Notes for Leonard Darr:

Leonard was listed in the 1850 Census as 70 year old farm laborer residing in Hillsboro, Va. In 1860 he was listed residing near Lovettsville at age 84. In 1870 he was living with son Enos near Wheatland and listed as age 92. In 1850, wife Mary was the only one in the household listed that could read and write.

**16. Conrad Darr, [II]**<sup>18,19,20,21</sup>, born Bef. 1755 in [?] Pennsylvania or [?] Maryland; died Aft. 1826 in [?] Culpeper County, Virginia. He was the son of **32. Johann Conrad Darr** and **33. Anna Elizabeth ?**. He married **17. Mary Warner** Abt. 1775 in [?] Frederick County, Maryland.

**17. Mary Warner**, born Bef. 1755; died Aft. November 1826. She was the daughter of **34. Peter Warner**.

Notes for Conrad Darr, [II]:

The Loudoun County, Va., Poll Tax records of 1782, show Conrad listed separately from his father. This proves that he was over age 21 and had taxable property. In 1794 he is listed as a Private in Capt. Jnothan McIlhanney's Company of the 2nd Batt., 56th Regiment of the Loudoun Militia.

In the 1810 Census, Conrad and his eldest son Leonard were residing in Culpeper County, Va., in which is now the Ben Venue area of Rappahannock County, Va. In the 1820 Census, Conrad was still living in Culpeper County. The same census indicates Leonard had moved back to Loudoun County, near Lovettsville [Wheatland

area]. Conrad was never listed in a Virginia or Maryland Census after 1820.

Conrad transferred an Indentured lease of 140 acres to a Richard Grubb in Loudoun County, VA., in 1809 for \$1076. This could have possibly been the same 140 acre farm of his father's estate near Short Hill, passed on to him after his Mother's death in 1787. On October 11, 1809, Conrad purchased a 206 acre farm in Culpeper County from Edmund and Elizabeth Pendleton for \$1339. A Culpeper County Deed dated December 14, 1816 shows Conrad Darr and wife Maryann selling 69 acres to Jelson B. Douglas for \$414. On September 17, 1823, he mortgaged his property to John Tell, Sr., for a note of debt of \$100.33 held by James and John Tell. The property was listed as 135 acres that Conrad Darr resides on bounded by Landon Butler, William Jones and Joseph Righenour.

The deed states that if the note is not paid that John Tell could put the property up for public sale in the township of Washington after September 1, 1824. In March 1824, due to old age, he granted the farm consisting of 135 acres to son Ezenious [Enos]. This Indentured deed entered March 2, 1824 refers to Conrad's wife as being named Polly. The farm was then sold to Joseph W. Carter on November 10, 1826 for \$700. This deed was signed by marks of both Conrad and Mary Darr.

Notes for Mary Warner:

In various deeds recorded in Culpeper County, Virginia between 1810 and 1826, she was referred to as Mary, Maryann, and in one of 1824, as Polly.

Notes for Elizabeth Darr:

Some family researchers show this person as being the child of Johan Conrad and Ann Elizabeth Darr. Frederick County, Maryland church records prove relationship of their daughters Ann Margaret, Ann Barbara and Mary Barbara. However, I have found no records in Maryland or Virginia listing Elizabeth as their daughter. If she was their daughter, they would have been in their late 40's and early 50's when she was born. It was the custom in Colonial times that children be deemed and recorded as "orphans" when under the age of 18, if the parents are deceased. I have found no Loudoun County Court records listing choice of or dedicated custody for Elizabeth during or after 1787.

Notes for Abraham Darr:

On September 14, 1814, one month after he was married, Abraham and Eliza were recorded as appointed guardians of 5 children of Robert Ogle, deceased. The children were Theresa (age 9), Franklin (age 6), Nancy (age4), Eliza (age2), and Robert, 18 days old as of 18 August 1814.

Warren County, Virginia Land Warrent 369-39 lists Abraham as being granted 80 acres on December 24, 1851. The 1860 Census recorded 21 May 1860 lists his farm as 80 acres @ \$0.70 per acre for an estate value of \$56.

Notes for Hannah Rightnour:

Found in the surname file of the Jophlin, Missouri Library, a card for Philip Darr, left there by first cousin Nathaniel Cole (deceased), that indicated Philip's first wife name might have been Reiterauer.(?). Joseph Rightnour lived on the next farm to Conrad Darr, in 1810-1823, according to two different Culpeper County, Virginia Deeds. Also Howard Bowers, grandfather Joseph Phillip Darr, had a cousin, Jack Ridenhour. The Rightnour surname found to have other various spellings, as Ritenour and Ritenhour.

A March 1824, Culpeper County Deed states that he was of legal age, which was 21. Moved to Ohio about 1830, then to Plainfield, Illinois about 1845. 1850 Illinois Federal Census lists him as a Farmer, value \$550. Shown living with son John in 1860 Census.

Notes for Johann Conrad Darr:

A personal estate appraisal held in Loudoun County, Va., on May 4, 1782 and settlement made in 1787, lists Johan Conrad Derr (Darr) as a Farmer and owner of 140 acres near Short Hill Mountain. His personal estate was valued and recorded at 84 lbs/16s/5p English on November 8, 1773, in session of Loudoun County Court.

Let it be noted, that it would not be uncommon for a person living in the northern end of Loudoun County, Virginia near the Potomac River to have conducted business and worshiped in or near Frederick, Maryland. In 1730, a Grant of 10,000 acres east of the Shenandoah and south of the Potomac Rivers was granted to a Mr. ? Stoner for settlement by German families migrating down from Pennsylvania and Maryland. The German settlement in Loudoun County was located between the Catoctan and Short Hill Mountains north of present-day Hillsboro and Morrisville. This settlement was comprised of approximately 71 families by 1733. An Irish settlement was established down the Potomac River between Lovettsville and Point of Rocks, Maryland in 1725. In early records the residents of this settlement often recorded the area as "Blue Ritsch Mountains" [Blue Ridge Mountains].

In the book "Pennsylvania German Pioneers", by Ralph B. Strassburger a Conrad Derr is found on Immigration Passenger List 151C. The following is taken from a publication of the Original Lists of Arrivals in the Port of Philadelphia from 1727 to 1808 and edited by William John Hinke, Norristown, PA for the Pennsylvania German Society in 1934: "At the Courthouse at Philadelphia, Tuesday Ye 21st August, 1750. Present: Thomas Lawrence, Esq; Mayor. The Foreigners whose names are underwritten, imported in the Ship Anderson, Capt. Hugh Campbell, from Rotterdam and Cowes in England, did this day take and subscribe Ye usual Oaths. 91p.list 45.6 (women and children)." Conrad Derr's 1750 immigration is found in the publication

"Names of Foreigners Who Took the Oath of Allegiance to the Province and State of Pennsylvania, 1727-1775, with the Foreign Arrivals, 1786-1808" (Pennsylvania Archives, ser. 2, vol. 17).

This may or may not have been the same Conrad Derr listed on Marriage Bond and Lutheran Church Baptismal records in Frederick County, Maryland in the 1770's. My research in Frederick County, Maryland found a Sebastian Derr, who immigrated in 1728, a Hans Georg and Michael Dorr, 1732 immigrants, all recorded living in the German settlement near Frederick, Maryland.

A common practice found in some German families names their children in the following traditional manner: The first son is named after the father's father; the second son is named after the mother's father; the third son is named after the father; the fourth son is named after the father's oldest brother. The first daughter is named after the mother's mother; the second daughter is named after the father's mother; the third daughter is named after the mother; the fourth daughter is named after the mother's oldest sister. Additional children are named after the brother or sisters of the father and mother based on the child being a boy or a girl. The fifth son would be named after the father's second oldest brother. When the "Saint" names of Hans, Johan, Anna, and Maria are included, it becomes difficult in some cases to separate the generations.

It's possible that Conrad the son on record could have had older brothers. According to the Virginia 1800 and 1810 censuses, a George Darr, born before 1760, was living in Fauquier County and a Joseph Darr, born before 1760, was living in Botetourt County. In the Frederick Co., Maryland 1800 Census in Westminster District 6, a Abraham and Michael Darr are both listed as being between age 26 and 45, married with children under age 10. To date, I have found no direct proven relationship to any of these gentlemen.

Notes for Anna Elizabeth ?:

Elizabeth Derr [Darr] was listed as head of household of the Conrad Darr farm in the 1783 Loudoun County, Virginia Poll Tax records. According to Loudoun County Court records, Elizabeth] must have died before settlement was made on her husband's estate. On June 11, 1787 an Indentured Lease on the 140 acre farm held by George William Fairfax was recorded released to her son Conrad. The deed mentions the son Conrad's wife being Mary and is son Leonard.

Children of Johann Darr and Anna ? are:

- i. Anna Barbara Darr, born Abt. 1752; married Johannes Wolf Abt. 1772 in Middletown Evangelical Lutheran Ch., Middletown, Frederick, MD.
- ii. Anna Margareta Darr, born Abt. 1753; married Christian Furst 08 November 1773 in Evangelical Lutheran Ch., Frederick County, Maryland<sup>31</sup>.

Marriage Notes for Anna Darr and Christian Furst:

Original quotation of 1782 Lutheran Church records of Frederick, Maryland: "Johann Conrad Derr's single Daughter Ann Margareta Derrin, residing on the "Blue Ritsch" in Virginia, married Christian Furst, single son of Johann Furst".

- 16 iii. Conrad Darr, [II], born Bef. 1755 in [?] Pennsylvania or [?] Maryland; died Aft. 1826 in [?] Culpeper County, Virginia; married Mary Warner Abt. 1775 in [?] Frederick County, Maryland.

- v. Maria Barbara Darr, born 03 August 1773; married John Hartness Aft. 09 October 1796 in Loudoun County, VA.

Notes for Maria Barbara Darr:

May have been the daughter of Conrad and Mary Warner Darr. John and Barbara [Anna Barbara] Darr Wolf were recorded witnesses to this person's Baptism. Anna Barbara Wolf could have been an older sister or aunt, records do not indicate which.

**34. Peter Warner<sup>33,34</sup>**, born Abt. 1708 in Palatine State of Germany; died Abt. 1780 in Frederick County, Maryland.

Notes for Peter Warner:

A Peter Warner (sometimes listed as Warnar, Worner, Warnecke & Varner) is found on a list of imports from the Palatines, Germany in 1743 in the book "Pennsylvania German Pioneers" by Ralph Strassburger. They arrived in Philadelphia in October 1743 on the Ship St. Andrew, Robert Brown, Master, from Rotterdam by way of Crewes, England. Peter Warner, age 35, took the Oath of Allegiance to the Province of Pennsylvania on October 7, 1743.

- 17 i. Mary Warner, born Bef. 1755; died Aft. November 1826; married Conrad Darr, [II] Abt. 1775 in [?] Frederick County, Maryland.
