Notes for SAMUEL WILSON:

According to my grandfather's sister's bible, Samuel moved from somewhere in Pennsylvania to Mifflin Township in Richland County, Ohio. Richland County was formed in 1813 and it, along with several other counties, was incorporated into Ashland County at a later date. There are no records of births or deaths in the county until 1865, birth records began 1865 to 1908, death records began 1865 - Dec. 1908. Richland County was included along with four counties into Ashland County on February. 24, 1846. According to cousin Clifford Sweet, Samuel may have come from Butler, PA and may have been in mining there. The townships of Lucas and Mifflin, Ohio were locations of the Wilson Farm.

Samuel lived to be 61 years old and is buried in the Mt. Zion Lutheran Church Cemetery in Monroe Township, Ohio, near Mansfield. Aunt Vera has his death from the cemetery as 1888. Clifford has it as Jan. 20, 1889. He migrated to Mifflin Township, Richland County, Ohio in 1884. Richland County was formed in 1813 and was incorporated into Ashland County at a later date. There are no records of births or deaths in the county until 1865. The townships of Lucas and Mifflin, Ohio were locations of the Wilson farm.

"Died on Friday evening, Jan. 20, 1888, Samuel Wilson, Sen., aged 61 years and 14 days. Funeral services were held at Mt. Zion church on Sabbath afternoon, conducted by Rev. G. M. Grau. A large concourse of people were in attendance. The deceased was born in Westmoreland County, Penn. He grew up under the control and influence of Christian parents, and at an early age became a member of the U.P. church. In the beginning of the year 1884 he with his family removed to Ashland County, Ohio. Shortly after coming to Ohio he connected himself with the Lutheran Church at this place, of which he lived a consistent member up to the time of this death. During the whole period of his sickness, which lasted for about eight months, not a word of murmur was ever heard to escape from his lips, but he was fully resigned at all times to the will of his maker, when he finally fell asleep in the faith in which he had lived so long. He leaves a wife and four children to mourn his departure. "

Notes for MARGARET A. FARRELL:

Margaret Farrell was an Irish mail order bride. This information was gathered by Aunt Vera, but no documentation to prove this is the right Samuel Wilson, so she may not have been married to our Samuel Wilson.

Notes for MARGARET (ID#37) SHANIBARGER:

Ref. #37. Margaret and Samuel were married by the Reverend Isaac Culler.

Margaret's brother, Elias, bought 320 acres of property in Orange County, Florida on July 25, 1893. On December 21, 1894 he deeded almost 27 acres in Pine Castle, Florida to Margaret. When Samuel died, Margaret moved from Ohio to Pine Castle along with her children, including my grandfather, John Henry Wilson. She lived there until she was 68 years old and is buried at the Conway Methodist Church Cemetery in Orlando, Florida.

It is unproven but assumed that she died in Pine Castle, FL. Aunt Vera and I visited her grave in February, 1999. This is what her gravestone said:

He is was unaware of the value of the violin and kept it in the barn at the house at 1330 Perkins Road in Pine Castle, Florida. it was destroyed when the barn burned down. During the 1930s John and Mabel left for work at dawn and worked until midnight on a regular basis. This was before the 40 hour work week was implemented. During the 1940s and 1950s he worked as a night guard for the Royal Crown Can Company in Orlando. He moved to Pine Castle, Florida with his family in 1892.

She frequently invited one or two young soldiers from Pine Castle (later McCoy) Air Force Base home for Sunday dinner after church. She always baked extra cakes and pies because friends and neighbors would drop by on Sunday afternoon. Frequently she would take us out to visit old folks on Sunday afternoon. Sunday night she took us to Baptist Training Union and church service again. She loved to gamble. She and Daddy John frequently went to the Greyhound dog races in Daytona Beach. They played an illegal numbers game, Cuba, every week. They had poker games with other family members in the dining room. Also played Bridge. They loved to play Bingo.

Tommy was very handsome as a young man and very popular. He joined the army when he was underage by lying about his age. While in the army he contacted spinal meningitis. This affected his nervous system for the remainder of his life.

When Tommy and Kathryn married, Aunt Vera and Grandmother Mabel Wilson rode with them to the Baptist minister, who refused to conduct the ceremony because Tommy had been married before, although the marriage had been annulled. Grandmother took them to the Methodist minister in Pine Castle, who married them.

There is a possibility that this was the reason she switched from the Baptist Church to the Methodist. She later returned to the Baptist Church, but this was many years later.

Tommy was buried by Baldwin Fairchild Funeral Home in Greenwood Cemetery in Orlando, Florida in Section G, Lot 15.

Before World War II, Roy worked for Detweiler Nursery in Pine Castle, Florida. He fought in World War II against the Japanese as a paratrooper in the Air Corps in the Philippine Islands. After Japan surrendered, he was part of the occupying forces of Japan. He returned from the war with his new wife, Faye.

After the war he became an office manager for Suwanee Life Insurance Company in Orlando. At first he and Faye lived on Perkins Road in Pine Castle next door to his parents, John and Mabel. They later moved to Cook Street in Orlando. About 1949 he was transferred to West Palm Beach, Florida and they bought a house there on Clyde Road.

They lived there for many years and moved to Margate, Florida just after Mary Ann or Cheryl were born. While they were living there, Faye developed breast cancer. They moved from Margate to Plantation, Florida and from there they moved to Apopka, Florida shortly after that and were living there when Faye died.

After Faye died, Daddy He married Lavonia. They moved to Ft. Myers, Florida. They were divorced and Daddy took the children to Marie for child care. He then married Marie, who was Catholic, and the children were then raised as Catholics. Marie also died of cancer while they were living in Ft. Myers. His last wife was Aida.

Authorities identify man killed in wreck

CODY - The Wyoming Highway Patrol on Friday identified a 29-year-old man killed in a car wreck Sunday as Jason C. Fullon of Cape Coral, Fla. The 2003 Mazda that Fullon was traveling in was eastbound on Highway 14-16-20 about four miles east of Cody when it crossed the westbound lane, went through a fence, struck a power pole and continued through a creek where it hit an embankment, investigators said. Fullon was ejected from the vehicle. Another person in the car, Kristina Gevara, 19, of Elk Grove, Calif., was trapped in the car and had to be extricated.

She was taken by helicopter to St. Vincent Healthcare in Billings, where she was listed in serious condition Friday. Highway Patrol officials said they do not know who was driving the car at the time of the accident. Alcohol is being investigated as a possible factor.
