In the name of God Amen. I, Jones W. Roark, of the county and state aforesaid being weak in body but sound in mind being desirous of disposing of my property by will do make, publish, and declare this my last will and testament - hereby revoking all others heretofore made by me.

Item 1st - I desire and direct that my body be buried in a plain decent & Christian like manner suited to my circumstances in life my soul, I trust, return to God who gave it.

Item 2nd - I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid by my executrix hereinafter named, the money to be raised out of such personal property as can be best spared.

Item 3rd - I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife, Elizabeth M. Roark, during her natural life my house place being lot of land number sixty in the tenth district of Hall County containing two hundred and fifty acres, more or less, to be by her

for the purpose contained in this Item, my personal property of every description after paying my just debts, whether horses, cattle, sheep hogs, corn, fodder, wheat, oats, notes, accounts, or any other kind of property or claim. I give to my said wife during her natural life also the product and income of my said farm all for her a respectable support and for the support and education of my children until they arrive at the age of twenty one with (unreadable) to dispose of the products and income of the land or any of the other personal property for the purposes named in this Item if need be, and at her death my land to be sold in such manner as may be best for the estate. Also all the personal property not disposed of by her for the purposes named in this Item and the money equally divided between my children and representatives of children. Should any of them be dead, the representatives of children standing in the place of the parent they accounting for what they may have received from me or my wife after my death, and should my wife depart this life before the youngest child living shall arrive at the age of twenty one years, then I desire and direct that the income and product of the land and as much of the personal property, as may be necessary, shall be used for the support and education of the minor children so thus all shall be equal and where the youngest child arrives at the age of twenty one years, then my whole estate, real and personal, to be dispersed of as directed in this Item, upon the death of my wife. I wish my whole will to be taken together in ascertaining my wishes, and no child to account for anything received for her or her support and education in the branches of a common English education until they arrive at the age of twenty one years, except my son, Melville P. Roark who is to have board for one year and tuition for that time out of my estate.

Item 4th - I hereby constitute and appoint my beloved wife, Elizabeth M. Roark, my executrix to this my last will and testament, and I further desire that my said executrix be not required to make and return any inventory to the Court of Ordinary or annual returns to the same. The p(unreadable) except my son, Melville P. Roark, who is to have board for one year and tuition for that time out of my estate.

#### TRIBUTE OF RESPECT

Brother Jones W. Roark joined the M. E. Church in early life, and gave his youth and manhood to the cause of his Master.

His Brethren, confiding in his piety and ability, gave him license to preach while quite young, and as a local preacher he served the Church faithfully until his death. He was a child of affliction, having lost the use of his right are in infancy, yet by his industry he provided for a large family of children, six of whom are now acceptable members of the M. E. Church. By his integrity as a citizen, his piety and zeal as a minister, and by his tenderness and devotion to his family, he had the

entire confidence of his neighbors and was emphatically a useful man - a brother whose memory we delight to honor, and in the happy triumph of whose death we love to rejoice.

1. That in his death the Gainesville Circuit has lost a useful local minister and a beloved brother.
2. That we resign ourselves to this dispensation of an Allwise Providence which has taken from our midst in the 53d year of his age and in the midst of his usefulness a brother so much beloved.

"Page J. Roark was born in Hall County, GA on April 9, 1845.

His life, like that of many others, was mixed with sunshine and shadows; but came to a calm and peaceful close in Gainesville, GA on his birthday - at the end of sixty-five years.

He was reared by pious parents, his father being a local Methodist preacher, and in early youth professed religion at old Antioch campground, and joined the Methodist Church.

He was married to Miss Nancy A. Prater, on December 6, 1863, and after the death of his companion, lived a widower for several years, sharing in part the loneliness of his motherless children; and on December 21, 1884, was married to Miss Julia V. Smith, in Antioch Church, the writer of this tribute performing the ceremony.

Naturally endowed with a sweet and mellow voice, and loving the assembly of the saints of God, he was for many years the chosen leader of the congregation in inspiring song and praise.

"Mr. P. J. Roark, aged 65 years, died last Saturday evening at 7:30 o'clock at his home, 41 Academy Street.

The funeral and interment occurred Monday morning at Antioch church, Rev. T. J. Christian conducting the service.

Mr. Roark was a man whose manner and character were commendable and useful to the young and to the aged, for he loved the service of that Savior whom he found and followed with a faith and courage on the plains of life. He wrought richly the circle of his citizenship, and found that peace which gives "the kiss of love when life must say goodnight."

He leaves a large circle of friends who mourn with his immediate family, the latter being his wife and five children, namely Mrs. U. E. Rankin, Messrs. Ben T., R.C., W.W., and Henry Roark."

A Third Obituary from the Gainesville News:

"Mr. Page J. Roark died at his home, 41 Academy street, Saturday evening at 7:30 o'clock from a stroke of paralysis in his left side which came on him Friday afternoon. He was not in robust health but he had been up and about his business every day and no thought of the sudden affliction visited upon him was dreamed of by his family and friends.

Mr. Roark was quiet and unostentatious, but withal he was a good citizen, whose friends were many. He was a christian man, and he was true to his convictions and friends. Over the faults of his fellow men he believed in throwing the mantle of charity, and no harsh criticism of others ever came from his lips.

Mr. Roark is survived by his wife and the following children, viz: Messers B. T., R. C., W. W., and Henry Roark and Mrs. M. E. Rankin

The body was carried to Antioch church in the Fork district, near his old home, where the funeral services were held Monday morning at 11 o'clock, conducted by Rev T. J. Christian. The remains were interred in the church cemetery there."

Found in my research:

Page joined in the Civil War. He was a member of Cobb's Legion, Company H. His uncle, Augustus C. Baker, was a member of this company as well. They fought at Gettysburg. Page was apparently wounded or injured as his muster roll shows him in a hospital on or about July 10, 1863, 6 days after the end of that battle. He was said to be awaiting

retirement. The muster roll is at the National Archives in Washington, DC.

Page's children have posed quite a quandry! But, the census records of 1870 list his and Nancy Prater's children as:

Benjamin went on to become a jeweler in Charlotte, NC. Robinson was known as Robert Cicero and is my great-grandfather, Unity was known as Mattie and William H. was known as Henry. Willis W. was found in the 1910 US Census in Hall County with wife Ida, age 25, daughters Ruby, age 7, and Willie, age 5, and son Manny(?), age 2. By the time Robert passed away in 1923, Willis may have also been dead. He is not mentioned as a surviving brother.

"B. F. Roark, jeweler, known for many years for his active participation in the life of Charlotte, died this morning at 3 o'clock at his home here, 5 Harvard Place, Myers Park. Mr. Roark had been in ill health for several months. He suffered an attack of pneumonia and influenza last Winter and never fully recovered from that.

Funeral services will be held tomorrow afternoon at 4 o'clock at the Roark home, to be conducted by Rev. G. R. Combs, D.D., paster of Myers Park Methodist Church, assisted by Rev. John Moore Walker, D.D., paster of St. Peter's Episcopal Church. Burial will be made in Oaklawn Cemetery.
