The battle lasted two day's and a night and when they went to get him, he was gone. **Hugh** had been captured as a prisoner of war near **Allentown, Georgia, Oct., 1864** by forces under **Major General William T. Sherman..** **Hugh** was moved to **Camp Chase, Ohio,** arriving there **Oct. 24, 1864.** He died of pneumonia in 1865 at **Camp Chase** and is buried in grave #1908.

During the nineteenth Century, Ben and Melissa's children all lived in or near the community of Cumberland, Ms. Many of the families activities were centered around the local school and the "Marvin Hill" Congregatioal Methodist Church at Cumberland.

Ben, his brother's, James Pierce, and Willis all joined the Confederate Army in 1862. Willis, joined Company B, 31'st Infantry, on Mar.12, 1862 in Choctaw Co., Ms. and sadly, was captured May 17, 1863 near Raymond, Ms. and taken north to the "Infamous" Yankee prison camp, Point Lookout, Maryland" where he died from Chronic diahrrea, on Nov. 7, 1863.

Benjamin and James Pierce, in another division, joining Company G, 35'th Regiment on Apr. 20, 1862, in West Point, Ms., decided they were not cut out for this war, so... on a Troop march to Iuka, Ms. on Sept. 12,1862, Ben and James Pierce came home and apparently were never arrested. There are no records at the Mississippi Archives to indicate they were arrested or punished.

With only one exception, Ben and Melissa's children (seven out of eight) are buried in Marvin Hill Cemetery, Cumberland, Webster Co., Ms. Mary "Stallings" Earnest is the only child not buried at "Marvin Hill".

The story on how James Pierce Stallings died was related to Ruble Alford by his Grandmother; Parthena Ellen "Stallings" Alford, a niece of James Pierce, Seems James Pierce and his neighbor got into an argument over a bucket of molasses. Each was trying to give the molasses to the other and finally got into a deadly argument. James Pierce finally told the neighbor if he ever came on his property again, he would kill him. One day, sure enough, here came the neighbor, carrying a baby, and his wife across James Pierce's barnyard. (Apparently a path ran through the barnyard connecting the neighbor to the main road, or something to that effect.) James Pierce grabbed his gun, ran out on his porch and said, "Put the baby down, I'm gonna kill you!" When he said that, the neighbor's wife reached into a bag she was carrying, pulled out a pistol and shot James Pierce in the stomach. James Pierce turned the gun on the woman, and shot her, killing her instantly, then he sat down on his porch and would not let anyone go to her until he died a few minutes later. No information on what happened to the neighbor and the baby.

In the name of God amen I Samuel Zimmerman of Edgefield Dist., state of South Carolina, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, but weak in body and calling to mind the uncertainty of life and being destined to dispose of all such worldly estate, as it has pleased God to bless me with do make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner following that is to say.

First: I desire that after my death all my debts of funeral expenses be paid out of what I

leave at my decease, not interfering with anything I have here to fore given out to my several children unless the same be needed for said debts, or expenses of account of a deficiency in the balance of my estate at my death.

Secondly: I desire that my daughter Mary Anne Andrews shall have a negro girl named Caroline together with her offspring to my said daughter Mary Anne and her children forever also all other goods or chattels, I have here to for given to my said daughter & forever, And I also desire that my daughter Eliza Spikes shall have a negro girl named Charlotte together her offspring to my said daughter Eliza and her offspring forever also all other goods or chattels, I have here to fore given to my said daughter & forever.

Thirdly: I desire that after my death, my wife Margaret Zimmerman shall have all my residue of my estate after my just debts and funeral expenses are paid and excepting that here in before willed to my several children, as well real as personal, for and during the term of my said wife, natural life and if she fails to make a support for the place then hire out such of the negro's as she can best do without or sell such other property as can be spared to make said wife to support the place and after my wife's death all the property left her, her lifetime {except she may have sold something in aiding her to make a support then except that been sold according to directions} shall be sold to the highest bidder and the proceeds of sale after giving to my several daughter's the following sum's of money to them and their children forever; to wit: Mary Anne Andrew four hundred dollar's, Eliza Spikes four hundred dollar's, Melinda Zimmerman four hundred dollar's, Sarah Charles four hundred dollar's, Martha Seigler four hundred dollar's.

Also I will to release my son George S. Zimmerman from all judgments I the said testor hold against the said George S. Zimmerman and the balance of the proceeds of sale after my wife's death to be equally divided between my several children here in before named forever or any of them be dead their share to go to those legally entitled to the same.

FREDERICK SCHAFFER, born in Germany in 1729, removed to London where he paid his passage for America on Captain Bogg's ship. He landed at Savannah, Ga. and on Mar.7,1750, was granted 50 acre's (indicating that he was unmarried at the time of his arrival) between Broad and Saluda River's in South Carolina, a short distance southeast of Saint Peter's Lutheran Church. He served in the American Revolution in South Carolina (Nat. No. 360793 DAR) and died in 1786. After his arrival in S.C. he married about 1761, Elizabeth, with issue: Frederick (married Magdalena Eickleberger), Rebecca (married John Eargle), and Elizabeth who married John Peter Schumpert. Frederick Shaffer Jr. and his wife Magdalene were God Parent's to John C. Sease who was born 5 Feb.,1796.

In a "History of St. Peter's Lutheran Church (Piney Woods)", Chapin,S.C. compiled by Rev. Verley L. Fulmer, Newberry,S.C. 15 Oct.1944: Frederick Schaffer came to this country on Capt. Boggs' ship. Landed at Savannah and came to the Congarees. He had paid his passage at London. He petitioned for 50 acres of land- - his bounty between Broad and Saluda River's. It was granted Mar.7,1750. Frederick Schaffer died in 1786 and his wife Elizabeth drew his pay for service in the Revolutionary War. His home was a short distance southward of Piney Woods Church. The Schaffer's moved to Greene Co.,Tenn. about 1810. Their only known son was; John Frederick Shaffer, who married Magdalena Eichelberger, later moved to Greene Co., Tenn.! His wife may have died before he left South Carolina. He later settled in Perry Co., Alabama, with 9 children! He was buried at Mt. Hebron Church Cemetery, in Hale Co., Alabama, near

Greensboro, Ala. John Frederick once owned this land where the church and cemetery is today!

Charles Holland was born Apr.2, 1758 in the Netherlands. Sometime prior to 1761, he was brought to the State of Maryland by his parent's. He had two brother's born in Maryland; Jacob Holland born abt. 1761-1763, and Thomas Holland, born in Anne Arundel Co., Maryland on Dec.17, 1763.

These three brother's were soldier's in the Revolutionary War, and served their country in the same South Carolina military.

Though Charles Holland was born in the Netherlands, he taught his children the Dutch language in his home and attended the Dutch reform church in the United States. The name Holland appears to have been of English origin. It is not known how long the

family lived in Holland, but is thought to be their original name and is believed they left England for their religious freedom.

Charles Holland died March 16, 1846, in Choctaw County. He is buried in New Hope Presbyterian Church Cem., formerly located in the northern part of Choctaw County. This area was later cut off to form Sumner County in 1874; in 1882, the name was changed to Webster County by which name the county is now known.

Charles Holland was known as a brave soldier in the Revolutionary War and he carried to the grave the scars of three wounds which he received fighting for our liberties. He enlisted in September 1776, about 35 miles from the town of Ninety-Six District (now in Greenwood County, South Carolina). He served as a private in the company commanded by James McCall, Andrew Pickens, Thomas Weems, and Joseph Pickens, for seven years, throughout the war. The battles in which he participated were some of the most sanguinary and hard fought campaigns of the Revolutionary War.

In 1776 and 1777, he fought the Tories at Ninety-Six, South Carolina, and on Feb. 11, 1778, his unit fought the Tories and the Cherokee Indians at Vann Creek, Georgia. It was in this battle that his brother, Jacob Holland, was wounded in the left knee with a rifle ball, and as a result, was incapacitated for the remainder of his life. Thomas, the other brother, also fought in this battle.

From June 20, 1780, until Oct. 7, 1780, he took part in the battles of Ramsour's Mill, North Carolina, the Battle of Hanging Rock, South Carolina (where he was injured in the groin by a gunshot) and the Battle of Kings Mountain, where the American Patriots won a glorious victory that has been called the turning point of the Revolutionary War.

Then came the Battle of Williams Fort, captured Dec. 29, 1780, and the Battle of Hammond's old store in South Carolina; also the Battle of Cowpens. It was here that Charles received a sword thrust into his side, the point breaking against his hip bone, an injury from which he never fully recovered, even though he lived to be 88. Many class the battle of Cowpens as the most decisive of the entire Revolutionary War. At the Bullock's plantation, near Ninety-Six, South Carolina, as the Tories staged a surprise attack, he lost many of his personal possessions as the Patriots retreated. The State of South Carolina compensated him for the loss of his saddle and blanket when he applied for payment in 1783.

From May thru July 1781 the three brothers were engaged in this same battle, the Siege of Ninety-Six, against the British forces, occupying that place. This marks the last recorded major action in which he took part during the Revolutionary War, although his services did not end until the close of the war in 1783.

Charles settled in the South Carolina vicinity and married Sarah Hughs, daughter of James Hughs and Catherine Prothro. Catherine died in Abbeville County, South Carolina in 1804.

To this union seven children were born, all apparently near the town of Ninety-Six.

I, Henry Zimmerman, being sick and weak in body but of perfect mind and memory. First I will that just debt's and funeral expenses be Paid. I give to my beloved wife Mary one mare, side saddle and bridle, one feather bed and furniture. I also lend to her four negro'es, Tom, Sarah, Annis, and her child Ame, until my youngest son become the age of 21 year's old, she to pay for maintence and schooling of my children, I give to my son's Samuel and Henry all my land I possess, I also give to my son Samuel, one cow and calf. I give to my daughter's; Mary, Nancy, Betsy and Susan 40 pounds sterling and one feather bed and furniture each. I also give my eldest daughter Mary one cow and calf when she comes the age of 18. I direct that the remaining part of my negro'es be hired out by the year and the money and the money for the portion I gave my daughter's and the remaining part of my estate to be sold by then my son Henry should come of age. Should any daughter die their share to be divided among the survivor's, likewise with the son's. I appoint my beloved wife Mary executrix and John Shively and my son Samuel Executor's. Wit: Abner Perrin, Turner Harris, and William Perrin, Stephen Mantz (wrote in Dutch). Signed Henry Zimmerman Proved in open Court by the oath of William Perrin (son of George Perrin) March Term 1799 and ordered to be recorded.. clk.
