Grandma once told me that she didn't learn to speak English until she was eight years old, when she was sent to the Pipestone Indian school. She shared memories of seeing teepees outside of Fort Snelling. Her grandmother, Cecelia Coursolle, was a midwife on the Pipestone Indian Reservation. Marcella would accompany her grandmother to the Reservation and assist with the birthings (getting water, towels, etc.). She never actually saw a birth, it was considered too indelicate for a young girl.

He accompanied the Jim Fisk Expedition to the gold mines of Montana. Subsequently, he learned the blacksmith's trade under his brother George in St. Paul, Minnesota. His early education was acquired in Canada. After coming to St. Paul, he studied in the office of his brother-in-law. He was appointed and retained the position of U.S. Inspector of Customs at Pembina for one year, then returned to Mendota. At Mendota, he served as Justice of the Peace and School Clerk. He was also engaged in the liquor trade.
