Elizabeth Evans had helped nurse first wife of William Patterson when the last child (Ruby) was born and then during her last days she took care of her and the baby, as well as the rest of the children, I guess. She and GP had 4 children: Hugh Aubrey, Lera Alice Marie, (my mother), Buel Bernard, and Mary Avral, who was afflicted. I guess she was a Down's Syndrome child, but I don't know. I don't think Drs. knew enough about those things in those days to actually diagnose correctly. If they ever made a diagnosis, I never heard of it. Drs. advised GM to put her in an institution of some kind, but GM refused. Mother said the child almost died 2 or 3 times before she was 2 or 3, but GM always nursed her through her problem.. Once she had rickets. Mother said she was a beautiful baby with blue eyes and red hair. She went to school till the fifth grade, and could read with the class, but could not do other subjects very well. After GM died, Uncle Buel put her in Children's Home in Enid, OK. She died a few years back, after Mother died. Mother usually went by the home to see Avral when she made a trip back her to see us, and she would write her sometimes. She talked of taking Avral to care for, because she hated seeing her in the home, but I'm glad she didn't, because by that time Avral was used to her surroundings there, and Mother was not really able to care for her, and then died before Avral did. However, I think Avral was 70 or close to 70 when she died. I have a picture of her and GM made not long before we went to California in 1946. I will have that put in the book.

In Oglethorpe County, Georgia in 1805, Abner Jinks married Sintha Anderson and William Jinks married Betsy King. I feel sure Abner and William were brothers. Also in the same area about this time were David Jinks and, perhaps, Charity Jinks (a man) who may also have been brothers. Can anyone connect these four Jinks with a Jinks family in North Carolina.

I believe the William Jinks who appears in the 1820 GA census in Gwinett Co. is probably the same William who married Betsy King and that the Thomas who appears in the 1830 GA census in DeKalb County is probably the son of Abner Jinks.

Abner Jinks married Sintha Anderson and had two children, Malinda and Thomas. Malinda married in Oglethorpe Co. and her descendents remained in this area. I do not know what happened to her brother, Thomas. Abner was the son of a Thomas Jinks of North Carolina. I have found very few references to the Jinks family. There was a Thomas Jinks, b. 1748 who applied for a Revolutionary War Pension in Wake Co., NC. There is a will, 1811, for a Joseph Jinks in

Chatham Co., NC. I have been unable to make connections between any of these people. Can you?

If you look in the 1850 Censuses of GA and AL, almost every male Jinks/Jenks who is 50 or older states that he was born in NC. Most of the younger ones who are in AL state that they were born in GA. I believe that the Wake Co. and Chatham Co., NC Jinks/Jenks families were related and that between 1810 and 1830 a large number of the migrated from NC to GA, between 1840 and 1860 many moved into AL. If you look at the names in the 1800, 1810 and 1820 NC Censuses, many match with names that appeared in GA in 1820 and 1830 Censuses. After the war, several moved into TX including my great-grandfather, Wilburn Smith Jinks and his brother William Everett Jinks, JR, called "Cooney".

One of Wilburn's sons, my great-uncle, told me that one of his father's sisters, "Aunt Mattie" traveled from AL to TX to visit the family around 1890. While there, she entertained the children by telling them that their family was descended from a man who came from England in the late 1600's and opened a blacksmith shop in Lynn, Massachusetts. Uncle John had never tried to research the family history. He just thought that it was an interesting story. I was amazed when I started searching and found out that Joseph Jencks was a blacksmith in Lynn, MA in the 1600's. I found a reference in one book about early Massachusetts settlers that stated that it was believed that a son, a nephew or a brother had moved into VA around the late 1600's. Until around 1700 most of what is now called NC was considered part of VA. The names that were mentioned in the book matched names that appeared in the 1790 NC census.

Battle activities of Company I, Third Infantry Iowa Volunteers were In Northeastern and Northern Missouri during Mark's comparatively short service from June 10 to September 17, 1861. First action was near Monroe under command of Col. Nelson Ums. Apparently in retreat, under constant enemy pressure, the officers reported in sequence from Shelbina, Shelbyville and Brookfield.

On September 16 Brig. General John Pope ordered the Regiment to move to Lexington, a short distance east of Kansas City. It was during this move under command of Lt. Col. John Scott that the report read, "We met the enemy in force. Company I lost four men killed and twenty wounded, about one fourth of the total." Mark was "severely wounded in the leg" during this action on September 17.

The period from 17 September to Mark's honorable discharge on April 21,1962 at Blue Mills Landing does not cover his whereabouts. We found no mention of troops having been taken prisoner. This may, or may not, refute stories of Mark's sojourn at the infamous Andersonville Prison. It is possible the Rebels had held him until the condition of his wounds caused his release.

They soon decided to call themselves Boatwright instead of Taylor. One of the boys married an Indian woman of the Tuckahoe Tribe, a branch of the New Hampshire Seneca Indians.

Chesley Hood Boatright was born 25 Nov. 1797, the youngest son of James and LOUISA (Taylor) Boatright of Cumberland Co., VA. he moved from Virginia to Tennessee in 1825 and to Arkansas in 1849. Chesley and Louisa were the parents of 11 children. Chesley died 27 May 1867 in Madison Co., AR.

Jacob Strickland died about March or April 1790. As he was not listed n the first census 1790 of N. C., he must have died before they took the census.

. . . it will be recalled that the Strickland family figures in the ancestry of the Youngs, Blakes, and others. And His Descendants

The will of Matthew Strickland, Jr. of Isle of Wight Co., Va. probated in 1730 in Isle of Wight, establishes that Matthew⁵ Joseph and Jacob of the 1744 land grants of North Carolina were his sons rather than the sons of a John Strickland from England. They could not be the grandsons of John Strickland of 1629 of Dedham, Massachusetts as is seen from the outline so far since about 3 generations would have to precede Matthew Strickland Sr. for them even to be in the line of descent from this John. More Court records are needed from both Virginia and North Carolina to trace all the children of Matthew Strickland, Sr. Especially needed are the early deed records.

ISLE OF WIGHT COUNTY WILL BOOK NO. 3, 1726-1734 # 224

(Will made July 14, 1730)

I, Matthew Strickland being very sick and weak but in perfect memory blessed be God and do remembering the Mortality of my Body do give and bestow of what worldly goods God hath pleased to endow me with in this manner following: Viz: FIRST, I bequeath my Soul to God who gavit and my Body to be buried in a decent manner according to the Discretion of my Executors. ITEM, I give unto my son, JOHN STRICKLAND one hundred acres of land more or less beginning at a Maple and running across the Neck to the Swamp~ I say unto my son, JOHN STRICKLAND and his Heirs forever lawfully begotten of his Body and for want of such Heirs then to the next Heir of the Family---never to go out of the Name of the Family. ITEM, I give unto my son WILLIAM the land of the East Side of the Swamp, I say unto my son, WILLIAM STRICKLAND and to the Heirs of his Body lawfully Begotten and for want of such Heirs then to the next Heir of the Family never to go out of the Name. ITEM, I give unto my son, SAMPSON STRICKLAND; D my now dwelling Plantation and the land thereunto containing one hundred and fifty acres. I say unto my son, SAMPSON STRICKLAND and to the Heirs of his Body lawfully begotten and for want of such Heirs then to the next .Heir. of the Family never to go out of the Name, ITEM I give unto my son, MATTHEW STRICKLAND one gray mare with one eye two years old. ITEM, I give unto my son JACOB STRICKLAND one young horse bay aged a year and upwards---ITEM, I give unto my son, JOHN STRICKLAND one dark bay mare aged three years old brand-ed upon the shoulder with James Bryants brand branded by Edward Chitney and Abraham Daw. ITEM, I give unto my son, WILLIAM STRICKLAND one gray mare aged three years old and upward. ITEM, I give unto my son, SAMPSON STRICKLAND one bay mare with a star in her forehead. ITEM, I give unto my daughter, SARAH STRICKLAND one black mare with her ears cropt and her colt if she has one---ITEM, I give unto my daughter ANN STRICKLAND one stone horse branded with two CC one open at the upper part and the other at the under. I give unto my daughter, ELIZABETH STRICKLAND one black mare with a Crop in one Ear taken off. ITEM, I give unto my daughter, JANE STRICKLAND one bay mare branded in the buttock with twoSS, ITEM, I give unto my daughter, ANN STRICKLAND one bed blankett and sheet already received, two dishes and and one plate already received. ITEM, I give unto my son MATTHEW STRICKLAND four steers to be sold for the families rest I say unto my son MATTHEW STRICKLAND. ITEM, I give unto my son, JOSEPH STRICKLAND two two year old heifers, one of them with a calf by her side ~ the other has not, I say unto my son JOSEPH STRICKLAND. (This is marked with an asterick and inserted at the side of the document)* I ITEM, I give unto my son, MATTHEW STRICKLAND tw'o two year old heifers one of them with a calf by her side the other not, I say unto my son MATTHEW STRICKLAND. ITEM, I give unto my oldest sons a sorrell horse a stone horse to purchase land for them and Jacob with a barren cow to purchase land for them. ITEM, I give unto my sons, JOHN, WILLIAM AND SAMPSON STRICKLAND a two year old heifer a piece, I say unto my sons, JOHN, WILLIAM AND SAMPSON. ITEM, I leave my two eldest sons in charge with their brothers cattle and their increase to take care of them, ITEM, I give unto my son, JOSEPH STRICKLAND a feather bed and furniture and a pot, two dishes and a plate and half a dozen of spoons. ITEM, I give unto my loving wife all the rest of my moveable Estate during her life or widowhood. I say unto my loving wife, ANN STRICKLAND excepting one cow and calf to my daughter, ELIZABETH STRICKLAND and leaving my wife and son JOSEPH STRICKLAND executors of this my last Will and Testament dated the 14th of July 1730.

As is seen by this will Matthew, Joseph and Jacob were not given land in their father's will but were given assets with which to purchase land for themselves,

Notes for James Boatwright (Allen):

In an undated letter from Martha E.J. Boatright Hamor Chitty to her sister, Rietta Jehoshebeath Boatright Johnson, Martha discusses the family history as she knows it. These ladies were granddaughters of the James Boatwright of Cumberland County, Virginia, who was married to Elizabeth Kidd, and who, upon her death, married her sister Mary Kidd. Martha's father was Chesley Hood Boatright, the youngest child of James.

My grandmother, Verna Boatright Milstead, received a copy of this letter from Ruth Boatright Parker of Hobbs, New Mexico, a great great granddaughter of Chesley Hood Boatright. Mrs. Parker obtained a typed copy of the letter from Opal Johnson Cook, of Little Rock, Arkansas. Mrs. Cook had copied it from the original letter which belonged to an Aunt in Missouri. The location of the original is unknown to me as this is written in 1998.

In the letter to her sister, Martha states:

"Well, now for all that I can tell you about where our Boatwright ancestors came from; three brothers, Daniel, Jesse, and James Allen (English) stood buckled in armor to guard the life of King George of England, always standing in the king's court. They heard much of the new world, as this Western

continent was then called. There was no freedom for men whose services the king required. They could not marry nor own property. They were slaves to the king for as long as they lived. The 3 brothers skipped their bondage and came to America. They took up the trade of boat building and took the name Boatwright. James and Jesse married. Daniel did not. The brothers fought for American liberty in the Revolution from King George. Two of our father's brothers were soldiers in 1812 to 1815.

James was our great grandfather (English). Our grandfather was named James. His first wife, Elizabeth Kidd, his second wife Mary Kidd. Our grandmother--[letter is torn here]. They lived in Virginia. After our grandfather died, his sons scattered into different states. They are scattered, I suppose, in every state; never were much to huddle together. I don't know where the three brothers landed on the American shore, nor the exact date.

They were here in time to do their part in freeing Young America from the British rule, but they took the name Boatwright in the new country to protect themselves from the King's officers that were in power before the revolution that freed Americans from a tyrant across the sea. I have always been proud of their love of freedom and their determination to succeed, even to leaving their old English name and taking a purely American name & chose to labor with free people rather than stand as a slave in the King's palace. Yes, children, I am proud of the blood. I don't know of any record except what Father kept of his own family. I know two of his brothers fought the British and Indians 100 years ago. I don't have an idea of who has a record, other than you. I hope you will write soon to your

Information supporting this version of our line of the Boat(w)right family was also found in Goodspeed's "History of Northwest Arkansas", which was published in 1889. This information is quoted in the "notes" section on the family page of Chesley Hood Boatwright.

As this is written, 1998, we know nothing of the family of the Jesse Boatwright (Allen) mentioned by Martha Boatwright Chitty. According to her, the third brother, Daniel, never married and nor had any children. The genealogy of James' son, also named James, is a part of this family history and is relatively complete. We do not know at this time if the second James was an only child, though this is unlikely in an era of large families.

The story of the name change from Allen to Boatwright was passed down in several branches of the family. Another version of the story indicates that the three brothers were named James, Jesse, and John.

There is one Jesse Boatwright included in this genealogy who lived in Cumberland County in the late 1700's and early 1800's about whom we know very little. His will, from which virtually all of the information concerning this Jesse is derived, is dated in 1821, which would exclude him from being one of the three original brothers unless he was well over 100 years of age. We know his wife was named Judith, we have a list of all of his children living at the time his will was written, and we know from marriage records that one his sons, Langhorne, married a cousin, Sally Boatwright, in Cumberland County in 1785. We know little else about this Jesse but speculate that he is some relation to James, the progenitor of our line of the family, because of the geographic proximity between the two and the similarities of the names of the children of both. The best guess, and it is a guess only, is that Jesse and James are probably brothers.

There are references that have been found to several Boatwrights of whom we either have little or no knowledge, or are not able to positively identify, who lived during this time period in the same area of Virginia. Different documents, land records, etc., mention a John Baughtwright in 1704 in New Kent County, a Thomas Boatwright in 1735-1736 in Powhatan County, and a Thomas Boatwright again in 1751 in the same area.

The U.S. Census of 1782-85 gives a William, Jesse, and James Boatwright as living in Cumberland County. The same census indicates that a Benjamin, Daniel, James, and John Boatwright lived in Hanover County.

Daniel and Micajah Boatwright enlisted as soldiers in the Revolutionary War and John Boatwright, who died in Prince Edward County in 1832, enlisted from Cumberland County under Captain Brad Haskins in the winter of 1780-81.

A number of Boat(w)right family researchers have speculated that the above mentioned Thomas Boatwright is the father of our James and/or the Daniel Boatwright who married Jane Martin about 1757-1758. I do not agree with this speculation for the following reasons:

1. The above quoted letter makes it clear that the father of our James was also named James.
2. It was the custom of the times to name at least one male child after the grandfather, father, and/or uncles. None of either James' or Daniel's children or grandchildren is named Thomas. Furthermore, none of the family records such as those mentioned above or any of the existing Bible records mentions a Thomas Boatwright. Also, many of Thomas' descendants in the Carolinas and Georgia are named Thomas, but no other Thomas Boatwrights are found in the Cumberland County area of Virginia.
3. Thomas moved from Virginia to the Carolinas between 1751-1755. James, born about 1745, would have been much too young to leave by himself, but we have no information which indicates our James ever lived anywhere but Virginia.

Therefore, I do not believe Thomas Boatwright is directly related to our line of the family.

Cumberland County records contain the will of Daniel Boatwright, probated march 26, 1798, in which he mentions his wife Jane, sons John, James, and Valentine, and daughters Jane Smith, Elizabeth Martin, Esther Martin, Nancy Miller, Rhoda, and Lockey. I have a copy of this will in my possession.

We are not sure of Daniel's exact relationship to James Boatwright, the progenitor of our line of the family. He could not be James' son Daniel as that Daniel was born in 1777 and would have been only twenty-one in 1798 when the Daniel in question died. Hardly enough time to have sired nine children.

Based upon the time frame and residence in Cumberland County, we must assume that Daniel is the son of either Jesse or James, two of the original brothers who came from England. If one accepts the alternate version of the Allen story, then he could be the son of John. He may also be the brother of our James, but as with Jesse, there is no hard evidence of that available to us at this time.
