Robert E. Lee was born 1807 in Virginia, the son of Lighthorse Harry

Lee , a military commander. Robert was educated at the U.S. Military Academy . He received a commission as a 2nd Lieutenant on his graduation in 1827 . After distinguishing himself during his service, he was appointed as the Superintendent of the Military Academy. He was commanding the Department of Texas in 1860. He was offered a field command of Union forces, but he declined. Three days after Virginia seceded, Lee resigned from the U.S. Army. He became the military advisor to Jefferson Davis, President of the Confederacy, and later Commanded the Virginia Military forces.

Robert E. Lee was made commander of all Confederate armies in February 1865. He eventually surrendered to General Ulysses S. Grant at Appomattox.

"At a little before 4 o'clock General Lee shook hands with General Grant , bowed to the other officers, and with Colonel Marshall left the room . One after another we followed, and passed out to the porch.

Lee signaled to his orderly to bring up his horse, and while the animal was being bridled the general stood on the lowest step and gazed sadly in the direction of the valley beyond where his army lay - now an army of prisoners . He smote his hands together a number of times in an absent sort of way; seemed not to see the group of Union officers in the yard who rose respectfully at his approach, and appeared unconscious of every thing about him. All appreciated the sadness that overwhelmed him, and he had the personal sympathy of every one who beheld him at this supreme moment of trial. The approach of his horse seemed to recall him from his reverie, and he at once mounted. General Grant now stepped down from the porch , and, moving toward him, saluted him by raising his hat. He was followed in this act of courtesy by all our officers present; Lee raised his hat respectfully, and rode off to break the sad news to the brave fellows whom he had so long commanded." --Gen. My aunt who died in 1960 corresponded with these Taylors and even visited them on occasion. The tree lists Armstead as the son of Charles and Nancy Taylor. I realize this tree is not documented and we know there are mistakes on it but believe this to be true.
2. I received from Betty Frain, a professional genealogist in Loudoun County Virginia, the two Descendant Charts I have attached. An email from her is also attached.
3. I copied notes my mother has from her mother (Rhoda Taylor Marion) that listed Charles B. Taylor and Nancy as the parents of Armstead.
4. This following is a portion of an email I received from a lookup volunteer for Loudoun County, VA: "I found no marriage for Charles Taylor but Charles Taylor secured bond for marriage of James Hill and Hannah Taylor 1 July 1809. Also, secured bond for marriage of Ruth Hannah Taylor, his daughter, and John H. Greenleaf 12 Jan 1846." I believe Hannah Taylor to be the sister of Charles.
5. 1850 Loudoun Co. Federal Census has a Charles Taylor age 61 (born about 1789) and wife Nancy age 63 (born about 1787) - right ages to be Armstead's parents born 1818.
6. Family lore that 11 Taylor brothers came to America in the mid to late 1600. Benjamin settled in Bucks Co., PA before migrating to Frederick Co., MD, and then Loudoun Co., VA.

I know I have more but this is all I can think of now and did want to get this to you before the weekend.

Charles is a brick-wall, as you can read in the email from Betty Frain. No one has been able to prove his father is Timothy - yet! In the 1960-1970s my cousin's husband also researched the Taylors and found the same

brick wall. Someday I hope to go to Loudoun County to do research.

Do you have any info on Nancy Jane Barrett, wife of Armstead?

Hope you will share what information you have.

Do you belong to any Rootsweb email lists. I find the Loudoun County list to be especially helpful and interesting. The Taylor list can get a bit confusing at times but still helpful.

The cornerstone of the White House, located at 1600 Pennsylvania Avenue, in Washington DC, was laid on October 13, 1792. James HOBAN, an Irish architect, designed the structure, which has three stories and more than 100 rooms.

President John ADAMS and his family were the first to occupy the 'Presidential Palace' as it was known, taking residency in November, 1800. The White House was burned by British troops in 1814. It was reconstructed by 1817.

In his book, "Across the Plains", my great grandfather, Henry TAYLOR, said that his people lived in Alexandria, Virginia and witnessed the burning of the White House from across the Potomac, River.

Quotes from Valerie Larson's "Taylor Book":

Thomas TAYLOR3 was a Methodist minister.

Reverend Thomas TAYLOR lived in Virginia, met and married a wealthy planter's daughter, Penelope RICHARDS. Her father was a slave holder. Their son, my great grandfather, Henry TAYLOR remembered being carried to school through the snow 'piggy back' by the slave that was given to Thomas and Penelope for a wedding present. Her father also had silver dollars melted to have her wedding silverware made.

Griffie TAYLOR was a brother of Henry TAYLOR and he was killed in the war of 1812. Thomas TAYLOR4 was another brother of Henry TAYLOR. He married and had one child Bessie TAYLOR. She married John HICKSON, a Nevada sheep rancher. John HICKSON also had a silver mine and was said to be the third richest man in Nevada. There is a mountain and a mountain pass named after him.

Inform you of Joseph's death, he died last October. Mary is well. Henry Thomas is not much account. Ian (?) is a number one boy and is a great comfort to Lizzie.

Once we were all together in one sweet home circle. First of all your mother. You are gone. Thomas is gone farther. And Griffith farther and farther. And Albert too is gone.

Henry how can I help feeling a sorrow akin to anguish. Charles is not now or never was much company for me.

Charles has another boy making six in all.

Lee has been in Iowa all summer and fall.

I suppose you heard that Hazelton has triumphantly made the riffle at last. Tom Lecum (?) bitter opposition notwithstanding.

Wish you would write to your Aunt Sally. Her last letter informed me of the death of two of my sisters, Polly and Nancy. I have only two left out of seven of us. Only three of us are lingering on the shore.

"Marriages of Loudoun County, 1757-1853" by Mary Alice Wertz: "Loudoun County was formed from Fairfax County, which was primarily Truro Parish, in 1757. In October 1748, Truro was divided at Difficult Run and the upper part became Cameron Parish. When Loudoun was created, its boundaries were essentially those of Cameron Parish; on the north it was bounded by the Potomac River; on the south by Prince William County (which later became Fauquier); on the east by Difficult Run; and on the west by the Blue Ridge Mountains. In 1770, Shelburne Parish was created from the western part of Cameron and included, generally, the land west of Goose Creek running to the Blue Ridge"

Henry Taylor wrote a book, "Across the Plains", about himself and his two brothers that went from Wisconsin to California during the gold rush of 1849-1851. Henry Taylor came back through the Isthmus of Panama and was caught in a hurricane off the coast of Panama and almost lost his life. The name of the ship was the "Northern Lights". The two brothers Edward & Thomas Taylor stayed in California. Henry left San Francisco on November 1853 and landed in New York. Henry returned to Wisconsin, but the winters were too cold and they came to live in Nebraska. He finished his story about the San Francisco, California earthquake (1907) where he went to help his son Frank B. Taylor and his family cope with the aftermath.

Henry married Arminda Eastman on January 1, 1851 in Grant County, Wisconsin. She died in 1894 in Beaver City, Furnace County, Nebraska. They both are buried in Furnace County, Spring Green Township, in the "Keith" family cemetery located north of Norton, Kansas just inside the Nebraska border. Henry lived to the ripe old age of 107 years and is buried beside his beloved Arminda.

Henry Taylor cast his first vote in 1844 for Henry Clay. He cast his last vote for Herbert Hoover at the age of 104 years, the year being 1928. A national magazine picked up the story and they declared him the oldest voter to ever vote, up to that time.

From an interview of Fern Taylor:

"In the spring of 1852 Grandpa left his young family and wife Arminda and infant son Frank and joined a wagon train going to California. Grandpa made him promise to come home in two years whether he struck gold or not. He mined at

Downville on the Feather River. Marysville was the trading post. True to his promise came home in two years. He never got rich but he made a tidy sum of money. They ended up as farmers in Kansas. Grandpa dabbled in politics and was an old time settler. He was well known".

A 70 year Look Back:

A Valentine's Day issue of the 1931 McCook Daily Gazette included an article about Henry TAYLOR (born February 24, 1824 & died July 5, 1931) of Beaver City, Nebraska. He was 107 years old that year.

"Beaver City helped Henry W. TAYLOR celebrate his 107th birthday on February 18, 1931. He was born at Leechburg, Virginia, in 1824. He first voted for Henry CLAY for President (of the USA).

Because of a defective leg he was unable to take part in the Mexican or the Civil War, but was able to go west in the California Gold Rush of 1849. Although he lived in Atwood, Kansas with a daughter (Louise Arminda TAYLOR PRIDEAUX MEYERS), Henry spent much of his life in Nebraska and in Beaver City, moving there in 1880. He humorously gave part of the credit for his long life to spending so much time in Nebraska. 'To live until he is 110 years', is Uncle Henry's ambition.

He has already seen a century and the amazing changes man has made in that time, but Uncle Henry is not yet tired of living."

Search of the ship called NORTHERN LIGHTS at Rootsweb.com that Grandpa Taylor came home on across the Isthmus of Panama after sewing the gold dust in his belt and tying it around his waist. Edward and his other brother Thomas Taylor stayed in California. Edward Taylor joined the Army and became an officer in the Spanish American War of 1812. Thomas married and had one daughter "Bessie" who married John Hickison who owned land in Utah. There is still a mountain peak in the Atlas called Hickison's Peak, that was named after him. Henry came home to his two year old son Frank. He did not know that Arminda Eastman Taylor was "In the Family way" when he left on his long trek to California.

ACROSS THE ISTHMUS:

Aspinwall (now known as Colon City) is located in Panama and was a US Port. It became a stop over for those coming from the California Gold Rush back to New York or visa versa. Many merchants went to make money by opening shops in Aspinwall.

In 1864 the cost of the trip would be \$250. They would travel by train to New York City where a ship would be waiting to take them west to Aspinwall, Panama (Then part of Columbia). From there they would journey across the Isthmus by train to Panama City and then again by ship to San Francisco and Seattle.

PICTURES FOR BOOK:

Today Saturday January 17, 2003. I received pictures today from Donald Parman, retired History Professor of Purdue University who is writing and publishing Grandpa Henry Taylor's memoirs. They were of Thomas and Penelope Richards Taylor's tombstones in Grant County, Wisconsin. He had also visited Harry Taylor's granddaughter Margaret who had him photograph the quilt that Arminda had made while Henry was in California those two long years. Hope I haven't caused any problems, just thought I'd look Henry and Armin da up, to see if indeed they appeared in the 1880 census, and this is what I found.

This refers to Henry's brother Thomas Taylor who after the three brothers, Henry, Thomas and Edward went to Downyville, California during the "Gold Rush" Henry was the only one who came home to Wisconsin. Edward never married and was Colonel Edward Taylor in the Army during the Civil War and not much is known about Thomas Taylor who stayed and married and lived in Nevada. Our family story was that Henry's wife Armin da Eastman Taylor didn't

know she was expecting a child when they left in their covered wagons. When Henry Taylor returned to Wisconsin he had a two year old son, Frank Buy Taylor born December 03, 1851 at Wingville, Grant County, Wisconsin. Henry returned through the Isthmus of Panama and came up into Boston Harbor on the ship "The Northern Lights".

Thomas Taylor IV born about 1823 in Leesburg, Loudon County, Virginia ; died September 17, 1908 in Austin, Nevada. They had a daughter. She married John Hickison or Hickerson and had only one daughter Elizabeth 'Bessie' Taylor and I believe they were childless.

John Hickison owned silver mines and was a wealthy rancher and had a mountain pass or peak named after him. See Don Parman's note below.

I contacted the Nevada State Historical Society about Thomas Taylor, his wife, their daughter (Bessie Hickison), and her husband (John), and I got an e-mail saying that they had found information on Thomas and his wife and were mailing it to me. I will send it on to you when it arrives.

Mary:

I worked on a few odds and ends this morning. Found a tidbit on John Hickison who married Bessie Taylor, Thomas Taylor's daughter. Thought you might add it to your files. John and Bessie lived in Austin, Nevada but also operated a ranch in the area. In a geographical dictionary by Helen S. Carlson, N E V A D A PLACE NAMES, I found a Hickison or Hickerson Summit on Highway 50 about twenty miles southeast of Austin. The natural feature was named after John Hickison because it was on the way from their home in Austin to their ranch. I checked and to my surprise, the feature is even in my road atlas. I think the ranch was about 20 miles beyond Hickison Summit. This supplements what Henry Taylor says in his autobiography and some correspondence in Valerie Larson's compilation.

All goes well here, especially after Purdue defeated Wisconsin last Saturday.
