Mary had at least one child out of wedlock. Father may have been Isacc Suggard. Child Jonathan Whitted.

Thomas and Mary moved to Lawrence Co. IND in the early 1800's. They may have moved around 1816 with her brother, John Whitted Sr., when he came. Jonathan did not come with them.

Notes for Thomas Whitted, Jr.:

Donald P. Whitted notes that Hugh Whitted, another researcher, says that there were 15 children in this family, 10 male, and 5 female. Sidney is Hugh's ancestor. The Evancos list 9 children in this family, naming only Sidney, as the 9th child. They also have a note about Sidney:

"A mystery remains as to the parentage of Sidney Whitted. One family genealogist suggests that his father was 'James Whitted' (born ca. 1783). Another source suggests that Sidney Whitted was a son of Thomas Whitted Jr. (born 1780 - 1784). The authors leave this complex problem to be resolved by the reader."

Isaac Fadis<sup>4</sup> Whitted** (Jonathan<sup>3</sup>, Mary<sup>2</sup>, Thomas<sup>1</sup>) was born August 24, 1822 in Chatham County, North Carolina, and died October 30, 1909 in Buckley, Iroquois County, Indiana<sup>63</sup>. He married **(1) Emily Stafford<sup>63</sup>**. She died Unknown. He married **(2) Mary Pearson** January 16, 1845 in Rockville, Park County, Indiana<sup>64</sup>, daughter of William Pearson and Mary Anderson. She was born November 17, 1824 in Ohio<sup>65</sup>, and died May 23, 1862 in Annapolis, Parke County, Indiana<sup>66</sup>.

Notes for Isaac Fadis Whitted:

"Isaac lived in Liberty Township, Parke County, Indiana, until his first wife, Mary Pearson, died. He, then, moved to Iroquois Co., Illinois. He lived near Cissna Park." *The Whitted Family, Book 3*, by Michael and Anita Evanco. Iroquois County is northwest of Parke County, Indiana, just over the border in Illinois.

A family researcher told the Evancos in 1976 that:

"I have receipts for tombstones for Mary Pearson, Lydia Ellen, Charles Sumner, and William Allen to be delivered to Isaac Whitted's residence one mile east of Russel's Mills. A small town, Russelville, is now in that area and I presume that is their resting place. Andrew J.'s stone was delivered to Buckley, Illinois and I presume he is resting with the group of Whitteds in the Quaker cemetery (also known as Pigeon Grove) between Buckley and Cissna Park, Illinois. Great grandfather Jonathan lived in Annapolis, (Parke Co., Ind.) and that is the home of Grandfather Whitted as a young man. At present, I am not sure where the others are buried, but either in the Quaker cemetery with Isaac or in the Buckley cemetery. I have many letters from Mary Pearson's brothers (Bloomfield, Indiana) to Isaac and they show great affection for their brother-in-law.

"Byrd L. (or Bird L.), seventh child of Isaac and Emily Whitted, b. 20 April 1875, d. 4 August 1895 at Escondido, California. This child had Consumption, as T. B. was called then. My grandfather was sure he would be cured if he could be in California. So Isaac bought a 40-acre ranch at Escondido and sent my father and mother (newlyweds) with Byrd (or Bird) to live there. All went well for a few years until the boy caught a bad cold and died. My parents accompanied the body back to Illinois. Isaac was so saddened and disillusioned with California that he refused to pay the taxes on the ranch, and it lay

idle from then until about 1910. Back taxes left almost nothing for grandfather's estate. The land turned out to be what is now the center of Escondido, which is the closest I will ever come to owning a piece of California."

Michael and Anita Evanco think Mary Pearson Whitted's place of burial may be the Friend's Cemetery at Bloomington, Indiana. Bloomington is close to Annapolis in Parke County, west of Indianapolis and not far from the border with Illinois.

Elbridge Mabrin<sup>4</sup> Whitted** (Jonathan<sup>3</sup>, Mary<sup>2</sup>, Thomas<sup>1</sup>) was born February 28, 1824 in Chatham County, North Carolina, and died January 6, 1899 in Oneco, Manatee County, Florida. He married **Caroline E. Aldridge** May 9, 1846 in Rockville, Parke County, Indiana<sup>67</sup>, daughter of Elijah\* Aldridge and Jane\* White. She was born April 20, 1822 in Montgomery County, Kentucky<sup>68</sup>, and died August 29, 1900 in Oneco, Manatee County, Florida<sup>69</sup>.

Notes for Elbridge Mabrin Whitted:

New Cemetery is now called Major Adams Cemetery.

"Elbridge departed Boone Co., IA on his trek to Florida, with his sons, ending in Manatee Co., FL. Subsequently, he had his family come by train--although he came by horseback. He stopped in Tuscaloosa Co., Alabama to visit with his sister, Nancy Caroline Kelly. He, also, was instrumental in taking care of his brother's, Isaac, child, Charley, who died while Elbridge was visiting with his sister. Elbridge arrived in Manatee County, FL and settled on land in Oneco. The Manasota Cemetery is now located on what was once Elbridge's land. Elbridge was a successful orange grower and he lived the rest of his life in Manatee County. He died at Oneco. The authors have a newspaper clipping commemorating his death. He was buried in New Cemetery (now called Major Adams Cemetery), Bradenton, Manatee Co., FL. The gravesite was unmarked when the authors found it. The authors were instrumental in having a plaque erected on the mastabas. Caroline, his wife, is lying beside Elbridge. Allen Whitted, son of Elbridge, purchased the gravesite, prepared the gravesite and personally buried Elbridge Whitted. Allen performed the same actions for his mother.

"Elbridge and Caroline (Aldridge) Whitted are located in northwest corner of the lot in New Cemetery. Allen's first wife, Allie Mae Graham, is buried in the southwest corner of the same lot. Allen performed the same service for his wife.

"The newspaper article reads, 'An Aged Citizen Dead. Mr. E. Whitted, an aged and honored citizen of Manatee County passed away suddenly from cerebral hemorrhage on Thursday night at the advanced age of 76 years. Mr. Whitted was a native of North Carolina, but lived several years in the West before coming to Florida about 20 years ago. Since coming to Manatee county, he had resided on Orange Ridge, about three miles south of town, surrounded by sons and daughters and their families, all of whom have nice orange groves and are prosperous. Funeral services were conducted by Rev. W. B. Tresca on Friday afternoon, and the body laid to rest in the Manatee Cemetery.' "
