Sanders, of the Pittsburgh Conference, whose critical illness was announced in last week's Recorder, passed away on Tuesday morning, November 3, and the funeral service in the home, at 110 Locust Street. Etna, was held on Thursday evening, November 5, and a final service in the old home church at Bakerstown. We pay editorial tribute to this highly gifted minister elsewhere in these pages; but the best tribute a departing preacher of the Word can receive was heartily given him in the united testimony of his fellow-ministers at the funeral service, and in the many tokens of friendship and love from those to whom he had so faithfully ministered.
