last will and testament of Phoebe A. Cook appearing in the records of Vigo County IN and dated August 13, 1907 appoints Amanda D. Mack executor and provides "I give and bequeath all of my property of every description to Saint Stephens Protestant Episcopal Church of Terre Haute, Indiana, requesting that the property be used and the money be expended as may be determined by my executor."

The father of Phoebe was Thomas Dowling an pioneer in Terre Haute, serving several terms in the Indiana Legislature and a publisher of several papers. Thomas Dowling was born in County Down, Ireland and orphaned as a small child in Washington DC. His brother John Dowling died in Washington DC and had their parents moved to Mount Olivet cemetery where John Dowling was buried from their former resting place at old St. Patrick burying ground.
