The east half of the N.W. 1/4 of Section 33, Twp. 21, Range 6 in the District of the land's sold at Cahaba containing 79 acre's, Also two other tract's or parcel's of land laying in the county and state of Perry Co., the west half of the S.W. 1/4 of Section 33, also 80 acre's in the N.W. corner of the east half of the S. W. 1/4 of Section 33, Twp. 21, Range 6.

That same year, 1837, Adam Shaffer and his wife's uncle Caleb Russell Jr. bought a whole section of land in Oktibbeha Co., (now Clay Co.,) Miss.

Some recollections of Clarence Smith as told to him by his Grandfather:

Matthew was hurt during the war by a shelter falling on his shoulder which gave him trouble the rest of his life.

The closet he came to being killed was a bullet went through his whiskers.

He knew for sure that he killed one Yankee during the war. They were sharpshooting in the some woods with Matthew Smith hidden behind a clay root (a turned-up tree) and the Yankees behind a tree. The Yankee blinded Matthew with dirt from a shot. He then was able to get a bead on the Yankee, and after he fired, he saw the Yankee pitch forward. Later at camp one of Matthew Smith's comrades told his Company, "Ol' Matt got one today". Granddaddy Smith felt bad the rest of the day about it.

He talked more about the battle at Vicksburg than any other. That was the hardest one on him. The toughest fighting was done in Georgia. He fought on Lookout Mountain on the Tennessee - Georgia line. He was also in the Atlanta Campaign.

Matthew was buried in the Pleasant Valley United Methodist Church Cemetery, Hale Co., Alabama. He was buried on Mar. 21, 1923.
