John KLUMP Sr. and his wife, Anna Juliana (Bauer) took up acreage in Marion Township, Hocking County, Ohio. According to the 1880 Agriculture Census, there were 53 acres tilled, 60 acres in meadows, 25 in woodland and two acres of scrub/wetlands, valued at \$5,000. Three acres were in apple orchard with 60 trees producing approximately 15 bushels in 1879, valued at \$3. The principle livestock on the farm consisted of cattle and swine; four "milch" cows which produced milk for drinking and cooking and 400# of butter, 18 other cattle, one slaughtered for family use; and 19 swine. Besides these livestock, the family had three horses for transportation & to work the land. were 75 "barnyard" poultry (chickens) which produced 200 dozen eggs, and 10 "other" (geese? guinea hens? ducks?). Livestock valued at \$400. Crops on the farm in 1880 included six acres of barley, producing 100 bushels; 13 acres of "Indian" corn producing 600 bushels; 11 acres in wheat, with 150

bushels produced; one-eighth acre was planted in sorghum with 25 gallons of molasses harvested. One acre was planted in Irish potatoes with 40 bushels harvested and stored. From the woodlot there were eight cords of wood, valued at \$8. Farm products valued at \$400. Farm machinery and equipment were valued at \$100 in 1880; \$15 was paid in wages for hired help.

As the children in this family grew they probably had regular chores feeding calves, poultry, currying horses, collecting eggs, splitting firewood and perhaps helping their mother with the milking and churning.

Found in the Lancaster Daily Gazette, Thursday, December 16, 1920: "First Funeral Service In New Church will be conducted Friday afternoon for John KLUMP, well known farmer of near Sugar Grove - Rev. KAUMEYER, pastor of Emanuel Lutheran Church will officiate, assisted by Rev. SCHUTES of Logan. Funeral services for John KLUMP, well known retired farmer of Hocking county, will be held at Emanuel Lutheran Church this city, Friday afternoon, one thirty o'clock. Revs. G.A. KAUMEYER and Geroge SCHUTES of Logan will officiate at the servies and burial will be made in Forest Rose Cemetery under the direction of B.F. LINVILLE, funeral director of Bremen. Mr. KLUMP's death occurred Wednesday morning at 9:30 o'clock at his home five miles east of Sugar Grove, following a two months illness due to complications. The deceased who was 83 years of age was a prominent retired farmer of Hocking county. He is survived by three sons, Eugene of near Sugar Grove, John C. of Amanda, and Edward of Millersport; two daughters: Miss Christinia of the home and Mrs. Charles ELLINGER of near Lancaster. His wife preceded him in death four years ago. The funeral of Mr. KLUMP will be the first held in the new Emanuel Lutheran Church since its dedication several weeks ago."

"Mrs. Anna Juliana KLUMP, nee BAUER, a daughter of Jacob and Juliana BAUER, was born February 8, 1842, in Marion township, Hocking county, Ohio, and baptized on March 2nd of the same year by the Rev. LEHMANN. Her parents were members of St. James' Lutheran Church, Marion township, and after due instruction in the doctrines and tenets of the Lutheran church she was confirmed there on April 8, 1855, by the Rev. RICHMANN. She was united in marriage with Mr. John KLUMP on November 28, 1861, the Rev. DALB performing the ceremony. To this union were born seven children, two of whom have preceded her in death. For almost 55 years she led a happy wedded life with Mr. KLUMP, bearing life's burdens and sharing its joys and sorrows with him. Besides her aged and stricken husband she leaves to mourn her departure three sons, two daughters, four daughters-in-law, one son in-law, nineteen grandchildren, four brothers and a large number of other relatives.

Mrs. KLUMP was born and reared and was a lifelong resident of the same community in which she will be missed by her friends and neighbors. She was also a lifelong and faithful member of St. James Lutheran Church, having remained true to the end by the covenant made with her God in baptism and renewed in confirmation. For the past few years Mrs. KLUMP had been ailing with the infirmities attending upon old age. She passed away on Friday night, July 21, rather suddenly, shortly before midnight at an age of 74 years, 5 months and 13 days, as we hope, in the faith in which she had lived and followed her Good Shepherd to the heavenly pastures. May the Lord comfort the bereaved, and also be and remain their Good Shepherd.

Funeral services were held on Monday afternoon, July 24, at the family home in Marion township where many of her old friends and neighbors had assembled to pay their last respects to her. After this service the funeral procession

proceeded by auto to the Imanuel Lutheran Church in Lancaster where services were conducted by her pastor, assisted by the Rev. KAUMEYER who preached the German sermon. She was laid to rest by the side of her kindred dead in Forest Rose cemetery.

John Philip ELLINGER and his wife, Sarah Elizabeth (Daubenmire) took up residence in Walnut township, Fairfield County, Ohio following their marriage. The 1880 Agriculture Census shows John ELLINGER, owner of 52 acres, valued at \$1,800; farm implements and machinery at \$90 and livestock valued at \$340; farm products at \$337. There were two horses for transportation and to till the soil. Two "milch" cows to produce the milk for the family to drink and to cook with, producing 206# of butter. There were four other cattle on the farm, with three calves dropped. 34 swine finished out the livestock. The crops consisted of 11 acres in corn, producing 350 bushels; three acres in oats, 80 bushels; 13 acres in wheat with 180 bushels produced. Three fourths of an acre was set aside for Irish potatoes producing 40 bushel. Of the grasslands, 11 1/2 acres were mowed, 12 not with 12 acres of hay."

From the Lancaster Eagle-Gazette - SUDDEN DEATH Comes to John P. ELLINGER of Near Pleasantville, Last Night. Funeral Services Wednesday A.M. at Zeigler Church - Burial at Forest Rose Cemetery.

John P. ELLINGER of near Pleasantville died very suddenly Sunday evening at 10:30 o'clock at his home following a stroke of apoplexy. He was 70 years of age, but had been in good health, attending church in the morning and spending the day with his daughter, Mrs. Daniel BAUER of the Infirmary Road. He did his work as usual in the evening, but death came very suddenly.

He is survived by his wife and eight children, Mrs. Sarah KLUMP, Mrs. Daniel BAUER, Mrs. Joseph WOLF, Mrs. Wm. DEETER and Mrs. Edward KLUMP, also Charles, John and Elmer ELLINGER. Two sons preceded the father to the grave. They were Daniel and Andrew ELLINGER.

The funeral service will be held - - - - -

John Philip, son of Jacob and Helen ELLINGER, was born in Hocking county, Ohio, February 24th, 1849 and was baptized into church in infancy, by Rev. J. DEIB, and after thorough instruction in the faith and practice, he was confirmed in the Evangelical Lutheran church in 1863. to this faith he kept all the days of his life.

He united in Holy matrimony with Sarah DAUBENMEIR, February 9th, 1871. This proved to be a most happy union, he proving himself an exemplary husband and she a devoted helpmate.

God blessed them with eleven children, Sarah, Charles, Clara, Emma, John, Bertha, Christina and Elnor. Three of their children, Catherine, Daniel and Andrew preceded their father to eternity.

Two years after his marriage he purchased the homestead, where all his children were brought up, of the Harter estate, in 1873.

The buildings were poor and the land was in bad condition, but he was God fearing, honest and industrious, and God blessed his work, so that the homestead became one of the best and most desirable farms in the neighborhood.

Here has identified himself with Emmanuel Lutheran church, of which he was an exemplary member to the close of his life. He was never absent from the communion and seldom failed to be present at public worship. He was a member of the building committee in constructing this church edifice, always contributing his part towards its success.

During the last 40 years of his life he was usually an efficient member of the church council in which capacity he was faithfully serving God at the close of his life.

His last journey Sunday April 13th, was to his church, where he devotedly participated in a Lenten service. The last message which he heard from the Lord, which he also carried home with him, was "It is finished; Father into thy hands I commit my Spirit."

On the way home he visited his daughter, Mrs. Clara Bowers. On his return, he retired early, and at 10 o'clock the same night his wife was awakened by unusual sounds proceeding from him, and discovered that he was in a dying condition from a stroke of apoplexy. Help was at once summoned but the end came very soon, at 10:30 p.m. April

13th, 1919, aged 70 years, one month and 20 days, he peacefully fell asleep.

He leaves his faithful wife and 8 children, three sons and five daughters, Sarah KLUMP, Charles G. ELLINGER, Clara BAUER, Emma WOLFE, John ELLINGER, Christina DEETER, Bertha KLUMP and Elmer ELLINGER; 26 grandchildren, two brothers and four sisters.

Jacob F. BAUER/BOWERS owned land in Marion Township, Hocking County, Ohio. In 1850 he owned 50 acres improved, 30 acres unimproved, valued at \$600. Farm implements and machinery were worth \$90. There were three horses for transportation and to till the land. Four "milch" cows, two other cattle, 15 swine and 14 sheep were the sum total of livestock, valued at \$115. The wheat crop was 72 bushels, 200 bushels of "Indian" corn, 50 bushel oats. 40# of wool, 45 bushels of Irish potatoes, 50# of butter and four tons of hay. By 1860 Jacob had increased his acreage to 80 acres tillable and 40 acres unimproved, valued at \$3,000. Farm implements at \$150. He now had four horses, eight cows, three other cattle, 26 sheep and 21 swine, total value of \$500. 125 bushels wheat, two rye, 400 bushels corn, 175 bushels of oats. The sheep produced 60# of wool. There was 15 bushels potatoes, 13 barley, and 22 bushel of buckwheat. Four tons of hay was harvested to feed the cows that produced the milk for 400# of butter.

By 1870 the land went to 170 acres; 100 tillable and 70 not, valued at \$5,000; farm equipment at \$150. There were now six horses, seven "milch" cows, 12 other cattle, 21 sheep and 11 swine, valued at \$500. The crops harvested included 200 bushel wheat, 600 corn, 400 oats, 20 bushels potatoes, ten ton of hay. 200# of butter was produced and 60# of molasses. The home produce was valued at \$50, while the farm products were valued at \$405, with \$10 given as the value of a slaughtered animal.

In 1880 he is shown as the owner of 160 acres valued at \$3,000; implements valued at \$100, livestock at \$250. Farm labor of \$23 was spent. All farm products were estimated to be valued at \$230. Twelve acres were mown, 68 not, ten ton of hay produced. There were two mules/asses on the farm by 1879. Only five milch cows, 10 other cattle, fives calves dropped; four were sold, one was sold and one died, 300# of butter produced. There were nine swine, 50 barnyard poultry with 150 dozen eggs gathered. Seven acres in "Indian corn" produced 200 bushels; three acres in oats, 70 bushels; 12 acres in wheat with 100 bushel harvested. Six acres were planted in sorghum in 1879 producing 20 gallons of molasses. One fourth acre was planted in Irish potatoes, producing 30 bushels; three acres in apple orchard with 80 bearing trees with 40 bushels harvested; total value of orchard products sold or consumed was \$11. There was 12 cords of wood cut, valued at \$12 in 1879.

There was the usual assortment of livestock on the farm; three horses, probably used for transportation and to work the land; four "milch" cows, which produced milk for drinking and cooking; four other cattle, 18 sheep and six swine in 1850. In 1860 there were still three horses, three milch cows, which also produced 100# of butter; three other cattle, only one sheep with 26# of wool produced for the year; and five swine. The livestock was valued at \$150 in 1850; \$175 by 1860.

Crops on the farm in 1850 included 70 bushel "Indian" corn; 100 bushel wheat; 40 bushel rye and 80 bushel oats, produce valued at \$1300. In 1860 these crops included 80 bushel wheat; one bushel rye, 60 bushel "Indian" corn, and 40 bushel oats; along with five tons hay harvested.

Farm machinery and equipment was valued at \$62 in 1850; \$75 by 1860 and \$100 by 1870. 1870 showed 20 acres in apple orchard.

He was 82y10m18days at time of death; having raised 14 children, three sons and 11 daughters; 12 lived to adult.
