1. Sidney Thomas Price, born 23 March 1909 in Cardiff, Glamorgan, South Wales.; died 14 May 1955 in Barry, Glamorgan, South Wales. (age 46). He was the son of **2. Francis Henry Price** and **3. Ellen Souch**. He married **(1) Ethel Irene Norman** 30 April 1932 in Cardiff, Glamorgan, South Wales.. She was born 10 May 1906 in Barry, Glamorgan, South Wales., and died 31 October 2001 in Llandough Hospital, near Cardiff, South Wales. (age 95). She was the daughter of John Norman and Annie Elizabeth Hicks.

Notes for Sidney Thomas Price:

Sidney, also known as Tom was born at 5 Bishop Street, Grangetown. He had nine brothers and sisters, Fred, George, Leonard, Violet, Nelly, May, Gladys, Dolly and Nancy. Tom drove lorries for Hills Transport, Dinas Powis, before he came to Barry, where he laboured for the council. Tom enjoyed growing vegetables on his allotment. During World War 2 (1939 - 1945) Tom was sent to Manchester on war work, he didn't like it at all and was sent home on health grounds. Tom wasn't allowed to go to war due to a leg injury sustained when he was kicked by a horse. Tom was an Air Raid Warden in Barry during the war. He would walk around the town with his bucket of water and pump ready to extinguish any incendiary devices, and knock on the doors if any windows weren't blacked out. After the war he returned to labouring for the council. After an operation on his ulcers at the Barry Accident & Emergency Hospital Tom contracted post op. pneumonia and died. His death certificate gives the cause of death as 1a) Peritonitis, b) Volvulus (twisting of the intestine), c) Intestinal obstruction. 2) Broncho Pneumonia, chronic duodenal ulcers.

Rene bought Tom's grave at the cost of Two Pounds and Ten Shillings.

Barry & District News, Thursday May 26th 1955.

The funeral took place yesterday (Wednesday) week at Barry Cemetery of Mr Sidney Thomas Price, of 22 Edward Street, Cadoxton, who at the age of 46 died on the previous Saturday at Barry Accident Hospital.

Mr Price, who was a masons labourer, was born in Grangetown, Cardiff. He lived in Dinas Powis for a time before coming to Barry 24 years ago.

He is survived by his wife, Mrs Ethel Price, and one son, Mr Donald Price, and a daughter, Jean.

Dean, T. Swain, A. Thomas - Collins and many others. Bearers were Messrs Harry Havewood, Fred Watts, Alf Pearce and S. Williams.

Funeral arrangements were carried out by Messrs W. Spickett and Son.

(The bearers were Tom's council work-mates).

Tom was buried on the 18th May 1955 at Merthyr Dyfan Cemetery, Barry, Grave Space T338. There is no headstone. To locate the grave go to the Buttrills Park end of the cemetery and in section T locate a wooden cross with the name Leslie Anthony on it. To the right of the cross is a large stone grave of Frank Chatt Collins, Tom is to the right of this grave as you are looking towards the Buttrills.

Notes for Ethel Irene Norman:

Ethel, also known as Rene was born at 24 Evans Street, Barry on the 10 May 1906, daughter of John Norman and Annie Hicks. Rene grew up with her five brothers Jack, George, William, Frederick and Albert.

Rene was very poorly as a child, she had an illness which caused her hair to fall out. Because of this illness Rene did not learn to talk until the age of ten.

Rene attended Gladstone Road School for two weeks only, she never learnt to read or write.

Rene was a domestic for the manager of Rank's Mills and also for her Auntie Honnor. One of Rene's childhood recollections was listening to the old 78inch records on the gramophone which had a large brass horn.

Rene had two Yorkshire terriers, the mother was called Candy and the daughter, Sugar. She also had a cat called Blackie which Jean brought home from the enamel works.

Rene married Tom Price at the Cardiff Register Office on the 30 April 1932. Their son Don was born on the 1 November 1938 and their daughter Jean was born on the 16 July 1935.

The family lived with Rene's mum at 24 Evans Street until her death there in December 1938. The family had to move out of Evans Street and took up temporary residence in a number of lodgings throughout Barry until they settled at 22 Edwards Street, Barry, which had previously been rented by Tom's sister, Nelly.

Rene moved from Edward Street to Pontalun Close. Rene's final address was 16 Brecon Court.

Rene died at Llandough Hospital on the 31 October 2001. The funeral service was held at Mount Pleasant Baptist Church, Barry at 10.00am on the 5 November 2001, the service being officiated by Reverend G Lewis. The undertakers were Spicketts of Barry. Rene was buried with her husband at Merthyr Dyfan Cemetery, Barry, grave space T338.

His son, Sidney's birth certificate of 1909 gave their address as 5 Bishop Street, Grangetown, Cardiff. Frank lived at Sunnybank, Dinas Powis, then, at 14 Elmgrove Place, Dinas Powis.

He grew vegetables and sold them, he also kept chickens at his allotments.

Frank had many jobs including stoker in the merchants services, general labourer, dock labourer, master baker & confectioner and he also had a coal round.

Frank was living with his daughter Nelly and her husband Bob Robertson at 'Malgwyn', Pencoedtre Road, Barry when he died of stomach cancer on the 21 May 1952, age 76.

Frank was buried in St Andrews Church Yard, St Andrews Major on the 24th May 1952. I think he is buried with his wife, Ellen. The burial records at St Andrews Church have Frank's middle name as Harry. There is no headstone.

Notes for Ellen Souch:

According to the 'Your Family Crest' web site the name Souch is English in origin and was first found in Leicestershire where they were anciently seated as Lords of the Manor.

Ellen died on the 29 November 1919 at home, 14 Elm Grove Place, Dinas Powis. She died of (1) Lobar pneumonia, (2) Mitral disease. The mitral heart valve is the passage between the left atrium and the left ventricle.

Ellen is probably buried in St Andrews Church Yard, St Andrews Major with her husband, Frank. There is no headstone.

And I do hereby direct that they the said Francis Berry and Francis Berry the younger and the survivor of them his executors or administrators do and shall stand and possessed of and interested in the money to assist by such sale or sales and also the principal money and interest to be received on such security or securities as aforesaid and also of and in the rest and residue of my personal estate and effects in trust in the first place to pay off and discharge all my just debts, funeral expences and the expences of proving this my will and in executing the trusts them of and from and after payment thereof upon this further trust that they the said Francis Berry and Francis Berry the younger or the survivor of them his executors or admors do and shall place out and invest the remainder of my estate and effects in covernment or other securities in their own names as they my said trustees shall think proper and the interest to accrue but there from time to time to pay and apply in manner following / that is to say / as to one moiety of such accruing interest upon trust to pay the same to my wife Elizabeth Souch and her assigns for and during the term of her natural life to and for her own sole and absolute use and benefit provided she shall remain my widow and unmarried but not otherwise / and as to the other moiety of such accruing interest I direct that the same shall remain vested in the said Francis Berry and

Francis Berry the younger and the survivor of them his executors and administrators to be by them or him applied from time to time as the same shall become due towards the maintenance, education and bringing up of my son James Sciance Souch in such manner as they my said trustees or the survivor of them his executors or admons shall think proper until my said son shall attain his full age of twenty one years and when and so soon as he shall have attained that age then principal money from my said effects and securities as aforesaid unto or in the name of my said son James Sciance Souch to and for his own absolute use and benefit to whom I give and bequeath the same to my said trustees a proper release or discharge for the same and as to for and concerning the other moiety of the said principal money arising as aforesaid upon trust also / from and after the death and or decease of my said wife / to pay, assign or transfer the same unto or in the name of my said son James Sciance Souch to and for his own absolute use and benefit to whom I give and bequeath the same he releasing and exonerating my said trustees from payment thereof and upon this further trust that if my son James Sciance Souch shall happen to die under the age of of twenty one years leaving his mother surviving him that then my said trustees and the survivor of them his executors and administrators do and shall immediately on the death of my said son under age pay and apply the whole of the interest to arise from my effects as aforesaid unto my said wife Elizabeth Souch and her assigns for and during the term of her natural life / she remaining my widow and unmarried as aforesaid / and upon further trust that from and after the decease of my said wife and my said son under the age of twenty one years as aforesaid to pay, apply, assign or transfer the whole of the said principal money arising from the sale of my said effects as aforesaid in manner following / that is to say / as to one moiety thereof to such person or persons and for such uses intents and purposes and in such manner as my said wife Elizabeth Souch shall in her lifetime by her last will and testament duly executed and attested or any codicil or codicils annexed thereto give devise, direct, limit or appoint the same and for want or in default of such gift, devise, direction, limitation or appointment then upon trust to make sale of or call in the same and the monies to arise thereby to place and invest in some provincial or savings bank to the use of all and every the children of such of my four brothers John Souch, Thomas Souch, William Souch and Richard Souch as shall be then living and also the child or children of such of them as shall be then dead equally between and amongst them share and share alike and as to and for and concerning the other moiety of the principal of my said estate and effects upon trust and to the use last mentioned of all and every the children of such of my said four brothers John, Thomas, William and Richard Souch as shall be then living and also of the child or children of such of them as shall be then dead equally amongst them share and share alike and upon this further trust that if it shall happen that my said wife shall intermarry with a second husband in the lifetime of my said son that then and in such case my said trustees and the survivor of them his executors or admons do and shall immediately on such her second marriage pay on transfer such share of my said personal estate and effects as she my said wife would have been entitled to under this my will had she remarried my widow unto my said son James Sciance Souch to and for his own use and benefit to whom in such case I give and bequeath the same and do then revoke all bequests to my said wife under this my will accordingly but incase my said wife shall happen to survive and outlive my said son and should intermarry subsequently his decease then I will and direct that my said trustees and the survivor them his executors or admons shall permit my said wife and her assigns to have, take and receive the interest arising from one moiety of my said effects during the term of her natural life to and for her own sale and absolute use and benefit notwithstanding her coverture and where with her then present husband shall
