He married MARGARET MCALPINE February 17, 1799 in Glassary district, Argyllshire, Scotland (Source: Scots Origins search has date and location as Glassary district. Basswood book has location as Oban, Argyllshire. GROS: 511/2, FR374.), daughter of DUNCAN MACALPINE and EUPHEMIA FERGUSON. She was born 1778 in of North Knapdale, Argyllshire, Scotland (Source: Marg Thompson. Location from marriage record.), and died Unknown in Scotland.

Notes for DONALD MACTAVISH:

11/24/01. Have discovered the entire family in Scots Origins. The home is in the Glassary district.

Possible parentage for Donald MacTavish:

1) A Donald MacTavish was born at Kilmartin to Donald MacTavish and Flory Lick on 1 Jan 1774. Note: there are no GROS references to anyone named Lick, male or female, being born or married in Scotland from 1700 to 1850.

2) A Donald MacTavish was christened at Kilmartin, Argyll, 1 Nov 1775. The parents of this child were Duncan MacTavish and Janet MacLauchlan. SP (GROS) FR136, 521/00-0001. This may or may not be the same child as the husband of Margaret MacAlpine. Duncan MacTavish and Janet McLellan married in Glasgow in 1774. SP (GROS) FR2757, 644/01-0026.

3) In 1777, a Donald MacTavish was born to Roderick MacTavish and Eupham (Effy) MacIntaylor in the Glassary parish. SP (GROS) FR44, 511/00-0001. Parents marriage: Roderick MacTavish m. Euphemea Taylor in Glassary parish 7 Mar 1772. FR346, 511/00-0002.

Mother's birth: Euphy Taylor, dau. of Donald Taylor and Mary Carswill, b. 30 May 1752 in Kilmartin parish. No frame no., 521/00-0001.

John MacTavish, 10 Mar 1775, Glassary, to Roderick MacTavish and Eupham Taylor FR33, 511/00-0001.

4) In 1781, another Donald MacTavish was born at Kilmartin to Dougall MacTavish. The mother's name is not given. SP (GROS) FRnot given, 521/00-0001.

Note 1: Contrary to prior citations in family histories, there is no evidence that this Donald MacTavish ever used the name Thompson or Thomson. The first known use of Thomson/Thompson was with sons Donald and Malcolm when they were in Ontario.

Note 2: Donald and Margaret are known to have 11 children, not including Archibald and Ebenezer. These two are listed here just to keep track of the information. These men, nearly the same age as sons Donald and Malcolm, also were found in the Bosanquet Twp. area in Ontario during the 1860s-1870s. Their line of descent is not known.

There is no GROS birth record for Margaret McAlpine anywhere from Knapdale to Oban. There are two born in the Rothesay parish in 1773 - either of which might be this Margaret.

Some possibility that she is the daughter of Dugald MacAlpine and Isobell Smith of North Knapdale. They had a son, Malcolm, born in 1783 in North Knapdale - Scotland's People (GROS), FR18, 530/00-0001.

Margaret MacAlpine born 17 Nov 1786 to Duncan MacAlpine and Jean MacFarlane in Glassary parish. 511/1, FR76. She says that both Donald and Mary died in the house where she now lives, the house which Malcolm built in 1854.). He married MARY MCINTYRE (Source: Ontario census 1871. Maiden name from Marg Thompson.). She was born April 20, 1825 in Kilmichael, Argyllshire, Scotland (Source: Ontario census 1871. Date and location from Marg Thompson.), and died June 24, 1904 in Bosanquet Twp., Lambton, Ontario, Canada (Source: Marg Thompson.).

location is Glassary parish. Tombstone has 31 Jul 1821. Basswood 1878-1978 A Century of Living, 268, has 31 Jul 1823. Ontario 1871 census gives age as 52, implying birth in 1819. Ontario 1861 census has age 38. 511/3, FR454.), and died August 18, 1897 in Cadurcis, Manitoba (Source: Basswood 1878-1978 A Century of Living.). He married NANCY ANN MCLARTY (Source: Basswood book. Most sources use only Ann McLarty.) March 10, 1856 in Sarnia, Lambton, Ontario (Source: Basswood 1878-1978 A Century of Living.), daughter of JOHN MACLARTY and CHRISTIAN MACNICOL. She was born July 18, 1830 in Taynamullan, Argyleshire, Scotland (Source: Scotland's People website (GROS), FR 472, 511/00-0003. Basswood 1878-1978 A Century of Living cites Ontario census of 1871 giving age as 38, yielding July 1832 as birth month.), and died February 14, 1908 in Cadurcis, Manitoba (Source: Manitoba death record 1908-002378 at age 76. Basswood 1878-1978 A Century of Living has simply 1907 (from tombstone).).

Have a hard-paper copy of the birth record from GROS. Confirms birth at Dunadd.

Emigrated to Canada from Scotland in 1846 to a farm near Forest, Ontario, at a place called Thedford. Malcolm farmed in Ontario for many years. Then, at age of 55 in 1878, accompanied by his wife and family of 8, came to Manitoba to homestead. Arrived at Hare's Crossing on the Little Saskatchewan River on 5/24/1878. Family came to homestead on the NE quarter of 4-15-19W1 in what was to be known as the Cadurcis district. The farm is now (1978) owned by Robert Greig. Later on the family lived on N 1/2 of 6-15-19 and finally moved to 5-14-20 in the Moline district where Ken Bridgeman now farms. Christina and Alexander continued to farm at Moline until he sold to Dr. Young, DVM, and then Alexander purchased 28-14-19 where Rixon McKinnon now farms (1978). In March 1909 Alexander and his sister Christina moved to Warren, Manitoba to farm there. At retirement they sold the farm and moved to Stonewall, Manitoba. Neither was ever married. They are buried at Stonewall. - Basswood 1878-1978, p. 268.

Speculation is that Alexander and Ebenezer were brothers of Donald and Malcolm who also emigrated to Ontario. This relationship is not based on any evidence other than age and proximity. They may or may not have been brothers. There were no twins, unless the Scots Origins date for Malcolm is wrong. Scots Origins does not support the idea of twins.

Notes for NANCY ANN MCLARTY:

Family stories report someone being a "mail-order" bride. Ann McLarty may have been this woman.

There are few direct old references to draw upon, but she was generally called Ann until the 1871 Ontario census, which is the earliest known reference to the name Nancy.

Scots birth records and family records have numerous items of confusion.

Birth from family records is Jul 1832, parents John McLarty and Christina McNaughton. One Scots record has birth 18 Jul 1830, parents John McLarty and Christian McNicol. This is the birth record reflected in these files. The parents were married in 1812 in Glassary parish, and the other children are listed here. There is also a Glassary marriage for a John McLarty and Catherine McNaught[on] in 1810, with no records of children born to that marriage. Another Scots record has birth 20 Jul 1832 in Glassary parish, parents Angus McLarty and Janet McTavish [sic], residing at Silvercraigs. Siblings are Isobel, b. 4 Dec 1830, John, b. 22 May 1834, and Duncan, b. 27 Feb 1837. The parents married at Glassary 16 Jan 1830. Apparently, Angus the father was born in Glassary to Archibald McLarty and Janet Balfour on 25 Dec 1802 - no other siblings listed. It is logical to assume that these possible fathers were probably related somehow.

Donald and Margaret began farming on pre-emption quarter the SW of 4-15-19. They had a frame house built in 1888 to replace his log shack that had been located on his homestead quarter NW 4-15-19. This two-story frame house 22x16 was built by Shannon, Madden, & Martin, contractors from Rapid City. Total cost: \$500. That same house, with an addition and renovations, Earl Thompson still occupies (1978). Dan Thompson had a second homestead on SW quarter 5-16-19, NW of Basswood, which he worked for a few years. They had 10 children, 3g/7b. The older children attended McBride School, SW 1/2 28-14-29, where they were taught up to grade VIII. They walked about 2 miles, or took a horse-and-cart or cutter, according to the weather. The boys didn't get much schooling, due to farm work, going to school only in the winter months. Some of the family attended Winterton School, at that time on SE 7-15-19, and those that wanted more, stayed in Minnedosa and went to high school there. The family owned a small house in Minnedosa, up near the fairgrounds. Then, when Consolidation came to the area, they were able to receive HS education at Basswood. Religious instruction came from Cadurcis Church, a short distance from where they lived. Dan Thompson had to clear his own farm land. Sometime just before 1900, he built a stable referred to as the Old Stone Stable, in the side of a hill with a high stone foundation and a frame loft above ground level used as a granary. The top was torn down in 1975, and Earl has a fragment of the wood construction showing no use of nails,

done by Duncan Buchanan of Basswood. The Thompson house became a resting place for the many workers and teams from Rapid City and beyond who passed on the trail. During the early years when the children were small, Dan had to have hired help: Thomas McAdam worked for him for 14 consecutive years, and then bought a farm a mile down the road on 5-15-19 for \$6 per acre. My grandparents farmed the homestead until 1912, when they moved to the John Nicholl farm, a half-mile away on 33-14-19, where they had a larger house for their family. Dan died there, and was buried in Cadurcis Cemetery. His wife and family carried on the farming, and she lived to the grand old age of 94 years.

Thompson-McLean reunion book (2003). Homestead entry was dated 12-12-1879, and he received patents on 12-20-1886. This was all in the Cadurcis district, four miles south of the present-day village of Basswood. For the the first few years, he lived with his parents until August, 1883. Then, he built a log cabin on his homestead, recorded value \$75. Recent information indicates that he was, for his early years in Manitoba, either unlucky or prone to misfortune of one kind or another. Having arrived in Manitoba in 1878, he then applied for a homestead and preemption. By 1883, he had built a log house along with some other buildings, and by 1886 he was cropping 45 acres. Further information suggests that in the spring of 1882, he had the misfortune to receive an injury to his arm when he got caught in the gears of a grain crusher. Also, in 1882 he lost a team of horses. In the spring of 1883 he had an attack of some form of paralysis which kept him under the doctor's care for three years. In addition to his health problems, a prairie fire in 1886 destroyed 45 acres of crop which he had stacked, as well as burning his stable. All this is explained in a letter he wrote dated 14 Oct 1886 to the Honorable Thomas White, Minister of the Interior in Ottawa, in which he asked for a reduction in his preemption fees from \$250 to \$1 per acre because of the problems he had encountered. The results of the request are not known, but he received his homestead patents 20 Dec 1886, but without information about his preemption. There is no further information on his days farming on the NE of 6-15-19.

In 1890 he was in the implement business with a fellow named Armstrong, presumably a relative of his wife. In 1892 he was in the insurance business in Rapid City, MB.

Back a few years, in September of 1889, he had a business transaction with a Mr. James Jermyn of Minnedosa to purchase from Jermyn timber rights to 15 square miles of timber located in what is now known as the Lake Audy district. Also included was the purchase of a sawmill in Rapid City, MB - total purchase price, \$4000, with interest at 8%, secured by a mortgage on 1/2 section of land near Rapid City and 1/4 section of land near Cardale, MB. However, things did not go as well as planned, and on 15 Aug 1890, all of the logs and sawmill were put up for public auction at the Queen's Hotel in Rapid City, subject to a mortgage of \$3000 plus interest. Some years later the family moved to Warren, MB, or maybe Winnipeg, where from 1910-1912, Emily owned land in the Warren, MB, area.
