Andrew Jackson Cruey, a wagon maker, the youngest son of Christopher and Ruth Hunnel Cruey. He was born 23 December 1837 in Smyth Co., Va. near 7 Mile Ford. The 1860 census has him at this location and between 1860-1870 he moved to Tazewell Co., Va.

Both the parents, Ruth and Christopher, had died before his marriage to Mary Cline in January or February 1858. Smyth County records the Marriage Bond, 12 January 1858, however, the licence was never returned to court. It is believed they were probably married in another county. William J. Cruey, his oldest brother, gave permission along with Mary's father John Cline for Andrew to marry since he was under the age of 21, about 20 years old.

It is believed his father came from Ireland. A picture of the ship, name unknown, always hung on the wall of Andrew's grandson John Hall in Cedar Bluff, Va. Glenna Martin Poe, Bluefield W.Va., our 2nd cousin, daughter of MaMa's sister Corneluis, also said the picture of the ship was the one the Crueys came over on.

Christopher Cruey, as well as his brothers, William J., Thomas, Hamilton and Charles J. were all wagon makers - no information on Daniel J. The building in Cedar Bluff, Va., which made many wagons going west to the new frontier stands today as an auto mechanics business, owned by a Cruey. Andrew and Mary had ten children.

In the 1880 Census of Tazewell Co., Va., Maiden Springs, Dis 91, page 316, we find Alexander Hall, 23, a blacksmith, as head of the household, future husband of Margaret. Next door we find Andrew Jackson Crewey with his family. In the 1900 Census of Tazewell Co., Va. ED 100, Page 8B, we find Alex Hall, 40, a blacksmith and Margaret, 37, with the family listed and next door we find Andrew Jackson Curey, married 41 years and if you add 22 years to this he, AJC, would have been born in 1837.

In !870 Tazewell Co. Va. Maiden Springs Township, page 264, dwelling 79 we find Henry Hall and in dwelling 77 we find William J. Crewey. (See Henry) In 1880, Henry Leonard Hall lives with his sisters and nephew and niece in dwelling 229, near his nephews Alexander and Erastus, who live in dwelling 222: Andrew Jackson Crewey is in dwelling 223. William is in Kentucky. Between 1870 and 1880 Andrew has taken over the wagon making from William. Hamilton in 1870 is in Smyth Co. and in 1880 in Tazewell Co., Va.

In a hand written report by Ron Shortridge April 1983 and helped by his mother Edythe," Uncle Jack (Andrew Jackson Cruvey) passed away at the age of 67 during a church service which was being held in the upstairs of the Cruvey shop in 1904. His wife, my great grandmother, Mary Cline Cruvey, lived to be 101 years old , dying in 1934." A newspaper report of his death said he, Jack Crewey, was a Holiness or Evening Light people and died during a prayer meeting.

The file was contributed by Karen Eagle Moman in USGenWeb Archives. This story says that Andrew was born Dec 1836 and has been married 41 years.

A Hand Written Report: Written by Ron Shortridge, April, 1983

The name Cruey seems synonymous with Cedar Bluff because that family was among the earliest settlers to make their home there. Their arrival dates back to the late 1800s and a time when it was known as Indian, Va.; probably consisted of little else than the Higginbotham Mill when Andrew Jackson Cruey, Sr. built a place for his family to live at the bottom of what would later be widely known as "College Hill". He built across Indian Creek on Old Kentucky Turnpike near the Higginbotham Mill and adjacent Hotel known in those days as "Montecello".

A.J. Cruey, Sr., (My Great Grandfather) was known among his friends as "Uncle Jack". He came to Indian to open his own business as a wagon maker.

According to a brief history of Cedar Bluff which Miss Mildred McGuire wrote for the News Progress, mention is made of Uncle Jack, being an early settler, moved in a house formerly occupied by a Spott family. It was that house along with his shop, two log buildings, beside Indian Creek directly across from Higginbotham's "Montecello" (Now known as the Bane home) and Uncle Alex Hall's blacksmith shop which was washed away in the June flood on 1901. A cloud burst suddenly erupted on upper Indian Creek at about four o'clock in the morning. No one had any advance notice and Indian Creek became flood waters almost immediately.

They rebuilt the Cruey Shop promptly. Indian Creek got its name from a band of Shawnee Indians having a village near the head waters of the creek during early pioneer days.

The Cruey story has a beginning in the year 1813, with the marriage of Christopher Cruey to Ruth Hunnell on March 28 in Smyth County, Virginia. It is currently believed that Christopher came to the Southwest Virginia from Pennsylvania, where he had arrived earlier by ship from Holland. According to family tradition the Cruey name is of German origin. It is said the original Cruey home place in America was located at Rish Valley in Smyth County. The union of Christopher and Ruth produced a son named Hamilton who married Harriet Wood, October 23, 1830. They both made their living as wagon mechanics. It is not currently known if Christopher and Ruth had children other than Hamilton, nor do we know how many children Hamilton Cruey and Harriet Wood had, but we do know that two of Hamilton's sons were named Andrew Jackson and Charles. Andrew Jackson, of course, was my Great Grandfather. He married Mary Cline of Smyth County on November 11, 1853. Mary Cline was of Black Dutch descent.

While the family was still together in Smyth County that controversy arose over the spelling of the family name. Some wanted to spell it "Crewe" or "Crus". Our part of the family chose to retain "Cruey", but some distant relations today go by changed spelling. "Uncle Jack", as my Great Grandfather was commonly referred to by friends and acquaintances, managed the Higginbotham farm shop at Liberty Hill where wagon and farm tools were made and repaired and horses shod. Two fellows by the name of Shamblin also worked in that shop. One day there developed an argument which led to a fight, resulting in Joe Hagy, a Higginbotham relative, being hit over the head with a horse shoe hammer by one of the Shamblins. This caused the Shamblins to relocate to Pounding Mill and the Crueys to Indian.

Uncle Jack and Mary Cline left two girls and a boy buried at Liberty. At Indian they raised my Grandfather, Andrew Jackson Cruey, Jr. (nicknamed "Uncle Bud") and six daughters. Uncle Jack's bother Charles lived with them until his death. He never married. My Grandfather (Uncle Bud) at age 20 married 15 year old Nancy Catherine Brown of Raven's Nest Branch. They moved to Belfast where he operated a grain mill. It was here that Charles and Lona were born. After a couple of years Grandfather moved back to Indian and built a house next door to "Uncle Jack" (his father) - Uncle Jack passed away at the age of 67 during a church service which was being held in the upstairs of the Cruey shop in 1904. His wife (My Great Grandmother), Mary Cline Cruey lived to be 101 years old, dying in 1934.

Granddad is remembered for having some "firsts" in Cedar Bluff. His house had the first electric light, thanks to a generator, he rigged himself. Also first running water and indoor toilet and first automobile, 1911.

Do you remember the old Ram at Bane's dam that pumped water on the hill in that large tank? That furnished our first indoor plumbing. Memories -- Memories !!!

Alexander Hall, a blacksmith, the oldest son of James M. and Nancy B. White Hall was born in Giles Co., Va. in July of 1857. When he was about one and one half years old, his mother died during childbirth to twins James and John. When the twins were about two their father married Louisa Mowles in Mercer Co., Va. They then moved to Maden Springs in Tazewell Co., Va. in 1859 or 1860. Alexander married Margaret M. Cruey 3 May 1882. Her father Andrew J. Cruey was a wagon maker in Maiden Springs. They had nine Children: Nanny Lou, Mary J., Bettie, Gracie, Earl Preston,

Andrew J., John H., Cornelius, and Robert who died of Rheumatic Fever at the age of 10 or 11. He grew up during the Civil War, possibly following his father after the war into Grayson Co., Va. and Ashe Co., N.C. and then returning to Maiden Springs. His wife, Margaret, died shortly before 1910 with five children still at home. Cornie, the youngest, was only four or five. World War I came in 1917 and the three boys, Andrew, John, and Earl all served in France at the same time. They all came home, however Earl who had been gassed was mentally affected. I'm not sure of the events leading to the death of Alexander. But I was told by my grandmother, Nannie Lou, that one evening in 1919 he went down by the creek and committed suicide with a knife to his throat.

Alexander and Margaret, her parents, and some of their children; Betty, Mary, Andrew, Robert and Earl; are all buried in Jones Chapel Cemetery, Cedar Bluff, Va. There are no markers for Alexander, Margaret, or Robert.

He is remembered as being a pleasant happy man over six foot tall with red hair and riding a white stallion.

Herbert B. Doyle, a brakeman, switchman, and later a flag man for the Norfolk and Western Railroad, was born 13 February 1886 in the Beaver Pond District, now Bluefield, Mercer County, W.Va. He was the fourth child of nine. His parents were William Montgomery and Sarah Evelyn Winfery Doyle.

He was reared on a farm, which is now located on the old Bluefield- Princeton Rd., off highway 460 The quite valley of south western West Virginia, in the Appalachian Mountain range, among the Maple, Catalpa, Oke and Birch trees with an abundance of wild to hunt and clear streams to fish, would be considered a utopia to raise children today.

When he was in his late teens he hired on with the Norford and Western Railway; since his older brother, William C., was already working and earning good money with the railway. Part of his job to ride the train to Richlands, Va. and back to Bluefield.

While in Richlands, Va. he met Nannie Lou Hall , who was born 13 July 1883. Her parents were Alexander and Margaret M. Cruey hall. Bee and Nannie, with another couple, ran away by horse and buggy to Bristol, Tenn., because they were not of age, and married 19 November 1903. He was 17, she was 20.

They lived in Bluefield, W.Va. until about 1914 when he received a transfer from N.& W. Railroad to Roanoke, Va. They had six children: Herbert Wade, Lucy B., Aileen, Clyde, Sarah Virginia, Elizabeth France.

Clyde, who died, age 2 mo, 11 days, of whooping cough and spinal meningitis, is buried Jones Chapel, Cedar Bluff, Va.

Wade died 20 June 1963, Tucson Az of a coronary from complications of emphysema and buried South Lawn Cemetery, Tucson Az.

Frances died 5 Sept 1885 of cirrhosis of the liver, buried Green Memorial Cemetery, Roanoke, Va.

Aileen died 15 Oct 1998 of double pneumonia, She had been bed ridden with arthritis for a number of years, and buried in Roanoke, Va.

Herbert Bee was the kindest man I ever knew. No matter the problem he could always find a way to make a person laugh, either by a riddle, song or a story. One could always find him in the vegetable garden, or in the evening , if he could find someone to go with him, "The Rialto Theatre", for a western movie, and afterwards, a chocolate ice cream cone, at Granden Rd. Drug Store.

I spent all my summer vacation with my grandparents, when I was a child, and I cannot ever

remember hearing a cus word from his mouth. The worst was, " Carnsarn the carnsarn luck".

Sometimes we would take a drive in the car, not often, because the city bus was more covenant and cheaper. But when we did, the route would take us down thur Norwich area and Shaffer's Crossing, thru the railway tunnel. This tunnel was enclosed on both sides, so you couldn't see the other side of traffic. Then he would blow the horn, on the country setting, not the city setting, tapping the horn in such a way that the horn sounded like a train whistle. Many times he would let me sit on his lap and steer the car. I thought I was driving! Other times, he would drive to the railway yards, tapping the horn in such a way that the engineer driving the train, would answer with the toots of the train whistle. It was a lot of fun.

When he retired from the N.&W. Railway, he was bored and lonesome for people, other than family. He got a job driving a taxi cab. Once he was stopped by the police. When he asked what was wrong, the policeman said, "Nothing, I just wanted to give you a reward for your good driving habits."

Sometimes he would take his vacation time, ride the train to Bluefield, W.Va., where we lived, without telling anyone he was comings. Many times, by chance, we would look out a window, and there he would be , walking up the road. We all would be very excited. One of us, would run to meet him, while everyone else would try to straighten the house before he could reach the fount door.

He loved the Lord and he could really preach, even though he had no formal training to be a minister. He was the guest speaker for many small churches around Roanoke, Va.

Nannie Lou was a wonderful person too, her family always came first. When any of her children or grandchildren were sick or needed her in anyway, she would drop what she was doing and go to them.

As a child , I was always sick. She was probably at our house more times than any other. When I was 6 years old, i had pneumonia. I remember, lying in bed, while Mother , daddy, the doctor, and Ma Ma (That's what we call her.) were sitting at the food of my bed, and the doctor said," This is the crisis, if she makes it through tonight, all will be well". I remember, thinking, "What's a crisis?". My grandmother asked the doctor if he minded her trying something, and went to the kitchen, make a mustard poltis and put it on my chest. During my recuperation,and before I could even return to school, I had German Measles and then mumps. Not just for me, but this is only one of the many examples how she saved our lives; Durning a time before antibiotics were invented.

Nannie Hall Doyle had other talents. Dressmaking. I was always amazed. She could look at a garment in the department store, purchase material,go home,cutting her own pattern, creating a garment exactly like the one she had seen downtown. All of her grand daughters were very lucky to be the recipients of these lovely garments. In fact, she made my mother's wedding dress.

Herbert Bee died 6 August 1960 of heart failure and emphysema ( he had a functional genetic heart mitro valve prolapse) He is buried at Greenlawn Cemetery in Roanoke, Va.

In 1954, Nannie Lou Hall Doyle suffered a stroke, which left her unable to remember many of her family and to care for herself. Her oldest daughter, Lucy, quit her job and stayed home lovingly caring for her mother and father, only leaving the house once in 9 years, and that was to bury her father. Nannie Lou Hall Doyle, died 20 September 1963. She is buried at Greenlawn cemetery in Roanoke, Va.

Herbert Wade Doyle, the oldest child of Herbert B. and Nannie Lou Doyle , was born 8 January 1905 in Bluefield, Mercer County, W.Va. About 1914 or 1915 his parents moved to Roanoke, Va., where he grew up, studied to be a minister: but either was unable to continue his studies or felt this was not the right profession for him, and became a salesman working for a variety of firms during his life.

He married Runella Louise Walters 17 June 1930, They had four children, Sarah Jane, twins Nancy Lou and Herbert Wade , Jr. , and William Alexander.

Durning World War II he worked for Linde Aire Products, a Division of Union Carbine, in Charleston, W. Va. Several time he tried to enlist. His greatest desire was to be an Aerial Reconnaissance Photographer. This was not to be, however, because of a deferment due to his priority job. He was transferred to Bluefield, W.Va. where the family lived until 1955 when they moved to St.Albans

near Charleston, W. Va. In 1958 the doctors advised him to move to a warm climate for his emphysema. His daughter Sarah Jane and her family were living in Tucson, Arizona with an Air Force assignment at that time, and he decided to give Arizona a try.

Some more facts before I tell you a story. Degrees: Wayland Baptist College (Plainview, Texas)- Bachelor of Science in Occupational Education, Business Management and Electric Power Technology ; Rollins College (Winter Park, Florida) - Associate of Arts, Business Administration and Economics; Community College of the Air Force,- Associate in Applied Science, (1) Work Center Management, (2) Electric Power Technology, (3) Instructor in Technology.

My sister, Nancy Lou, and I were the first twins born at St. Francis Hospital in Charleston, W. Va. on October 23, 1937. It was a wet and windy day. It rained so much that the Kanawha River swelled its banks and my Daddy could not get home in Dunbar, W. Va. that night, so the story goes. My parents owned a white frame house on Frederick St one block from the river. The flood waters ran the street but not into our yard. I don't remember much about living in Dunbar except a pet goose Daddy brought home in our car and put in a cage in the back yard. We had to cross the railroad tracks near our house to get to our street. This is 2002 and I am 64 years old at the time of this writing.

We moved to Bluefield, W. Va. when I was 2 1/2 years of age and lived there in three locations until I was 13 years old or there about. Daddy's job was transferred by Linde Aire Products Co. in the summer of 1940. The first house was at 1308 College Ave on the corner of Maryland Ave. Our house was two stories made of brick with a thorn tree in the front yard were Nancy was always getting bit by the tree. My older sister tell me of the time when she was playing in Billy Wassum's back yard with other neighbor kids her age. My sister Nancy and I followed her except we went in the back door and helped ourselves to the sugar and butter sitting on the Wassum's kitchen table.

The house was sold and we moved in 1942 to Farmer Street and rented a big white house at the end of a dead end street. In the old fenced hunting dog quarters we had chickens and a gardener named Gray Eyes who told us a lot of stores while taking care of the chickens.

We, Nancy and I, went to a little school up on the hill near by for the first grade. Whitethorn School on Maryland Ave was a two room school with first, second and third grades. There, I and other boys, chased the girls into the bathroom and got into trouble. Bad News! Big Time! This was 1943 and we three all came down with scarlet fever. Our house was quarantined and Daddy had to go to a hotel because the Doctor would not let him come home.

I had a special friend, David Platnik, who lived one street behind us. His mother and my mother were friends too as they had the common interest of twins, David had twin brothers. David had a train set which we played with except on the Jewish High Holy Days. (I found out why we did not play those days after I married Roz).

Daddy lost his job and big money and we moved to 1701 Bland St. across from St. Lukes Hospital and Goodkoontz Drug store. It too was a big white frame house with a front bay window. Today it is gone, replaced by a used car lot.

We, Nancy and I, went to grade school at Preston Street School. One day, in March 1948, it snowed so bad school was dismissed and we had to go home. Now Nancy and I did not go straight home as we had to stop to play in the snow with some kids. One of the boys let me use a broken sled. We had to sled down a big hill and of course I had to do one more ride before we went home, higher up the hill in the woods. On the way down at a good speed I hit a stump covered with snow and lost control. That's when I went under a parked truck and split my head open with blood ever where. Nancy was yelling, "Don't let him die." while I went up to a house and asked for help. Two things saved my life. A vet from the war came running, applied a pressure point and took me to the hospital. The second and of course the most important was my brand new War War II pilot's helmet, lined with thick sheep skin wool. I had bought it by saving money from selling "GRIT" newspapers. The helmet saved my life as the cut on my head was less than 1/8 inch from my brain. So much for a sled ride.

Then I went to Fairview Jr. High School (which has been torn down) and met my first puppy love, a girl named Arlean. She could not go to the big dance with me because she was a Jewish girl and her mother would not here of it. I also had the chore at home during the winter to keep the furnace hot. I was not so good at that as I spent a lot of time doing my school home work watching the fire. It keep going out. The only time the house was warm is when my grandfather came to town. My chore in the summer was to keep the small garden in the back yard growing. Weeds had a field day. Playing was what I wanted to do. On the way home from school for lunch one day I broke my arm going after an apple in a tree behind the hospital. DUMB. I could have broke my neck. I was lucky though, because while the doctor was setting the compound fracture, he discovered a small tumor which was benign.

We moved again. This time to Glenwood Park, about 8 miles east of Bluefield, and Nancy and I went to Princeton High School for four years finishing at 17 years of age. We lived in a big house set on fourteen areas of land with a barn and chicken coop. I got to take care of chickens and raise one and a half areas of food for the family. My skills as a farmer had improved. I also caddied at the local golf course and learned to play. (I am still not a good golfer.) I became a member of the Pocalier Club, a pin pal club for the Norfolk and Western Railway, and that is how I met my first true love (joke) Susanne Long. She lived in Roanoke, Va., just down the street from my cousin Bonnie Jo. She was Baptist and her father did not want

his little girl going with a Methodist. He caught us smooching in his living room and "Pop Went The Wesel". This love did not last long. She wrote me a "Dear John" letter my first year in the Air Force. ( By the way my father was raised Methodist and my mother Baptist. I guess that was a mixed marriage.)

When I graduated from high school I did not have the \$35.00 for tuition to go to the local collage or the bus fair to get there so I joined the Air Force at age 17. I had 50 cents in my pocket when I went, June 6, 1955, to Samson AFB , New York on the finger lakes near Geneva for basic training. It was cold but we cleaned the beach for the dependents to go swimming and I had a fight with another airman. Loss a tooth, got in trouble, and had to clean the stairs with a tooth brush to teach me a lesson in patience. From there I went to Shepard AFB, Wichita Falls, Texas were I learned to be an Aircraft Electrical Tech and to dodge dust storms. I learned another lesson because I got into fight with a big guy and loss another tooth. "Don't be so quick to hit someone when they call you a name." (The reason for first and second fight.)

My first real duty assignment was at Westover AFB, Springfield, Mass. about March 1956 and I worked on F-86 fighter planes. I was indirectly evolved in the accident of a plane blowing up. The crew chief ask me to turn on the power after he had changed a fuel pump. Boom. I was lucky again, no one was hurt. The commander had said the day before that one more accident and he would be replaced and sure enough he was replaced. I went TDY (temporary duty) to Yuma, AZ. and learned there was a place that was warm in the winter. We had flown there in a two engine cargo plane, and froze. I also saw the dirt streets and night life of a border town in Mexico.

Then Sept 1957 I was assigned Goose Bay AFB. in Newfoundland and worked on F-89 fighter planes. Now this is one cold place but not the coldest place I have been. We got a lot of snow. I also found out were my ex commander went. You got it, my new commander. (Note: My folks had moved to Tucson , Arizona in 1958.) My second true love was Dona Zigler in New London , Conn. I had meet her in Springfield just as I was leaving and we wrote while I was in Goose Bay. I spent two great weeks in New London when I returned from cold country. She wanted me to convert to be an Episcopalian, "When we get married", her words. We had different idea as to what that meant and I am not sure to this day as to what I would have been converting. She wanted me to go to work at the local ship yard . I re-enlisted at the beginning of my next duty station and she broke up with me .

My next duty was Lockborne AFB., Columbus ,Ohio, September 1958 to October 1963. I changed fields to be an In flight Aircraft Refueling Tech. While I was there I went to a lot of places TDY. We went to Lajes Field in the Azores twice. While there one night Airman Fish and I were working on a KC-97 Tanker and we turned the job over to another crew. Ten minutes after we left one of the crew members walked through the prop and was killed. The little village on the beach had great wine and cheese so we went there to relax. Speaking of relaxing. We Spent R and R (rest and recuperation) in England twice for 10 days each were I met Jennifer Crook in Queen Mary's Rose Garden at the tea house. She showed me London and the sites. Went once to Spain for 10 days and saw Seville with a beautiful escort . About the 21 day of December 1961 in Columbus I was a passenger in an auto wreck and was thrown about twenty feet into a field of snow. I had multiple injuries and spent 6 months in the hospital. Again I was lucky. The driver and the occupants of the other car died. After about four more months I was able to go back to work full time and the Cuba Crise happen. So off to Plattsburg AFB, N.Y., TDY were I found out how good a kitchen sink Pisa was. Great. Then to Goose Bay for a few days in the snow. Oh Brother.

I met Roz and fell in love for the first time really and even thought she was Jewish we were able to work that out. We have been married for 39 years at this writing. I married Roz June 21, 1963 and we moved to Pease AFB in New Hampshire across the bay from Maine. We were only there for three months when I was off to school to Shepard AFB, Texas (again) to be a Missile Faculty Tech for the Atlas program. Roz was pregnant with our first child, Davita Anne. Roz went home to Columbus to have the baby, and then joined me in Texas. So I went fishing with a friend and a very very large "White Tornado" (went across the river first) bounced out of the sky and made a mess of the base. Covered my car with two inches of mud. I did not catch any fish either.

We went to Lincon AFB at Lincon Neb. Sep 1964 and was there until the Air Force closed down the Atlas program. This was a very cold place to be in the winter when a snow storm buried the car in four feet of snow. I worked in a dangerous place called a missile silo and one night almost went kboom.

Off we went to Fairchild AFB, Spokane Wash. in 1966. I again changed fields to become an Aero Space Ground Equipment Repairman. ( Note: Roz's folks moved to Tucson, AZ. in 1968) Jefferson was born. I was there. He weighed eleven pounds, two and a quarter oz at birth and has not lost and oz since. But I was soon to go TDY to Okinawa for three months, back home for a while and then to Guam for six months. In route to those places I stopped in Alaska, still not the coldest place I have been. I also stopped in Japan. I was promoted to TSgt in Gaum. On the way back home a TSgt needed to leave early so I gave up my seat to him. The plane crashed on Wake Island and he was one of the few who was killed.

When I got back to Fairchild I had orders to go to Okinawa and report January 1969. Ros could not go with me at that time because she was pregnant and a lack of housing on Okinawa. She went to Tucson were she stayed with her parents. Jay was born in Aug 1969. Traveling alone with three children Roz joined me in Okinawa but was late because she missed the plane and had to catch the next one. Yep I had to go TDY to the Philippines for a week during a cyclone. Butch was borne at Camp Kue Hospital on Nov 13, 1970 and shortly there after Okinawa became once more part of Japan. Boy did all the rules change and when were not under the USA. I made MSgt in the 376 th Bomb Wing. Roz and I were able to go to Tapia City in Taiwan for some fun with the help of our Okinawa friends who looked after the kids. I also became a Freemason near

the end of my stay in Okinawa with the Grand Lodge of Japan and we stayed until 1973.

I ask to go to the southwest but the Air Force sent me to Patrick AFB., Fa. where I became a MFT on the Titan Launch Pad , 40 and 41. Wow ! We launched missiles to space and to Mars.

About May 1975 we went to Wichita Falls, Texas, Shepard AFB, what again, to write the Career Development Course and to teach MFTs for the Titan program. I joined the Scottish Rite and Shrine. I made SMSgt and this was our longest stateside assignment of 3 years, 3 mounts, and 10 days. We did the normal things that families do.

And then off we went to Grand Forks AFB, Grand Forks, ND in May of 78. The coldest place I have ever been . The telephone pole is the state tree and the mosquito is the state bird. Flat as a pancake with nothing in the way to the North Pole. I was the Branch Chief for the Minute Man Missile Facilities Repair with 143 men and women working for me. After 18 mounts of cold weather I retired from the Air Force 31 Jan , 1980 and moved to Tucson 1 Jan 1980 .

Then 15 Jan 1980 I went to work for Industrial Time Systems and bought it in May 1981. We bought a house and settled down to work and to raising a family. I also joined Adobe Lodge and demitted to the Grand lodge of AZ. I became a Past Master, then for 10 years the Treasurer and after a year and half I am The Treasurer again. Davita and I played in Rainbow and then she got married to a Captain in the Air Force. She and Kurt had three boys . Rox and I had to go off and visit them when we had time from the business. In 1989 I sold the Clock part of the business and only sold Fire Alarm systems to electric contractors. Jay married and has three girls . This is 2002. What did I do for 20 years. Work. I retired.
