From the Denison Review(Iowa) May 11, 1910.

A.D. Herrig-- A prominent German citizen of Denison, died at his home on Church Street on Thursday night of last week. His death did not come as a sudden shock to either his family or the community, for his torment was of such a nature that for sometime all hope of recovery was practically abandoned. Mr. Herrig had all his life enjoyed almost perfect health up to last Christmas Eve, when he was suddenly stricken, and while he soon recovered from the severity of the attack, was never a well man after that time. Early in March of this year he was taken to Colfax, where it was discovered that he was probably suffering from cancer of the stomach. He was afterward treated by Dr. Kagel of Shelby, Iowa, who diagnosed his trouble as simple catarrh of the stomach. On April 6 he was taken to Rochester, Minnesota, and placed in charge of Drs. Mayo, the famous physicians and surgeons of that place for treatment. An incision confirmed the suspicion that the trouble was a fast growing cancer and that an operation would be useless, and after spending two weeks in the hospital, Mr. Herrig was brought back to his home, where just about two weeks from the date of his return, his death occurred.

The deceased was born in the town of Kemp, in Germany, on June 4, 1839, being at the time of his death but one month short of 71 years of age. When a young man, Mr. Herrig immigrated to the United States from Germany, coming direct to Davenport, Iowa, and ever since that time has resided in this state. On his arrival in this country, he did not wait for a job to come to him, but immediately sought and found labor as a farm hand, and for six years worked on a farm, after which for eight years he rented and operated a farm. He was engaged for a time in conducting a restaurant in Wheatland, Iowa, and later engaged for a time in the merchantile business in that place. In 1878 he moved to Wall Lake and engaged in merchantile and banking business with Henry Mohr, his brother-in-law. He became president of the German Bank of Wall Lake, which position he held until the time of his death, one of his sons filling the position of cashier, and of later years having an active management of the institution. A few years ago Mr. Herrig moved from Wall Lake to Denison and erected a fine home on Church Street, where he resided until his

death.

In October, 1862 he was married to Miss Anna Mohr, with whom he lived until her death in 1903. On January 10, 1906, he was married a second time in Schleswig, Iowa, to Mary Naeve, widow of Wm. Naeve, who survives him, by his first marriage there were born eight children, three boys and five girls, as follows-- Mrs. Louisa Sifford, Mrs. Henry (Pauline) Brown, Mrs. John(Augusta) McClurg, all of Wall Lake, Sac Co., Iowa, Mrs. Elmer(Laura) Mahood of Canon City, Fremont Co., Colorado, Mrs. Joe(Ruphenia) Kenan of South Fork, Cambria Co., Pennsylvania, Charles M. Herrig of Wall Lake, Emil Herrig of Holibird, South Dakota, and Adolph Herrig of Havre, Hill Co., Montana. The stepchildren are Mrs. Peter Jepson of Schleswig and Miss Alfreda Naeve of Denison.

Mr. Herrig was a man of more than ordinary mental capacity and enterprise, and succeeded not only in the accumulation of property, but in the winning of esteem and good will of those with whom he came in contact. His popularity was due to his genial and happy disposition, as well as his reputation for absolute honesty and trustworthiness. He was a devoted husband, a kind and indulgent father, and greatly loved by all his children, his stepchildren no less than his own. He was an obliging neighbor and will be greatly missed by a large circle of his friends.

Short funeral services were held at an early hour on Monday morning at the home, the Rev. C.E. Schoenleber, pastor of the German Methodist Church, officiating, and at 9 o'clock the body was taken to Wall Lake, where at 2:30 in the afternoon regular services were held at the Presbyterian Church, after which the body was taken for burial to the Wall Lake Cemetery. The pallbearers were Peter Atzen, Peter Meggers, Paul Voss, Adam Schneckloth, Peter Henningsen, and Gustav Buesing.

Date of death April 30th, 1903

Thursday morning the citizens of this place were greatly surprised when they learned that Mrs. A.D. Herrig had passed from this life the night before at about twelve o'clock.

Mrs. Herrig had been sick, more or less, the past three years. She had an attack of heart failure about two weeks ago, which was very severe. She rallied from that attack and it was supposed that she was out of danger when, about eleven o'clock Wednesday night she had another attack. She was not strong enough to overcome it this time and was compelled to leave this world and those she loved so well.

Deceased maiden name was Anna Mohr. She was born in Windeboe, Schleswig, Germany, March 18, 1844. Came to this country in 1854 with her parents, who settled in Davenport, Iowa. They moved to Wheatland, Clinton County, in fall of 1856. On the 26th day of October, 1862 deceased married A.D. Herrig, of Wheatland. In the spring of 1878 Mr. and Mrs. Herrig moved to Wall Lake where they have resided ever since.

Deceased was the mother of nine children, eight of whom survive her, namely: Mrs. Louis Sifford, Mrs. H.F. Brown, Mrs. John McClurg, Charley and Miss Ruphenie, of this place, Mrs. Elmer Mahood, of Dows, Iowa, Emil and Adolph of Buffalo, North Dakota.

Beside her husband, a brother, D.H. Mohr of Arcadia, and a sister Mrs. Charley Weilding, of Topeka, Kansas also survive her.

Deceased was an excellent lady. A kind and loving mother and beloved wife. Her friends are counted by the hundreds.

Mrs. Herrig was a charter member of the Wall Lake Chapter O.E.S., and has always taken great interest in it.

Funeral services will be held at the Presbyterian Church, of which she was a member, Saturday afternoon at two o'clock, and will be conducted by Rev. H. Gill, of Quimby, Iowa, a former pastor at this place.

Death of L. J. Sifford

On last Sunday, February 21, Lewis J. Sifford died at his home in this city. He had been sick for several weeks and it was thought for some time he would recover, but owing to a complication of diseases death claimed him.

Deceased was born December 25, 1854, at Howard, Mich. He came to Calhoun county, Iowa with his parents, November 10, 1864 and came to Wall Lake in the fall of 1877 and engaged in the drug business which he was still in at the time of his death. On June 14, 1883, he was united in marriage to Miss Louise Herrig, of this place. To this union four children were born, one having died about 10 years ago in infancy. Besides a wife and three children, he leaves an aged father and mother, two brothers and two sisters, all of which were here to attend the funeral services which were held Wednesday afternoon and conducted by Rose Cruix Commandery, K.T. of Sac City, of which he was a member. Lake Lodge, A.F.&A.M. and Wall Lake Chapter, O.E.S., of which he was a member, also attend the funeral service in body. Deceased was also a member of Chuvallier lodge K and P.

During the twenty years he was a resident of this place he made many friends by his genial disposition and his kindness for his fellowman. There never was a resident of this place, who by acts of kindness, did more to relieve his less fortunate brother than he; he was generous to fault, and will be greatly missed by all.

Brother Lewis J. Sifford was born on the 25th of December, 1854, at Howard in Cass county, Mich. He came to Calhoun Co., Iowa, November 10, 1864, was made an Eternal Apprentice in Zernblall Lodge, No. 240, A.F.&A.M., at Lake City, Iowa on the 2nd day September, 1876, was passed to the degree of Fellow Craft 27th day of January, 1877, and raised to the sublime degree of Master Mason on the 3rd day of March, 1877. In the fall of 1877 he came to Wall lake and when Lake Lodge

was organized he became a charter member, acting as Senior Deacon, for some years. He died February 21, 1897 and thus a good brother and kind neighbor has left us.

Wall Lake Woman Commits Suicide
Ill Health and Financial Troubles Cause Death of Mrs. Herrig

Wall Lake --- The dead body of Mrs. Luella Herrig was found hanging in the basement of her residence in Wall Lake about 8 o'clock last Thursday morning. She had been missing that morning and search by family revealed the tragic deed.

Mrs. Herrig's health had not been good for some time, although she had given no intimation to her loved ones that she contemplated self-destruction. Poor health together with financial difficulties are assumed

to have the cause of her death.

The funeral was held at the Lutheran Church Wednesday afternoon and pretty much all the surrounding county as well as the citizens of this town attended. Some nearly three hundred viewing the remains for the last time on earth. Reverend A. Dischner had charge of the funeral services after which the remains were laid to rest in the last resting place in Wall Lake cemetery.

August C. Herrig was born in Kembs, Germany, August 27, 1841. He was married to Miss Erne Brockmann who died in 1878, having borne him five children, four of whom are dead, one Helen now Mrs. Ralph Kaiser, who lives near Lytton. In 1880, March 30, he wedded Helen Bauer who survives him. To them were born six children two of whom are dead, the other four, Paul J. living on the home farm, Ross A., Edward H., and Nora are at home.

In 1885 Mr. Herrig came from Germany to Wall Lake, near which he resided until three years ago, when he moved into the house

he had purchased in the east part of town and where he died after an half hours illness, of heart disease March 8, 1908, about 10:30 p.m. He also leaves one brother, A. D. Herrig of Denison and a sister in Germany.
