George out and married; Daniel and Joseph are 15-20, Jacob 5-10, is the 10-15 son John Jr. or maybe I have wrong birth date for Jackson. What about youngest son? What is the girl's name?

Dearborn Co. records show 9/20.). She was born in Pennsylvania (Source: Melba Biddle Kolbe. Death certificate for Joseph.), and died Unknown.

Notes for GEORGE BIDDLE:

1830: Manchester Twp., Dearborn Co., IN, in 20's, with wife in 20's, son under 5, daughter under 5, and daughter under 10. Son Joseph is not born yet, Maria may be one of the daughters.

6. MARIA³ BIDDLE (*GEORGE², JOHN HENRY¹*) (Source: Melba Biddle Kolbe. Citing Joseph Biddle's Bible.) was born in Indiana (Source: *1850 census.*), and died Aft. 1870 (Source: *1870 census.*). She married JACOB FOSTER (Source: Melba Biddle Kolbe. Citing Joseph Biddle's Bible.). He was born in Pennsylvania (Source: *1850 census.*), and died Aft. 1870 (Source: *1870 census.*).

Notes for MARIA BIDDLE:

Melba: Lists several Foster children, Thomas, Louise or Eliza, as given here, and also Lillie May Foster (b. 11/5/1882, d. 3/28/1935), John William Foster (b. 5/14/1884), Mollie or Mary Eliza [Foster?] (b. 2/4/1886), and Henry Milton [Foster?] (b. 9/29/1888). There is no indication that these four are grandchildren. Henry W. is not listed. - It seems to me that the 20 year gap between the first two and the last four suggest that the latter are the children of Thomas. Thomas married Louisa Waters (daughter of Mary Ann Frisbie Waters Biddle from her first marriage) in 1881; these children come in sequence after that date. Melba provides a copy of the sheet, not completely readable, which I judge to have all these Foster records written in a slightly smaller and different hand than the heading and initial listings; the subsequent records of deaths in the 1950's are clearly after Joseph's death. Melba thinks Joseph wrote this; I am not so sure.

1880 census shows both Thomas and Henry W. living with Oscar and Kate Frisbie in Hannibal. This

is the only mention I have of Henry W. and I am assuming he is a son of Maria and Jacob Foster because of Thomas and he living together with Kate and Oscar. The deaths of Maria and Jacob are assumed before 1880 because their children are living with other family members -

7. JOSEPH³ BIDDLE (*GEORGE*², *JOHN HENRY*¹) was born 12 Feb 1832 in Indiana (Source: Melba Biddle Kolbe. Death certificate in her papers. 1990 census indicates 1831 as the year.), and died 26 Aug 1913 in Hannibal, Marion, Missouri (Source: Melba Biddle Kolbe. Death certificate in her papers.). He married (1) SARAH ANN TURNER 18 Sep 1857 in Missouri (Source: Melba Biddle Kolbe. Quoting a citation in his Bible.). She died 03 Mar 1866 in Missouri (Source: Melba Biddle Kolbe. Also, she gives date as 3/9/1866.). Evidently by age, the first three children are Mary Ann's by her first husband Waters, and possibly Enos also. The last two are Joseph's by his first wife Sarah Turner. However, later reports do not confirm who the father of Enos was. We know that Joseph and Mary Ann had two sons born in 1868 and 1869 who both died in 1869.

See also Jacob Foster living in the same ward.

Louisa and Nathaniel are Mary Ann's from first marriage to Waters; Thomas is Joseph's by first wife (Kate by first wife was married in 1876).

Biddle Joseph 69 mar 10y bFeb 1831 bIN fbKY mbPA farmer rents, Virginia wife 45 mar 10y bKY pbUnknown, Frank son 14 bMO fbIN mbIA farm laborer

Living in same building with dau Mary and her husband William Neal.

1910 - see son Frank's listing.

Did he live in Indiana earlier? In Illinois? At some time lived in Hydesburg (Ralls Co.?) near Hannibal, not Hartsburg in Boone Cty.

1860 Pike Co. IL shows only a James Biddle (m. Lucy) and a Q. Biddle. There are two J. Fosters and a J.W. Foster in Pike Co. IL.

1860 MO shows no Joseph Biddle and no Biddles in the Hannibal area.

1870 MO shows a Joseph Biddle in Boone Co., no Biddles in Hannibal area.

MO State Archives, microfilm of wedding certificate: Dates and place as given; Mary Ann Waters is the wife; both she and Joseph were residents of Pike Co. ILLINOIS at the time.

Cemetery records (Riverside) confirm his burial (8/26/1913), but apparently there is no stone. I looked for it. Aunt Ruth - he was so piss-poor that Uncle Frank (son) had to pay for his burial.

Death certificate in Melba's papers gives birth year as 1842 - apparently an error by Mary Ann Florence Biddle, the informant.

Melba: Frank says that Joseph always claimed to have walked all the way from Pennsylvania to Missouri. ... that Sarah Ann Turner was a widow when she married Joseph [unclear whether Turner was married or maiden name].

Melba on Joseph himself: "He is said to have walked from Pennsylvania to Missouri. However, there is little doubt that his ancestors were English. His surname is English, he looked English, and behaved like the English. He also gave all his children English first names. I have been told that in the prime of his life, Joseph was about medium height, had light brown hair, blue eyes, and fair skin. ... [My mother] has said that he was a very courteous, soft-spoken man, that he kept himself very clean, and he always went around the house fully dressed, including vest and coat. He didn't drink and was not profane. He was 80 years old when Mother first met him, and she has said his eyesight and hearing were good. Joseph made all the early entries in his Bible, and his handwriting is firm and strong, and it also had a certain elegance. Mother always felt that he was a very civilized man and had a refinement belied by the poverty in which he lived so much of his life. However, from the pictures of his family in Joseph's Bible, we must conclude that Joseph was not always poverty-stricken. Those

pictures are of babies, children and adults who are neatly groomed and very nicely attired. So there must have been some good times in their lives. Joseph's spine was very bowed in his old age and he walked bent over and used a cane for support. He died of old age and heart failure and did not linger a long time. ...

[Around 1911 or 1912] my father received a rather pathetic letter from his stepmother. Joseph was now 80 years old and unable to work any longer. She was also too old to work, and they were now in desperate straits. He was the only one of the children unmarried [recently widowed by Cora] and without responsibilities. If he couldn't help a little she didn't know what they would do. Right here you can chalk up a credit for Father. He went down into the country, packed them up and moved them into his house in Hannibal. So, when Mother married Father, her home was shared by two very elderly strangers. ... If the four of them ever argued or "had words", it must have been trifling, because Mother could never remember any ugly episodes. During all my life, I never heard Mother say an unkind word about Grandpa Joe and Grandma Ginny. She used to tell us stories about 'old Joe', but it was always with great humor and kindness."

Notes for MARY ANN FRISBIE:

1850: Age 9, called Mahala A., b. IA. Living in Pike Co with parents and siblings. Pike Co, Salt River Twp, p. 274.

1860: Age 18, called Mary A., b. IA. Living in Pike Co with parents and siblings. Pike Co, Salt River Twp, p. 375.

1880: Living in Hannibal with second husband, 7 children, Louisa 18, Thomas 17, Nathaniel 14, Henry 9, George 5, Ella 2, and Mary F. 8 mos born Nov 1879, and with her brother Enoch Frisby [sic] 35. Born in IA, looks like LA; father born Md (Ind?), mother born NY. Louisa and Nathaniel believed to be children of Mary Ann by Waters. Thomas believed to be child of Joseph by Sarah Turner. B340 v22 ED13 s25 l.42.

Enoch (Enos?) and Oscar were her brothers (Frank knew them well - Melba); she also had a sister Melissa, who Melba and Ruth both remember. Melissa had a daughter Goldie and a grandson Leonard Larmis.

Melba reports that Joseph says she died in childbirth, so there must have been another baby after William.

Louise Biddle Green said she is buried in Old Baptist Cemetery, Hannibal. Records for the cemetery in the Hannibal Library are incomplete, and the cemetery is in bad disrepair. I have not found her grave, or that of Mary Ann's daughter Susan Ellen, who is also buried there (obituary in Melba's papers) or that of Thomas Biddle.

Melba does not know birthplace. All she has is a small precious picture in Joseph's Bible. "... a nice looking young woman with dark hair and dark eyes. Her hair is long and drawn back in a bun at the back of the head. It is parted in the middle, looks quite thick and frames her face softly. She is wearing a blouse and skirt which shows up darkly on a black-and-white picture. The blouse has drop shoulders, and full sleeves which taper to the wrist. There is a small ruching around the neckline and cuffs. The blouse buttons down the front and at the throat there is a flat bow and on the bow is a small, round brooch. The skirt is full from the waist down and is made of a shiny material. It could be brocade or taffeta, or something similar. Grandmother appears to be somewhere between 25 and 35 years old, and is neither fat nor thin. Considering that she was in her prime child-bearing years, and was having babies as fast as the laws of nature would allow, I think she looks just great." Melba mentions that she knows of only three siblings of Mary Ann; Oscar and Enos Frisby, who Frank Biddle knew - both lived past 90, and Great Aunt Melissa (no surname given). As an older woman, Melissa stayed with Melba and Eula Frances while their mother was hospitalized in 1923. Melba mentions Goldie and her son Leonard Larmis. Melissa, Goldie, and Leonard apparently all had red hair. She mentions the Oscar Frisbie/Catherine Jane Biddle marriage and that Frank Biddle had very dim memories of his natural mother.

Melba: "If there was anything like a black sheep in the Biddle family, it had to be Uncle George. The rascal drank and cursed and gave poor Aunt Lucy a hard time. ... Marrying Lucy McGee was probably the most sensible thing Uncle George ever did in his entire life. She was a good woman, a wonderful cook, and was very good at all kinds of needlework. Uncle George was the smallest of the Biddle brothers. He had a small, slender bone structure, but he had the square shoulders common to all the brothers. ... George was loud and profane, very hot tempered, and he was very often inebriated. Today he would be known as an alcoholic. He was possessed of a great deal of nervous energy which should have been an asset, but never was. In spite of all his faults, Uncle George had a certain charm and was always very kind to my sister and me. ... In spite of the abuse Uncle George's body endured for so many years, he lived to age 83, which is something of a small miracle." Melba reproduces the death notice from O'Donnell Funeral Home, indicating burial in Hope Cemetery.
