Logan Very numerous: all areas, especially Ulster. Ir. Ó Leocháin, a sept of W Meath at the Invasion, they were dispersed through Connacht. Ulster Logans are part indigenous, part Scottish and the Normans added de Logan to the Ulster scene in 12 cent. MIF.

County Monaghan (Muineacháin, "Place of thickets")

Along with Armagh and Louth, Monaghan was originally part of the Gaelic kingdom of Oriel which dates from around 330 AD. The McMahons were the dominant family in the Monaghan area and, together with the McKennas, remained so until the mid-seventeenth century. Although a part of Ulster, the county was not included in the great Plantation which began in 1610. It was only after the failure of the rebellion against Cromwell later in the century, and the subsequent confiscations, that some settlement by the English and the Scots took place.

Like Armagh and Louth, Monaghan was one of the most densely populated areas of Ireland in 1841. Accordingly, its people suffered greatly in the Famine. The population dropped by almost a third between 1841 and 1851, and went on falling as emigrants flooded out of the county over the following decades. By 1961, there were only 47,000 inhabitants left, less than a quarter of the total 120 years before.

Surnames associated with the county include McKenna, McMahon, McGowan, Smith, McPhillips, Finnegan, Duffy, Hughes, Markey, McArdle and Mulligan.

COUNTY MONAGHAN, COMPRISING SOME 136,000 hectares, is a landlocked county, having boundaries with four other Ulster counties - Tyrone, Armagh, Fermanagh and Cavan - as well as with Louth and Meath.

The county name derives from Muineachan, the place of the thickets. Much of the county is a mix of rounded hills and poorly drained uplands interspersed with more fertile and manageable soils on the lower parts where limestone predominates.

The highest hills are the Slieve Beagh range in the north-west, along the Tyrone border. Reaching around 1,200 feet in height, the range is somewhat isolated and featureless. Other mountains are Cairmore, with its deep upland lake, and Crieve Mountain overlooking the southern part of the county.

The Blackwater is the chief river in Monaghan, and today most of the county is given to pasture and beef farming with sheep on the higher farmland. Nearer the main towns, potatoes and cabbage are grown, while in the northern part, near Tyrone, there is a concentration of mushroom-growing industries.

Monaghan is the county town, being the episcopal seat of Clogher diocese and noted for St Macartan's Roman Catholic cathedral.

The town has long served a relatively prosperous mixed-farming area, and despite a decline in local industries over the past few decades, evidence of its former solidity remains in buildings like the Market House, dating from the 1790s, the Westera Hotel and the nearby printing works producing the Northern Standard newspaper.

Clones, 12 miles west of Monaghan, possesses a fine high cross in the market place and several notable Georgian houses.

The chief GAA playing field in Ulster is located here, and provincial matches regularly attract tens of thousands to the town. Castleblaney, at the head of Lough Mucknoo, one of the largest of Monaghan's many lakes, is the hometown of 'Big Tom' McBride, pioneer exponent of the hybrid musical form known as 'Country and Irish'.

Other towns include Newbliss, Emyvale and Ballybay.

Carrickmacross, in the south-west of the county, is noted for its fine lace, a tradition stretching back several centuries and today carried on by a dedicated co-operative movement.

The Logans migrated to the Colony of Upper Canada from Ireland approx. 1820. George and Elinor were among the early settlers in West Nissouri Township. They moved to Lot 17, concession 3 around 1825.

The book "Place Names of Ontario" states the Village of Thorndale was laid out by the Logan family in 1858. The map shows the village located on concession 3, lots 15 & 16 near George & Elinor's farm. In 1859 the village was named "Thorndale". Thorndale was the name of the large estate of their Irish neighbour James Shanly.

notes from Bernice Severson:

Robert's will was dated just a few weeks before his death, so speculation is that he knew he was dying. The land was not left outright to his widow Elizabeth, rather he left to her the use of the east half of Lot 17, Conc 3 for a term of four years. At the end of that time his son George was to have the NE 1/4 of said lot & the SE 1/4 was to be Elizabeth's provided she remained his widow. If she remarried, the land was to go to Thomas, the 4th son. If she remarried and Thomas did not outlive his mother, the land was to become the property of the 2 younger sons, Robert Jr., and John. As it turned out Thomas and his mother were to live out their lives on that land. Robert left other land to each of his oldest sons, Andrew and William. Both of them were to give money from their profits to the 2 younger unmarried daughters, Margaret & Martha. In addition both of these daughters were to receive money that was owed to Robert by the railway which had recently bought an easement across his land. The 2 younger sons, who were at this time but 12 & 14 yrs old were to receive money owed Robert in mortgages. Elizabeth, the 2nd daughter & newly married to George Fitzsimmons was to receive 4 sheep, and Maryann, who had been married to William Hueston for 11 yrs was to receive one dollar.

In 1892, George E. Logan founded the funeral home to fulfill a needed service for the London Community; based on the highest ideals of his profession.

George E. Logan came from Thorndale to begin what is today, London's longest serving funeral home. The George E. Logan Funeral Home was located on Dundas Street, beside what is known today as Kingsmill's (within a block of the courthouse). At that time horses were extensively used in the funeral profession, and families were beginning to use the facilities of a Funeral Home, rather than their residences.

Because the stable was attached to the Funeral Home, it was decided a new location would be more desirable, and the firm was moved to the East Side of Richmond Street, just north of Dundas Street.

With the increasing demand for still larger facilities, the property at our present location was purchased in 1920. Early in 1922, one of the few buildings in Ontario that had been built purposely for a Funeral Home was opened, along with the local ambulance service. The Logan Family made their residence on the second floor of the funeral home for many years as did the Logan's

Ambulance Attendants.

The new Funeral Home included a permanent Chapel that provides the family with reverence and dignity at all times. Large and small gatherings can be accommodated with equal ease and grace, in a church like atmosphere. A separate room for the family is provided for those wishing privacy.

In 1935 George E. Logan passed away and was buried in Woodland Cemetery. George's two sons, Harold G Logan and A. Everett Logan, carried the business on under the high ideals set down by their father; until 1962 when Harold died And the business was sold. George's daughter

Ivy continued to play the organ at the funeral home for many years after the funeral home was sold.
