A record for Lizzie King may have been found in Omaha, Nebraska in 1889-1890. There is a Lizzie King whose occupation is a laundress that is living at 408 N. 13th in Omaha, NE. I am not certain that this is the mother of Fred Tom King, my grandfather, but I've made note of it just in case.

Notes for FRED* TOM SR. KING:

There is conflicting information from various sources on a number of important statistics.....

(1). Name: His Drivers License lists his name as Fred Tom King, his SS-5 Social Security application lists it as Fred Tom King, death certificate lists it as Fred T. King, but others list it as Thomas F. King (such as a delayed birth certificate that may or may not be his) and his two son's, Samuel E. and Thomas Frederick King Jr's birth certificates.

(2). Place of Birth: His SS-5 Social Security application lists his place of birth as Detroit, Michigan, the birth records of his first four sons relate that he was born in Canada, the birth certificates of his remaining 5 children

state that he was born in Detroit and the delayed birth certificate (which may or may not be his) gives Detroit, Michigan as his birth place.

(3). Date of Birth: His SS-5 Social Security application says he was born 05 April 1902, his Drivers license gives the date as 02 April 1902 and a delayed birth certificate (which may or may not be his) gives his date of birth as 04 Feb 1902

(4). Parents names: His SS-5 Social Security application lists his parents as Percy James King and Lizzie Pratt, the delayed birth certificate which may or may not be his, lists the parents names as John King and Anna (or Arma) King.

(5). 1930 Federal Census for St. Louis, St Louis (Independent City), Missouri Lists his birth state as Michigan.

OBITUARY NUMBER TWO FOR FRED T. KING

Funeral services for Fred T. King, 52, of 2619 Crawford, who died unexpectedly at his home Saturday evening, will be in Culbertson Mortuary at 2 p.m. Wednesday. The Rev. Irving Conradson, pastor of the Metropolitan Baptist Church, will officiate. Burial will be in Old Mission Cemetery.

Mr. King was born April 5, 1902, at Detroit, Mich., and came to Wichita from Joplin, Mo., in 1936. He was a grading and landscaping sub-contractor.

Surviving besides his widow, are three daughters, Misses Betty, Emma and Wonda, all of the home; five sons, Wayne, Garry and Tom, all of the home, Sam, 2502 Maxwell, and Percy, 458 Leonine Rd., and three grandchildren.

The question marks indicate something to check into further. Fred would have been 18-19 years old in this year. His father was listed as a moulder on the delayed birth certificate (which may or may not be his) so he may have been trying out his father's profession. Further research in the Detroit City Directories is warranted, but my source for the City directories (The renowned Newberry Library in Chicago) only had volumes up to 1920-1921.

It is believed by her son, Sam, that Nellie died giving birth to a female child that also died with her. Sam thinks she is buried somewhere in Little Rock Arkansas. However, an inquiry to the Arkansas vital statistics office turned up no death for her in that state. A check was made with the state of Missouri for the years 1936-1937 also, and it turned up nothing as well. I also checked with Kansas Vital Statistics in Topeka and they also have no record for her. Oklahoma and Illinois the same, no record of death.

Nellie is listed on the 1920 City of Omah, Douglas Co., Nebraska Federal Census with her father and two sisters.

Nellie is listed on the 1930 St. Louis, MO census with her husband Fred and her children Gladys and Percy.

NOTE: State of Illinois has no Death record for Nellie King. Records were searched from 1916-1998

In a telephone conversation with Aunt Delrea GARNET KING I was told by her that when her husband, Thomas KING, (Nellie's next to the oldest son) was alive, he told her that he remembered that Nellie was buried out behind a barn. Taking this into account and hunting for Cemeteries in the last known county and state where the family lived before her death, I have found the description of a little cemetery where Nellie could be buried. It is in Franklin County, Missouri in the Unnamed cemetery on the Blankenship farm off Schubert Road off Blankenship Lane/Rd behind a barn in a grove of trees. There are at least five or more stones in the cemetery that cannot be read. This cemetery is in very bad repair with headstones turned over and broken into pieces.

NOTES FROM DAVID McCONNELL:

26 Dec 1910 a Christmas post card with a picture of Santa in his sleigh pulled on the snow covered ground by 4 reindeer, behind him the sleigh is overflowing with bags, dolls, toys and a small Christmas tree, with apples showing. The words "A Merry Christmas" are printed in the front. On the back there are two somewhat illegible postmarks. The first being Dec 21, (no year stamped) Garden City, KS, the other is Dec (possibly 24,) 1910 at Doss, MO. (was it stamped at both sending and receiving ends?) It was addressed to Miss Lilie (sic) Beaumont, Doss, Missouri R. D. and was dated Dec 26, 1910 it was written by Nellie to her sister Lillie. The Penciled message reads: "Dear Lilie, How are you I am fine and hope that you are the same. I wish you a Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year. Good bye too Lilie from Nellie XXXXX."

NOTE: Nellie would be 11 yrs. old. She could have been visiting her older sister Alice Beaumont McConnell who had married Harry Calaway McConnell in Kansas in March of 1910.

NOTE CONT.: Doss, Missouri does not appear in an 1875 list of U.S. post offices or in 1941 WPA "American Guide Series" on Missouri, 1971 World book Encyclopedia or current Rand-McNally Road Atlas. It may have been a suburb of St. Louis. Nellie then 11 yrs. old could have been visiting her sister Sara who later sent an Easter card to her sister Lily also from Doss, Missouri on 1 April 191. Lillie at that time lived in Salem, MO a small town about 30 miles south of St. James, MO.

3 Dec 1912 (Saturday) Postcard with "Best Wishes" printed at the top, small bunch of colorful flowers in a circle and the poem "Take this little message as a token true, that the wish recorded here is sincere for you" at the bottom. There is no postmark on the back. It is addressed to "Miss Lilie Beaumont, Salem, MO., R. F. D.. #3" There is no heading for the penciled message. It is faint and in a childish scrawl. As best as can be made out it reads: "Dear Lilie, How are you. I am fine and hope you are the same. Dear sister I am 12 years old today. Dear Lilie we hot (got?) some speaches (peaches?) at (?) our (?) school (?); all 5 of us had one, and the teacher did to and Lola Derby ??? is 6 years old. Good by to Lilie from Nell." It is not known from where this was written. The addressee was 15 years of age at the time. It is not known why she was in Salem, Mo. There is an uncanceled 1

cent stamp on the card.

12 Nov 1914 Postcard with pictures of 13 girls/young women and captioned "AMOMA Class" F'IST BAPT. CH., Burlingame, KS. 1914" (Burlingame is a small town south west of Topeka, KS.) The Postmark is mostly illegible, but it appears to read "Burlingame" and "Nov." The card is addressed to "Miss Lillie Beaumont, Belknap, Iowa c/o H. C. McConnell" The message is headed "Burlingame, Nov 12, '14" and reads: "Dear sister & all; Well, I suppose that you are all wondering what is happening here. Well, I will not leave here until the first of Dec. Our deal fell through and I am not sorry. Is papa and mama there now? This is a photo of our Sunday School class. Ans. soon. with love, Florence & Nellie."

NOTE: It is unknown if any of the girls in the picture are Florence or Nellie.

NEWTON (ADMINISTRATOR OF SAMUEL NEWTON, DECEASED) AND G BENNER (GUARDIAN). TYPEWRITTEN IN AFTER THIS LAST NAME IS THE NAME E. B. WALLACE. ALSO, THE NAMES ESTELLE M. BEAUMONT AND EMILY A. Received your always welcome letter, was real pleased to hear from you. I hope you are feeling fine, & enjoying life as much as anyone can now days.

I'm feeling pretty good, of course I'm rather miserable, but who wouldn't be in my condition, I remember, how I used to think how Mom looked so miserable, now I know she was.

Yes I go to the Dr's every month, I went the first of this month & halfto go again this week, & I suppose every two weeks from now on. I only have one month too go yet thank goodness.

No, I haven't been working since Nov. I sure do feel lazy; of course I try to get some kind of exersize every day.

As the time comes closer I get sort of scarry but, afterall it's only normal, & the Dr. says I'm doing just fine so there really isn't anything to worry about, of course I get to thinking about Mom, & it doesn't make me feel any to good, but she didn't have any Dr. care at all, & that's what caused all her trouble. Oh, well it's best to forget it.

Boy, is it ever cold here today its raining & the wind is blowing, the tempiture is 30. My fire doesn't seem to want to burn for some reason or another, of course it wouldnt beings it's cold out doors.

Yes, maby you think I don't pray for this war to end, we heard over the news the other day that Henry Ford, expects it too be over in 60 days, boy, I wish we dared to even hope. wouldn't be to soon to suit me.

Glen was home on a 10 day, delay in'rout we sure had fun, & it sure was good to have him home, but it was much harder to see him leave, than it was the first time.

He is so good to me. I sure wish you could meet him, he did go to Salt Lake, when he left here, & said he would look you up, but like a dumb cluck I forgot to give him your add. & he was only there two or three weeks, & was sent back to Calif. (Blythe), I sent your add. to him but he didn't get it in time, & he said he had been all around east So. Well, maby we will get to see you someday who knows. A person can always hope, anyway.

You said something about Jean and Dan's boys are they in the servace's to, but I emagine they are, they are just the right age.

Yes, I was so afraid they would send Glen, over right away, because he has been in a year, or will be next month the 16th, of course they might still skip him, one never knows. He has 30 days furlough time comming, I sure hope he could get home to see the baby, before he is sent across.

You asked if I listened to my radio, I would be glad to listen to it if I had one. But they are so scarce anymore, that if you so much as ask for one, people look at you as though you were crazy, & that's the facts. Boy, I sure

wish I could get one.

I have been in Burlington on Glen's sister's farm, she is awful nice, & is just as neat & particular as you always were (and still are no doubt), & I sure had all the nice milk I could drink.

I listened to a few programs while I was there, & got interested in them, now I'll miss out of course. Oh, well, such is life I guess.

Yes, I hear from Glen every day, sometimes I get two letters a day, they are all pretty much the same, but I enjoy hearing from him any way, I write to him every day, but it's hard to think of anything to say, but he doesn't care, if they weren't anymore than, Hello & Goodby.

Well, I can't think of anything more to say, probably have you wore out with this letter already anyway, so will close with much love, & am hopeing you are feeling well.

Answer as soon as possible. I always enjoy hearing from you.

I was 6 years old at the time. I have no recollection of anyone's face. I remember Percy as being the oldest boy & thought of Gladys as being an adult along with Aunt Nellie and Uncle Fred. I remember that the adult women (I also considered my two older sisters adults--they were in high school) spent a lot of time washing cloths and cooking. I have no idea where everyone slept (as we had no extra beds) except I believe the King boys slept in their car, which was a large old four door sedan with a "fence" on at least one running board for extra carrying capacity. Howard says it smoked a lot.

Percy was more "worldly" than we were--he showed off his counting ability by saying "1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, Jack, Queen, King". I had no idea what he was talking about as we had no playing cards at home, except a flinch game. Percy liked the smell of gasoline and took the gas cap off their car as well as others in order to smell the gas. I remember him daring to jump off the big wheel on our old tractor (3 or 4 feet) and would shout (ala Geronimo) "Kelloggs Corn Flakes" as he jumped.

I remember Aunt Nellie reading the newspaper to Uncle Fred, as he was illiterate & said that he "had got along alright" without an education.

Percy James King died in his home at 1410 Hempstead, Passidena, Texas of COPD; and was taken to the Harris County Corner (713) 791-7568 Thomas Heflin.
