To date we have not proven Mary's lineage. It's possible that she was born a WALCUTT and married a Thomas JACKSON in mid-1840's. There is a Sirilda Ann "Jackson-Levingston" who married a Lafayette WALCUTT. Whenever there are children being born to this couple, the birth records of the children bounce from 'mother-Sirilda Jackson to Sirilda Levingston'. It's possible that since a Thomas Jackson died circa 1849 and evidently Mary was having children by Andrew Levingston by 1851, that the family never knew for sure exactly who the father was. It's also possible that she was raised by Andrew Levingston even though she was fathered by Thomas Jackson. Just one more of the many mysteries in this family.
