"There occurred a mont remarkable family reunion at Corsica, PA., Saturday, Oct. 14, 1911, including the surviving members of one of the old families of the western part of Jefferson County. The family is that of Sheridan and Mary Ross McCullough the surviving children of which family are portrayed in the above picture [sorry! can't cut & paste a picture in here]. These children are: Mr. John McCullough, Mrs. Edward Orcutt, Mrs. D.S.Orcutt, and Miss Elizabeth McCullough, all of Corsica, Mrs. David Sowers, Decatur, Michigan, and Mr. William McCullough of Clarion [PA]. Their combined ages amount to 473 years, or an average of 73 years.

The McCullough family in this country began it's history with Mr. Hugh McCullough who emigrated from Ireland about 1748 or 1750 and located in Maryland.

William McCullough was the son of Hugh McCullough. He was born in the state of Maryland. He followed the trade of cooper. He was married to a Miss Sheridan. He moved to Center County, PA and from thence to Jefferson County where he died at the home of his son, Sheridan McCullough, at the age of 77 years.

Sheridan McCullough was a son of William McCullough and was born in Baltimore. He was married to Miss Mary Ross, who was a lineal descendant of Betsey Ross, who made the first - (the next line is on the fold of the newspaper and is completely obliterated) - ough went to Center County, PA, with his parents. From thence he went to Jefferson County in 1830, and bought the old Grimes farm back of the Cowan farm he had purchased. He was a carpenter by trade and worked in Brookville. He built one of the first houses at the corner of Main and Pickering streets soon after removing to the county. He died at his home at the age of 88 years.

The McCullough men have almost all been soldiers. John and Archibald McCullough, older sons of Hugh, served in the Revolutionary War. William fought in the War of 1812. Sheridan missed the war period in his time but everyone of the four sons born to him served in the War of the Rebellion, as follws: David McCullough, Corsica and Clarion in the 11th PA Calvary (deceased); J.L. McCullough, Brooksville, in the 10th PA Reserves (deceased); William McCullough, Clarion, 66th Vet Inf; and John McCullough, Corsica, 11th PA Calvary.

Polly McCullough, a sister of William McCullough, married John Hull, who served under Commodore Perry, and the decendants still have the gold medal vote by Congress."

One of the first settlers was Elisha M. Graham, who located on the farm now owned by Sheridan McCullough, to whom he sold it in 1829.

Mr. Sheridan McCullough is now in the eighty-fourth year of his age, and has resided in Union about fifty-eight years. Mr. McCullough for some years has been almost blind. He says that the worst experience he had in farming in Jefferson county was caused by the long and severe drought of 1844, which was of longer duration than that of the summer of 1887--no rain fell for many weeks. Mr. McCullough had taken grain to four different mills, but though he went to the mills time after time, he found his grain unground, and his family had to subsist on potatoes. When he had gone for the ninth time to mill, his son David, and daughter, Elizabeth, who were digging potatoes upon which to make another meal, desried him coming, and perceiving that he had at last a "grist" with him, threw down their hoes and rushed to the house, knowing that they would have bread at last. Sheridan became a member of the Jacksonville Presbyterian Church, Centre Co., PA early in life. Minister at the time was Dr. James Linn after whom one of his sons was (presumably) named. After moving to Union Township (then in Lycoming Co), he joined the local Presbyterian Church. At his death, he was a member of the Pisgah Church in Corsica.

WILLIAM MCCULLOUGH OBITUARY (copy of newspaper clipping including spelling errors)

William McCullough, a man of sturdy frame and strong upright character, who lived almost 92 years, quietly sat in his chair at the residences of his son, Edward M. McCullough, in Beaver Falls, Pa., last Thursday evening, December 18, 1919, and closed up the book of his life, and was not, for God took his spirit back to his care until the time of the restoration of all things. He had rheumatism, especially in one foot which had been crippled in the war of 1861 - 65, and finally that became the seat of the disease which terminated his life and from which he suffered very much in the last days and weeks of his life. But on the evening named his supper had been carried to him and placed before him as he sat in his chair. Shortly thereafter his son noticed him sitting with a bowed head and his right hand hanging down at his right side, and spoke to him only to find only the house in which he had lived, that father had gone away, leaving o long.

William McCullough was born in Jefferson county, PA., March 1, 1828, a son of former Sherrif McCullough, of that county, and grew to manhood there. He learned and followed the carpenter's trade, and in his prime was considered a man of great skill and splendid ability in his chosen occupation. On December 28, 1842, he was united in marriage with Eliza Jane Frampton, a daughter of William Frampton, and shortly thereafter moved to and established his home in Mechanicsville, where he made his home until a couple of years ago after his wife died 21 years ago last Feb. 9. Following that he resided with his children, spending most of his summers with his daughter, Mrs. J. W. Russell, of Clarion, and his winters with his son where he died.

Mr. McCullough is survived by seven children, namely: Spurgeon, of Cleveland, O.; Mrs. Denton Tucker, Graham, Wash.; W. S., Pittsburgh; J. D., Beaver falls; Mr. N. Heckman, New Kensington; Ed. M., Beaver Falls and Mrs J.W. Russell, of Clarion.

There also survive more than 40 grandchildren, 40 great grandchildren and 6 great great grandchildren. He also leaves one brother, John McCulough, Brooksville; Mrs. E. O. Orcutt, and Mrs. David Orcutt, Corsica, and Mrs. David Sowers, in the west.

The deceased served in the war of 1861 - 63 as a member of Co. G, 26th Pa Vol. Inf., and gave his country a devoted service at the expense of his own body, and he goes out honored member of the Grand Army of the Republic.

The deceased became a member of Zion Baptist Church at Reldsburg many years ago. Funeral services were conducted at his late home and the mortal remains were brought to Clarion last Saturday and were interment in the Clarion cemetery. The Rev Wm. EE. Mr. Edward Bean Orcutt, whose death we reported last week was a native of Maine, where he was born near Charleston, October 3, 1827. His parents names were David and Phoebe (Inglis). He had been a resident of Jefferson county since 1844. August 8, 1854, he was united in marriage with Miss Rachel McCullough. Seven children were the result of this union, and death had never entered the home till the father was called. The mother and children were all present at the funeral service. Al lives at Oakland, Md.; Cad at Leechburg; John and Pearl at Oil City, and the other three, Laura (Mrs. Dr. Holden), Winnie, and Reed at Corsica. Mr. Orcutt has been a member of Pisgah church since 1854 and the funeral services were conducted by the pastor at his late residence on Main St. on Thursday, the 14th. OBITUARY - DAVID RAMSEY SOWERS

Otsego County Herald - Gaylord, Michigan, July 29, 1904 (RMS- 6/16/2000)

DAVID R. SOWERS- died at the family residence in this village Wednesday afternoon, at the age of 69 years. The better part of his life was a happy one, but his later years have been a blank, his memory breaking down, and or the last six or seven years has been a constant care to his ever faithful and devoted wife who has been unremitting in her labors for his creature comforts.

The deceased was born in Jefferson County, Pa. Aug. 1, 1836, and at the age of 22 was united in marriage to Miss Rebecca Jane Mc Collough (sic), at Brooksville, Pa. OBITUARY

Death claimed another of the few remaining Civil War veterans at Jefferson county, when John B. McCullough of Corsica died in Erie last Friday evening. January 18 at 9:30 o'clock after a week's illness, aged 81years 10 months and 6 days. Death was due to the infirmities of age.

Mr. McCullough had been a resident of Corsica for more than fifty years, where he followed his trade of carpentering. He was born on the McCullough farm in Union township on March 14, 1847, a son of Sheridan and Mary (Ross) McCullough. When the Civil War broke out, he joined Company G, 11th Pennsylvania Volunteer Cavalry and saw much active service. He was twice wounded in the fighting around Richmond, Va. He was one of four brothers who served in the Union army during the war.

The deceased was united in marriage to Miss Henrietta Matson of Union Twp on August 15, 1871. To them were born six children, five of whom survive one daughter dying in infancy. Mrs. McCullough preceded her husband in death a number of years ago. Surviving children are: S.J. and Enolia of Corsica, Acta of Wilkinsburg; M.M. of St. Mary's and Elizabeth wife of Marvin Rowley, of Bridgeville. He is also survived by two sisters: Mrs. Arma Orcutt of Corsica, and Elizabeth McCullough of Brooksville.

He was a member of Corsica Lodge I.O.O.F. and of Plagah Presbyterian Church.

From The Pittsburg Press, January 3, 1909:

The big steam shovel which is to level the new field of the Pittsburg Baseball club at the entrance to Schenley Park, Oakland, in 60 days was set up New Year's day, but did not begin actual work until yesterday.

The improvement of a new street through the property, which is independent of the baseball enterprise, has been going on for nearly a month and the contractors in charge of that job have permission to dump on the land owned by Barney Dreyfuss, so that much progress has been made towards filling the big hole at the Joncaire street end of the new park, but the machinery which started yesterday will do the work much quicker. The shovel began on the Boquet street side and in two weeks will be out of the way of the Nicola Building Co., which has the contract for the erection of the stands.

In addition to the grading machinery, there was set up yesterday all of the machinery needed for the concrete work and tomorrow the building of the massive retaining wall from Joncaire street nortto Boquet street will be under way. The permit for the part of the improvement was granted Thursday.

With the graders at work on the new ball park, the street makers busy, a large force employed by the city on improvemntns in Schenley Park, and skilled workmen erecting the University of Pittsburgh, the new Memorial Hall and additions to the Carnegie Technical schools, Oakland was the busiest section of the city yesterday. The ball park improvement alone furnished work for more that 100 men.

C. E. Marshall, representing Charles W. Leavin, Jr, the engineer who is in charge of the work, will arrive tomorrow morning from New York to supervise the construction of the retaining walls and the sewer system. He is an expert in that line, having served for two years on the United States corps at Panama. While an extensive system of drainage will be established at the new park, the best feature is that the natural drainage is nearly perfect. At Exposition Park the field is in a basin and catches all of the surface water from the surrounding streets and property while at the new park the pitcher's plate will be the highest point and the field will shed water on all sides.

The Nicola Building Co. is erecting a temporary office for the use of the employees and the engineers. This building will be finished this week.

Last week, before the contractors took possession, the Pittsburg Baseball Club had a photograph taken of the property. Views were obtained from all four sides and it is the intention to keep a photographic record of the improvement, showing how much has been accomplished in a stated period. The photograph from which the cut on this page was made shows the northern end of the site. What will be left and center fields, the site for the left wing of the grandstand and the left field bleachers are in the foreground. Prominent in the background is the Schenley Hotel. The small buildings now on the Forbes street side are next and to the extreme left is the Oakland Methodies Episcopal Church.

President Dreyfuss, who went South with his family for the holidays, will return this week. He is due in Cincinnati on Monday to attend the meeting of the joint schedule committee of the American and National Leagues. This is only one of several important gatherings at Cincinnati this week. The National Commission Eastern League and the American Association with the commission about minor league affairs will follow. There are rumors of deals and there is some foundation for the talk, as President Ebbets, of the Brooklyn Club, who will be in Cincinnati tomorrow, expects to name his manager this week. M.S. Robison, president of the St. Louis Club, will come to Pittsburg as soon as President Dreyfuss returns to furnish information about the folding chair which he has designed. The newsamples have arrived at headquarters.

President Robison is also interested in the baseball improvements here. He owns the land on which the Cardinals play now at St. Louis, and is only waiting until he braces up his team to improve the new park. C. H. Ebbets, of Brooklyn, and George B. Dovey, of Boston, will pass through this city. President Ebbets is chairman of the ticket committee, and as Pittsburg is represented by Secretary W. H. Locke, he will stop for a conference [if] possible.

The National League will in all probability take some action towards eliminating the pass evil next season. The American League and the American Association have already legislated against the nuisance. Most of the players are in hearty accord with the reform, as it will save them from annoying attention from the professional passhunters.
