Francis Baker, is listed as a passenger on the ship "Planter", which sailed from London England 22 March 1635 and arrived in New England 11 April 1635. Francis arrived with a certificate from St. Albans Parish, Herts, and was listed with an occupation as a tailor - age 24.

Francis is listed as a habitant of Yarmouth, Cape Cod, however he is listed as being a Cooper in the book " History of Yarmouth".

Francis settled in a part of Yarmouth on Cape Cod about 1642, this part of Yarmouth is now known as Dennis, Ma. He appears in Court Records for selling wine without a license. On 1 June 1641 he received a grant for land near Follens Pond on Nobscusset Territory. His grant was not within the bounds of Dennis. in 1658 he had a grant of 10 acres near his father-in-law, in Eastham, Massachusetts. These town records listed him as a cooper, blacksmith and surveyor. (info from Deborah Whitman of Vermont.)
