HEDGIE AND I WERE MARRIED AT LATONIA KY. IN THE CHRISTIAN CHURCH. OUR MINISTER WAS HOLDING A REVIVAL THERE AT THE TIME. WE ONLY WANTED A SMALL WEDDING. OUR MOTHER AND FATHERS WERE THERE, AND THE BEST MAN AND MY BEST FRIEND WHO STOOD UP WITH US AND WITNESS.

HIS NAME WAS GORDON PICKETT AND HER NAME WAS SHIRLEY ROBERTSON.

WE HAD OUR OWN APARTMENT PICKED OUT.

HEDGIE HAD GRADUATED IN 1952. I WAS IN THE TENTH GRADE THEN.

I WAS 15 YEARS OLD WHEN I MET HIM.

I HAD A HALLOWEEN PARTY AND MY FRIEND BETTY DUNN INVITED HIM TO COME WITH HER. THIS IS HOW WE MET. I LATER FOUND OUT THAT THEY WERE NOT GOING TOGETHER AS SHE GOT SICK AND HE TOLD ME HE HAD NOT SEEN HER SINCE THE PARTY.

WE ALL GATHERED IN THE AUDITORIUM AFTER LUNCH UNTIL THE NEXT CLASS BEGIN. HE ASKED ME OUT IN FRONT OF A LOT OF OTHER BOYS. I DID NOT WANT TO TELL HIM I WOULD NOT PROBABLY BE ABLE TO GO AS MY DAD SAID I COULD NOT GO OUT IN CARS WITH BOYS. I TOLD HIM YES, BUT EXPECTED MY DAD TO NOT LET ME GO. I DO NOT KNOW UNTIL THIS DAY WHY HE LET ME GO WITH HIM IN THE CAR, FOR MY FATHER WAS VERY STRICK.

I HAVE THREE SISTERS AND ONE BROTHER WHO DIED SHORTLY AFTER HE WAS BORN.

I WAS THE FIRST CHILD AND EXPECTED TO GROW UP VERY EARLY. WHEN I WAS LITTLE AND BEFORE I WENT TO THE SEVENTH GRADE I MOVED EVERY YEAR, AND WENT TO A DIFFERENT SCHOOL. I ALWAYS HAD TO SHARE MY ROOM WITH MY SISTER PAT. THERE WAS NOT A LOT SPECIAL ABOUT MY ROOM AS MY MOTHER AND DAD DID NOT HAVE A LOT OF MONEY FOR EXTRAS. WE ALWAYS HAD INSIDE BATHROOMS, RUNNING WATER AND A ROOF OVER OUR HEAD. UNTIL WE MOVED TO ADDISON AVE. WHERE MY FATHER DID NOT SELL THAT HOUSE WHILE I LIVED IN IT, WE GOT A ELECTRIC REFRIGERATOR.

WHEN WE LIVED ON LOUDEN AVE I WENT TO THE EPWORTH METHODIST CHURCH. THERE WAS A GROUP OF YOUNG PEOPLE WHO WERE VERY ACTIVE IN THE CHURCH. IT WAS CLOSE ENOUGH FOR ME TO WALK. WHEN WE MOVED I RODE THE CITY BUS TO CHURCH. WE HAD MANY ACTIVITIES WHICH WERE SUPERVISED BY THE YOUTH MINISTER. WE WENT TO THE HOMES OF OLD PEOPLE AND SANG SONGS FOR THEM, SOME OF THE BOYS READ THE BIBLE AND VISITED WITH THEM FOR AWHILE. WE ENJOYED BRINGING A LITTLE HAPPINESS INTO THE LIFE OF THE OLD PEOPLE WHO COULD NOT COME TO CHURCH. WE HAD LOTS OF FUN GOING AND COMING FOR THEY WERE ALL GOOD FRIENDS. WE ALSO HAD HAY RIDES AND PARTIES AND WHAT WE CALLED COTTAGE PRAYERS MEETINGS IN THE HOME OF DIFFERENT YOUNG PEOPLE.

HEDGIE AND I WERE UNDER AGE WHEN WE GOT MARRIED. OUR PARENTS HAD TO SIGN FOR US. NEITHER PARENT WAS REAL HAPPY THAT WE WERE GETTING MARRIED SO YOUNG. I WAS 17 AND HEDGIE WAS 19. MY DAD MADE ME PROMISE TO FINISH HIGH SCHOOL. I GRADUATED IN 1954. THAT YEAR WE LIVED WITH POP FRYMAN AS MOM FRYMAN WAS IN THE HOSPITAL. I WORKED A HALF DAY FOR 2 CREDITS AND TOOK A SALESMANSHIP CLASS IN THE MORNING ALONG WITH SENIOR ENGLISH AND THE FOURTH YEAR OF HOME ECONOMICS. IT WAS A GOOD YEAR, BUT AT TIMES HARD, BUT I WAS NEVER SORRY THAT I HAD GOT MARRIED, SO YOUNG. I HAD GROWN UP EARLY.

WHEN MOM FRYMAN GOT OUT OF THE HOSPITAL WE MOVED BACK OUT TO OUR SELF, BUT LATER THAT YEAR HEDGIE WAS DRAFTED INTO THE ARMY. I COULD NOT GO WITH HIM AND WE DID NOT KNOW IF HE WOULD GO OVERSEAS OR NOT. THEN EVERYONE HAD TO SERVE THEIR TIME IN THE SERVICE IF THEY WERE HEALTHY AND NOT IN SCHOOL. WHILE HE WAS IN THE ARMY AND AWAY I WENT TO U OF K FOR A SUMMER AND THEN IN AUGUST AFTER SCHOOL WAS OUT, I GOT TO GO WITH HIM. I LIVED WITH MY MOTHER AND DAD FOR AWHILE AND SOME WITH HIS PARENTS. I HAD TO TAKE DRIVING LESSONS AS WE NEVER HAD A CAR AND HEDGIE SAID I HAD TO DRIVE IF I WAS GOING TO BE WITH HIM, AS AT ANYTIME I MIGHT HAVE TO GO HOME IF HE WAS SENT OVER SEAS. I WAS

JUST REALLY GLAD TO BE BACK WITH HIM.

HE WAS STATIONED IN FAYETTEVILLE KY. WE DID NOT STAY THERE LONG AND HE WAS TRANSFERRED TO GEORGIA. WE WERE THERE SEVERAL MONTHS AND THEN CAME BACK TO FAYETTEVILLE, NORTH . CAROLINA WHERE BOTH JEFF AND GREG WERE BORN.

WHEN HEDGIE GOT OUT OF SCHOOL WE LIVED SEVERAL PLACES COMING TO CARROLLTON WHEN MIKE WAS A BABY ABOUT SIX WEEKS OLD. THAT WAS IN 1961. WE LIVED IN A TRAILER THAT WAS 10 BY 54. IT WAS EASY TO KEEP CLEAN BUT YOU COULD NOT HAVE A LOT OF EXTRAS IN IT. JEFF WENT TO KINDERGARTEN AND BROUGHT ALL THE CHILDHOOD DISEASES HOME. NOW THE BABIES DON'T HAVE TO HAVE ALL THE SICKNESS AS THERE IS MANY SHOTS TO KEEP THEM FROM GETTING SICK. ALL OF THE CHILDREN WERE TO KINDERGARTEN.

WHEN MIKE WENT TO KINDERGARTEN I WENT BACK TO SCHOOL AT HANOVER COLLEGE IN INDIANA. HE WENT TO SCHOOL HALF DAY AND HEDGIE WATCHED HIM AT THE OFFICE WHERE HE WORKED UNTIL I GOT HOME. BEFORE THAT YEAR WAS UP HEDGIE WENT TO WORK AT THE BANK AND I HAD TO DROP OUT OF SCHOOL AS WE COULD NOT AFFORD A BABY SITTER AND COLLEGE TUTION. THAT DID GIVE ME ONE YEAR OF COLLEGE THOUGH WITH WHAT I HAD AT UK.

I WENT TO WORK AS A CLERK TYPIST FOR THE STATE IN NOV. OF THAT YEAR AND WORKED FOR THREE YEARS. THEN I WORKED AS A NUTRITIONAL ASSISTANT IN THE HOMES OF THE PEOPLE WHO DID NOT HAVE VERY MUCH MONEY. I DID THIS FOR THREE YEARS AND THEN WENT BACK TO WORK FOR THE STATE AS A CLERK TYPIST AND THEN WAS PROMOTED AFTER TAKING A TEST TO AN ELIGIBILITY WORKER. THIS WAS MORE MONEY AND I WANTED TO HELP PUT MY SONS THROUGH WHAT EVER COLLEGE THEY WANTED TO GO OR WHAT EVER FURTHER TRAINING THEY WANTED.

WE ALSO BUILD HOUSES AND I HELPED WITH THINGS LIKE CLEANING, DECORATING, PAPER, GOING AFTER SUPPLIES AND ETC. THE BOYS WORKED ON THE HOUSES AS THEY GREW OLDER AND WE PAID THEM WHEN WE SOLD THE HOUSES FOR A PROFIT.
