

# *A History of the Emo's from the Early Venetian Republic*

## *Generation No. 1*

1. PANTALEO<sup>2</sup> AIMO (*PATRIUS*<sup>1</sup> *AIMUS*) was born Bef. 1297. He married UNKNOWN WIFE Aft. 1300.

Notes for PANTALEO AIMO:

Aka:- Pantaleone Aimo; his family was registered into the Venetian Nobility in 1297.

As the Guardian of the Great Council, his descendants were numbered amongst the 'Patrizi' from then onwards.

His ancestors included many men of learning, including public and military figures.

Amongst those on record were :

### GIOVANNI & RIGO AIMO

In the year 1122 they appear to have underwritten a 'privilege of exemption' granted to the nobles of council from the Doge Domenico Miciel for the city and district of Bari.

### GIORGIO AIMO

A Captain in the army against the Infidels in 1180 on the record of the third crusade.

He, it is said in the true testimony of the third crusade, would be the first to have raised the coat-of-arms of the Emo.

### ALVISE AIMO

In 1193 he was a galley captain, under the command of Tomaso Morosini, against the Genovese.

### NICOLO AIMO

In 1268 he is found amongst the electors of the Doge Lorenzo Tiepolo.

He was awarded two bands to his coat-of-arms to distinguish his own line from the others.

### GIORGIO AIMO

In 1280 the green lion was superimposed on the red bands of his coat-of-arms.

He was a galley or prison commander.

In 1379 he contributed 12,000 lira as a loan for the war of Chioggia which brought great glory to Venice with the sensational defeat of the Genovese.

Gabriele Emo di-Benedetto was an accomplished orator and a courageous soldier.

In 1389 he suppressed a rebellion in the Udine and in 1394 he mediated a dispute between the Friulani and the Patriarch of Aquileja.

As Ambassador to the Marquess of Mantova in 1404 he became Provider of the army in the war against the Carraresi (Signori di Padova)

With Jacopo Dal Verme he occupied Verona, the city of the famous 14th century Cangrande della Scalla, handing the keys of that city to the Venetian Nobles in 1405.

In 1406 he became Captain of Vicenza and in 1409 Mayor of Verona where he still maintained a regiment in 1412.

Leaving a widow without sons, his fortune was willed by her to her nephew Angelo Venier.

On the 16th day of the war he prevailed, with some help from Venetian ships, in effecting the surrender of the city and capturing a Hungarian nobleman whom he ransomed to recover the cost of the war.

As Councillor to Doge Andrea Contarini, he accepted the terms of surrender from the Genovese in 1380.

Later he was to become Master and General Provider of the army, Ambassador to Milan and Genoa and a Knight of the Golden Stole.

He was elected the first Mayor of Verona in 1404.

Giovanni Emo di-Giorgio, reported as second born to Giorgio and Maria in 1425.  
He was a great-grandson of the most just and austere of the Ducal Princes, Doge Antonio Venier.  
He aspired to the highest offices; Senator, Ambassador, Knight of the Golden Stole, Head of the Council of Ten and General Provider in the field at the conquest of the Polesine, culminating with the assault on Stellata in 1483. Savior of the 'Terra Ferma' and one of the electors of Doge Nicolo Tron in 1471.  
Renowned for his military and political genius, he was considered amongst the grandest of the Emos. He was also a political man of letters, a great mind, complex, multifaceted and a true 'Prince of the Renaissance'.  
In the capture of Stellata, while crossing the Po, his horse fell and dragged him, resulting in death a few days later on 15th Sept. 1483.

Having engaged the young Andrea Palladio in designing the layout of the Villa Emo, he died before the building was commenced. The estate was willed jointly to one son, Zuanne, and a grandson Leonardo.

While defending a Martinengo Bastion he was struck by a rock from a cannon ricochet and died, in Oct 1648, at just 40 years of age.

The capital, Iraklion, was besieged by the Turks for 22 years before it surrendered in Sept. 1669. The Venetians were given 12 days to leave after ruling Crete for 459 years.

Gabriele Emo di Pietro was elected Senator in 1702 and later in 1712, 1713, 1714 and in 1716. He was Mayor of Brescia in 1707 and in later years in 1713, 1714 and in 1716. His other noble assignments included, member of the Council of Ten, Deputy to the Circuit Bank, Superintendent to Beccarie, Savio to the Markets, Superintendent to the Military and Senator of the Council.

Notes for ANGELO EMO:

Angelo Emo served, as a volunteer, in the army against the Turks for 18 years, then became the 'Provveditore Ordinario' in Zara di Morea. In 1686 he was at the capture of Navarino and Modone under Napoli of Romania, and in 1687 at the purchase of Athens.

Later he became Deputy Assistant of the army of Francesco Morosini in 1693, Commissioner of wages in 1697, Superintendent of Corfu in 1702, Pregadi and General in Morea in 1704, Councillor of Canareggio in 1707 and in 1711, Superintendent extraordinary in the Terraferma in 1710 and General Superintendent in Dalmatia in 1713. At the siege of Sign, seven leagues north of Spalatro, he fought the Turks victoriously in open field, raising the siege in Aug 1715. His portrait, with full regalia, was hung in the Albrizzi Palace,

Venezia.

After the peace in 1716, Angelo Emo became Mayor and Captain of Padova. He was appointed Envoy to Constantinople, making a solemn entry in Dec. 1730. His relationship to the Serenissimo is recorded in the Library of the Civic Museum of Padova, dated Sept. 1740.

Notes for PROSPERO EMO:

Aka : Gian-Alvise Luigi Emo. He became an influential Senator and in 1775 and one of the five Correctors of the Law. He always worked for the public good and an independent judiciary, so that he alienated both the nobles and the poor. The author Romanin alludes to the use of caricatures, published in those days, to achieve the goals of those in opposition to attempts at reform to the established system.

This resulted in the triumphal election of Giorgio Pisani as the Procurator of San Marco, so that Alvise withdrew in disgust to private life.

Notes for GIOVANNI EMO:

Giovanni Emo di Pietro became one of the most influential men of his time, holding high offices in his service to the Republic.

Being honoured beyond his contemporaries, in 1707 he was elected Senator of the Committee, Saviour of the Terraferma, Cashier for the Contract Assignments until 1711, Superintendent of the Artillery, Savio del

Consiglio, Inquirer over the 'Olj' and Superintendent of Arms.

In July 1711 he was sent to France, on a delicate mission, to treat on some seized ships and to mediate on the choice of Cardinal Ottoboni of Verona as the Patron of France to Rome. In 1715 he was commissioned as Ambassador to England and some years later as Ambassador to Constantinople. Upon his return in Nov. 1723 he was created Procurator of San Marco, Venice. His purple robes of office marked him as the most distinguished servant of the Serenissimo, next to the Doge.

Notes for ANGELO EMO (KNT.):

Angelo Emo di Giovanni studied in the Jesuit College in Brescia, then in Padova where his father was 'Riformatore dello Studio'.

Following family tradition, in 1752, he dedicated himself to the naval service of his homeland and advanced his merits through the ranks, until he achieved the supreme rank of Admiral of the fleet. He was active in the political arena, and travelled also for pleasure in Europe.

His encounter with the King of Prussia, Federico II, in Berlin, records a curious dispute between them, regarding the relative merits of fortifications and naval artillery. The sharp wit of the Emo resolved the impasse, resulting in a cordial detente.

In 1769, in action against the Pirates of Algeria and the Bey of Tunis, he proved the value of his artillery in bombarding Tunis, Susa, Sfax and Biserta, forcing the 'Barbarians' to make peace and resolving the pirate issue for a long time. On his flagship, 'La Fama', he was accompanied by an 'embedded reporter/writer' of the time, Luigi Vittorio Valle of Vicenza.

Already a Knight of the Golden Stole, Angelo Emo was elected Procurator of San Marco for life after the Tunisian war. He was likened to the greatest Admirals of history, such as Caracciolo or Nelson, and turned down many offers of high office in order to continue to serve at sea.

While embarking on a new venture in Africa, he died at Malta in 1792 at the age of 61 years; great was the loss to the Republic of Venice.

He was probably the only leader who could have saved the Serenissimo from the results of Napoleon's invasion in 1797.

His remains were buried in the Chiesa dei Servi, Venezia; since removed to San Biagio in Venice with a marble catafalque inscribed :-

Notes for LEONARDO EMO-CAPODILISTA (CONTE):

Leonardo Emo di Giorgio studied mathematics and philosophy on the intellectual side, but he was most fervent and lively in artistic studies.

In 1858 duty compelled him to serve in Piemonte, for the furtherance of his Homeland, in its struggle to forge the destiny of a new Italy.

Strong in spirit but vulnerable physically, he contracted a fatal illness returning him to his paternal home, where he died in March 1864.

He willed his copious picture gallery and his estate to the city of Padova, showing his final dedication to his homeland.
