King's three children eighty dollars each when they become of lawful age and make their deed to him for their interest in said fifty acre tract on Monyes Run and the said Jeremiah King is to pay Margaret E. King my daughter the sum of three hundred dollars and he is to have all my farming utensils my wagon and harness and my \_\_\_ mare and young horse, my clock and two pare of bedsteads. All the livestock on the place except the cattle which is to be divided between the said Jeremiah King and Margaret E. King to suit themselves and if Elman F. King stays with Jeremiah King till he is twenty one years of age he is to be sent to school in the winter season whenever he can have an opportunity. And when he becomes of that age he is to be furnished by Jeremiah King a good young horse saddle and bridle with good and decent wearing appeal. And to pay to my son Thomas P. King fifty dollars at some convenient time in the settling of my estate and also the said Jeremiah King is to pay to John S. King five dollars and the said Margaret E. King is to have my young mare and two pare of bedsteads. The above named property is given and bequeathed to the aforesaid persons to their heirs and assigns forever. And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint Jeremiah King executor of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all other former wills or testaments by me heretofore made in witness whereof I hereunto set my hand and affix my seal this nineteenth day of June 1859

Notes for John King:

John and his family moved from Maryland to Monongalia County, VA sometime between 1797 and 1803. This is derived from the information about his known children. The youngest, Comfort was born 1796-1798. All of John's known children were married in Monongalia County, VA between 1803-1826. All of his children listed Maryland as their place of birth during the 1850 census. Comfort's marriage, in 1826, was bonded by her brother-in-law, John Cunningham. John King, his wife, and his daughter Comfort King were counted in the 1820 Federal census for Monongalia County, VA (page 53). John's son, John (Jr.), was counted on the same page, next line of the 1820 Monongalia Co. census. John (Jr.) moved to Tyler Co. in 1824. John King (Sr.) could not be found living anywhere in VA for the 1830 census. No information is known about the spouse of John King.

There were two John King marriages listed in Monongalia county. One was in 1811 to Elizabeth Shaw. The other was in 1816 to Mary Elizabeth Floyd. One of these was assuredly the marriage of his son. This would indicate that there were two John Kings of about the same age with sons named John, all living in Monongalia county. Another possibility is that one of the John King marriages was a remarriage of John King (Sr.).

There is a record that he purchased 100 acres on January 23, 1789 from William and Hannah Slone.

The Last Will & Testament of James Regester/Register dated 8 October 1824, probated 6 March 1833, Will Book #5, pp. 57 & 58, Washington Co., Pa.

The text of which follows, as written:

In the Name of God Amen. I, James Register of Washington county East Bethlehem Township, and State of Pennsylvania being frail in body but perfectly in My Right Mind and Sences, and calling to mind the Mortality of my Boddy and that it is appointed for all ment to die, believeing it to be my duty to settle my Estate both Real and personal I ordain and make this My Last will and testament, after Committing My soul to God who gavit it and my Body to Receive a Decient Burial, as to My Wordly goods which God has endowed Me with, I Bequeathe as follows, Viz. First after my decease the espences to be paid, My will is that My well beloved Wife Mary Register Shall have all my Real Estate at My Decease also one horse and one Cow and Such houshold furniture as She maythink propper to keep.=  
to my Son Joseph I bequeath one horse and one Cow. and sixe Sheep and all the farming utentials, the Remaining part of the horses Cows Sheep hogs or Stock to be Equally Devided among my other sixe Children, John, Hannah, Aaron, Sarah, William, & James Register. My will is at the Death of my bloved Wife that my Real Estate Shall be my Son Josephs. If he Should decease before My beloved Wifes Death, and without an Heir, then, my Son James to have the place on My Real Estate, but Should My Son Joseph Live untill after his Mothers Death then he is to have the Real Estate, and is to pay forty Dollars yearly for Sise years that is to Say forty Dollars to, John, the first. year, and at the End of the Second year forty to Hannah, and so on year after year, untill the Sisc, Children has Each of them gotten forty Dollars apeace - then Returning, back, to John again, at the End of the Seventh year, and pay himm forty Dollars more, and soon yer by year, untill. Each one of the Chil!dren Receive Eighty Dollar, which amounts unto four hundred and Eighty Dollar in the Whole - and will take - make twelve years to Bring the payments Round But Should the place or Real Estate fell into my Son James hands on account of the Death of Joseph, without an heir, then my Son James is to pay four hundred and Eighty Dollars to the Remaining five Children. Ecactly in the Same Manner, and payments that My Son Joseph, was to - do - had he Lived - it is my will and pleasure to Constute - My Son Aaron and William Register Escuteors to fullfil all my wishes as tousching there things.
