He was a farm laborer at the home of Ruchard Bullard and his wife Elizabeth Benson Bullard. His Civil War Records state that he married Mary Bullard in Oct. of 1854. His home was a log cabin on the farmland that is known as the Old Tom Crapps Home Place in Dyal School Community on Road #535, just a short distance from the Bacon County Line.

Thomas Sr. enlisted in the Volunteer Army Infantry on Mar. 4, 1862 and was assigned to Co. F 47th Regiment and died of Typhoid Fever in a Savannah Hospital on Oct. 5, 1862. His wife, Mary was taken by horse and wagon to go and bring his body home for burial, by a black slave descendant named Bishop (Ole Bish) The trip there and back took several days, and this was told by Aunt Nance, who was the daughter of Bish and also a midwife and living in one of the Black Quarters cabins on the farmland of Dennis Smith, near the Dyal School.

**His parents apparently migrated to Germany, because it was fro Germany that he and his wife and children came to America. They came with other emigrants fro the Lower Palatinate on the Rhine River to Germany. Isaac and his family probably arrived on the Oliver which docked in Charleston, SC on July 20, 1735. The SC Gazette of JULY 26, 1735 says of the arrival of the ship Oliver:**

**On Sunday last arrived here Capr. Robert Robinson mentioned in our last, with about 200 Palatines, most of them being poor, they are obliged to sell themselves and their children for their passages ( whis is six Pistoles in Gold per head) within a fortnight from the time of arrival according to the agreement the made with the Captain, or wlse to pay one Pistole per head more to be carried to Philadelphia.**

**It is certain that Isaac indentured himself for on Feb. 22, 1738/39 he petitioned for 350 acres of land stating that he was now out of servitude and listing a family consisting of himself, his wife, one son 15 yr. old (Charles), daughter 16 (Anna), daughter 13 (Sarah) one son 12 (peter) and a son 2 (jacob). His grant of 350 acres on Limestone Creek and town lot No. 282 on Fenwick Street was surveyed on JUL**

**25, 1739. He received the Royal Grant on Mach 1, 1744. Isaac took an interest in the affairs of the community and the local Church. REverand John Ulrich Giessendanner mentions his name on several occasions in the church record and recorded his death as follows.**

**1752 - On Monday Aug. 17 was buryed the Body of Isaac Hottow, a Settler in this township for Several years past, who died suddenly on Sat. Aug. 15th in the Evening in the Path, as he was going home and was found and taken up dead between his house and the Town of Orangeburgh, no Mark, of any Fall or Violence done him could be seen on his Body. He left a wife and 7 children, 4 of which are married. He was aged 57 years and buryed at his own plantation.**

**His widow, Mary Catharina remarried in 1753.**

**A fortunate circumstance is the Rev. John Giessendanner who was a Luthran minister IN 1738 and who was ordained in the Church of England in 1749 kept a record of baptisms, marriages, and death of his congrgation, without this careful records the beginnings of the Hutto clan would be virtually unknown.**
