1. Harmen⁹ Vanderbeck (Paul⁸ Vanderbeek, Paulus⁷, Paulus J.⁶, Jacob⁵, Paulus⁴, Conrad³, Paulus², Cornelis¹) was born March 17, 1810 in Paramus, NJ, and died July 17, 1867 in New York City. He married **Catherine Fox**, daughter of John Fox and Jannitje Bogert. She was born Abt. 1802 in NJ, and died September 23, 1873 in New York.

Notes for Harmen Vanderbeck:

Herman (Harmen) died of a carbuncle infection according to his death certificate. He was buried in Greenwood cemetery in Brooklyn. he is listed as living at 408 West 16th Street on his death certificate.

Notes for Catherine Fox:

Catherine must have had a sister named Margaret, as Margaret is listed in the 1850 census's; however, maybe she is a sister-in-law, because she is listed as widowed.

Catherine died in 1872 and is buried with Harmen and John Jacob at Greenwood cemetery.

Margaret must be mistakenly listed as widowed, as she died in 1891 and is listed as single on her death cert. She was living with Richard Barnecott when she died.

Notes for John Jacob Vanderbeck:

Buried in Greenwood cemetery on July 1st, 1867. His father died later on that month. John Jacob died of an abscess. His death certificate is filed with the NYC municipal archives and is listed alphabetically at the end of the 1867 year. It is not listed between U and W. Rather it is listed after Z.

Single when he died.

2. Sarah Ann¹⁰ Vanderbeck (Harmen⁹, Paul⁸ Vanderbeek, Paulus⁷, Paulus J.⁶, Jacob⁵, Paulus⁴, Conrad³, Paulus², Cornelis¹) was born Abt. 1832 in New Jersey, and died August 28, 1879 in Mt. Hope, Westchester (The Bronx) - 1684 Weeks Rd.. She married **Richard Barnecott**, son of John Barnecott and Ann. He was born December 1828 in Isle of Jersey, , England, and died March 21, 1896 in 1684 Weeks Road, Bronx, NY¹.

Notes for Sarah Ann Vanderbeck:

Sarah is listed as being buried in St. Peter's in the Bronx on September 31, 1880 at the age of 49.

This is difficult to believe because the 1880 census is as of June 1, 1880 and Richard is listed as a widower in the census.

Why the discrepancy?

12/27/00 An Answer! Today I found Sarah's death certificate. She died in August of 1879. She was 49 and she

was buried at St. Peter's. Question: Does St. Peter's have the wrong date, or is that Sarah Barnecott the wife of John Barnecott, Richard's brother?

The 1855 New York City Directory (Trow?) lists both Richard Barnecott and a Jams P. Vanderbeck living at 810 Washington Street. James is also listed in the census. Richard is not. What is the relationship between Sarah and James P?

James P. Vanderbeck is listed as a carpenter. He is listed in the 1860 census with a family. Wife's name is Emiline (Emily in 1855) She is listed as 45 in 1860 census and 38 in 1855. They have a 17 year old daughter, Margaret, married to an Abram Brown in the 1855 census (the couple are living with them). They also have a daughter Mary (13 in 1855, 17 in 1860), A daughter Emma (9 in 1855, 14 in 1860), a son William ??(3 and 8 respectively in each census) and in the 1860 census they have a son named James Albert (2). James is listed at other addresses in earlier census returns. He lived on Grove Street, Washington Street and Perry Street. By 1869 he was living on Greenwich Street. He is listed as a dock builder in early directories an a carpenter in all later ones. He is listed in the 1860 census as having been born in Paramus, NJ (interesting detail; somewhat uncommon to name the town).

It appears that James P. Vanderbeck is the brother of Herman Vanderbeck, Sarah's father.

Notes for Richard Barnecott:

Richard was an immigrant from England he lived at various addresses through his life as listed by the NYC directories in the late eighteenth century. He became a naturalized citizen in October 27, 1854. It was witnessed by a man named John Hutchinson who lists himself as working (or living) at 162 Perry Street in NYC. Richard lists himself at 810 Washington Street in NYC. He submitted his application to the Superior Court in NYC on Cooper (Street?). Bundle Number 56, Record Number 11. I received the copy of the petition. it provides no personal information other than the sworn deposition of Richard to renounce the Queen of England and declare allegiance to the United states. It indicates that he arrived here at the age of eighteen; however, I can not be totally sure of this at this time, as the indication appears to be part of the standard form.

Richard died in 1896; Ethelyn moved in with him and her family for several years before he died, as evidenced by the fact that Dennis is listed with the same address in the 1890 NYC directory.

It appears that Richard worked as an Iron Moulder. He may have worked in the J F Barnecott and Son Carriage Works shop in Westchester in the 1890's. This store was on Westchester avenue in Westchester. It would seem that the JF Barnecott store was owned by John F. Barnecott and his son Francis. This Francis should not be confused with Francis A. who is Richard's son.

07/17/00

Received Richard's Death certificate in the mail. Buried in St. Peter's graveyard in Westchester(?). I believe that this means Westchester Square and St. Peter's graveyard in the Bronx. It is part of St. Peter's Episcopal church at 2500 Westchester Avenue in the Bronx.

07/19/00

Visited St. Peter's today. The records show that he is buried there. (I was right!) Unfortunately, I could not find the grave. Perhaps the years have made it illegible. About 30 percent were illegible - and many were broken. Maybe I'll look again at another time. I also found four other Barnecott's buried there including two infants and Sarah. The records gave the dates of burials. Good job!

05/05/2002

An aside: There is a Frederick Barnecott listed as a cutter in the 1888 NYC Census. He is listed at 334 East 41st Street. Who is he?

05/14/02

Today I discovered that Richard Barnecott was living at 343 East 36th Street as per the 1875 NYC directory. This is important as Catherine Vanderbeck died at this address. This further establishes that Sarah is Catherine's daughter and that Catherine was living with the Barnecott's (or vice-versa) at the end of her life.

August, 2002

Found records in the Bronx regarding home of Richard. Home was purchased in 1874 and sold for \$1.00 to Dennis O'Connell in 1891.

November, 2002

There is a Richard Barnecott listed as living at 339 East 22nd Street in 1869. He is listed as being in the Oyster business. I think that this is actually Richard Barnecott as Catherine Vanderbeck, widow of Harman is also listed at this address in 1868.

March 5, 2003

Finally I found Richard, Sarah, Frank, Herman, Walter and Odell living in Kingsbridge, NY. They belonged to the Church of the Mediator in the Bronx. They appear in the census. The last name looks nothing like Barnecott. They are in the 1860 census in Westchester, Town of Yonkers, page 222 (or 646). I also found them listed in the back of an old church publication.

December 2, 2003

Double checked the 1887 NYC Directory. Richard is listed as a Barnacott and is listed in the Fish business on Morris Avenue and the corner of 174th street. His home is 1684 Weeks Avenue

February 24, 2004

Found Richard Barnecott and family in the second enumeration of the 1870 census living at 328 East 24th Street.

December 28, 2004

Found a listing for Richard in the school roll census in Yonkers at the Yonkers Historical society for 1857-1858. He had two children in over the age of four in 1858 and three over the age of 4 in 1859. It would appear that there was another Barnecott child who died later on, as only Frank and Herman would fit this criteria.

We know very little about Walter; he is listed as a bookbinder in the 1880 census.

The records at St. Peter's in the Bronx have him being buried at the age of 23 years, four months and three days on December 27, 1881. Did he die on Christmas Day? I can not find the Barnecott plot at St. Peters, even though five of them are buried there.

08/15/00

Death certificate found at the municipal archives. Walter dies of Typhoid fever and exhaustion at 9:30 PM on Christmas Eve. It must have been a very sad Christmas.

Notes for James Odell Barnecott:

Ate poison ivy to prove that it could be eaten and not catch it. He was one of the first people to have a colostomy. He had poor bathing habits and lived with Ethelyn. he moved in after Dennis O Connell died. Ben Crogent was his friend.

James is listed as working in the carriage maker's shop in the 1870 census. This shop was part of John Barnecott's company in Westchester.

He is buried (with Ethelyn) in Woodlawn at the McAdams Plot in BlueBell section.

He is listed as 8/12's old on July 3, 1860 in the census.

Notes for Baby Barnecott:

Unnamed baby listed at St. Peter's as having died as an infant. was it a boy or a girl? Why no name? I can not find the plot at St. Peter's

3. Garret Odell¹⁰ Vanderbeck (Harmen⁹, Paul⁸ Vanderbeek, Paulus⁷, Paulus J.⁶, Jacob⁵, Paulus⁴, Conrad³, Paulus², Cornelis¹) was born Abt. 1842, and died November 04, 1887 in Brooklyn, NY. He married **Sarah J. Dixon** January 06, 1861, daughter of John Dixon and Caturah. She was born Abt. 1846.

Notes for Garret Odell Vanderbeck:

Found information on family from 1870 US census. Living in Brooklyn.

Was a veteran of the civil war. Served with the 79th infantry, Company E. He enlisted in May of 1861. The record shows him to be 28 years old. He was actually 18. He mustered out in 1864. His pension record shows a Silas Dutcher for whom he was a guardian.

Buried in Greenwood cemetery in Brooklyn. Lot 18372, section 3.

When he died, there is a listing in 1888 for his wife Sarah in Brooklyn on Hamilton Avenue as his widow.

Located his headstone on March 17, 2002. My son Richard (8 years old) actually found it for me.

April 17, 2002

I received updated information from Janet Jordan in Mass. she is his great great granddaughter. Silas Dutcher was actually the "guardian" for Margaret Vanderbeck". Margaret was his daughter. Sarah Dixon remarried George W. Harris on September 19, 1889.

Herman Rowe¹¹ Barnecott (Sarah Ann¹⁰ Vanderbeck, Harmen⁹, Paul⁸ Vanderbeek, Paulus⁷, Paulus J.⁶, Jacob⁵, Paulus⁴, Conrad³, Paulus², Cornelis¹) was born September 1852 in New York, and died July 19, 1903 in Bronx, NY. He married **Sarah Elizabeth Needham** May 19, 1886 in Tremont, NY, daughter of George Needham and Jane Corty. She was born Abt. 1862 in Fordham, Bronx, New York.

Notes for Herman Rowe Barnecott:

Herman is listed as a printer in various census and in some directories. He is listed as a painter in one directory. I think he was a printer and is mislabeled a painter in the 1879 -1880 NYC directory. He is listed as a printer in the 1890 directory. I believe he may be the same man listed as Rowe H. Barnecott in the 1887 -1888 directory; or this may be the son of John Barnecott of Westchester County. John seems to have owned the carriage shop that Richard and his sons worked at in Westchester.

Herman was buried in St Peters cemetery in the Bronx (part of St. Peter's Episcopal church) on July 21, 1903 at the age of 51 years. I got this information from the church records that still survive in old books.

Herman was listed as Rowe H. Barnecott on his marriage certificate to Sarah Elizabeth Needham. They were married by Philip Germond a "clergyman" in 1886. She was from South Fordham. The certificate number is 69038.

08/15/2000

Received death certificate from NYC Municipal archives. Sarah predeceased him. He died of ??? at 1770 Bathgate Avenue in the Bronx. He lived at this time at Anthony Avenue and 173rd Street.

02/14/2001

Just got copy of 1900 census. Herman was living on Anthony Avenue with Dennis O'Connell and Ethelyn in June of 1900. He had been out of work for seven months at the time (Was he sick?). He is listed as a laborer.

Listed at 512 181st Street in 1890 directory. Appears in the police census in September as 38 years old with his wife Sarah and two children.

In 1900 Herman was living with his sister. He is listed as a widow on his death certificate. Was Sarah dead? Where are the children?

More About Herman Rowe Barnecott:

Fact 1: May 01, 2000, Herman was a printer according to the 1870 census and the 1890 NYC directory.

Listed working at Bicycles in the 1910 NYC directory at 1439 Williamsbridge Road

His draft registration lists him as crippled with a right short leg. He worked as a ticket agent for the NYNHRR (just like his cousin?). He registered on June 5, 1917 and he is single. He lists his birthday as Feb 13, 1891 on the registration.

IN the 1920 census he is listed as a boarder at 1457 Ferris Place. He is working as a chauffeur.

By the 1930 census he is married to Harriet and living at 1419 Rowland place. He is listed as 37 in that census, although he is really 39 and both he and Harriet say they married at 30. They list no children. He has his own Taxi and is a chauffeur. The listing spells his name "Barneycot"

He married **Katherine (Katie) Henrietta O'Connell** Abt. 1883, daughter of James O'Connell and Mary Doyle. She was born May 30, 1858 in NYC, and died December 21, 1928 in Bronx. New York.

Notes for Francis (Frank) A. Barnecott:

Summer, 2000

Married Dennis Barnecott's Sister Katherine, known as Katie. He is listed as an iron moulder in the 1880 census. He is buried in Woodlawn; Honeysuckle ares, range 24, plot 243. The headstone looks to be made out of a sandy stone. The name Barnecott was carved into the top; however, with weathering is now barely legible. (Today's date 07/12/2000). I am sure within ten years it will be totally illegible; however, the names on the front should remain legible for many years.

I believe the actual birth date for Frank is 1854. He is listed on his headstone as 1857; however, the 1870 census and 1880 census lists him as 16 and 26 respectfully, thereby, supporting my belief.

He is listed as an iron moulder on his death certificate.

1900 census lists Frank as being born in November, 1856

1890 police census lists him as 38, or being born in 1852?

05/05/2002

The 1910 census list him as being 59 years old (born in 1851?)

03/07/2003

Finally, I have found the Barnecotts living in Kingsbridge in the 1860 census. Frank is listed as six years old; therefore, he was almost definitely born in 1853 or 1854.

Notes for Katherine (Katie) Henrietta O'Connell:

According to Ruth Fischer, Katie was so big, that you would hear her feet hit the ground when she walked. She is buried in Woodlawn with her husband Frank. Honeysuckle area of cemetery; Plot number 243.

According to the 1900 census, Katie was born in May, 1858

12/30/2003

According to St. Augustine Catholic church of the Bronx, Catherine was baptized on June 6, 1858

According to the 1910 census, Katie had six kids, but only four were left living.

1900 Census lists incorrect months for William, Katie and Sarah for births.

William is buried in Massachusetts where his wife was from.
