Benjamin Franklin Pruitt was born in 1839, in Polk, Paulding Co. Georgia. He was the seventh of nine children born to Tillman Dixon Pruitt and Diannah Hillsman Farrar. He was named after his father's brother Benjamin Pruitt. Benjamin's parents were school teachers and taught each of the children to read and write except Harriett.

The family had moved from DeKalb Co. to Paulding Co. Georgia in the 1830's and Ben's eldest sister Catherine married there in 1838, before he was born. Sister Martha married in 1843. About 1844, when Ben was five, the Pruitt family moved to Talladega Co. Alabama, where his sister Harriett married in 1846. Benjamin's father, Tillman Dixon Pruitt, died in 1847 when he was eight years old. In 1850, he and five siblings were living with his widowed mother Diannah back in Paulding Co. Georgia.

In the early 1850's the family moved west to Mississippi, where Benjamin and three of his siblings married into the Catlege family. Mother Diannah remarried twice more. Eldest brother William married in 1854 and then moved to east Texas in 1857.

About 1859, Benjamin, age 20, married Mary Jane Catledge, the daughter of James Catledge and Martha Ann Cotton, in Mississippi. Mary Jane, born in Winston Co. Mississippi, was the fourth born of the eight children of James and Martha Catledge. In the mid 1850's the Catledge family moved to Polk Co. Arkansas where the youngest child, Thomas Overton Catlege, was born in 1857. James and Martha Catledge both died in 1858 leaving baby Thomas, only a few months old, and the seven older children orphans with no other family nearby or means of support. The oldest son, Alson Asberry Catlege 17, led his siblings as they all walked back to Winston Co. Mississippi; the older children taking turns carrying baby Thomas. In Winston Co. MS the Catlege's were close neighbors to widow Diannah Pruitt and her family. Ben married Mary Jane Catlege before 1860, and his brother Jesse later married her younger sister Martha "Susie" Catlege. Sister

Thurza Pruitt had married their cousin William McMillan Catledge in 1855. All were listed on the same page of the 1860 Winston Co. Mississippi Census together. Alson Catlege, age 20, was listed with four of his younger siblings: Martha (Susie) 14, Sarah 12, Harriet E. 10, Thomas 3. Ben 23, and Mary Jane Catlege Pruitt 16, lived in the household of his mother Dianna Pruitt.

Later Ben and Mary Jane took over raising her youngest brother Thomas Overton Catlege, and he later married Martha Dianne Pruitt, daughter of Ben's brother Joseph in 1884. Benjamin and Mary Jane moved to Choctaw Co. Mississippi and the first three of their eight children were born in Mississippi.

Benjamin, at age 22, was conscripted for service by the Confederate States Army in Mississippi to fight in the Civil War. A few months after being conscripted Ben was told his wife Mary Jane and child[ren] had died. Ben deserted the Southern Army and surrendered to the Union Army. He took the Oath of Allegiance to the United States, and stayed in the north for three or four years. After a short time there he went through a marriage ceremony with Martha Frances Huddleston on June 20, 1864 in Robertson Co. Tennessee which was technically bigamy. He and Martha had two daughters. After the close of the war Benjamin deserted them when he learned Mary Jane was alive, and returned to his legal wife and resumed where he left off. He kept his second family a secret for many years until it was revealed by accident.

About 1867 Ben and Mary Jane moved to Texas with their children, James 5, Anna 3, and Ben, Jr. 2, and Mary Jane's brother Thomas 9. They went down the Mississippi River across the Gulf of Mexico and up the Sabine River on a boat. They settled in Hopkins Co. Texas, and on the neighboring farm lived Ben's sister Martha L. Wilson and her family.

Benjamin's nephew, William Malone Pruitt Jr., was elected Justice of the Peace in Camp Co. Texas. The local paper, the Pittsburg Weekly Gazette, once printed Ben's name and address in regards to some Justice Court proceedings. Somehow Ben's daughters in the north saw the paper and wrote to Bill Jr. at the address listed in the newspaper, explaining about their search for their father. Bill Jr. mailed them his uncle Benjamin's address. The daughters wrote to Benjamin and arranged to visit and meet with him. They both arrived in east Texas and Benjamin acknowledged and accepted them as his own children.

After the war Benjamin was known to have been very critical of war. He frequently used the old saying, "War is a rich man's war and a poor man's fight." It is also known that he took no part in the Old Soldiers Reunions, as did his brother Jesse.

Before 1890 Benjamin and Mary Jane had moved to Greer Co. Oklahoma. He filed on land one and half miles north of Reed, on the east side of the road. This made him the neighbor on the east of his nephew, Berry Ponder (son of sister Catherine and John P. Ponder). Deceased brother Joseph's daughter, Martha Dianne Pruitt, and her husband Thomas Overton Catlege (Mary Jane's brother) would go by wagon from their home near Wanette, Pottawatomie Co. to Greer Co. to visit "Uncle Ben" and "Aunt Jane" in 1889. A trip of about 160 miles.

In late November 1901, Benjamin's sister Harriett and her sons Francis Marion Pruett, and Thomas Jefferson Pruett travelled by train to Greer Co. Nephew Thomas J. couldn't get possession of his house from the renter until January 1, 1902, so Thomas J. and his family lived in one room and a shed room on Benjamin's farm for just over a month.

Pictures of Ben taken late in life show that he, like his brothers William and Jesse, had thinning white hair and long white beards. One day when Mary Jane was gone from home Ben thought how funny it would be to shave his beard and greet Jane when she came home. When she arrived Ben hid behind a little bush in the yard, he jumped out and caught hold of her and nearly scared her to death. She didn't recognize him and told Ben he could just start growing him another beard because he didn't look good to her without it.

Benjamin died at his farm home on January 7, 1906 and was buried in an unmarked grave in the north center of the original Reed Cemetery Plot. In 1922 his brother Jesse was buried on one side of him and his widow, Mary Jane on the other. Years later, Haskell Lloyd Pruett (1902-1988), the son of Thomas Jefferson Pruett, placed markers on the graves of his grandmother Harriett Elizabeth Pruett's two brothers, Benjamin Franklin Pruitt and Jesse Carter Farrar Pruitt.

(According to Tennie Pruitt Coaley, Ben and Mary Jane are buried in Greenville, Texas. Ben is at Reed Cemetery, but Mary Jane isn't listed at Reed, is she in TX?)

B. F. Pruitt, Jr. sold land on quick claim to J. A. Pruitt, O. W. Pruitt, and F. L. Sweet for \$1.00 in August 1907 and in 1909 selling land to Amanda J. Sadler and M. J. Pruitt for \$1.00.

The 1910 census lists Benjamin Jr., Della, and Mary Jane, Ben's mother, living in Greer Co., Oklahoma.

October 22, 1910, Book 46, page 310, Benjamin Franklin Pruitt, Jr. sold all of his undivided interest in Section 12, township 5, for \$1500 to D. V. Pruitt. The property had a mortgage of \$500 to F. G. Barlow which grantee agrees to pay my share. The notary was Percy Powers.

Della V. Pruitt and Benjamin Franklin Pruitt, Jr. sold land in Section 12 for \$1 to A. W. Givens on February 8, 1911.

Della filed for divorce from Ben on January 12, 1913 in Greer Co. Oklahoma. According to the divorce document No. 2255, Della married Benjamin Franklin Pruitt, Jr. in Wellington, Texas, on 17 August 1903.

(Marriage certificate says 27 Aug. 1903). Census records show Della had been married before and the divorce papers stated she owned 59 head of cattle, 4 head of horses and mules, reasonably worth the sum of \$1200.00 which she turned over to her husband after their marriage. Della said she married

Benjamin without previous knowledge that he had been institutionalized in Norman, Oklahoma for an unsound mind. Ben, Jr. was in and out of institutions and that on May 16, 1913 he was returned after having escaped 19 January 1913. The divorce papers show him institutionalized at (Fort) Supply, Oklahoma when papers were drawn up. Della claimed that Benjamin had not supported her and had disposed of all property they had owned. She also claimed that he had sold the land that they lived on, but she had been able to secure the farm back. (Records show the land described in the divorce document to be the homestead property of Benjamin Franklin Pruitt, Sr.; a Benjamin F. Pruitt filed on land March 27, 1901, HE WSE & E2SW, Section 8, township 7N, range 26W, 160 acres, Cert. 6861M. F. C. 588 Lawton-Nov 2, 1906.)

On the July 7, 1942 Ben, Jr. signed an affidavit for the birth certificate of his brother, Joseph Asberry Pruitt in Beckham Co., Oklahoma.

Funeral records of the Fatheree-Albert Funeral Home of Erick, Oklahoma, shows his date of birth as 5 October 1863. His residence was Erick, Oklahoma, but he died in Elk City, Oklahoma. His parent's names were listed as B. F. and Mary Pruitt. He was married in 1903 in Mangum, Oklahoma (marriage certificate and divorce papers show Wellington, TX). He married Della Bliss, but she was no longer living. He had no children. He was a member of the Church of Christ. Relatives shown are: Mrs. A. O. Sweet- sister; Mrs. Parlie Ponder-sister of Heaton, Okla.; Joe Pruitt of Albuquerque, New Mexico; Oscar Pruitt of San Antonio, Texas. The minister was W. H. Whrye. Pall bearers were: Cal Prather, Dolf Velvin, Floyd Crawford, Memory Sprouls, Earl Hobbs, and Marvin Balkman. It was signed by Mrs. A. O. Sweet of Erick, Oklahoma.

THOMAS OVERTON CATLEGE'S STORY OF HIS LIFE written March 1944:

"My full name is Thomas Overton Catledge (Catlege), and I was born in Polk Co., Arkansas, March 29, 1857, so that I will be 87 years old within a few days. I do not know when my first ancestors came to America, but as far back as I know anything about them, they were of old southern stock, my parents having emigrated from Mississippi to Arkansas a few years before I was born.

When I was fourteen months old my father died, and four months later my mother passed away. My married sister, Mary Jane Pruitt, then took me to raise and not long after the death of my parents, my sister and her husband moved back to the home community in Mississippi where we lived until I was twelve years of age. They pulled up stakes and went west, this time to Texas, settling in Montague Co., then on the fringe of western settlement. Some farming was done there at that time and a little farther west the expansive Texas prairies were devoted almost exclusively to cattle raising, large ranches being 20 miles across.

Our new home in Texas was near the old Chisholm cattle trail, just south of the Red River crossing where it crossed from Texas into the Indian Territory. I have seen thousands of head of cattle driven up the trail on their way to railroad points in Kansas, as there were no railroads that far west in Texas at that time. The cattle would be started on the trail in the spring as soon as grass was big enough to sustain them and grazed through the Indian Territory to points on the Santa Fe Railroad in Kansas, from where they were shipped to the eastern markets. It must be remembered that at that time there were no white settlements in what afterwards became known as Oklahoma, and both Oklahoma Territory and the Indian Territory were then spoken of as the Indian Country. Though the cattle would often leave their winter range in Texas in poor condition, they would arrive at the Kansas shipping points two or three months later fat enough for market.

Some of these immense herds would number several thousand head, mostly longhorns, and would take several hours to pass a given point. Where the grass was good, the herd was driven leisurely through Montague County, Texas, and crossed Red River at the western edge of the Chickasaw Nation just below where the little town of Ryan, Oklahoma, is now.

When I was seventeen years old, I thought I was old enough to make my own way in the world, so left the home of my sister and brother-in-law. I worked for wages on farms and ranches awhile and in 1884 made a crop with a boyhood friend, John Richardson, who had married a few years before. We made a good crop that year and on Christmas Day, 1884, I was married to Martha (Pruitt-Ponder). If we both live until next Christmas, we will have been married sixty years. That is a long time for a woman to live with one man, but personally I have never seen the woman I preferred to that little girl I married in Texas so long ago."

Martha Dianne Pruitt, at age three, remembered her father, Joseph Waters Pruitt, coming home from the Civil War shortly before he died. She told her second great granddaughter, June Nack, she remembered he was hobbling on crutches or a cane. Joseph had been injured on August 17, 1863 in battle. She was told he walked home from the hospital in Rome, Georgia to Winston Co. Mississippi and died soon after (November 18, 1863).

Martha Dianne married Thomas Ponder, son of Berryman Shumate Ponder on September 10, 1877, in Camp Co., Texas. They became parents of three sons. Tragically in 1883 Martha's husband and all three of her sons succumbed to measles leaving young Martha, at age 23, a childless widow.

On Christmas Day, 1884, Martha married Thomas Overton Catlege (brother of Mary Jane Catlege-Pruitt who married Benjamin Franklin Pruitt). They were married over 63 years and had eight children. Martha and her husband were first cousins, once removed.

Martha recalled that when her husband, Thomas Catledge, went to Oklahoma City to file his claim to the land, he rode horseback and took all their money, \$14. The cost of filing was \$14.50 and rather than ask for the \$.50, he rode to his home, harvested a cotton crop and returned.

The county was very wild and abounded with wolves, mountain lions, and rattlesnakes. She had running water, but it was at a spring a quarter of a mile away. Then she told how she would tie her baby to a bedpost and run to the spring for water--carrying a pail on each hand and another on her head. Once while working in a field she left two small children on a pallet. A rattlesnake approached them, and she resolutely chopped it to pieces with a hoe.

Thomas Overton Catlege and Martha Dianne Pruitt Catlege would go by wagon from their home near Wanette, Pottawatomie Co. to Greer Co. to visit "Uncle Ben" and "Aunt Jane." (Benjamin Franklin Pruitt and Mary Jane Catledge). A trip of about 160 miles in 1889.

On her 100th birthday, she was ask what she found to be important in life. Her words of wisdom were, "Having a fine, healthy family is first. Then good health, good friends, and always having something, a quilt, a pillow, clothing, or some meat or garden stuff to divide with those who had burnouts or other misfortunes."

In 1963, at the age of 103, Martha Dianne Catlege sat down with her grandson Daymon Catlege and from memory told him birthdates and marriage dates of her parents, Joseph Waters Pruitt and Melinda Elizabeth Blanton, and of grandparents, Diannah Hillsman Farrar and Tillman Dixon Pruitt. (This is the only known source of the marriage date of Diannah Hillsman Farrar and Tillman Dixon Pruitt as February 25, 1822)

She was a roly-poly little grandmother, about as wide as she was tall. Had her wits about her up the day she died. She never spent a day in the hospital and used her fathers walking cane in her later years. She died during the night while visiting her son Oscar Overton Catlege and his wife Naomi at their home in Lexington, Oklahoma on June 22, 1965, just short of her 105th birthday. She lived to be 104 years, 8 months, and 25 days old. Martha Dianne Pruitt Ponder Catlege is buried at Wanette, Oklahoma Cemetery next to her mother Malinda Elizabeth Blanton-Pruitt-Avant.

Seeking documentation for family legend:

There is a grave in Ward Branch Cemetery (Somervell County) that is supposed to be that of a Mr. WHITE, who was hanged for stealing a horse in the mid to late 1870s. He was the second husband of Zelfhia/Zilphia [PUGH] LINDSEY (1840-1901), who is buried at White (Baptist) Church Cemetery near Glen Rose.

Can anyone verify the story about the man buried at Ward Branch Cemetery?

Based on my research, Mr. WHITE was Absalom Turner WHITE, b. c1822 in SC. He first married Salena PRICE, 19 Nov 1844 in Benton (now Calhoun) Co., AL, and moved to Smith Co., TX, before 1850. By 1860, the couple had moved to neighboring Henderson County, settling in an area near the PUGH homestead. Salena died apparently in the 1860s, as Absalom appears on the 1870 census of Henderson County with wife, Zilphia. Shortly after the birth of their son, Tignal Turner WHITE (1871-1931), the family moved to what is now Somervell County. They had one other child, Viannie Victoria WHITE (1873-1966), before Absalom's reported date with the hangman. Descendants of Absalom and Zelfhia/Zilphia have generously provided information on these two children.

I primarily am researching the PRICE family and would love to know more about the children of Absalom and his first wife, Salena PRICE:
