Notes for Lena Ethel QUINN:

On Tuesday, November 2, 1993, Lena was a passenger in a car driven by a friend, Lorene JONES, when Lorene fell unconscious at the wheel. In the parking lot of the Hook's Drug Store in French Lick, her car struck four other vehicles before coming to a stop. Both women were transported to Orange Co. Hospital where Lorene was pronounced dead. Lena was transferred to Jasper Memorial Hospital, and later still to St. Mary's Medical Center in Evansville, IN, by Lifeflight helicopter.

From the accident until her death, in 1997, she was in and out of St. Mary's. She was able to maintain her own apartment for a while, with added precautions, but finally had to give it up and maintain a residence with George and Vicki LAGENOUR in Evansville.

According to Bernadine VOYLES Montgomery of Lincoln, IL, as of July 1974, John and Elizabeth came to IN in 1812 and settled in Farabee Station, about three miles northeast of Pekin. His brothers, Jacob and Joseph, also came at this time. John entered land in Madison Twp. in 1829.

Johann (John) was the only Laughenour(sp?) in Washington Co., IN, in the 1830 Census.

John was in Vernon Twp., Washington Co., IN, during the 1840 IN Census.

"The Daniel LOCKENOUR farm was located one mile north of Fredericksburg. In 1969, Raleigh ELLIS took us to the farm. A barn is all that remains of the LOCKENOUR buildings. At that time, the old farm and some adjoining acres were owned by aman from Louisville, KY. An 1860 map of Washington Co., IN, shows Daniel in ownership.

"At the time of Mary's death, all the children were married except Rebecca and James Grover. HARMON remembered grandpa living with them for a while when he was a boy. He said that Grandpa liked whiskey -- he bought it by the jugful. Daniel spent his last years at

Lawndale, IL, with his son, William. Linus Boyles remembers that he went to Daniel's funeral and that he died from consumption. Indications are that he is buried in Lawndale Cemetery in an unmarked grave. "

These quotes came from Bernadine VOYLES Montgomery.

Seven of their children moved to Illinois. One lived Edgar Co., the others in Logan Co., IL. The ones who lived in Logan Co. are buried with their spouses in the Lawndale Cemetery.

According to records of the village of Friedland, NC, George was the man who surveyed the land and the lots. The LAGENOUR's had been visited by Moravian or Brethren missionaries while in the Broadbay colony and gladly joined them in North Carolina.

As a resident of Surry Co., N.C. during the Revolutionary War, Jacob served as a militiaman. He applied for and received a pension in Stokes Co., N.C. (Pension File #S-7129)

Moravian records have Jacob already a widower when he married Julianna ROMINGER.

"In 1770, Jacob, along with his brother, George, and their mother and step-father, moved from Broadbay to North Carolina. They left Boston in mid-August. Their schooner ran aground off Roanoke Island and they lost all their possessions. They reached Wilmington, NC, in another schooner. From there, they came up the Cape Fear River to Cross Creek (now Fayetteville) and then by land to Bethabara, NC. Early in 1771, the Broadbayers decided upon a site for a new settlement six miles south of Salem, NC. They named their town, Friedland."

According to research by Al LAGENOUR, they arrived in Broadbay, Maine in the week prior to 18 Oct 1753 on the ship Elisabeth as

Hans Georg Lauchnauer (naismith, age 31, originally from Bauschlot)
Sophia Saloma Lauchnauer (wife, age 19)
Jacob Friederich Lauchnauer (son, age 1 1/2)

According to Al's research, the surname, Lauchenauer, comes from the place name Langenau, e.g. a person from the town of Langenau in Canton Thurgau, Switzerland, confirming a theory. It seems the family was new to the area of Durlach before they emigrated to America. Originally the family probably came from Switzerland. The earliest ancestor on this family that he and others he's in contact with have found is a Jacob Lauchenauer, a pig herdsman, who died and was buried 3 Aug 1748 in Konigs. Evidence show two children:

- 1) Johann Christian, also a pig herder. He married 14 July 1749, to Anna Margretha Kautzen, daughter of the BAKER, Wilhelm Kautzen, in Konigsbach, Baden, Germany.
- 2) Johann Georg, a nailsmith

Al also cites a possible third child, a Jakob LACHENAUER, listed in the book, "Swiss Emigrants in the Kraigau" which he feels may give us more information on the Swiss family connections. He states that the Lauchenauer/Lauchenauer was quite prominent in Schlatt parish (District of Diesenhofen, Switzerland.)

Notes for John H. DERRICK:

John and wife, Mary, in 1782, moved from PA to Shenandoah Co., VA, to a plot of 400 acres about two miles north of Forestville, VA. (Botetourt Co., VA.) His brother, Jacob, had 300 acres nearby. John, his brother, Jacob, and his brother-in-law, Adam Fox, and their families formed a caravan migrating to TN. In 1783, Simon's brother, Jacob and Simon's son, Henry had moved a branch of the family freighting business into the Tennessee frontier. They went down into the eastern edge of what later became Sevier Co., TN. Adam Fox, Jr. and his wife, Elizabeth DERRICK, were found to be living in Sevier Co., TN, by 1786. John DERRICK had hopes of going with some of his family to TN, but failing health prevented him from the trip. John's will was probated on September 14, 1790.

The two sons we're mainly concerned with have been Michael and John. There is a record for the marriage of Michael to Elizabeth Moyer 16 Jun 1789 in Botetourt Co., VA. A 1799 deed exists there showing Michael DERRICK in TN and proving that he was there by that date.

Michael and Elizabeth left Hawkins Co., TN, around 1821, leaving John and John's grandson, Marvel, Sr., in Hawkins Co. as far as anyone can see. Marvel, Sr., was born around 1802, was 18-19 by 1821 and came to marry Nancy ANDERSON. Michael was taxed on 233 ac. in 1809.

Marvel DERRICK, Sr., married Nancy ANDERSON about 1822. No one has found a marriage record. She was born between 1799 and 1803, it seems. While she appeared to get younger every census, she seems to be about one or two years older than Marvel. She undoubtedly came to that marriage either a widow or with an illegitimate son, David DERRICK/ANDERSON, and Marvel became his step-father. David apparently thought quite highly of Marvel and Nancy, naming two of his children after them. He became a well-known Brethren Church minister in Hawkins Co., TN, and remained very close throughout the years. He was administrator of Marvel's estate (Marvel died intestate) and was guardian of Enoch DERRICK, Marvel's underage son. Marvel's heirs are listed in the papers, David not being one of them. His descendants in letters to researchers called him a half-brother to Marvel's children.
