

Descendants of Andrew Foy

Generation No. 1

1. Andrew¹ Foy was born Bet. 1766 - 1775, and died Bef. 1830 in Rockingham County, NC (Source: 1830 Rockingham County, NC, Census.). He married **Hannah Amos**, daughter of ? Amos and Elizabeth ?. She was born Abt. 1775, and died Bef. 1840 in Rockingham County, NC.

Notes for Andrew Foy:

It is not known that the descendants listed below are actually descendants of Andrew Foy, but census records indicate it is possible. For the purpose of this report, I am listing them together.

According to census records, Andrew Foy was listed in Stokes County census in 1800 and in the Rockingham County censuses in 1810 and 1820. He was age 26-44 in the 1800 census and over 45 years of age in both Rockingham County census records. In the 1820 census, Andrew lived with a female over 45 (probably his wife), seven males ranging in age from infant to 25 years of age, one female age 0-9, and other female age 16-25. There is a record of Andrew Foy in the 1790 Montgomery County, PA, census. Abel Amos' will from 1823 Montgomery County lists Hannah, wife of Andrew Foy, as the sister of Abel. Abel Amos' death is confirmed by a burial record of Merion Meeting, Montgomery County, PA. There is a Pleasant Amos living near Andrew Foy in the 1810 census and John Amos living near him in 1820. John Amos is living near the younger Andrew Foy on the 1830 census records. According to Abel Amos' will, he had a son named John, who would be Hannah's nephew.

In the 1830 census, John Foy and a much younger Andrew Foy appear in the Rockingham County census. They lived near each other so it is possible that they were both sons of the Andrew Foy from Stokes County. By 1840 in Rockingham County, John Foy is listed and nearby is a Richard Foy, possibly another son to the elder Andrew.

By 1850, there are three Foy families in Rockingham County. They were John and Rebecca Foy, each 46 years old, and four children; and Pleasant Foy, age 36, his wife, Martha, age 38, and their seven children. A third Foy in that census was Samuel Foy, age 30, who was living with William Carter, age 40, and his wife, Elizabeth, age 30, and their son, Pleasant Carter, age 6. Elizabeth Carter was Rebecca Webster Foy's sister.

Because the name "Pleasant" reappears later in these families, it is possible that John Foy, B. 1804, Pleasant Foy, B. about 1814, and Samuel Foy, B. about 1820, were siblings, possibly all children of the Andrew Foy from Stokes County. There are also records that Elizabeth Foy, B. about 1820 married Thomas Southern in Rockingham County and that family is listed in the 1850 census there. Elizabeth could also be a child of Andrew Foy from Stokes County. Hester Foy, B. 1797, married Pleasant Webster in Rockingham County. She is also possibly a child of Andrew.

In 1860, census records show only four Foy families living in central North Carolina. They

were John Foy, age 56, and his family; William H. Foy, age 25, (one of John's sons) and his family; and Pleasant Foy, age 46, and his family. Neither Samuel, the younger Andrew, nor Richard Foy appear in the 1860 census in this area. Samuel, Andrew and Richard are listed in later census records in GA, MS, and IL, respectively.

Andrew's birth date is estimated based on the 1810 and 1820 Rockingham County census records. His death date is estimated because he does not show up in the 1830 census. A younger Andrew Foy is listed in the 1830 census, but it is probably the other Andrew Foy, B. 1812, who may be his son. An older female appears in that listing, who may be the elder Andrew's wife.

Notes for Hannah Amos:

In the 1820 census, a female over 45 is listed with Andrew Foy. This is probably his wife. Andrew is not listed in the 1830 census, so it is assumed that he died before 1830. However, his wife could have lived past 1830 and could have been living in another household when the 1830 census was taken. There is a female living with the younger Andrew Foy in the 1830 census that could have been his mother. Hannah's birth date is based on census records ages of Andrew's wife.

2. Hester² Foy (Andrew¹) was born 1797, and died 3 Nov 1839 in Rockingham County, NC. She married **Pleasant Webster** Bef. 1827, son of John Webster and Margaret Walker. He was born 1791, and died 25 Jul 1873 in Rockingham County, NC.

Notes for Hester Foy:

It is unknown if Hester was Andrew's child, but census records show he had a daughter about her age. She is listed on her grave marker as Hester Webster, but the indexer listed her as Hester Foy Webster. However, I originally had Pleasant Webster's wife listed as Hester Fontaine, based on a Webster family researcher's information, but I believe Fontaine was

either Hester's middle name or the researcher had the last name incorrect. Information from 1883 History of Henry County Missouri, National Historical Co, pg 710, lists her as Hester Foy.

James H. Webster, farmer and stock raiser, section 19, a well known and prominent man of this township, is a native of Stokes County, North Carolina, and was born February 14, 1827. Pleasant Webster, his father, also originally from North Carolina, grew to manhood and was married in Stokes County to Miss Hester Foy, of that county. The subject of this sketch passed his youthful days in tilling the soil, and in his 19th year came to Missouri in the fall of 1845 and located in Henry County. Three years later, March 15, 1848, he was married to Miss Mary Jane Carpenter, of Kentucky, and a daughter of Wilson D. Carpenter, one of the pioneers of this county. She died February 4, 1864, and left four children living: P. W., Hester Ann (wife of J. Anderson), Sarah E. (wife of William Stanberry), and May C. Mr. Webster married his present wife, Mrs. Mary A. Lotspeich, widow of William Lotspeich and a daughter of Abraham Fisher, May 3, 1868. They have four children: Charles, Dora, Walter and Oscar. After his first marriage Mr. Webster located on Honey Creek, where he improved a farm and where he resided for seven years. He has since improved three other farms, and now owns 150 acres of land, with 110 acres fenced, upon which is a good house and a young orchard. He was elected justice of the peace for Big Creek Township and has since been re-elected, and has served continuously in that capacity for twelve years. Mr. and Mrs. Webster are members of the M. E. Church South. The former is connected with the Masonic fraternity.

3. John² Foy (Andrew¹) was born 1 Feb 1804 in Stokes County, NC (Source: Mary Foy Payne's death certificate indicates she and her father were born in Stokes County, NC, and her mother was born in Rockingham County.), and died 23 Feb 1864 in Rockingham County, NC. He married **Rebecca Webster** Abt. 1829, daughter of John Webster and Margaret Walker. She was born Feb 1804 in NC, and died 9 Apr 1872 in Rockingham County, NC.

Notes for John Foy:

The first known record of John Foy, B. 1804, was in Rockingham County, NC. He is listed in that county's census records for 1830, along with a wife and two young male children. He died in Rockingham County in 1864 and is buried there in a small family cemetery along with his wife, Rebecca Webster (1804-1872). According to census records, John Foy was born in North Carolina, but it is not known in which county or who his parents were. Some of his descendants still live in Rockingham County, while others moved to neighboring Guilford County, NC.

According to the 1870 Thomas County, GA, census, John W. Foy, age 40, was living with James and his wife and children. His occupation was listed as a stock trader. It is not know if this the same John W. Foy, but it's possible that James was his uncle.

Pleasant's death date is estimated based on his second wife's census record in 1870 Rockingham County. Pleasant is not listed in that record along with Mary Kinner Foy, age 36, with two children, Joseph, age 16, and Ophelia, age 5

Possibly a brother to John Foy, B. 1804. Moved to Massac County, IL, from Rockingham County, NC, about 1845, based on census information. Listed in Massac County in 1850 and 1860. There is no record of Richard or his wife in the 1870 census, but two of his children are living in Massac County with James Lynn.

Notes for James Madison Foy:

Census records show James M. Foy, B. NC, living in Thomas County, GA, in 1850 and 1870. He was in Brooks County, GA, in 1860.

James' wife, Mary, was living her daughter and son-in-law in 1880, so James had apparently

died before the 1880 census.

There is another James Foy, B. about 1815, who was the son of Lewis Foy and Bathsheba Lipsey of Onslow County, NC. This James Foy, who lived in Meriwether County, GA, and later in Hamilton County, FL, is often confused in genealogy records posted on the internet as the same James M. Foy, who married Mary Parimore. These are two different individuals. Both show up in the 1850, 1860 and 1870 census records in two different areas with two different families.

An Oathnel McCann (sic), a male, age 45, B. NC, is living with James in Mary Foy in Thomas County, GA, in 1850. This could be a relative of either James or Mary, but their relationship is not known.

They are indexed incorrectly in the 1870 census as Thomas S. Simpson and his family, but are living with another Southern family.

In 1860, he was living with James Foy and his wife, Mary, and their children in Brooks County, GA. In both the 1850 and 1860 censuses, he is listed as a carpenter, B. NC. In 1870, he was living with his daughter, Carrie, age 7, in Thomas County, GA.

In the name of God Amen -

I, Benjamin F. Foy being of sound mind and memory, and considering the uncertainty of life do made and ordain this as my last will and Testament.

To With

1st After my decease I wish all my just debts to be paid.

2nd In view of the present prospect of an heir, I give my entire estate real and personal except such as may be assigned hereafter to my wife and child. I further desire if the child shall die or if my wife shall marry again, in either case, I desire the estate to be divided, one half to go to the heir's of my brothers and sisters the other half to my wife during her natural life and if she dies without bodily heirs, then in that case to the bodily heirs of my brothers and sisters.

3rd I give and bequesth to Irene McGehie(?) the watch and chain owned by my first wife.

4th I give to William A Payne (Payme ?) my medical library, shop furniture and saddle horse.

5th I give to B. F. McGehie One Hundred Dollars in money.

6th I give the horse which James Foy has now in possession to his wife and children.

7th I give all claims which I hold against W. H.Foy to his wife and children except the -most gage-(?) of about Twelve Hundred Dollars.

8th If the present prospect of an heir should be realized and if the child should live to be twenty one years of age, then I wish the estate to be divided equally between the mother and the child.

9th I further disire that Thomas H. Robertson shall remain in the place where he is now as long as he may wish to do so at the same rates as heretofor.

10th I further desire that all claims I may hold against Milton Stamps at the time of my decease may be canceled.

11th I further desire that my executors shall have a stone a iron fence placed around the graves of my Father and Mother, my first wife and myself, and that they shall have stones with suitable inscriptions at the head of each.

12th I further desire that Mrs. Payne (Payme ?) shall have Five hundred dollars in the division of my property over and above my brothers.

13th I hereby appoint Thomas Payne (Payme ?) and my wife my executors.
