

Descendants of Thomas Thrower

Generation No. 1

1. THOMAS¹ THROWER was born Bef. 1657, and died Bef. Feb 1705/06.

Notes for THOMAS THROWER:

There appears to be THREE Thomas Throwers in successive generations, starting with Thomas Thrower of Charles City Co., VA who was likely born before 1657. To help differentiate between them I have listed them as Thomas Thrower I, II and III. That listing doesn't appear in any of the records that I have found.

THOMAS THROWER I OF CHARLES CITY & PRINCE GEORGE CO'S VA
b. before 1657 d. before 1706?

1678-- First record I find for THOMAS THROWER was in Charles City Co., VA Order Book Jervis Dix and THOMAS THROWER referred to next court. Jno. Smith gave testimony in case of Dix & THROWER. Jno. Higdley & his wife have judgement for 3 days as witnesses in case of Dix & THROWER. 18 Feb 1678/9. (CC Co. Order Bk 1676-1679 p. 362, Abst, by Ayers.)

1694--Aug. Court Will, an Indian of THOMAS THROWER, is judged 5 years old.
1694-- THOMAS THROWER among those sworn to Grand Jury duty. NOTE A person had to be wealthy to serve on Grand Jury, for instance, in 1701 their worth had to be more than 50 lbs. Sterling. (From "Autographs" by Elizabeth Lawrence-Dow).

1698-- THOMAS THROWER and George Passmore claiming 900 acres of land by Entry dated 17th of April 1698, it is therefore ordered that the Surveyor of the county survey and lay out the land for said THROWER and Passmore----- but in Oct. 1701, the Patent for THOMAS THROWER and George Passmore, (both of Charles City Co., VA) was for 680 acres for importing 14 persons.

1702-- The Legislature created Prince George Co. from the section of Charles City County that lay south of the James River, apparently where Thomas was living.

1704-- THOMAS THROWER on Quit Rent Roll of Prince George Co. VA. with 150 acres. Also on the Roll was JOHN THROWER with 250 acres and EDWARD THROWER with 150 acres.

1706--This could be the THOMAS THROWER, I who died before Feb. 1706, according to deed of that date in which THOMAS THROWER II sold land that had been given to him by the will of his father. (See Thomas Thrower II, deeds of 1706 and 1713.)

COMMENTS ABOUT THOMAS THROWER OF CHAS CITY CO/PRINCE CHARLES CO., VA

He was born before 1657.....To plead or sue in court, legal age 21. " The Source, Ages in Legal Action" (Dix vs Thrower in 1678).

His peer Jarvis Dix was age 62 in 1678 when their suit took place. (per CC Co. Order Bk 1679).
George Passmore, his partner in Patent of 1698 was born 1651.(Passmore Fam. Hist.)

William Dobson, with consent of his wife, gives his two step-sons Jarvis & Robert Winkfield to their grandfather Jarvis Dix for as long as the law provide & at the expiration of their time to give them whatever the court considers "convenient." (CC Co. VA Order Bk 1676-1679 p. 262. Abst by Ayers). Jarvis & Robert were sons of Wm. Winkfield (Wingfield) and Jarvis Dix's daughter.

The Wingfield and THROWER family seemed to migrate around the country together.

"to Dr. Lawrence Wingfield's near neighbors in Halifax Co., VA and Halifax Co., NC.
" The THROWER family, a relatively small group, was originally from Charles City county, VA. Surviving CCCo. court order books reveal a close connexion between Thomas Thrower and Jarvis Dix as far back as 1678, when they were in litigation together. In 1715, Thomas Thrower and Jarvis Wingfield move from this area to present day Sussex Co., near the Dinwiddie border, where they patent land adjoining each other. (Nugent, v. III, p. 180).

"Thomas Thrower makes his will in 1729, (Surry Co. Will and Deed Book 1715-1730, p. 1020), mentioning his son Thomas Thrower, "Jr." This is the same Thomas Thrower "Jr.", who with his sons Benjamin and Mason Thrower, appears in District 15, Halifax, NC so close to Dr. Lawrence Wingfield's family. It should be noted that the name Mason Thrower suggests a Thrower connexion with the Mason family of Sussex/Dinwiddie, and John Wingfield's only daughter, and thus Dr. Lawrence Wingfield's only sister, married Capt. Daniel Mason of the same Mason family."

NOTE Jarvis Wingfield was born 1669 in Charles City Co., VA (Wingfield Family History)

NOTE This appears to be part of the same land that THOMAS THROWER & George Passmore patented in 1701.

NOTE 1 The above tells us that Thomas' father was also named Thomas Thrower.

NOTE 2 Legal Dictionary says HEIR AT LAW "The ordinary heir by blood, succeeding to all the lands." So the deceased Edward may have been the older brother of Thomas II.

NOTES on the above will of Thomas Thrower.

#1 Thomas III may have been fairly young. He apparently had no children at the time of writing of the
will, nor did his sister Elizabeth.

#2 Neither of the sisters was listed as having a married name. There is a case for Mary being married
at the time of her father's will--because she had already received her inheritance.

#3 The will of Thos.II listed Thomas III as executor along with his mother Mary. So, Thos. III had to be
at least 14 years of age according to Table 6-3, Ages of Legal Action in "The Source".

#4 Daughter Hester received the bed she "usually lies on" makes it appear that she is still at home with
the family.

#5 It is very POSSIBLE, not proven, that ESTHER, the wife of John Freeman in the Albemarle Parish
Register is daughter HESTER mentioned in the will of THOMAS THROWER II.

NOTE JOHN THROWER & THOMAS THROWER both died in 1730, yet the lands are still in their names in 1746. POSSIBLE EXPLANATION In colonial Virginia family members were not required by law to notify the civil authorities of a death, only the local parish was to be notified.

This land that JOHN patented in 1723 was sold by his son HEZEKIAH THROWER in 1747. (See his writeup.)

Notes for THOMAS THROWER:

THOMAS THROWER OF HALIFAX COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA

Thomas Thrower was born before 1724 (according to tax list) and died 1787. His will was made 22 March, 1784 and probated 1787, February Court of Halifax Co., NC.

Wife Elizabeth and 13 children were listed in his will. So far Elizabeth's maiden name is unknown, as is the question of how many of the 13 children were born to her.

++++ We know that Thomas Thrower moved to NC from VA in the 1740's.++++

THOMAS BUYS LAND IN EDGECOMBE COUNTY, NC

NOTE: Thos. probably bought this land some time before it was recorded, because he is to be found earlier (2 Feb. 1748) as a chain carrier on a plat survey in Edgecombe Co., helping to survey land for William Adkins that adjoins his (Thos. Thrower's) line, also Walter Pitts, Pollocks, Rich'd Lewis and Aaron Etheridge's lines. (Vol. 4, 'The Granville District of North Carolina' by Margaret M. Hofmann)

NOTE: Chain Carriers were almost always relatives of the people receiving the land grants.

1749; Thos. was witness to the will of William Jones*, made Nov. 27, 1749, and probated at Aug. Ct. 1750. (Abs./wills of Edge. Co. NC, by Williams.)

1760; Thos. was a chain carrier for a land survey taken for Wilson Williams on 8 Aug. 1760 in the Parish of Edgecombe in Halifax Co. (Patent Bk 14, #3059, page 180).

Thomas could have been living in Chatham Co. when he married Elizabeth Shephard Dec. 20,1817 in Orange Co., NC. The counties were adjacent.

Daughter Susanna (Susan) was born 1818 and Elizabeth died in childbirth or soon after. Will of William Shephard (father of Elizabeth) Orange Co. dated Dec. 1, 1825, list heir of Elizabeth, namely minor Sussana THROWER who had executor Sampson Moore as her representative.

A man named Sullivan Leigh was appointed guardian for Susan THROWER. (Thomas Thrower and Sullivan Leigh had married sisters.) The time was 1828 when she was about 10 years of age. He remained her guardian until she married Moses Turner(about 1836). At that time, Moses and Susan took Mr. Leigh to court. Depositions from several neighbors claimed that she was "worth her victuals and clothes." Apparently Mr. Leigh charged the estate for these items but Susan felt she had earned them.

Susannah Turner, deceased, estate settlement Orange Co., Nov. 1838 assigns sons John E. and William each 1/2 of their mother's estate, fourteen dollars and 71 cents each.

Have copy of receipt dated Nov. 10, 1828 signed by Thomas THROWER, to: Sullivan Leigh for \$10 received for board and schooling of Susan THROWER.

Thomas THROWER married Martha (Patsy) Fields, daughter of Levi and Agness McDaniel FIELDS, about 1828 in NC, probably Chatham Co.

They had 2 children born to them while they were still living in NC, namely Matthew, born 1829; and John, born 1831. The family moved to McNairy Co., TN where Mary was born in 1836. Joseph (1839), and James(1841) were also born in TN. The family is shown on the 1840 census of McNairy Co. while Patsy's mother Agness FIELDS is living in 10th district of Hardin Co., which is on McNairy Co. line.

Thomas and Patsy's son William was born in Stoddard Co., MO, so between 1842 and 1846, the THROWERS had moved to Stoddard.

1850 census Stoddard Co. MO. Castor Twp. finds Thomas 55 and Martha 38 THROWER with 7 children age 2-21, and Martha's mother Agness FIELDS 61, in the household.

Thomas THROWER died between 1850 and 1860. In 1860 Liberty Twp., Stoddard Co., MO. Widow Patsey THROWER with 3 children who still live at home, Elizabeth SUTFIN 11, and Agga FIELDS 83 (Patsy's mother).

Roy Glover's Story about Frances Abigail Lee Thrower:

Grandma Thrower lived in a big house along the Old Dudley Road. She was a very flabby fleshy lady when I knew her.

I think we must have had Christmas dinner with her in 1908. This was about the first cap pistols that Bert and I had. They were single shooters with round caps. She liked to shoot the guns and we liked to watch her shoot them because her whole body would jerk when the cap exploded.

There were several things about the place that fascinated me as a very small boy. The clock with two dials that not only kept time but the date. The roller organ whose records were made of wood rollers with pegs that looked like shoe tacks. And the chicken house that had been a traveling home and photography shop. It had been set off the wagon in that

spot. The advertising picture of the camera was as tall as I was.

I found out this year (1968) that her name was Lee, but her granddaughter knew nothing of this lady's ancestry.(by Roy Lee Glover)

I later learned that his name was actually Albert Jackson Thrower. He was one of the town Throwers who I never remember seeing. Maybe he had moved to AR by the time I was of an age to know who he might be. I do have a picture of him when he attended a Thrower reunion out on the old home place about 1912. The only Throwers I knew pretty well as a youngster, other than great grandmother Margaret (Peggy) Ann Thrower, were her brothers Tom and Fayette who both lived on the old home place of their father and mother.

Albert J. Thrower was for a number of years identified with journalistic interests as owner and editor of the Stoddard County Democrat, published in Dexter, MO. He also filled some local offices and was an active worker in the ranks of the democratic party here until his removal to *western AR, where he now resides. Stoddard Co. Biography, Date unknown, but was written after 1932.

ABOUT OUR ANCESTORS

When any of our ancestors reach a high station of fame in this life, it is our boast and pleasure to refer to them as our distant relatives. When a young man, I was informed by an uncle of mine, Matthew Thrower, that back in Scotland, where the Throwers came from to this country, about the middle of the 16th century(1), and settled in North Carolina(2), a great great uncle of his was the world's recognized

astronomer, during the first part of the 16th century.

It was this Thrower,(3) the astronomer, that first told the world that this earth was round like a ball and that it made a 24 hour revolution and a 12 month and 6 hour rotation on its annual orbit. He also told many other interesting facts connected with astronomy, such as an endless outer space in which millions of planets and worlds, usually called stars, continue to make their regular trips through this endless space.

But this Thrower(3), the astronomer was not put in prison, like Christopher Columbus of Spain was treated when he claimed the earth was round. No, because Scotland was a highly civilized country for many years while England was still in a state of barbarism.(sic)

About 75 years after the Throwers emigrated to America, my grandfather with his family moved to what was known as Middle Tennessee, where they remained for two years and then came to Stoddard County, MO, whjere he home-steaded land and settled. My father, Joseph Mark, who was about five years old at that time was born in Chatham County, MO(4). He died January, 1877.

My mother, who was Frances Abigail Lee, was a distant relative of General Robert E. Lee of Virginia, of Confederate War fame. My grandfather, William(5) Lee came to MO from Indiana, where he had gone from Virginia. The Lee family were early settlers in VA, and had much to do with early settlement of the colonies. General Robert E. Lee was born at Stratford, Westmoreland County, VA. His father was Light Horse Harry Lee, of Revolutionary War fame and he was a descendant of two signers of the Declaration of Independence. Patriotism was and always has been a tradition of the family.

From Roy Glover's notebook about his grandfather, Francis C. Glover:

"I never knew very many of his near relatives. Somewhere I have heard that his family came from Tennessee with a traveling show. At Dexter, Mo. his father and mother died and a man that everybody called Grandpa Dowdy took Francis and his sister Mary to raise. There was an ex-slave living at the Dowdy place, with her two sons, Pomp and Sam. They must have been about the age of grandpa as many of the stories that I heard from him about his early life was pretty well mixed with Pomp and Sam.

The first train ride that I recall was a trip to Fisk, MO to visit his sister Aunt Mary. This must have been 1908. Cecil was not born yet.

It looked like the train stood still and the trees moved. Everybody took Bert and me to be twins.

There were three Glover girls Lula, Ella and Mary staying with her at the time. These were children of her brother (Dick maybe).

John, who spent a lot of his youth with grandpa was a brother of these girls.

F.C. also had another sister but I don't recall her first name. She married a Frank Hodge and they moved down to San Antonio, TX.

Grandpa spent a lot of time down there before he was married. He was married twice. His first wife was a Shands. I think they had two children a boy and a girl but I only saw Joe once. He was back on a visit from California.

I never knew what happened to any of (Lula, Ella, John, Mary) except Mary who became a preacher. Clara had a letter from her a few years ago. (This was written in 1965)

There was another young man at aunt Mary's house. They called him Charley Perkins. Aunt Mary's name was Perkins, but I think he was adapt. He had a telegraph key and sounder connected to his next door neighbor. They would talk to each other for hours at a time. In those days telegraphy was thought to hold a great future for young people. Sears had about 25 varieties of sets listed in their catalog.

There was a Thomas Glover living near Dexter at one time. He had 4 children, Elmer, Charley, May and Edith. They were distant cousins and did not visit back and forth much.

Aunt Mary owned a store on the bank of the St. Francis river. It still had a pier and a boardwalk down to it. Lots of families came by boat to do their shopping. There were not too many roads through the woods.

F. C. had a lot of different occupations I gather from the stories that he related to Bert and me when were out sawing wood or logs. This was about the only time he did much talking directly to us and I enjoyed some of the things he told. It seems that he had been a farmer, cowpuncher, bronc buster, stock breeder, distiller, cotton gin operator, an unlicensed veterinarian and a fortune teller both with cards and coffee grounds.

He had a great sense of humor as long as the joke was not on him."

The above was excerpted from my dad's(Roy Glover's) recollections of his grandfather Francis C. Glover.

I have heard other versions of that visit, but here is the version of my father, Roy Glover, as he remembered it being told:

"My grandfather migrated out to Texas in the 1870's. He must have been a handsome young man in those days. It seems he was very fond of the ladies and horses in that order. He took a job as a ranch hand on the ranch of his brother in law.

Many of the natives lived on the land after it was annexed by the United States. One of these gentlemen took a shot at my grandfather. He aimed at the groin. The bullet hit a silver dollar in the front pocket of his (g'father's) pants. The bullet centered the dollar and bent it very much. It knocked grandfather down but hurt him very little.

I never saw my grandfather until at least thirty five years after this. I never heard the story until after he was dead. I do remember a saying that he often quoted,{A dollar in the right place, at the right time can do a lot of good sometimes.}"

Two people who played a paramount role in the early days of Pittsburg County were Elmer and Juanita Thrower. Both were born in Missouri. They met in Oklahoma City where they worked for newspapers.

Elmer Thrower and Juanita Stanley were married on Christmas Day in 1924. They purchased the Hartshorne Sun newspaper in December 1931 and moved to Hartshorne.

The Throwers developed a life-long love and loyalty for the community, its people and Pittsburg County. Their children : Janice, Betty and Frank. Their epitaph reads in part, "They were happy here".

The Throwers sold the Hartshorne Sun in January of 1966. The sale of the newspaper left a void in their lives, but they remained active in community affairs until their deaths. Elmer Thrower died July 7, 1971 and Juanita Thrower died Jan 24, 1974. Their sale of the Hartshorne Sun and their deaths forever closed a fondly remembered chapter in Pittsburg County's colorful history.

Ira did some farming but mostly worked as a sawyer. His hands were gnarled and parts of some of his fingers were missing or bent over as a result of the hazards of his work. The family moved around quite a bit as can be seen from the birthplaces of the children. I suppose they moved to areas where the timber and sawmills were located.

Later,Ira and Lou stayed on the old home place about three miles SW of Dexter, Mo., and in my era, he did some farming, fishing and hunting, and drove to Poplar Bluff, Mo., to work as sawyer in an ax handle blank mill. He was a member of Old Bethel Church nearby. The church was said to be the oldest Primitive Baptist Church west of the Mississippi River. It was sold in the 1960s for \$60.

Grandad Ira also did some maintenance work for the local telephone company. Those were the days of party lines, crank type phone hanging on the wall(I think my grandparents number was 2 long cranks & 1 short.)

One summer Lyle, Velma Lou and I were riding in the rumble seat of grandad's car as he drove into Dexter to pick up some cable and parts at the phone co. On the way home, bouncing over the roads and up "Old Soapy" hill, a roll of cable managed to lasso us kids. When we arrived at home and he looked in the back, there were 3 grand kids laughing so hard there were tears in our eyes.

Another memory of the rumble seat was when we went into town with grandad(the 3 of us again), he bought us a bunch of bananas and went about his business. When he came back,there was a circle of banana peels all around the outside of that rumble seat.

Many summer memories abound that include the Dexter area near Old Bethel, because when our school teacher parents spent the summers in S E Mo. Teachers College (as it was known then) to extend their teaching licenses, they left us children with grandad Ira & grandma Lou.

There were many woods to romp in, gulleys to play cowboys and indians in, sapling trees to ride to the ground, and apple trees to provide many a belly ache. Driving the cows back to the barn-even that was fun. And grandma's sugar cookies--yum-yum. Grandma saw to it that we were clean and fed, and it seemed like the only time she took off from her housework was to listen to Ma Perkins and My Gal Sal, her favorite soaps on the radio.

We didn't have to take many baths, because water was pulled up by cistern and was very scarce--too bad.

The old home place is gone now, but the same old oak tree still stands on that location.
