Deduction of 1800 Census:

Probate records of Samuel Fisher in Abbeville, SC of 1820 list family members who inherit his estate. The family members are his children and wife. Samuel Fisher is head of family in 1800 and is between 27 to 45 years of age as is Martha Ryne his wife according to the US 1800 census. Ten years later the 1810 census indicates that both Samuel and Martha Fisher are 46 years of age or older. It is estimated that Samuel and Martha Ryne Fisher were both born about 1763 or earlier making them both about 37 years of age in 1800. James Fisher indicates that he was born in 1783 according to the US 1850 Census. This means James was 17 years of age in 1800 and the oldest male child of Samuel Fisher. Since only one male is between 17 to 26 years of age, then James Fisher (1783) must be the oldest son of Samuel Fisher. In addition, Thomas and Stephen Fisher are between 10 to 16 years of age in 1800. Thomas and Stephen were both born between 1790 to 1784. One female was also born between 1784 to 1790. Five females were born between 1790 and 1800 according to the 1800 census.

Deduction of 1810 Census:

By 1810 James Fisher (1783) and Thomas Fisher have their own families. Both are listed in the 1810 census. James has no children and has married sometime between 1800 and 1810. Although James is older than Thomas, Thomas Fisher's family description shows that he is married (about 1806), has one female child (Jane Fisher, born 1807) and one male child (Samuel Crayton Fisher, born 1809). James Fisher was probably married in 1810 as he has no children in the 1810 census.

Samuel Fisher's family description shows that he has no male children, a wife, and 5 females living in his family. comparing the 1800 census to the 1810 census shows that the female child who was between 11 to 16 is now listed as between 16 to 23 years old. Two of the children are now between 11 to 16, 3 female children are 10 years or less, and one female child is missing from the 1810 census. It is assumed that she died between 1800 to 1809.

The only names known for the females are Mary and Frances from Samuel Fisher's probate records from 1820 in Abbeville County, SC. Mary and Frances may be Samuel Fisher's daughters. Reuben Fisher is also mentioned in

these probate records, but no males are shown in the 1810 census for Samuel Fisher's family except for himself. Reuben Fisher could have been born after the 1810 census and before Samuel Fisher's death in 1820.

In 1810 both Thomas and James are between 16 to 26 Thomas Fisher is about 25 years of age in 1810. Elizabeth Harris was born about 1790, age 20 in 1810. Thomas Fisher married Elizabeth Harris about 1806. Jane Fisher was born on 23 Feb 1807 in Abbeville, SC, age 3 in 1810. Samuel Crayton Fisher was born on 23 Feb 1809 in Abbeville, SC, age 1 in 1810.

Conclusion: James Fisher was born in 1783 and is 27 in 1810. James was born in North Carolina according to 1850 Census. Mary is estimated to be 20 years of age, born in 1790 based on census from 1810 to 1850. Mary was born in SC according to 1850 census. No children based on 1810 census. When viewing the 1810 census the first column represents the number of free white male children 10 or less, 2nd column is number of male children age 11 to 16, 3rd column 17 to 26, fourth column age 27 to 45, and 5th column 46 to 90. The female columns follow in the same order. The number of slaves that were own where shown on next columns. This column format was used from 1790 through 1820 census.

Conclusion: Based on comparing each person's age and name used in 1850 US Census to 1830 census, we then can determine the names and ages of each person in James Fisher's family. In the 1830 census there are 9 people listed. In the 1850 census there are 8 people listed. One male is missing from the 1850 census and would be 25 to 28 years of age in 1850. The 1830 US census only provides the range of person's age and head of family. The 1850 US Census provides the name, age, and sex of each person at the time of the census. Consequently we can deduct that:

James Fisher is head of family, age 47, born 1783 in NC;

Mary Fisher, age 40, born 1790 in SC;

Unknown son's name, age 16, born 1814 in Abbeville, SC;

Catherine Fisher, age 14, born 1816 in Abbeville, SC;

Sarah E. Fisher, age 10, born 1820 in Abbeville, SC;
Nancy L. Fisher, age 8, born 1822 in Abbeville, SC;
James L. Fisher, age 6, born 1824 in Abbeville, SC;
Poly A. Fisher age 2, born 1828 in Abbeville, SC;
and William F. Fisher was less than 1 year, born 1830 in Abbeville, SC.

4. STEPHEN² FISHER (*SAMUEL*¹) was born 1787 in Maryland, and died 1844 in Abbeville County, SC. He married JANE 1809 in South Carolina. She was born 1790, and died 1850 in Abbeville County, SC.

Notes for STEPHEN FISHER:

RESOURCE: According to US 1880 Census Records, Stephen Fisher was born in Maryland. All 1880 census records indicate the head of household's parents place of birth. Jane (mother of Amaziah) was born in Virginia. Amaziah Fisher (b. 23 Feb 1809 in Abbeville County, SC) was the son of Stephen Fisher and Jane Fisher. Jane Fisher died in Abbeville County in 1850. We do not know Jane's maiden name.

Most of the Fisher family for four to five generations resided in Diamond Hill - Abbeville County, South Carolina. Today Diamond Hill is called Antreville.

Most of the Fisher Families who lived in Diamond Hill are buried at the First Creek Baptist Church. The interesting part is that all of the families are buried next to each other. The organization of the burial plots indicate how each family is also related.

Edna Fisher is the daughter of Stephen Fisher (1787) and Jane Fisher (1790). Edna never married and always lived in Diamond Hill township of Abbeville, SC. In the 1900s the town name changed to Antreville. In 1850 Stephen Fisher has died and Jane Fisher is head of family living in the Saluda Regiment District of Abbeville, SC (later called Diamond Hill). In the 1900 census Edna is living next to Stephen Jacob Fisher in Diamond Hill. Stephen J. Fisher (born 1870) has been married two years in 1900. Edna Fisher is Stephen J. Fisher's aunt. Jane Agin (born 1838) is living with Edna in 1900 in Diamond Hill. Jane is Edna's niece according to 1900 census. Edna died in 1901. I suspect Edna Fisher is buried at the First Creek Baptist Church in Antreville (formerly Diamond Hill township and Saluda Regiment District), SC.

Census 1850 and 1860

Stephen M. Fisher is the son of Stephen Fisher (1787) and Jane Fisher (1790). His grandfather is Samuel Fisher. In the 1900s the town of Diamond Hill name changed to Antreville. In 1850 Stephen Fisher has died and Jane Fisher is head of family living in the Saluda Regiment District of Abbeville, SC (later called Diamond Hill). In 1850, Stephen (25 years old) is living with his mother, Jane Fisher and running the farm. The 1860 census shows that Stephen is now head of family and working farm in Diamond Hill and has no other family members. Jane Fisher died sometime after 1850. Amaziah Fisher (brother) has married and has his own farm. His other brothers and sisters all have married or have their own farms. Edna Fisher never married. Stephen M. Fisher died in 1904. I suspect Stephen M. Fisher is buried at the First Creek Baptist Church in Antreville (formerly Diamond Hill township and Saluda Regiment District), SC.

Samuel Fisher is living in Abbeville County, SC in 1830 as head of household, age 21. Samuel was born in Abbeville County, SC and died 16 Feb 1891 in Hart County, Georgia. He married Rhoda Wakefield on 8 Jan 1829. Samuel Crayton Fisher and Rhoda W. Fisher's birth and marriage dates are based on family Bible dates. Rhoda Wakefield is age 24 in 1830. The 1830 census shows that one person is 20 and under 30, another 15 and under 20, and one under 5 years of age. This recording is partially incorrect for the age of the adults. Both adults were between 20 and under 30 years of age. Samuel and Rhoda ages are confirmed in 1840-1890 US Federal Census. Hezekiah Little Fisher was born in Abbeville District (County) on 2 Dec 1829 and is 1 year of age in 1830. Hezekiah dies on 27 Jan 1864 in as a Confederate Prisoner of War. The POW camp was located in Maryland during Civil War.
